"START SPREADING THE NEWS...": The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their longest homestand of the first half with the third of three games against the Cincinnati Reds. The Cardinals are 5-3 on this nine-game homestand against Chicago (2-1), Texas (1-2) and Cincinnati (2-0). The final homestand of the regular season will also feature nine games over 10 games against Chicago-AL, San Francisco and Washington (Sept. 11-20).

"I'M LEAVING TODAY...": Following this afternoon's game against Cincinnati, the Cardinals will fly to New York to begin a six-game road trip over seven days against the Mets (June 9-11) at Citi Field and the Twins (June 12-14) at Target Field. St. Louis will have an open date tomorrow in the Big Apple.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis maintained their position in 2nd place in the National League Central with yesterday's win. They sit 5.0 games back of first place Milwaukee and 1.5 games ahead of Pittsburgh and Chicago. After today, the Cardinals will not play another divisional opponent until July 3 at Wrigley Field against the Cubs.

SWEEP-STAKES: The Cardinals are attempting to pull off their third sweep of the season, completing the trifecta at Houston (April 17-19) and a superfecta at Pittsburgh (April 27-30). The last time the Cardinals swept an opponent at home was Arizona (May 23-25, 2025) and their last sweep of Cincinnati at Busch Stadium came over five years ago April 23-25, 2021.

BIGGER IS...FASTER?: With a stolen base yesterday afternoon, **Jordan Walker** has a theft in three straight games, the first Cardinals player to do so since the speedy **Albert Pujols** April 22-24, 2009 (vs. NYM 2 & vs. CHI). The last time a Cardinals player recorded a stolen base in four straight games was **Cesar Izturis** (Sept. 20-23, 2008).

30-30?: **Jordan Walker** matched both his single-season highs in stolen bases (10) and home runs (16) yesterday, and did it in just the 62nd game of the season. With 100 games to go, Walker would need 14 home runs and 20 stolen bases to become the first Cardinals player with a 30-30 season in franchise history. He is currently on pace for 42 HR and 26 stolen bases and joins **James Wood** (WSH) as the only two players this season with 15 HR and 10 SB.

LEAVE'EM LOADED: Through two games of this series, the Cardinals have had eight plate appearances with bases loaded (3-5, 7 RBI, 2 BB, HBP). St. Louis leads all of Major League Baseball with a .425 batting average (17-40) with one grand slam, hit by **Jordan Walker** at Detroit (4/4). The Cardinals previous highest single-season BA with bases loaded was 2020 when they batted .400 (22-55) and in a full season in 2011 (.384, 43-112).

LAST CALL: Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** was brought into the game as a pinch-hitter in the 6th inning yesterday and was intentionally walked with first base open. It was the first time a Cardinals pinch-hitter was intentionally passed since **Brendan Donovan** at Boston (5/13/2023). Nootbaar hit the go-ahead home run in the 8th inning, making him the first player in MLB with an intentional walk and a home run in reserve role since **Seth Brown** (OAK) vs. LAA (9/3/23) and 1st Cardinal since **Randal Grichuk** vs. TOR (4/27/17-G1).

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Former Reds Executive, the late **Walt Jocketty**, served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06) & one World Series Championship ('06).

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball & coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ.(1995-97).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11)

Reds Asst. Pitching Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.

Justin Bruihl pitched for the Reds Triple-A Louisville affiliate in 2024.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

Bryan Torres made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on May 23, 2026 (G1) ...singled off Chris Paddock for his first MLB hit and homered off Jose Franco.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Senior Advisor **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St. Louis as a professional scout and special assistant.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons (1986-90) with the Cardinals.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julian Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds Senior Advisor **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

TODAY'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old makes his 13th start of the 2026 season today and his 32nd career start (34th career game).
- Is making his 3rd career start against the Cincinnati Reds, his 1st this season; **has a career mark of 2-0 with 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP) in two starts vs. CIN - both in 2025.**
- The Cardinals are 19-12 (.571 win pct.) in his 31 career games started;** the Cardinals have lost his last three games started - something they had not done prior to this season.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 31 career starts, passing **Paul "Daffy" Dean** (29 from 1934-35) for the the longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal.
- Has 12 wins through his first 31 career starts, the most by a Cardinal since **Dakota Hudson** had 16 through his first 31 career starts in 2019.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 19 of 31 career starts, going 11-2 with a 2.04 ERA (27 ER/119.0 IP) in those 19 contests.
- Allowed two runs or fewer in eight of his 12 starts this season.
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 16 of his starts - one shy of **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.
- Has made 17 career appearances (15 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-5 with a 3.64 ERA (94.0 IP).

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, June 1 vs. Texas): L, 2-1: 6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 1 SO, 0 HR; 87 pitches

- Dropped his 3rd-straight decision - a career high - despite recording his 7th Quality Start of 2026.
- it marked his 3rd straight start receiving little to no run support; the Cardinals have lost 7-0, 6-0 & 2-1 during his current losing streak.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

EMPTY HANDED: The Cardinals have scored just one run in his last three games started and were blanked in consecutive starts in 7-0 loss vs. PIT (5/20) and 6-0 defeat at MIL (5/26); they were also shutout 4-0 in his start at DET on 4/3.

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's 4th-lowest percent (20.1) of Swing & Miss; His difference in Opponent BA (.229) vs. xBA (.294) is the largest among all MLB qualified starting pitchers (-.065).

NESTING: Has worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in five of his six home starts this season, and did so in each of his 1st four starts before allowing three runs in his 5/20 start vs. PIT.

HAPPY IT HAPPENED: Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

ONE-HIT WONDER: Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (May 8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

DODGE BALL: Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

THROW IT BACK: Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on April 20, allowing a then season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

CURLY W: Limited Washington to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on April 8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak *as a starter* (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

RARE BIRD: In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the 2nd pitcher in team history with a hitless start within his first 2 starts (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0+ IP. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) had 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

SPRING FLING: Went 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 5 Spring Training starts, striking out 16 to just 2 walks but did allow a team-high 6 HRs. Led MLB with his 4 Spring Training wins and ranked in top 10 in ERA (2.45), Opp. BA (.229) and WHIP (0.98).

McGREEVY vs. CINCINNATI:

- Making his 3rd career start against Cincinnati and his 1st this season; previously faced the Reds on 8/30/25 at Great American Ball Park & 9/16/25 at Busch Stadium.
- Did not strike out a batter over 6.0 innings in his 8/30/25 start at CIN, holding the Reds to one run on five hits; It was a 1st inning run followed by five scoreless innings.
- Fired 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just 3 hits, in a 3-0 win over the Reds on 9/16/25 at Busch Stadium as he matched his 2025 season high for innings pitched.
- Is 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA career vs. the Reds and enters today's game with a 4-3 career mark vs. NL Central teams and a 4.08 ERA in 9 games (46.1 IP).
