RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals wrap up their home slate at Busch Stadium today with the finale of a three-game Interleague series with the AL Central Division Champion Cleveland Guardians  $\ldots$  The Redbirds have gone 4-2 on their Steel Corridor homestand against Pittsburgh (3-1) and Cleveland (1-1) ... Today's home finale marks the earliest St. Louis has wrapped up a home schedule since Sept. 21, 2014 at Busch III and Sept. 21, 2003 at Busch II ... The Cardinals have clinched a winning record at Busch III (42-37, .532) for the 17th time in 19 seasons since the stadium was opened in 2006.

WESTWARD HO: The Cardinals fly west after today's finale for a season-ending six-game road trip through Denver, Colo. (Sept. 24-26) and San Francisco, Calif. (Sept. 27-29) ... For only the second time in franchise history and first time since 1960, St. Louis will start and finish the regular season on the West Coast. - Elias

- The Cardinals started the 1960 season at San Francisco and 1964 and 1984 seasons at the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- St. Louis ended regular seasons in San Francisco twice (1958 and 1960) and once in Los Angeles (1962).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today 1.0 game behind Chicago in 3rd place in the National League Central Division & eliminated from postseason contention ... With seven games remaining, the Cardinals need three more wins to end at .500 and go at least 4-3 for a winning record (82+ wins).

GAMES THAT MATTER: From 2011 Opening Day through the end of this season, the Cardinals will have played 2,142 out of a possible 2,164 regular season games during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated (99.0%).

AN ERA OF EXCELLENCE: It has been 65 years since the Cardinals last experienced back-to-back losing campaigns in full seasons from 1958-59 (excluding seasons shortened by war, work stoppages, or COVID), the 2nd-longest all-time timespan by any franchise of the four major North American sports leagues (MLB, NBA, NFL, & NHL).

- The NHL's Montreal Canadiens hold the record of 80 years between consecutive full losing seasons occurring from 1938-39 to 1941-42 (4 seasons), and then again during the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.
- The Los Angeles Dodgers have the 2nd-longest active streak, last experiencing losing seasons 37 years ago from 1986-87.

THE HEAT IS ON: Happy 63rd birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer and 1985 NL Rookie of the Year Vince Coleman ... Other notables born on this date include former Cardinals Manager and Gold Glove catcher Mike Matheny (54), Cleveland Indians Hall of Fame pitcher Bob Lemon (b. 1920), and Dodgers Hall of Fame Manager Tommy Lasorda ... Happy 29th birthday tomorrow to Cardinals Player Communications Director Melody Yount.

HOLD MY BEER: Andrew Kittredge last night recorded his NL-leading 35th hold of the season, surpassing Mitchell Boggs (34 in 2012) for most in Cardinals single-season history ... the Astros RHP Bryan Abreu leads MLB this season with 36 holds ... 2015 Pirates LHP Tony Watson and 2013 Rays RHP Joel Peralta share the MLB record with 41 holds.

MASYN MILESTONES: Rookie Masyn Winn today plays his 143rd game at shortstop this season, 3rd-most at shortstop alltime by a Redbirds rookie behind 1929 Charlie Gelbert (146g) and 1907 Ed Holly (147g) ... 1978 Padres rookie Ozzie Smith holds the MLB single-season rookie record with 159 games at shortstop.

GOING YARD AGAINST THE GUARDS: With a home run today, Nolan Arenado would become the 21st active Major Leaguer to homer against all 30 teams in his career ... Among MLB debuts since the 1998 season when MLB expanded to 30 teams, four have completed the home run circuit by going yard against Cleveland as their final team: Mark Reynolds, Troy Tulowitzki, Josh Willingham, and Dexter Fowler, who went yard with St. Louis during the COVID-shortened 2020 season.

The Cardinals & Indians played an exhibition at Cleveland's League Park during the 1936 All-Star break, a game where 17-year-old **Bob Feller** made his unofficial debut with 8 strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

The Cleveland Spiders were rivals of the St. Louis Browns in the American Association (1888-89) and National League (1892-99)...before the 1899 season, Spiders owners **Stanley** and **Frank** DeHass Robison, who also owned the St. Louis franchise, transferred Cleveland's best players (future Hall of Famers Cy Young, Bobby Wallace, & Jesse Burkett) to St. Louis and formed the Perfectos...the Spiders endured the worst season in pro baseball history (20-134) and were disbanded as the NL contracted to eight teams.

The Cardinals won their 10,000th regular season game as a member of the National League with a 4-0 victory over Cleveland at Busch Stadium (June 25, 2018).

- TODAY'S GAME
- Making his 19th start of the season today and his 29th career.
- Today marks his first career start vs. Cleveland and his third career appearance. Made two relief appearances at Progressive Field in 2023.
- Was recalled on May 26 and has made 18 starts since, posting the lowest ERA (3.62) among Cardinals starters since. Blake Snell (1.99) has the lowest ERA in MLB during that period.
- Established new single-season highs in wins (7) and innings pitched (109.1) in his last start vs. PIT (9/16). Out-dueled rookie **Paul Skenes** by throwing 7.0 scoreless innings of four hit balls with a career-high nine strikeouts in a 4-0 victory.
- Ran his strikeout total to 77 establishing a new career-high in his start vs. CIN (9/10).
- Posted back-to-back starts of 7.0 innings or more against the Dodgers (8/17) and at the Twins (8/23).
- Began the season in the bullpen and was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances, getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21.
- Is 10-10, 3.75 ERA in 28 career starts (153.2 IP/64 ER) and 7-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 108 career relief appearances (131.2 IP/57 ER).
- Since May 26, leads all MLB starting pitchers with his 61.6 groundball pct.; has 179 ground balls and 57 fly balls allowed.
- Won his first three home starts (3-0, 2.87 ERA, 15.2 IP) this season, then lost three (0-3, 6.75 ERA, 16.0 IP) before he won again on 8/17 vs. LAD.
- Despite being winless in his four July starts, owned the Cardinals top starter's ERA (3.33) for the month and his .220 opponent's BA in July ranked 9th among N.L. starters.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 14-of-18 starts this season including 7 straight from June 28 to Aug. 10. Is 5-2 in his seven starts when receiving 3+ runs.
- Was involved in the decision in his first six starts and in 14 of 18 starts overall (7-7).
- His career reverse splits have continued this season, as he's held LHB to .224 BA & .590 OPS, while RHB are batting .262 with .734 OPS, hitting 6 of 8 HR's he's allowed in 2024.
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP in start at CIN (5/29/24).
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 104 at KC on (8/10/24).

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Fired a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball and established a new career-high with nine strikeouts in a 4-0 win over the Pirates while facing Paul Skenes.
- Shared in the 19.0 scoreless innings Cardinals starting pitchers have had in starts against Skenes this season (Mikolas 7.0; Lynn 5.0; Pallante 7.0).

- Making his first career start vs. Cleveland after two relief appearances last season at Progressive Field.
- Pitched two scoreless outings while allowing three hits vs. the Guardians in 2023.
- Is 1-1 with a 3.70 ERA in three career starts (8 app.) against American League Central Division clubs. Lone win was at Minnesota's Target Field on Aug. 23.
- · Starting against his 14th different opponent this season.

#### 2024

- Began the season in the bullpen and was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine relief appearances, getting optioned to Memphis (AAA) on April 21. Was recalled on May 26 and has made 13 starts since, posting the lowest ERA (3.75) among Cardinals starters and 15th lowest ERA in the National League.
- Made his first MLB start since 2022 at CIN (5/29), threw 6.0 scoreless innings at Great American Ball Park for a 5-3 win. Threw a then season-high 86 pitches (both Memphis & St. Louis) and did not allow a hit until the 4th inning.
- Made his second career appearance in a neutral site game when he started vs. SF (6/20) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala. Joined Alan Benes (4/19/1997 vs. SD) as the only two Cardinals starting pitchers to earn a win at a neutral site game.
- Logged a season-high 7.0 IP at PIT (7/4). His longest outing since a career-high 8.0 IP at WSH (7/31/22). Tossed a then career-high 101 pitches in his final start before the All-Star break in Game 1 of 7/10/24 split DH vs. KC.
- Suffered his first loss as a starting pitcher in 2024 and allowed runs as a starting pitcher for the first time since 2022 at HOU (6/4) in an 8-5 loss, allowing six runs on six hits over 3.0 IP
