A LONG BALL SHORT OF HISTORY: OF Cedric Mullins stole his 29th and 30th bases of the season yesterday; the 18th time (11th player) in Orioles history with a 30+ stolen base season...Was his sixth multi-stolen base game of the season...His 30 steals are the second-most in the American League and tied for the third-most in the majors...Mullins is one home run shy (29 HR/30 SB) of the first 30 SB season in Orioles history and the first in the majors since Christian Yelich and Ronald Acuña, Jr. in 2019 and first in the AL since Mookie Betts in 2018...He's looking to become the first center fielder (at least 75% of games played in CF) with a 30/30 season since Mike Trout in 2012; there have been 13 30/30 seasons by a center fielder in Major League history and four in AL history (Trout - 2012, Jacoby Ellsbury - 2011, Grady Sizemore - 2008, José Cruz - 2001).

- Ds He is looking to become the sixth player (10th time) in Major League history 5'8"-or-shorter to record 30 home runs in a single season: José Altuve (31 2019), Jimmy Rollins (30 2017), Kirby Puckett (31 1986), Yogi Berra (30 1956 and 30 1952), Hack Wilson (56 1930, 39 1929, 31 1928, 30 1927).
- O₃ He is batting .369/.406/.669 (48-for-130) in the first inning this season...Mullins' 48 first-inning hits are the most in the majors and also the most in any single inning in the majors...Mullins' 21 first-inning extra-base hits (11-2B, 2-3B, 8 HR) also lead all of baseball...His 48 first-inning hits are tied for the fourth-most in a single-season in Orioles history.
- O₃ Mullins' 298 total bases are the fourth-most in the majors, trailing only: Guerrero, Jr., TOR (338), Semien, TOR (320), and Pérez, KC (311).
- O_b He's made 138 starts this season (145 games), with 135 coming in center field and three as the DH; all have come while batting lead off...His 135 starts in CF are tied for the most in MLB (Straw, CLE).
- 6> His 5.6 WAR (according to Fangraphs) is the third-highest in the AL (Guerrero, Jr., TOR 6.7 and Semien, TOR 6.2) and tied for the fifth-highest in the majors.

AL ROOKIE OF THE YEAR CAMPAIGN: INF/OF Ryan Mountcastle hit his 30th home run of the season yesterday, tied for the most in the majors by a rookie (García, TEX)...He became the sixth rookie in the American League since 2000 to record a 30+ home run season (Judge, NYY - 52 in 2017, Abreu, CWS - 36 in 2014, Jiménez, CWS - 31 in 2019, Trout, LAA - 30 in 2012, and García, TEX - 30 in 2021).

- O₃ Mountcastle's 30 home runs lead the Orioles, one ahead of Cedric Mullins...Jay Gibbons in 2001 (15 HR) is the last Orioles rookie to tie for the team lead in home runs in a single season, while Curt Blefary in 1965 (22 HR) is the last O's rookie to lead the club in home runs outright in a single season.
- O₃ His 16 home runs since the All-Star Break (47 G) lead the O's, are the most by a rookie in the second-half, and are tied for the seventh-most in the American League...He's slashing .269/.322/.582 (49-for-182) in the second half...His .582 second half slugging percentage is the fifth-highest in the AL among qualifiers (min. 190 PA).
- \$\mathcal{O}_s\$ His 83 RBI are the fifth-most in a single-season by an O's rookie; trailing only **Jim Gentile** (98 1960), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (93 1982), **Eddie Murray** (88 1977), and **Ron Hansen** (86 1960).

SEPTEMBER HAYS: OF Austin Hays has hit safely in 14 of 16 games in September, including five multihit efforts, and has reached base safely in 15 of the 16...He's slashing .292/.343/.692 (19-for-65) with seven home runs and 16 RBI in 16 September games...His home runs and RBI are the most he's recorded in any month this season.

- O₃ His seven home runs in September, including two multi-homer games, are tied for the second-most in the majors, while his 11 extra-base hits (3-2B, 3B, 7 HR) this month are tied for the third-most in the AL and tied for fifth-most in the majors...His 34 RBI since the All-Star Break are the second-most on the O's (Mountcastle 35).
- 6» For his career, Hays has slashed .302/.345/.554 (73-for-242) with 15 home runs in 70 September games...Has 15 total homers in all other months combined (121 G).
- He's hit safely in 22 of his last 24 games, since August 24, raising his OPS +.082 during this stretch, from .686 to his current .768.
- This season he is batting .301/.335/.554 (56-for-186) with 11 home runs against left-handed pitching, while hitting .219/.277/.402 (55-for-251) with 10 homers against right-handed pitching.

GOING, GOING, GONE: The Orioles have homered 83 times since the All-Star Break, the fifth-most in the AL...Their 57 home runs at Oriole Park in the second half (31 G) lead the majors, while their 26 home runs on the road in the second half (28 G) are the third-fewest in the majors...For the season, the O's 114 home runs at home are the third-most in baseball, while their 70 home runs on the road are the second-fewest.

- O₃ The Orioles 103 combined home runs from their outfield and designated hitter spots rank second in the majors, behind only the New York Yankees with 107 (Mullins 29, Hays 21, Santander 17. Mountcastle 12. Stewart 12. Mancini 10. McKenna 2).
- Onioles players have recorded 17 individual multi-home run games this season, the second-most by a team in the majors, trailing only Toronto's 21 such games...The 17 individual multi-homer games are the fifth-most in Orioles history.
- The Orioles have four players with at least 20 home runs this season (Mullins, Mountcastle, Mancini, Hays)...They are one of eight teams in the majors to have at least four players with 20+homer seasons: Chicago-NL and Houston (4) and Atlanta, Boston, Cincinnati, Los Angeles-NL, Toronto (5)...Five teams (Cleveland, New York-AL, Seattle, Tampa Bay, Toronto) currently have two players each with 30+home runs.
- Ø_s Mullins (26 years and 353 days) 29 home runs and Mountcastle (24 years and 213 days) 30 home runs are looking to become the third pair in Orioles history to both hit 30 home runs in a single-season before turning 27 (also: Chris Davis and Adam Jones 2012 and Manny Machado and Jonathan Schoop 2017).

THIS AND THAT:

- 8 RHP Conner Greene has worked six-straight scoreless outings (6.1 IP) since September 6...Since rejoining the Orioles on August 25, Greene has worked to a 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) in 12 G.
- O_x INF Ramón Urías has recorded exactly one hit in 11 of his last 12 games (Since August 31); has reached base safely in all 12 games during this stretch...His .359 OBP leads American League rookies (min. 280 PA) and is the third-highest among all Major League rookies.
- 9» OF Cedric Mullins has hit safely in 13 of 14 games against Boston this season, slashing .379/.438/.586 (22-for-58)...INF Trey Mancini is a career .321/.383/.550 (42-for-131) hitter in 34 games at Fenway Park.
- The Orioles have used a club record 59 different players this season (37 pitchers and 22 position players), passing the previous record of 58 from the 2019 season...RHP Brooks Kriske has yet to make an appearance with the O's.

QUICK HITS: Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk when roster's expanded on 9/1; his fourth stint with the O's this year...Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Orioles system by MLB Pipeline and No. 28 by Baseball America...Added to the 40-man roster on 11/20/20...Selected to the 2018 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game...Named the 2017 Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year with Class-A Delmarva...Has a twin brother, Lachlan, who pitches in the Minnesota Twins Organization...Originally signed as an International free agent on 8/29/15.

LAST START: Suffered the loss in his most recent outing on 9/14 vs. New York-AL, allowing five runs on a season-high-tying seven hits (three home runs), one walk and one hit batter with three strikeouts through 4.0 innings...Became the fifth O's hurler to give up three home runs in a start this season (last: Kremer, 9/11 G1 vs. TOR)...Has lost three-straight decisions since 7/29 at Detroit.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Has never faced the Boston Red Sox...Is facing an American League East opponent in consecutive outings for the first time in his career...Has gone 0-2 with a 9.00 ERA (14 ER/14.0 IP), five walks, and 12 strikeouts in four games (three starts) against the AL East; is looking for his first win against the division...All but one of his appearances against AL East foes have come on the road.

WHAT A RELIEF: Three of his eight outings this season have come in relief, including his first two-career games...Most recently appeared out of the bullpen on 8/10 vs. Detroit...Is 1-0 as a reliever with a 4.76 ERA (3 ER/5.2 IP) and a .320 (8-for-25) opponents' average, compared to 0-3 in five starts with an 8.57 ERA (20 ER/21.0 IP), and a .333 (31-for-93) opponents' average...Has allowed just one extra-base hit (2B) as a reliever, compared to 12 (4-2B, 3B, 7 HR) as a starter.

<u>ROAD WARRIOR:</u> Wells became the fifth pitcher in O's history (since 1954), and the first since Donnie Hart in 2016, to make each his first five-career appearances on the road...He was the first pitcher in MLB to do so since Jose Quijada and Montana Durapau did so in 2019.

G'DAY, MATE: On 6/26, a native of Newcastle, Australia, Wells became the third Australian-born player in Orioles history (since 1954) to make his Major League debut, joining RHP John Stephens (born in Sydney) in 2002 and LHP Damian Moss (born in Darlinghurst) in 2003...On 6/29, he became the third Australian-born player to earn a win for the O's, and the first since Moss on 8/20/03...On 7/21, Wells became the 13th Australian-born pitcher to start a game in MLB history, and the first Australian-native to start a game for the Orioles since Moss on 9/26/03; was just the second pitcher to do so in the majors this season (Lewis Thorpe, MIN).

WELCOME TO THE BIGS: On 6/26 at Toronto, became the 10th Oriole (eighth pitcher) to make his MLB debut this season...Threw 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, allowing one hit and two walks...Earned his first-career win on 6/29 at Houston, tossing 2.2 innings of relief with two runs on four hits and two walks while striking out one; punched out Myles Straw swinging in the fifth frame for his first-career strikeout...Made his first big league start on 7/21 at Tampa Bay...Took his first loss on 7/29 at Detroit.

 $\underline{\text{ON THE FARM:}}$ Is 6-3 in 13 appearances (10 starts) with Triple-A Norfolk this season, posting a 3.29 ERA (20 ER/54.2 IP) with six home runs, seven walks, and 48 strike-outs...Did not give up a run in each of his last five outings (four starts) with the Tides from 7/4-8/28 (22.2 IP); has not allowed a run in seven of his 13 games this year.

2019 HIGHLIGHTS: Did not play in 2020 because of the cancellation of the minor league season due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Made 24 starts for Double-A Bowie, finishing 8-6 with a 2.95 ERA (45 ER/137.1 IP) a .236 (123-for-522) opponents' average, allowing 24 walks against 123 strikeouts...Named Orioles Pitcher of the Month for June...Earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors (5/27-6/2)...Named an EL mid-season All-Star...Ranked among the top 10 in the EL in ERA (6th, 2.95), innings pitched (7th, 137.1), opponents' average (9th, .236), WHIP (5th, 1.07), and win percentage (10th, .571).

Means will be facing the Philadelphia Phillies for the first time in his career...Has made seven-career starts against National League East opponents, going 1-3 with a 4.08 ERA (16 ER/35.1 IP)...Has gone 0-1 in three starts against the NL East this season, pitching to a 3.38 ERA (7 ER/18.2)...Means has made 10 Interleague starts in his career, posting a 1-4 record and a 4.32 ERA (24 ER/50.0 IP)...At the plate, he has gone 1-for-3 (.333) with a walk in five-career plate appearances; his lone hit came on 7/24/19 at Arizona...Means made his most recent start on 9/15 vs. New York-AL, allowing two runs on four hits (one home run) and two walks with four strikeouts through 5.2 innings of the no decision.
