**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles dropped the second game of the series with the Mariners, 4-3, following a 2:58 rain delay...**Grayson Rodriguez** took a no-hitter into the sixth inning and finished with 6.0 scoreless frames, surrendering one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts...**Gunnar Henderson** hit his MLB-leading 14<sup>th</sup> homer in the ninth inning...**Jordan Westburg** tripled in the second inning, setting a career high with his third of the year.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** At 28-15 (.651), the Orioles have the second-best record in the AL and third-best in MLB behind the Yankees (.681, 32-15) and Phillies (.702, 33-14)...Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 212-155 (.578), the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.584, 216-154), Braves (.633, 231-134), and Dodgers (.651, 242-130).

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles are tied with the Yankees for the MLB lead with 66 home runs, the second-most homers through the first 43 games of a season in O's history behind 1987 (67)...The most through Baltimore's first 44 games of a season is 69 in 1987.

O's The Orioles have an MLB-best seven players with at least six homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (14), **Adley Rutschman** (9), **Anthony Santander** and **Jordan Westburg** (7), and **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, and **Cedric Mullins** (6); the Yankees rank second with five players with at least six long balls.

**THE ERAS TOUR:** The O's have an MLB-best 2.23 ERA (37 ER/149.0 IP) in their last 16 games since April 29...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 99 hits while holding opponents to a .188 batting average (99-for-527)...The 2.23 ERA is the best mark in a 16-game span in a single season by the Orioles since September 6-22, 2014 (2.13).

O's For the year, the Birds rank fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB with a 3.25 ERA (142 ER/393.0 IP); the club has not posted a mark that low in a season since 1975 (3.17).

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** leads MLB with 14 home runs...He also ranks among AL leaders in total bases (2<sup>nd</sup>, 99), runs scored (3<sup>rd</sup>, 33), slugging percentage (3<sup>rd</sup>, .582), triples (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 4), extra-base hits (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 22), OPS (6<sup>th</sup>, .927), and RBI (T-8<sup>th</sup>, 30)...According to MLB's Sarah Langs (@SlangsonSports), he is the eighth player in MLB history age 22-or-younger to hit at least 14 homers in a team's first 43 games of a season, joining San Diego's Fernando Tatis, Jr. in 2020 (15), Washington's Bryce Harper in 2015 (16), St. Louis' Albert Pujols in 2001 (14), Seattle's Alex Rodriguez in 1998 (16), Washington Senators' Harmon Killebrew in 1959 (16), and Milwaukee Braves' Eddie Matthews in 1953 (15).

O's Henderson is the first Oriole to hold the outright MLB lead in home runs through at least May 18 since **Mark Trumbo** finished the 2016 season with an MLB-best 47, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

O's He is the eighth Oriole in team history (since 1954) with at least 14 homers in the team's first 43 games, joining **Manny Machado** (2018), **Nelson Cruz** (2014), **Adam Jones** (2012), **Luke Scott** (2009), **Brady Anderson** (18, 1996), **Frank Robinson** (15, 1967), and **Jim Gentile** (15, 1962).

**BIG TIME RUTSCH:** **Adley Rutschman** enters today ranked fourth in the AL in hits (55), sixth in batting average (.309), and tied for seventh in total bases (89)...He is tied for the AL lead and tied for second in MLB in multi-hit games (18).

O's Since April 19, he's slashing .330/.348/.596 (36-for-109) with five doubles, eight homers, 14 runs, 21 RBI, three walks (1 IBB), and a stolen base; over that period, he leads the AL in hits, ranks second in total bases (65), tied for second in homers, tied for third in RBI, and fourth in batting average.

O's Rutschman had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an O's batter this season.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles wrap up their season-long eight-game homestand today with the last of three games against the Mariners (was originally a nine-game homestand before Tuesday's game was postponed due to inclement weather)...Baltimore is 4-3 so far after splitting the two games in this series, splitting a weather-shortened two-game set with Toronto earlier this week, and taking two of three against Arizona over the weekend.

O's Since the start of 2023, the O's are 65-42 (.607) at Oriole Park, the second-best home record in the AL (TB, 67-40, .626) and the fifth-best mark at home in MLB.

**AGAINST SEATTLE:** The O's and Mariners meet for the first time this season this weekend at Camden Yards...Following these three games, the Birds will travel to Seattle from July 2-4 to complete the season series...In the last seven meetings between the teams, five games have been decided by one or two runs with three of those coming by exactly one run.

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** The Orioles have extended their sweepless streak to 106 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties), which passes the 1903-05 New York Giants (105) for the third-longest such streak in MLB history...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Baltimore's current streak trails only the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124) and 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115)...During this current stretch, the O's have now avoided being swept in the final game of a series 14 times: May 15 vs. Toronto (2G), May 8, 2024 at Washington (2G), April 14, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (3G), August 10, 2023 vs. Houston (3G), July 19, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3G), July 2, 2023 vs. Minnesota (3G), June 18, 2023 at Chicago-NL (3G), June 8, 2023 at Milwaukee (3G), May 28, 2023 vs. Texas (3G), September 21, 2022 vs. Detroit (3G), September 18, 2022 at Toronto (3G), July 3, 2022 at Minnesota (3G), June 11, 2022 at Kansas City (3G), and May 19, 2022 vs. New York-AL (4G)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

**LEADING ACTORS:** Baltimore leads MLB with five leadoff homers this season...**Gunnar Henderson** has hit four of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB...**Jordan Westburg** has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 22 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for ninth in MLB.

**TRIPLE THREAT:** The O's are tied for second in MLB with 11 triples with the Red Sox, trailing only the Tigers (14)...Marks the most triples by Baltimore through the first 43 games of a season since 1992 (13).

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Oriole manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 343 wins rank fifth all-time among Oriole managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 10<sup>th</sup> start of the season this afternoon against the Mariners...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision on May 13 vs. Toronto... Allowed one run on six hits and two walks with two strikeouts across 6.0 innings; the two strikeouts tied a career and season low as a starter...Has received two runs-or-fewer in run support in four consecutive starts... Threw 85 pitches, 58 strikes.

**AGAINST THE MARINERS:** Earned the win in his sole start against them on April 17, 2023 in Seattle, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) and two walks with three strikeouts in 5.1 innings.

**WILD WILD AL WEST:** Making his sixth career start against the AL West and his second of the season; has tossed 6.0 innings of one run ball in both starts this year, including his Orioles debut on March 28 vs. Los Angeles-AL...Owns a lifetime 3-1 record with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1IP) across five starts against the division...Opponents are slashing .192/.257/.404 (19-for-99) off him.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Scheduled to make his seventh home start of the season...Has gone 1-1 with a 2.34 ERA (9 ER/34.2 IP) across six starts at Oriole Park this year.

**DAY MAN:** Through four day starts this season, Burnes owns a 2-0 record with a 2.28 ERA (6 ER/23.2 IP)...Has allowed four walks compared to 25 strikeouts in afternoon games.

**EXTRA REST:** When pitching on at least five days of rest this season, Burnes is 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (12 ER/42.2 IP) in seven starts...Opponents are hitting .194 (30-for-155) on extra rest, compared to .244 (10-for-41) on four days rest.

**EARLY STRUGGLES:** Burnes has surrendered five of his 16 earned runs in the first inning this season with four of those coming via solo home runs... The four first-inning home runs allowed are tied for second in MLB with Atlanta's Chris Sale and MIN's Pablo López, trailing only San Diego's Matt Waldron (5).

**RING 'EM UP:** Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 81 strikeouts away from 1,000.

**INNINGS EATER:** The 616.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank fourth in MLB (Aaron Nola — 637.1, Sandy Alcántara — 619.0, and Zack Wheeler — 619.0)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts
