NATIONALS NEWS

DOWN, BUT NEVER OUT
The Washington Nationals beat the Houston Astros, 12-11, in a back-and-forth affair in the first game of this three-game series on Monday night...Trailing 6-1, the Nationals plated five runs in the third inning and six runs in the fifth inning to match their longest comeback win of the season.

- Washington is 36-29 (.554) since April 25 and are 11-4-1 in their last 16 series since May 12.
- The Nationals have 47 wins, the most by a Nationals club prior to the All-Star break since the 2019 Nationals recorded 47 wins before the break...The next highest win total belongs to the 2018 Nationals (48 wins).

ROSTER MOVES
The Nationals announced the following roster moves:

- Activated left-handed pitcher **Matt Krook**...Krook, 31, was claimed off waivers from the Athletics...He went 2-2 with a 3.72 ERA and 42 strikeouts in 25 games (29.0 IP) with Triple-A Las Vegas...He appeared in five MLB games with the Athletics prior to joining the Nationals.
- Optioned right-handed pitcher **Cole Henry** to Triple-A Rochester on Monday.

ALL STARS!
Nationals shortstop **CJ Abrams** and outfielder **James Wood** will represent the organization in the 2026 Major League Baseball All-Star Game in Philadelphia on July 14...Abrams was voted in by the fans and will start at shortstop for the National League, while Wood was selected through player voting...Both players will make their second career All-Star appearance...See boxes to the right for a summary of their rankings this season.

BIG GAME JAMES
James Wood is 11-for-28 (.393) with a .564 on-base percentage (11 BB, 5 SO) and a .964 slugging percentage (2 2B, 3B, 4 HR) in his last eight games...He's reached safely in 18 of his last 27 plate appearances (9 H, 9 BB, 0 SO).

- In addition to his rankings in the box to the right, he leads Major League Baseball with seven leadoff homers.

LUIS! LUIS!
Luis García Jr. ranks in the National League in RBI (2nd, 65), slugging (.3rd, .558) and home runs (T8th, 19).

- He is 15-for-37 (.405) with four doubles, six homers, 16 RBI, two walks and nine runs in his last nine games.
- He clubbed his career-high 19th home run on Sunday against the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- His 10 home runs in his last 16 games are the most in the National League (2nd in MLB) since June 19.
- Since May 24, García Jr. leads MLB with 43 RBI and a .764 slugging percentage...His 16 home runs are tied for the most, while his 1.115 OPS is good for third.

HOMER HAPPY
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 91 home runs since May 6, ahead of the Phillies (81) and the White Sox (80)...Washington leads in OPS (.794) and slugging (.467) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 128 home runs this season, the second-most in MLB behind the New York Yankees (131) and the second most in team history (2005-pres.) through 91 games behind the 2017 Nationals (138 HR).

NAS (H)IM
Nasim Núñez is 23-for-60 (.383) with a double, two triples, one home run, eight RBI, nine walks, eight stolen bases and 13 runs scored over his last 20 games...He's 6-for-14 (.429) over his last four games.

- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 33 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

THUNDER FROM DOWN UNDER
Curtis Mead is slugging .600 (2 2B, 3B, HR) with a 1.024 OPS over his last seven games...He's hit safely in six of the seven and has reached base safely in all seven (.424 OBP)...He's 11-for-30 (.367) during this seven-game streak and is 8-for-18 (.444) with a double, triple and homer over his last four games.

ROLLIN' RUIZ
Keibert Ruiz leads Major League catchers (min. 125 PA) with a .333 batting average, a .924 OPS and is third with a .556 slugging percentage in 33 games since May 7.

- He's hitting .333 with 11 doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 22 runs since that date.

CREWSIN'
Dylan Crews is hitting .290 (18-for-62) with three doubles, two homers, four RBI, six walks, one hit by pitch, three stolen bases and 13 runs scored over his last 16 games...He's posted a .362 on-base percentage and a .435 slugging percentage over this stretch.

- Crews has 10 infield hits this season, tied for second on the club despite playing in just 41 games so far and tied for sixth-most in MLB since he was recalled on May 19.

FARM REPORT

FUTURES GAME
Shortstop **Eli Villits** and right-handed pitcher **Miguel Sime Jr.** have been selected to represent the Washington Nationals organization in the 2026 All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia on Sunday, July 12...Villits is Washington's top prospect and the No. 3 prospect in all of baseball, according to MLB Pipeline.com...He leads Washington's system in OPS, runs and stolen bases...The 18-year old was the No. 1 overall pick in the 2025 First-Year Player Draft...Sime Jr. leads all of Minor League Baseball with 16.6 strikeouts per 9.0 innings this season. He has fanned 84 batters - second-most in Washington's system - in just 45.2 innings pitched between Single-A Fredericksburg and High-A Wilmington.
