RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Detroit Tigers kick off a three-game Interleague series with today's doubleheader at Comerica Park ... The Cardinals have won consecutive road series, taking two of three at Oakland (April 15-17) and then this weekend at the New York Mets at Citi Field to begin the road trip ... Last September, St. Louis won three straight road series at Atlanta (Sept. 5-7), Cincinnati (Sept. 8-10) and Baltimore (Sept. 11-13). **FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis opens today in 5th place in the National League Central, 4.5 games behind first place Chicago (18-11) and percentage points back of Pittsburgh (14-16) for 4th place ... A Cardinals win and a Pirates loss would vault St. Louis out of the bottom slot in the National League Central for the first time since July 26, 2023 (4th place, 1/2 game ahead of Pittsburgh).

LET'S PLAY TWO: Today's twinbill is the Cardinals first since splitting a doubleheader with the Yankees on July 1, 2023 at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals and Tigers have played one doubleheader in history, splitting a pair of seven-inning games on Sept. 10, 2020 at Busch Stadium during the COVID-shortened 2020 season ... **Jack Flaherty** started for St. Louis in the opener as the Cardinals belted five home runs in a 12-2 victory ... Detroit won the finale, 6-2, after scoring six unanswered runs in the last two frames.

JUNIOR CIRCUIT JUGGERNAUTS: Dating back to last July, the Cardinals have won or tied their last six road series against American League opponents, last dropping two-of-three at Globe Life Field against the defending World Champion Texas Rangers (June 5-7, 2023).

PATH TO THE 10TH TITLE: The Cardinals are retracing their steps from 2006 with their current road trip through New York and Detroit ... The 2006 Cardinals captured their 10th World Series title in franchise history after eliminating the Mets in seven games in the NLCS and then beating the Detroit Tigers in five games in the Fall Classic as closer **Adam Wainwright** recorded final outs via strikeout in both series (**Carlos Beltrán** looking & **Brandon Inge** swinging).

"GOOD WILL" BUNTING: Sunday, the Cardinals took a 1-0 lead on a safety squeeze by **Michael Siani** to score **Masyn Winn** ... Siani's bunt for an RBI was the first by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** dropped a sac bunt to score **Harrison Bader** vs. Milwaukee on Sept. 28, 2021 ... Siani leads MLB with five sacrifice bunts this season and is the first Cardinals position player with 5+ sac bunts since **Koiten Wong** dropped six in 2019 ... St. Louis, as a team, leads MLB in sac bunts (8) and ranks T-3rd in sacrifice flies (13).

FROM THE SPORTS BUREAU: **Michael Siani's** sacrifice bunt for an RBI Sunday was his first Major League RBI ... The last Cardinal to record his first career MLB RBI via the bunt was pitcher **Chuck Finley** in 2002, and the last Cardinals position player was **"Super" Joe McEwing** vs. Pittsburgh in 1998. - *Elias Sports Bureau*

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Cardinals (3.31) and Tigers (2.53) both rank 2nd in their respective leagues in bullpen ERA.

- LHP **JoJo Romero** and RHP **Andrew Kittredge** share the MLB lead with 10 holds this season.
- RHP **Ryan Helsley** leads MLB in games finished (14), shares the league lead in saves (9), and ranks T-2nd in appearances (15).
- Rule 5 Draft Pick **Ryan Fernandez** ranks 3rd among National League rookie relievers in strikeouts (15), ERA (2.45) and opponent batting average (.179).

DETROIT CONNECTIONS

Lars Nootbaar made his MLB debut vs. Detroit (June 22, 2021)...Tripled off **Matt Manning** for his first MLB hit (June 23, 2021).

Tigers Special Assistant **Jim Leyland** spent six seasons (2000-05) as a scout for the Cardinals, scouting NL clubs from Pittsburgh and AL clubs from Cleveland.

Tommy Edman was born in Pontiac, Mich...grew up a Tigers fan while living in Michigan in the 1990s...His father, John, attended graduate school at the University of Michigan and was a volunteer assistant coach for the Wolverines.

Jack Flaherty was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#34) of the 2014 MLB Draft...pitched parts f seven seasons with the Cardinals (2017-23)...traded to Baltimore at the 2023 MLB Trade deadline for **César Prieto**, **Zack Showalter**, and **Drew Rom** (Aug 1, 2023).

Alex Lange graduated from Lee's Summit West High School...Selected by the Cubs in the 1st round (30th overall) of the 2017 MLB Draft, which was received from St. Louis in compensation for the signing of free agent **Dexter Fowler**.

Matt Vierling was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College High School in St. Louis...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 30th round of the 2015 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Notre Dame...attended the 2013 World Series at Busch Stadium.

Tigers Special Assistant to the President of Baseball Operations **Kirk Gibson** was **Paul Goldschmidt's** first MLB manager in Arizona (2011)...originally selected in the 7th round of the 1978 NFL Draft by the St. Louis Football Cardinals.

Carson Kelly was selected by the Cardinals in the 2nd round of the 2012 MLB Draft...played parts of three seasons in St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged with **Luke Weaver**, **Andrew Young**, and 2019 Competitive Balance Rd B pick to the Diamondbacks for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018).

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was born in Highland Park, Mich...originally selected by the Cardinals Cardinals in the 1st round (#10) of the 1967 MLB Draft from Southfield (Mich.) High School...attended the University of Michigan and Wayne State in his offseasons.

Sacramento natives **Dylan Carlson** (33rd) and **Matt Manning** (9th) were both selected in 1st Rd. of the 2016 MLB Draft...Both grew up in the same neighborhood and played little league together.

Tigers Bullpen Catcher **Chris Chinea** was drafted by St. Louis in the 17th round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played spent five seasons in the Cardinals organization (2015-19).

Shelby Miller pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2012-14)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the first round (19th overall) in the 2009 MLB Draft.

Buddy Kennedy attended 2024 Spring Training with St. Louis before being claimed off waivers by Detroit (Feb. 29, 2024).

Tigers Hitting Coach **Michael Brdar** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 36th round of the 2017 MLB draft...played the 2017 minor league season with the GCL Cardinals.

Cardinals Sr. Director of Communications **Brian Bartow** is a native of Battle Creek Mich...graduated from Ferris State University in Big Rapids, Mich.

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 300th career start today. Becomes the 9th active pitcher with 300 or more games started. **Justin Verlander** leads the list with 511.
- Making his 27th career start (28th app.) against the Detroit Tigers and 15th career start (16th app.) at Comerica Park. His 14 starts at Comerica Park are the most among active opposing pitchers.
- Is the active leader in career starts vs. the Tigers (27) and ranks 2nd in active wins to Carlos Carrasco (12) with 11.
- Has thrown 6.0 or more innings in his first five starts this season, the longest active streak in MLB this season and the first time in his 12-year career he has done this. He's the first Cardinals pitcher to achieve this since **Mike Leake** (11) and **Michael Wacha** (7) in 2017. **Bob Gibson** holds the franchise record for the Cardinals with 35 in 1969 (every start that season).
- Is one of five pitchers this season with five starts of 6.0 or more innings (**Logan Webb**, SF; **Seth Lugo**, KC; **Zack Wheeler**, PHI; **Jose Berrios**, TOR).
- Has received two runs of support or less in each of his last four starts; Cardinals 1-3.
- Has posted a 3.32 ERA with **Willson Contreras** behind the plate, the 4th-lowest ERA of any of the 24 catchers he has pitched with in his career.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November.
- Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Joins his fifth Major League team Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Threw 6.0 innings allowing one run in the 1st inning before five consecutive scoreless innings to put himself in line for a 5-1 Cardinals win.
- Was his 5th straight start of 6.0 innings pitched, one of two pitchers with five consecutive starts of 6.0 or more innings this season (José Berrios).

CAREER

- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in ground into double plays (209).
- Has career marks of 105-103, one of 17 active pitchers with 100 or more wins. Ranks 10th among active pitchers with 105 wins, three behind **Carlos Carrasco** and **Wade Miley** (108) for 8th.
- Durable starting pitcher, has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has posted eight 10-win seasons since his MLB debut in 2013, tied for 4th-most among over that period trailing only **Max Scherzer** (10), **Gerrit Cole** (9) & **Clayton Kershaw** (9).
- One of four pitchers since 2014 to record 100 or more strikeouts in 9-of-10 seasons with **Jacob deGrom**, **Clayton Kershaw** and **Max Scherzer**.

2024

- On April 7 vs. Miami, became the most recent Cardinal to allow six runs in the 1st inning and still pitch 6.0 or more innings since **Bob Tewksbury** at Chicago Cubs (June 29, 1991 - 6.0 IP, 6 R, 1 ER). The six 1st inning runs set a personal opening frame record and was the second time in his career (May 10, 2014 at Detroit, 2nd inning) in any inning.
- Made his Cardinals debut on April 1 at San Diego, earned a win while throwing a season-high 7.0 innings for a Cardinals pitcher in the 6-2 win at PETCO Park. Allowed home runs to Jackson Merrill and Fernando Tatis, Jr., as his only blemishes.

TODAY'S GAME

N.L. RANKINGS: Ground Into Double Plays/9 IP (1.48, 5th), GIDP Induced (4, T-6th),

- Making his sixth start of the 2024 season today and first against the Tigers. Last faced the Tigers in St. Louis on May 7, 2023 in a 12-6 punctuated by a three home run game from Paul Goldschmidt.
- Is a career 7-0 against A.L. Central teams with a 1.78 ERA. The only pitcher in MLB history with a perfect winning percentage against the A.L. Central with 15 or more games started. Joins Rich Harden (6-0) and Joey Lucchesi (7-0) vs. N.L. East; as the only pitchers with a perfect record against any division with 15 or more starts.
- Leads Cardinals starting pitchers in run support average (6.29) and ranks 11th among National League pitchers.
- Has held left-handed batters to 4-for-20 mark (.200 BA) with the only XBH being a ground-rule double by Shohei Ohtani at LAD (3/31).
- Surpassed 900 career innings with his fifth out at OAK (4/17) becoming the 20th active left-handed pitcher with 900 or more innings pitched.
- Made his first start of the season against the Dodgers on Sunday Night Baseball in Los Angeles on 3/31 and received a no decision after departing with a 4-2 lead in the 6th.

LAST TIME OUT

- Suffered his 2nd loss of the season allowing seven runs on six hits over 4.1 innings in a 14-1 loss, the Cardinals largest of the season.
