## CINCINNATI REDS (15-16) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-19)

May 10, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #34/HOME #13

RHP TYLER MAHLE (1-1, 3.23 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (2-3, 6.29 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** returned home last night following a six-game road trip to San Diego (1-2) and Chicago (1-2)...Snapped their three-game skid with yesterday's 6-5 win at Wrigley Field...Have gone 2-8 in their last 10 games after winning a season-high three games in a row to go above .500 (12-11) on 4/27...Have gone 13-13 in their last 26 games after losing a season-high straight games from 4/3-8...Were 10-23 after 33 games in 2020 (10-24 after 34).

**HOMESTAND BEGINS:** The Pirates begin a seven-game homestand tonight with the first of three games against Cincinnati...It concludes with four games against San Francisco, beginning Thursday night...The Bucs have lost four straight games at PNC Park after winning five-of-seven...Overall the Pirates have posted a 5-7 record at home this season.

**THE HIT COLLECTOR:** Adam Frazier enters tonight's game with a season-high 10-game hitting streak (13-for-42, .310)...He had a career-high 12-game hitting streak in 2020...Frazier currently is tied with San Diego's Eric Hosmer for second among all National League players with his 39 hits, trailing only St. Louis' Tommy Edman (41).

**CATCH THIS:** Bucco backstop Jacob Stallings has reached base safely in 10 straight games and has collected 10 hits in his last 32 at bats (.313)...Stallings has also reached base safely in all 10 of his games played at PNC Park this season, going 12-for-30 (.400) with nine walks and a HBP (.550 on-base percentage)...Dating back to August 7 of last season, Jacob is hitting .329 (28-for-85) with four homers, 14 RBI and a .448 on-base percentage in 29 games at PNC Park.

**THE KA'AI OF THE TIGER:** Outfielder Ka'ai Tom connected off Trevor Williams for his first Major League home run Saturday afternoon at Wrigley Field...Tom went 1-for-3 with two walks on Sunday in Chicago and has now reached base safely in eight of his nine games with the Pirates, producing a .424 OBP and five RBI.

**BUCS/REDS:** The Pirates are 0-3 against the Reds this season, having been swept in a three-game series and out-scored, 30-8, at Great American Ball Park during the first road trip of 2021...Tonight marks the first of nine games against the Redlegs at PNC Park this season; they are not scheduled to return to Pittsburgh again until September 14...Dating back to the start of the 2018 season, the Pirates have gone 18-6 against the Reds at PNC Park.

**WANNA BE STARTING SOMETHING:** Over the last six games, the Bucco starting pitchers have posted a 2.48 ERA (36.1ip/10er)...Dating back to April 23, the starters have produced a 3.51 ERA (77.0ip/30er) - the fourth-best ERA among National League starting staffs in that time and the sixth-best in the Majors.

**4 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The Pirates scored six runs in Sunday's victory at Wrigley Field, the first time they scored more than three runs in a game since plating five on 5/1...The Bucs are now 11-3 this season when scoring four runs or more.

**BULLISH PEN:** Dating back to April 8, Pittsburgh's bullpen has posted the fourth-lowest ERA among Major League teams (2.79), trailing only the Marlins (2.42), Indians (2.69) and Mets (2.74).

**HOT ROD:** Richard Rodríguez saw his streak of retiring 29 straight batters come to an end in the ninth inning Sunday in Chicago...His 0.16 WHIP in his first 12 appearances was the third-lowest by any Major League pitcher thru his first 12 games (since 1900)...Rich Rod is also the first pitcher in Pirates history to allow no more than one hit over his first 12 appearances of a season...Dating back to June 1, 2019, Rodríguez has produced a 2.16 ERA (79.1ip/19er) in his 83 games - that is the third-lowest ERA in the Majors and lowest in the N.L. among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances.

**PEN PALS:** David Bednar has been scored upon once in his last 11 appearances (9.2ip/1er)...Kyle Crick has made nine straight hitless outings (8.0ip) and has allowed just one hit in his first 12 games (32 at bats) overall...Sam Howard has stranded all 10 of his inherited runners and Clay Holmes has been charged with one earned run in his last 10 games (12.2ip).

**SHELTY'S CREW:** Manager Derek Shelton and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021...Christian Marrero has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include Tarrick Brock (First Base), Joey Cora (Third Base), Rick Eckstein (Hitting), Don Kelly (Bench), Oscar Marin (Pitching), Justin Meccage (Bullpen), Mike Rabelo (Field Coordinator) and Glenn Sherlock...Catching coaches Herbie Andrade and Jordan Comadena have returned.

**WAIVER CLAIM:** Outfielder Ben Gamel was claimed off waivers Sunday from the Cleveland Indians...He went 1-for-14 with a double in 11 games with the Indians, collecting his lone hit in his final at bat on 4/16 at Cincinnati...With the Indians in 2021, Gamel made nine appearances (three starts) in center field and one appearance in left field...In his big league career, Gamel has made 208 appearances in left field, 168 in right field and 47 in center field...Gamel will be wearing uniform #18.

Made his Major League debut on 7/26 at St. Louis and pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief.
<b>vs. CINCINNATI:</b>	0-1 with a 1.93 ERA (9.1ip/2er) in two career starts...Made his first start of the 2021 season on 4/5 at GABP and received a no-decision (4.0ip/1er)...Suffered a 1-0 loss to Luis Castillo last year on 9/16 at Great American Ball Park; he pitched 4.0 scoreless frames to start the game before surrendering the only run of the game in the fifth inning.
