YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the White Sox, $6-4$, in the second game of the four-game set, guaranteeing at least a series split...Improved to 26-10 when homering...The start of the game was delayed by 41 minutes; Baltimore has had nine games impacted by weather this year, with one postponement, one suspended game, and eight delays ( 15 hours, 14 minutes).
$\theta_{0}$ Corbin Burnes did not factor in the decision after allowing three runs on seven hits and two walks with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings; leads the O's and ranks tied for second in MLB with eight quality starts; is the first O's pitcher with six straight quality starts since Alex Cobb from July 26 to August 24, 2018.
$\theta$. Craig Kimbrel worked a perfect ninth inning with a strikeout to convert his $11^{\text {th }}$ save of the season and $428^{\text {th }}$ of his career, tying Boston's Kenley Jansen for fifth all-time and the most among active pitchers (see box at right).

THE TIMES THEY ARE A-CHANGIN': The game between the Orioles and Tigers at Comerica Park on Sunday, September 15, has been changed to 12:10 p.m. ET (from 1:40 p.m. ET).

THE ERAS TOUR: The O's have a 2.75 ERA ( 61 ER/200.0 IP) in their last 22 games since April 29, the second-best mark in MLB behind the Yankees (2.47)...During that time, the Birds have surrendered an MLB-low 144 hits while holding opponents to a . 199 batting average ( 144 -for- 722 ).
TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson is tied with Houston's Kyle Tucker for the MLB home run lead with 17 and ranks among the leaders in a variety of statistical categories (see box at right)..Slashing .345/.486/.966 (10-for-29) with one double, one triple, five home runs, nine runs, 10 RBI, eight walks, and a stolen base in his last eight games; owns a 1.452 OPS during that stretch.
O. Homered in four straight games from May 17-20, the first Oriole to do since DJ Stewart from September 5-9, 2020; is one of five MLB players to homer in at least four straight games this year, along with Boston's Rafael Devers (6 G), Chicago-NL's Michael Busch ( 5 G), Los Angeles-NL's Mookie Betts (4 G), and Texas' Corey Seager (4G).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank second in MLB with 72 home runs, tied with 2012 for the third-most homers through the first 49 games of a season in O's history behind 1987 and 1996 (78); the most homers through Baltimore's first 50 games of a season is 81 by the 1987 team.
$\theta_{s}$. The Orioles have eight players with at least six homers, the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (17), Adley Rutschman (9), Anthony Santander (8), Jordan Westburg (7), and Colton Cowser, Ryan Mountcastle, Cedric Mullins, and Ryan O'Hearn (6); the Yankees rank second with six players.

LEADING ACTORS: Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...Gunnar Henderson has hit five of those, the most in MLB...Jordan Westburg has the other for the O's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.
$\theta_{\text {, }}$ Henderson's five leadoff home runs are tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history with Cedric Mullins (2022), Seth Smith (2017), Adam Jones (2016), and Don Buford (1971); he trails Brady Anderson (7 in 1999 \& 2000), Mullins (8 in 2021), and Anderson (12 in 1996).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Orioles are on a seven-game road trip...Were swept in three games by the Cardinals...Have won the first two games of a four-game set against the White Sox...The O's are 14-8 (.636) on the road this year, the second-best road record in the AL and third-best in MLB, behind the Yankees(.667, 18-9) and Phillies(.682, 15-7).

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: The Orioles and White Sox continue a four-game set in Chicago today, the first of two series between the teams this season...The Orioles need a win today or tomorrow to clinch their fifth consecutive series win over the White Sox, which would be their longest streak since winning eight sets in a row against them from September 1977 to August 1979, per the Elias Sports Bureau...The O's will host the ChiSox in Baltimore for three games from September 2-4...Last year, the Orioles went 4-2 against the Sox, taking two of three in Chicago from April 14-16 and two of three in Baltimore from August 28-30...The Orioles also won the season series against the White Sox in $2022(5-2)$ and are 11-4 against them since the start of 2022 .

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 346 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver (1,480).

TRADE WINDS: On Wednesday the Orioles acquired catcher Blake Hunt from the Seattle Mariners in exchange for right-handed pitcher Mike Baumann and minor league catcher Michael Pérez...Hunt was optioned to Triple-A Norfolk.
$\theta$, Hunt, 25, slashed .293/.372/.533 (22-for-75) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 15 runs scored, 20 RBI, six walks, and four hit-by-pitches in 24 games with Triple-A Tacoma this season...He was ranked as the No. 23 Mariners prospect by MLB Pipeline.
