The Red Sox took 2 out of 3 from the Mariners at T-Mobile Park from June 19-21 this year...last season at Fenway Park (April 22-24, 2025), the Mariners took 2 out of 3 as part of a 6-3 road trip.

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TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue the road trip tonight with the second game of a 3-game series against the Boston Red Sox (0-1)...Seattle also took on the Toronto Blue Jays (0-3) on the trip...following tomorrow afternoon's road trip finale, the Mariners welcome the Athletics (4 G, 9/3-9/6) and Texas Rangers (3 G, 9/8-9/10)...tonight's game will be televised and streamed on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Angie Mentink** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners dropped last night's game to the Red Sox by a 9-8 score in 10 innings... Seattle fell to 7-7 in extra innings and 21-21 in one-run games.

- **20 Home Run Quartet** - **Randy Arozarena**, **Dominic Canzone**, **Cal Raleigh** and **Julio Rodríguez** are 1 of 5 quartets with 20+ homers apiece this season, along with the Cubs, Reds, Braves and Nationals.
- **Summer Strolls** - The Mariners drew 101 walks in August, the most they have recorded in a month this season...their 101 walks ranked 3rd-most among AL teams in August.
- **¡Feliz Cumpleaños!**- Right-handed reliever **Eduard Bazarzo** celebrates his 31st birthday today.

WELCOME TO THE BIG LEAGUES, BIG LAZ...the Mariners have selected OF **Lazaro Montes** (#99), pronounced (lah-sah-ro mone-tess), and LHP **Hoby Milner** (#41), first name pronounced (HO-bee), from Triple-A Tacoma as Major League rosters have expanded to 28 players today...Montes will make his Major League debut when he first appears in a game...the No. 56 overall prospect per MLB Pipeline, is batting .292 (28x96) with 21 runs, 5 doubles, 10 home runs, 22 RBI and a 1.054 OPS over 25 games with Triple-A Tacoma since being promoted from Double-A Arkansas on July 7...over 123 games between Triple-A and Double-A this season, Montes' 38 home runs are the 2nd-most among MLB batters...Milner appeared in 38 Major League games this season with the Chicago Cubs, going 1-0 with a 3.53 (14 ER, 35.2 IP), 9 walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP before signing a minor league contract with the Mariners on Aug. 31.

WOO, WOO, WOO, YOU KNOW IT...tonight's starter **Bryan Woo** has fared well in each of his 2 road starts...during last road trip against the Yankees (Aug. 11) and Astros (Aug. 16), he combined for a 1.64 ERA (2 ER, 11.0 IP) with 10 strikeouts and 2 walks, limiting hitters to a .162 batting average (6x37).

YOU'RE CRUSHING IT, CAL...**Cal Raleigh** hit his 20th home run of the season in yesterday's game at Boston for his fifth consecutive 20+ homer season (2022-c)...it also marks his seventh home run over his last 10 games to put his slugging percentage since the start of the last homestand (8/21-c) at .971 for his 2nd-best mark over a 10-game span in his career, just trailing a .973 SLG from Sept. 13-24, 2025...his 7 homers are also tied for the most he has recorded in a 10-game span in his career and the most since Sept. 14-25, 2025.

- **The Latest Stretch** - Cal has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games (8/16-c), batting .293 (12x41) with 8 home runs, 1 double, 11 RBI, 11 walks, and a .442 on-base percentage while slugging .902 for an 1.344 OPS in 52 plate appearances.
- **Did You 'Catch' This?** - Raleigh became the 18th catcher (min. 50% of games at catcher in a season) in MLB history to record five or more seasons with 20+ homers, and the ninth to do it before turning 30 years old.
- **Quite The Month** - In the month of August, Raleigh posted an .877 OPS across 100 plate appearances, batting .195 (16x82) with 9 home runs, 15 RBI, 17 walks, a .340 OBP and .537 slugging percentage.

HAVE YOURSELF A GAME, RANDY...in yesterday's game, **Randy Arozarena** put together a 4-hit, 4-RBI performance with a double, home run, 3 runs scored and 4 RBI to help score 7 of the Mariners 8 runs in the contest...last night marked his second 4-hit showing of the season and his 10th game reaching base 4+ times, joining only 6 other players in MLB to record 10+ such games this season...was his 2nd game this season with 3+ runs and 4+ RBI (also: 7/4 vs. TOR)...became the 12th Mariners batter to have multiple such games in a single season, along with teammate **Cal Raleigh** (2023-24).

- **The Latest Stretch** - Over his last 19 games since Aug. 11, Randy owns a .968 OPS, reaching base at a .379 clip while slugging .589, and recording 10 extra-base hits, including 6 home runs that have all been to score the game-tying or go-ahead run.

JUST JOSHIN' AROUND...in 38 games since the All-Star Break (7/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .303 (44x145) with 14 runs, 6 doubles, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 11 walks, 7 stolen bases, a .354 OBP while slugging .387 for a .740 OPS, reaching base in 33 of those games...his .303 batting average in the 2nd half ranks 9th in the American League and T-17th in MLB among qualified hitters...he also ranks T-4th in the AL in stolen bases during that span along with José Ramírez-CLE.

IN THE CANZONE...**Dominic Canzone** went 2-for-5 with 2 RBI, a double, and a triple for his 2nd triple of the season and his career in yesterday's game at Boston...marked his 8th such game since Aug. 9, ranking T-8th most in MLB over that span...also marked his 8th game with multiple XBH...his 8 such games rank T-7th most in the AL this season...the Mariners have 6 games where multiple players have recorded 2+ XBH, including yesterday's game...Canzone has been apart of 5 of those 7 such performances.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...the Mariners begin September play today, with 24 games remaining in the regular season, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Seattle went 17-8 (.680) in September 2025?...last season, the Mariners went into September 2.0 games back of the AL West Division lead, dropped the first 4 games of September to fall as many as 4.0 games back of the division, before rattling off a 10-game winning streak from Sept. 6-16 and a 17-1 run from Sept. 6-25 en route to the AL West Division crown.

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - SEPTEMBER 1

- **1992** - **Edgar Martinez** is named AL Player of the month for the second consecutive month (July and August). In 27 August games Martinez hit .395 (45x114), with 22 runs, 16 doubles, three HRs, 19 RBI and a .443 on base percentage.
- **1996** - After having his bat confiscated by Baltimore manager Davey Johnson, **Alex Rodriguez** borrows a bat from **Ken Griffey Jr.** and hits a three-run HR helping Seattle to a 5-1 win vs. the Orioles. Rodriguez average hits a season high .376. Bobby Bonilla's bat had been confiscated earlier in the game by manager Lou Piniella. Both bats were later checked and cleared.
- **2008** - **Adrian Beltre** goes 5-for-6 and hits for the cycle...becomes first player in club history with 5 hits and 5 runs in a game...4th player in club history to hit for the cycle.
- **2025** - **Randy Arozarena** recorded his 25th stolen base of the season, securing the first 25+ home run, 25+ stolen base season of his career, the third Cuban-born player with a 25/25 season, and the fourth player in Mariners history with at 25/25 season, joining **Julio Rodríguez** (2022-23), Mike Cameron (2001-02) and Alex Rodriguez (1998)...**Leo Rivas** hits his first Major League home run in the 9th inning against Tampa Bay.

ABOUT BRYAN WOO...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is set to make his 26th start of the season and 96th career start...is also making his 3rd career start against the Red Sox and 1st of the season.
- Selected by Seattle in the 6th round (174th overall) of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of California Polytechnic State University...signed by Mariners scout Chris Hom.
- Spent 3 seasons at Cal Poly before being drafted, making 31 appearances (6 starts) for the Mustangs. Did not pitch in 2021 while recovering from right elbow surgery.
- Was selected to the 2025 American League All-Star team for the 1st time in his career.

LAST TIME OUT...L#9 on Aug. 26 in the series finale against the Phillies...tossed 4.0 innings, allowing 6 runs (6 ER) on 5 hits (2 HR) and 1 walk while striking out 5 batters...threw 76 pitches and 55 strikes...marked just the 12th time in his career that he has tossed 4.0 innings-or-fewer (last: 6/24/26 at PIT).

END OF AUGUST...finished the month of August with a 3.27 ERA (8 ER, 22.0 IP), 20 strikeouts, a 0.818 WHIP and 5.00 SO/BB...his 0.818 WHIP ranked T-6th best among pitchers in the month of August (min. 20 IP)...across 18 career starts in August, he owns a 2.37 ERA (29 ER, 110.0 IP) which is his best mark in any month throughout his career (next: 2.39 ERA across 17 starts in May)...his 0.800 WHIP and 6.29 career SO/BB in the month of August leads all pitchers (min. 100 IP), while his 1.35 BB/9 ranks 2nd-best.

APPROACHING 150...is 8 strikeouts away from 150 strikeouts this season and would join **Logan Gilbert** as the two Mariners pitchers with 150+ strikeouts...when Woo reaches 150+ strikeouts, the Mariners would become just the 5th team this season with multiple players with 150+ strikeouts, joining the Phillies (4), Pirates (2), Rangers (2) and Guardians (2).

MORE ON THE MILESTONE...Woo would also become the 7th pitcher in franchise history to reach 150 strikeouts in multiple seasons age 26-or-younger, joining Félix Hernández (7x, 2006-12), Freddy García (3x, 199-02), Mark Langston (3x, 1984-87), Mike Moore (2x, 1984-85) and teammates **George Kirby** (2x, 2023-24) and **Logan Gilbert** (2x, 2022-23).

AGAINST THE SOX...is 2-0 with a 1.38 career ERA (2 ER, 13.0 IP), 14 strikeouts to 3 walks and just 4 hits (1 HR) allowed) across 4 career starts against Boston...is making just his second ever start at Fenway Park, last tossing 6.0 innings and allowing 2 runs (2 ER) on 3 hits with 1 walk and 6 strikeouts on April 24, 2025...the Mariners have won in each of Woo's two career starts against the Red Sox.

ONE-HIT WONDERS...in his last career start against the Red Sox (6/17/25 at T-Mobile Park), he threw 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed just 1 hit with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts...it marked his first of three games of 7.0+ IP with 1-or-fewer hits since last season...is 1 of just 4 players with 3+ such games since 2025, joining Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD (4x), Sonny Gray-STL/BOS (3x) and Noah Cameron-KC (3x).

BRINGING THE HEAT...has gradually increased the average pitch velocity of his four-seamer over the season, starting with 95.5 mph in March/April to now averaging 96.9 mph across 4 starts in August (+1.4 mph)...threw a career-high 15 pitches above 98 mph on Aug. 11 vs. NYY then followed with 12 pitches above 98 mph on Aug. 26 vs. PHI...prior to Aug. 2026, he had never thrown more than 5 pitches over 98 mph...threw 4 pitches above 99 mph on Aug. 11 vs. NYY, marking the four fastest pitches of his career.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS...has thrown 5.0+ IP with 3-or-fewer in 3 starts of his last 4 starts (8/5-c) and in 8 total starts this season...his 19 such games since 2025 are tied for 2nd-most in MLB (also: Eury Pérez-MIA), trailing only Paul Skenes-PIT (21 G)...he co-leads MLB in starts of 5.0+ IP, 3-or-fewer hits and 0 earned runs allowed this season (7 G, also: Cam Schlichter-NYY) and has made 15 such career starts, tied for most in MLB since 2024, alongside **Bryce Miller**, Tark Skubal-DET/LAD, and Paul Skenes-PIT.

WATCH HIM WHIP...his 1.011 career WHIP ranked 3rd-best in MLB among pitchers since 2023 (min. 500 IP), trailing only Tark Skubal-DET/LAD (0.912) and **Logan Gilbert** (1.000) while ranking ahead of Zack Wheeler-PHI (1.012)...Woo's 1.011 career WHIP is also the lowest mark in franchise history (min. 500 IP), ranking ahead of **Logan Gilbert** (1.053) and Hisashi Iwakuma (1.143)...posted a sub-1.000 WHIP in both 2024 (0.898) and 2025 (0.927), becoming the first pitcher in franchise history to record back-to-back seasons with a sub-1.000 WHIP (min. 100 IP).

NO FREE PASSES HERE...among qualified pitchers since 2025, he leads MLB in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.15), ranks 2nd in walks-per-nine (1.81), and 2nd in walk rate (5.0%)...in addition, he has tossed 6.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer walks in 15 of his 24 starts this season and in 42 total starts since 2025, which leads MLB across that span, ranking ahead of next closest Sandy Alcantara-MIA (39)...his 27 such starts in 2025 were tied with Jamie Moyer (1998) for most starts of 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer walks in a season in franchise history.

- On Call Often - His 65 relief appearances this season lead the Mariners bullpen and ranks T-6th in MLB...his 26 holds also rank 5th in MLB.
- Reliable Arm - Has only allowed an earned run in 16 of 65 appearances this season...has allowed 2+ ER only five times.
- Super Stretch - Held a 0.77 ERA (1 ER, 11.2 IP) with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts over 12 appearances during April.
- El Campeón - Won the 2026 World Baseball Classic with Team Venezuela, which included a pitching appearance in the Championship Game against Team USA on March 17.
