RAY REPORT—The Rays continue their three-game homestand against the Tigers tonight at Tropicana Field...following the three-game stretch, Tampa Bay will embark on a six-game road trip against the White Sox and Brewers from April 26–May 1...they are 5-6 so far in a stretch of 13 consecutive games without an off day that concludes on Wednesday evening.

- ✦ With last night's 7-1 defeat, Tampa Bay fell to 1-7 in series openers to begin the 2024 campaign...it marks the first time in franchise history the Rays have lost at least seven of their first eight series openers to start a season (Elias).
- ✦ This marks the first time Tampa Bay has been in fifth place of the AL East 20+ games into a season since entering play on May 2, 2021 with a 13-15 record.
- ✦ The Rays fell to the .500 mark for the first time since April 9 (6-6)...they have not been under .500 since April 8 (5-6).
- ✦ Tonight, Tampa Bay looks to avoid their first three-game losing streak since a five-game skid from July 16-20, 2023.
- ✦ The Rays are also looking to avoid their first series defeat vs. Detroit at Tropicana Field since the Tigers swept a four-game set from June 30–July 3, 2016.
- ✦ **Kevin Cash** remains four victories shy of surpassing **Joe Maddon** (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader.

ALL ABOUT AMED—**Amed Rosario** led off last night's game with a single, extending his career-long hitting streak to 14 games...entering the at-bat, he was a career 0-for-10 opposite Detroit starter **Tarik Skubal**...he owns the longest-active hitting streak in the majors, ahead of **PHI Trea Turner** (11G), during which Rosario is batting .417 (25-for-60) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR and 11 RBI.

- ✦ The streak is the longest by a Rays batter since **Yandy Díaz** hit safely in 14 straight from May 3-21, 2023...the last Ray to hit safely in 15 consecutive games was **Manuel Margot** (15G: May 1-28, 2022).
- ✦ Rosario has multiple hits in eight of his last 10 games since April 12, the most by any player in the majors during that period, ahead of **BAL Gunnar Henderson** (6G).
- ✦ His 10 multi-hit efforts on the season are tied for the most in the AL with **CLE Steven Kwan**, **HOU Jeremy Peña**, **BAL Adley Rutschman**, **TEX Marcus Semien** and **HOU Kyle Tucker**...**LAD Shohei Ohtani** leads MLB with 11 multi-hit games.
- ✦ His .359 AVG leads the AL and is second best in MLB behind Ohtani (.368).

HOT AND COLD—**José Caballero** has recorded an extra-base hit in a career-high three straight games...he has hit safely in four straight contests and in six of his last seven.

- ✦ In 14 games this month, **Richie Palacios** is batting .341 (14-for-41) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 6 BB and 11 R...he has plated a run in a career-best four consecutive games, the longest active run in the AL.
- ✦ In 19 April games, **Randy Arozarena** is batting .110 (8-for-73) with 1 XBH (2B) and 23 strikeouts...it is the lowest batting average by any MLB player in April, with the next closest being **BOS Cedanne Rafaela** (.129).
- ✦ **Jose Siri** has struck out in 14 straight games, the third-longest active streak in the majors behind **CLE Bo Naylor** (17G) and **WSH Joey Gallo** (16G)...Siri's 37 strikeouts overall are tied with **PIT Oneil Cruz** for the most in the majors.

ROUNDING INTO FORM—In seven games since April 16, the Tampa Bay bullpen has posted a 1.03 ERA (26.1IP, 3ER) with 24 strikeouts against six walks while holding opponents to a .163 (15-for-92) average...in the previous 17 games to open the season, Rays relievers posted an MLB-worst 6.92 ERA (67.2IP, 52ER) with 60 strikeouts against 46 walks while opponents hit .279 (74-for-265).

- ✦ During the stretch since April 16, Tampa Bay relievers rank among all MLB bullpens in ERA (2nd), WHIP (2nd, 0.80), opp. OBP (2nd, .243), opp. OPS (2nd, .449), opp. AVG (3rd), opp. SLG (3rd, .207), pitches/IP (3rd, 14.7), hits/9.OIP (4th, 5.13) and BB/9.OIP (4th, 2.05).

TROP TROUBLES—Tampa Bay has allowed 22 HR this season at Tropicana Field, the most by any team at their home ballpark, with the next closest club being Toronto (18HR)...the Rays 1.42 HR/9.OIP at home is second highest in the majors behind only the Angels (1.83 HR/9.OIP).

- ✦ Tampa Bay has conceded at least one home run in 11 of 15 home games, including a season-high 5 HR on April 13 vs. San Francisco.
- ✦ Rays pitchers have allowed 32 HR overall, second most in the majors behind Toronto (33HR).

KNEES WEAK, ARMS ARE HEAVY—The Rays have scored four runs or fewer in six straight games, despite accumulating 50 hits during that period (8.3 H/G)...it marks the first time Tampa Bay has scored four runs or fewer in six straight games since a seven-game run from July 15 (G2)-July 21, 2023.

- ✦ During this six-game stretch, the Rays are batting .143 (6-for-42) with runners in scoring position.

UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY—Tampa Bay has suffered six losses by 6+ runs this season, the second-most such defeats in the majors behind Chicago-AL (7G)...the Rays had eight losses by 6+ runs in 2023, the fewest in the majors, with the next closest teams being Atlanta and Seattle (9G).

STAYING IN THE FIGHT—Tampa Bay is batting .280 from the 7th inning on, the third-highest average in the majors behind Atlanta (.311) and Baltimore (.292).

- ✦ **Amed Rosario's** .429 (12-for-28) mark in such situations ranks second in the majors behind **MIL William Contreras** (.478).
- ✦ Rosario is also batting an MLB-best .516 (16-for-31) with two outs, ahead of **Contreras** (.476) and **KC Salvador Perez** (.452).

MOTOR CITY MATCHUP—Tampa Bay and Detroit continue a six-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field...the Rays will travel to Comerica Park from Sept. 24-26, the first leg of their final road trip of the season before closing out the year in Boston.

- ✦ The Rays earned a 5-1 season series victory over the Tigers in 2023, including a three-game sweep at Tropicana Field to open the year from March 30–April 2.
- ✦ Since the beginning of the 2017 season, Tampa Bay is 15-5 (.750) vs. Detroit at Tropicana Field.
- ✦ Overall, Tampa Bay's 26-14 (.650) winning percentage vs. Detroit since 2017 is its second highest against any AL opponent, trailing only Los Angeles-AL (33-15, .688).

CONNECTIONS

- ✦ **Ron Cash**, the late uncle of Rays Manager **Kevin Cash**, played two seasons in the majors with the Tigers (1973-74) and hit .297 in 34 career games.
- ✦ Tampa Bay Bench Coach **Rodney Linares** was originally signed by the Tigers in 1997 and spent one season in the Detroit system, hitting .228 with 10 RBI across 25 games.
- ✦ Tigers Vice President, Assistant General Manager **Rob Metzler** spent 15 seasons with Tampa Bay, seven of which were as the Senior Director of Amateur Scouting.
- ✦ Rays Assistant Pitching & Rehab Coach **Rick Knapp** was the pitching coach for the Tigers under Manager **Jim Leyland** from 2009-11...his son, **Ricky**, was selected by the Tigers in the 44th round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft out of Port Charlotte High School, but opted to attend Florida Gulf Coast University.
- ✦ Rays LHP **Tyler Alexander** was selected by the Tigers in the second round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Christian University...he made 120 appearances with Detroit from 2019-2023 before being placed on waivers this past offseason.
- ✦ Tigers RHP **Casey Mize**, selected first overall by Detroit in 2018 First-Year Player Draft, resides in St. Petersburg during the offseason.

TONIGHT'S START—Pepiot will make his fifth start of the year and fourth at Tropicana Field, having alternated wins and losses in his first four outings...has tossed at least 5.0 IP in each start thus far...min. 20.0 IP, his 30.7 pct. strikeout rate ranks fifth in the AL...since SF LaMonte Wade Jr. homered off him on April 13, Pepiot has retired 18 of his last 24 BF with 7 SO and 0 XBH.

LAST TIME OUT—Overcame three walks to secure his second victory of the season in the Rays 2-1 win over the Angels on April 18 (W, 6.0IP, 3H, ER, 3BB, 7SO)...uncorked his first wild pitch since 2022 in the 2nd frame, but stranded two runners in scoring position...the only run against him was manufactured in the 6th inning when Mike Trout walked, stole second and third, and scored on a Miguel Sanó sacrifice fly...the Rays bullpen backed him with 3.0 scoreless frames to ensure the victory.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: LHP TYLER ALEXANDER (1-0, 4.79)

LAST START—Recorded 5.0 scoreless frames on April 19 at Yankee Stadium, but did not factor into the decision of a 5-3 Rays loss (5.1IP, 2H, OR, BB, 4SO)...his only two hits allowed were an infield single by Oswaldo Cabrera in the 3rd and a Jose Trevino single in the 5th.

vs. TIGERS—Alexander will be making his first career appearance against the Tigers, the club that he spent the first five seasons of his major league career with from 2019-23...he went 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (9.1IP, 2ER) in six relief appearances opposite the AL Central in 2023.

WE MEET AGAIN—Pepiot is set to make his first career start against the Tigers...in his lone appearance opposite Detroit on Sept. 19, 2023 at Dodger Stadium, he worked what would have been a quality start behind opener RHP Caleb Ferguson (6.0IP, 5H, ER, BB, 4SO, HR)...he has yet to receive a decision in three career games (1GS) vs. AL Central clubs, posting a 3.77 ERA (14.1IP, 6ER) with four walks and 14 SO.

WHIFF YOU PLEASE—Pepiot leads the Rays with 64 swings-and-misses, ahead of Zack Littell (61)...35 of those whiffs have come on his four-seam fastball, which opponents have gone 3-for-37 (.081) against, the lowest opp. average on any fastball in the majors (min. 25AB ending with pitch)...his 41.7 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer is the second highest on any MLB pitcher's fastball, trailing only OAK Mason Miller (46.2%).

✦ His 27 SO are tied with Taj Bradley for fourth most through a pitcher's first four games with the Rays, trailing Jake Faria (29SO), Chris Archer (28SO) and Wade Davis (28SO)...Pepiot would need 9 SO today to surpass Faria (35SO, 2017) as the Rays all-time leader through five games with the franchise.

HUNG OUT TO DRY—The Rays have been outscored, 23-10 (-13), in Pepiot's starts...they have provided him with only 2.38 runs of support per 9.0 IP, 12th lowest among AL pitchers (min. 20.0IP)...in his career as a starter, Pepiot is 6-0 with a 2.23 ERA (48.1IP, 12ER) when receiving just two or more runs of support (8GS) and 0-3 with a 6.46 ERA (23.2IP, 17ER) with one or zero runs...in the two starts in which he received multiple runs of support this season, Pepiot is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA compared to 0-2 with an 8.44 ERA (10.2IP, 10ER) in his other two starts.

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, holding opponents to one run and a .132 (5-for-38) average in innings 2-4 while posting an 8.44 ERA (10.2IP, 10ER) and .244 (10-for-41) opp. average in all other frames...opposing hitters are 4-for-34 (.118) against him the second time through the lineup compared to a combined 11-for-45 (.244) the first and third times.

(DON'T) WALK THE WALK—Limiting walks has been key to Pepiot's success early in his career...when he issues one or zero walks (12G/6GS), he is 5-2 with a 2.21 ERA (61.0IP, 15ER)...in outings with multiple walks (8G/7GS), he is 1-1 with a 4.76 ERA (34.0IP, 18ER)...six of his eight walks this season have come following a first-pitch ball.

THIS AND THAT—Min. 40 AB, his .143 (6-for-42) opp. average against right-handed batters is the lowest in the AL...righties are just 4-for-37 (.108) with 13 SO against his four-seam fastball/slider combination.

✦ Eight of 11 runs allowed by Pepiot have come in a total of three frames: the 1st and 6th innings on April 1 vs. TEX (3R each) and the 5th frame on April 13 vs. SF (2R)...in all other frames, he has produced a 1.35 ERA (20.0IP, 3ER).

2023 RECAP—Pitched to a 2-1 mark with a 2.14 ERA (42.0IP, 10ER) in eight appearances (3GS) with the Dodgers...after being named the organization's No. 5 prospect by Baseball America during the offseason, opened the year on the 15-day IL with a left oblique strain and was transferred to the 60-day IL on April...pitched behind an opener in his season debut on Aug. 19 vs. Miami (5.0IP, 3H, ER, BB, 5SO)...his 0.76 WHIP from the time of his debut through the end of the season led the NL (min. 40.0IP) while his 2.14 ERA ranked third behind SD Blake Snell (1.02) and NYM Kodai Senga (2.06).

- ✦ Is 3-for-41 (.073) in his last 11G...batting a majors'-worst .110 (8-for-73) in April... his lowest AVG in a full calendar month was .153 (13-for-85) in July 2023.
- ✦ Has hit safely in 8 of his last 10G vs. DET since Aug. 4, 2022, batting .289 (11-for-38) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI and an .860 OPS during that stretch.
- ✦ Averages 4.32 pitches/PA, most among Rays hitters.
- ✦ Has gone a career-long 20G without a multi-hit effort dating to March 31.
- ✦ Recorded an OF assist on April 17 vs. LAA to preserve a 4-4 tie in the 9th inning... marked his first assist since Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL.
