TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today placed on the bereavement list **RHP Pierce Johnson**; recalled from **AAA-Louisville RHP Zach Maxwell** and **OF Blake Dunn**; optioned to **AAA-Louisville OF Rece Hinds** (post-game, 5/2).

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 3-game series against **Jim Trdinich's Pirates** and the third game (0-2) of a 7-game road trip that includes an upcoming 4-game set against the **Cubs** at **Wrigley Field**.

- The Reds are coming off a 4-2 homestand in which they won 2 of 3 against both the **Tigers** and **Rockies**.
- At 20-13 (.625), the Reds are off to their best 33-game start to a season since 2006 (21-12)...the 2006 campaign was also the last time they won at least 21 of their first 33 games to begin a season (22-12).
- Following Thu's game at **Chc**, the Redlegs will return to **Cincinnati** for a 6-game homestand against the **Astros** (5/8-5/10) and **Nationals** (5/12-14).

STATE OF THE REDS: At 20-13 (.606), the Reds are tied with **StL** for second place in the NL Central division standings, 1.0 game behind **Chc** (21-12).

- The Reds entered May in first place in their division for the ninth time in the divisional era (since 1969)...last did so in 2006, when they finished April tied with the **Cardinals** for the top spot in the NL Central.
- Also marked the first time the Reds entered May in sole possession of the top spot in their division since 2002 (17-9 record).
- Of the 9 Reds teams to enter May atop their division, 3 qualified for Postseason play, including each of the last 2 World Series championship squads (1976, '90).

BIG ROAD MACHINE: The Reds' .667 road winning percentage this season is tied with the **Yankees** for the third-highest mark in MLB, behind only the **Braves** (.750) and **Cardinals** (.688)...have produced 2 series sweeps on the road this season, tied with the **Yankees** and **Cardinals** for most in MLB.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Reds have 3 players aged 24 or younger with at least 1.0 bWAR (wins above replacement) this season: **SS Elly De La Cruz** (1.5), **RHP Chase Burns** (1.4), and **INF Sal Stewart** (1.0).

- Their 3-such players are tied with the **Cardinals** for most among all Major League teams this season.
- Burns'** 1.4 bWAR ranks T3rd among National League pitchers, behind **NYM's Clay Holmes** and **Phi's Christopher Sánchez** (1.5 each).

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: With Thu's 6-4 win vs **Col**, the Reds kept their perfect record in games decided by 2 runs or fewer intact, improving to 12-0 in such games this season.

- The Reds' 12-game winning streak in games decided by 2 runs or fewer matches the 1987 **Brewers** for the longest-such streak by any Major League team to begin a season since 1900.

400/200/150: **SS Elly De La Cruz** is 3 steals away from ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to produce 400 hits, 200 RBI, & 150 steals...he's currently at 453 H, 231 RBI, & 147 SB in 453 career G.

- De La Cruz enters today's game at 24 years, 112 days old**...he's attempting to become the youngest Red since 1900 to reach 150 career steals (**Eric Davis** 25 years, 82 days).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Pirates** are meeting for the second time this season...**Pit** took 2 of 3 from **Cin** from 3/30-4/1 at **Great American Ball Park**.

- The Reds went 7-6 vs the **Pirates** in 2025, securing their first season series victory vs **Pit** since 2021 (13-6).
- Cin** has played the **Pirates** 513 times since both teams became charter members of the **National League Central** in 1994 (265-248, .517), more than any other **Pit** opponent.
- The Redlegs have lost 47 of the last 68 and 16 of the last 23 games they've played at **PNC Park**, including an 11-game losing streak spanning 9/3/18 to 9/27/19 and an 8-game losing streak to begin the 2019 season (4/4-9/27, 2019).

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of **Cin's** last 251 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fourth-longest consecutive games played streak by a Red since 1970.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have hit 22 home runs over their last 10 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), most among all Major League teams in that time...the 22 homers are also their most in any 10-game span since 7/9-7/22, 2024 (23hr).

- Cin's** 44 home runs this season are tied with the **Cardinals** for fourth-most in MLB, behind the **Yankees** (53), **Braves** (47), and **Dodgers** (45).
- Their 12 games with multiple homers this season are tied for third-most in the National League and for sixth-most in MLB.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Reds own a 13-2 record (.867) when scoring first this season, second to only the **Cardinals** (14-2, .875) for the best mark in MLB.

- Have scored 27 runs in the 1st inning this season, tied with the **Yankees** and **Astros** for second-most among all Major League teams...only the **Nationals** (32) have scored more runs in the opening frame.

- Owns a .140 batting average against through his first 38 career relief appearances, the third-best mark by any Red in that span since 1900, behind Alexis Diaz (.125) and Tejay Antone (.139).
- His .150 opponent batting average this season ranks sixth among Major League relievers with at least 60 batters faced.
- His 13 scoreless appearances this season are tied for 11th-most among all MLB pitchers.
- In the 8th inning on 4/16 vs SF was ejected by third-base umpire Quinn Wolcott... marked his first career ejection and first issued to any Red this season.
- Has won each of his first 6 career decisions as a reliever, dating back to 6/24/25 vs NYY...is tied for the fourth-longest streak by a Reds relief pitcher to begin his career since the mound moved to its current distance in 1893.

- Allowed his first 3 runs of 2026 on 4/24 vs Det, snapping his season-opening, 11-game scoreless streak...was tied for the ninth-longest streak by any Red to open a campaign since 1900, the longest since Lucas Sims (also 11g) in 2023.
- Prior to 4/24 vs Det, had worked a career-high 12 straight scoreless relief appearances (11.2ip), dating back to 9/26/25 at Mil...when it was snapped, his 11.2-inning scoreless streak was the sixth-longest active run among Major League pitchers on an active roster.
- From 3/28-4/22 became the fourth Reds pitcher since 1900 to begin a season by posting 11+ straight relief apps without a run or extra-base hit, joining Logan Ondrusek (17g, 2012), Gabe White (11g, 2002), and John Franco (11g, 1987).
