RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their eight-game, 10-day homestand with the finale of a two-game series against the division-rival Chicago Cubs tonight on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball ... The Cardinals have enjoyed a 6-1 homestand after taking 2-of-3 from the Boston Red Sox (May 17-19) and sweeping the Baltimore Orioles in three games (May 20-22) ... The last time St. Louis won seven or more games on a homestand was April 20-28, 2019 (7-2 record vs. Mets, Brewers, & Reds) ... St. Louis is 61-66 all-time on the nationally televised ESPN Sunday Night Game of the Week.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 2.0 games behind Chicago and 5.5 games behind Milwaukee ... The 3rd place mark is the highest St. Louis has started any day this season after Opening Day.

ON TO CINCINNATI: The Cardinals embark on their longest road trip of the season after tonight's game, a nine-game, 10-day, three-city trip through Cincinnati (May 27-29), Philadelphia (May 31-June 2), and Houston (June 3-5).

MOTHER NATURE: Winners of nine of their last 11 and a season-high four in a row, the Cardinals sport the National League's best winning pct. (.818, 9-2) since Mother's Day (May 12-present), and over that timespan:

- Lead Major League Baseball in batting average (.292), on-base pct. (.364), and BABIP (.351), while ranking among MLB leaders in runs per game (5.82, 5th), OPS (.814, 2nd), and slugging pct. (.451, 5th);
- Have experienced a total of 5 hours and 42 minutes of rain delays that has postponed one game and suspended another.

SWEEPSTAKES: A win tonight would give St. Louis its first series sweep of the Cubs since Sept. 2-4, 2022 at Busch Stadium III (three-game series).

- Last 2-game series sweep of Chicago: July 19-20, 2004 at Wrigley Field
- Last 2-game series sweep of the Cubs in St. Louis: Sept. 7-8, 1998 at Busch Stadium II

PALLANTE RECALLED: The Cardinals today recalled RHP **Andre Pallante** from Memphis (AAA) and placed RHP **Nick Robertson** on the 15-Day Injured List with right elbow inflammation (retroactive to May 23) ... Since being optioned to Memphis on April 21, the 25-year-old Pallante was 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP) and nine strikeouts in four games (three starts).

HELLS BELLS: **Ryan Helsley** saved his 16th game of the season last night, which tied **Jason Isringhausen** (16 in 2006) for the most saves by a Cardinals closer in the team's first 50 games in franchise history ... Cincinnati's **Danny Graves** (23 saves in 2004) holds the MLB record through 50 games.

WINN...WINN, WINN, WINN: Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** leads Major League rookies with a team-leading .301 batting average (9th in NL) ... Since May 5, Winn's career-best 14-game hitting streak (19-52, .365/.382/.596):

- is the longest by a Major League rookie this season and longest by any rookie since teammate **Jordan Walker's** 17-gamer in 2023;
- ties **J.T. Realmuto** for MLB's 2nd-longest active hitting streak behind **Anthony Volpe** (18);
- matches **Jerry Mumphrey** (Aug. 16-Sept. 1, 1976) and **Terry Pendleton** (Aug. 31-Sept. 12, 1984) for the 5th-longest Cardinals rookie hit streak in franchise history. (chart left)

MY BISCUITS ARE BURNIN': OF/1B **Alec Burleson** is enjoying a season-high nine-game hitting streak (16-37, .432/.447/.649) since May 14 ... Burleson's .432 batting average over that timespan ranks 2nd in the NL behind only **Luis Arraez** (.457).

BABY BIRDS: **Alec Burleson** (.304, age 25-189) and **Masyn Winn** (.301, age 22-072) are the youngest Cardinals duo to sport a .300 or higher batting average through the team's first 50 games of the season (min. 130 at-bats) since **Keith Hernandez** (.301, age 24-234) and **Garry Templeton Sr.** (.306, age 21-078) in 1977. - Cardinals Gameday Associates

CHICAGO CUBS CONNECTIONS

Willson Contreras played parts of seven seasons with the Cubs (2016-22)...was a three-time All-Star and member of the 2016 World Series Champions...originally signed as an international free agent with Chicago (July 2, 2009).

Sonny Gray was originally selected by the Cubs in the 27th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Vanderbilt University.

Matt Carpenter (June 4, 2011 at Busch III), **Tommy Edman** (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley), and **Stubby Clapp** (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Cubs.

Ryan Loutos was born in Elk Grove Village, Ill... graduated from Barrington (Ill.) High School... resides in Barrington.

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Cardinals VP/General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

As back-to-back compensation picks for the departures of **John Lackey** and **Jason Heyward** signing with Chicago in 2016, **Dylan Carlson** (No. 33) and **Dakota Hudson** (No. 34) were selected by St. Louis in Compensation Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

Dylan Carlson and **Nick Madrigal** were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif.) High School, coached by Dylan's father, Jeff.

Tommy Edman and **Nico Hoerner** were college teammates at Stanford University in 2016.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Lars Nootbaar and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Cubs Bullpen Coach **Darren Holmes** pitched in five games for the Cardinals in 2000.

Patrick Wisdom played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for **Octavio Dotel** signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for **Drew Robinson** (Dec. 11, 2018).

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Dexter Fowler** played four seasons in St. Louis (2017-20).

Chip Caray served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cardinals 25th round draft pick from Brown Univ...took first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord.

Cubs Special Assistant to the GM **Jaron Madison** previously served as the Cardinals Assistant Director of Scouting (2008-09).

- Makes his 9th start of the season tonight and 12th career start against the Cubs (first as a member of the Cardinals).
- Began the season on the Injured List and made his first start on April 9 at Philadelphia, 12 games into the season. Since April 9, ranks among National League leaders in starts (8), wins (6, T-2nd), strikeouts (59, 4th), and strikeouts/9 IP (11.30, 2nd).
- Made 9 of 11 previous starts against the Cubs as a member of the Cincinnati Reds from 2019-21.
- Has allowed six home runs this season in 47.0 innings pitched after an MLB-low eight homers allowed over 184.0 innings pitched (among 2023 qualifiers).
- Has MLB leading K% on Sweeper pitch, fanning 32 in 55 plate appearances (58.2%).
- Leads the Cardinals and ranks T-3rd in the National League with six wins. Has recorded decisions in all eight starts, with both of his losses coming against Milwaukee.
- Surpassed 1,600 career innings vs. CWS (5/3), firing 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in a 3-0 win, his 7th career win vs. the Pale Hose, the opponent he has his 3rd-most wins against.
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); the 15th double-digit strikeout game of his career.
- Ranks 13th among active pitchers with 104 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (137, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (107, T-11th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

- Making his 12th career start vs. the Cubs and his first as a member of the Cardinals in his historical rivalry.
- Faced them nine times out of his 11 career starts while as a member of the division rival Cincinnati Reds and was 4-2 with a 3.06 ERA (50.0 innings) and 68 strikeouts.
- Recorded 11 strikeouts in his last win against the Cubs, coming during the COVID-19 shortened season, July 29, 2020 at Great American Ballpark. Reds won 12-7 as Gray departed after 6.2 innings with a 9-0 lead before the bullpen made it interesting.
- Of active pitchers with 10 or more starts, Gray has the 6th-lowest ERA (2.98) and the 3rd-lowest opponent BA (.186) against the Cubs.

LAST TIME OUT

- Carried a no-hitter into the 6th inning before back-to-back errors, followed by a three-run home run by Gunner Henderson that escalated it into a 31-pitch inning before departing with two outs and two on base.
- Earned his 6th win of the season and moved his strikeout total to 59, most by any Cardinals pitcher in his first eight starts with the franchise.

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- His 3.46 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,574 strikeouts rank 16th.
- Has made seven career starts at Busch Stadium, with four of those being Quality Starts. He is 2-3, 2.90 ERA career at Busch (40.1 IP/13 ER). Five of his seven starts at Busch Stadium were with the Cincinnati Reds.

2024

- Has struck out 59 batters over his first eight starts for the Cardinals, most in franchise history through first eight starts as a Cardinal.
- Allowed a career-high 3 home runs and a season-high six runs on seven hits in 7-1 loss at Milwaukee on May 9.
- Struck out a season-high 12 batters over 6.2 innings in a 2-0 loss to MIL (4/21). Marked his 15th career double-digit strikeout game and first since a career-high 13 vs. HOU (4/7/23).

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed two hits and one unearned run for the win last Tuesday VS. the Orioles at Busch Stadium. After the top of the 6th inn. with the game tied at 1-1, rain suspended the game to the following day as the Cardinals scored two runs in the 6th inning in the 3-1 win.
