**BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN:** The Orioles defeated the Rangers yesterday, 3-2, in the finale of the three-game set at Oriole Park...Avoided being swept; have not been swept in a series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3) and have not been swept at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...Split the season series against Texas, 3-3, and have not lost a season series against them since 2019 (1-6)...Improved to 10-6 in one-run games, one of seven teams in MLB with double-digit wins in such games this season.

**O's Kyle Bradish** did not factor in the decision after allowing one run on four hits with one walk and four strikeouts in a season-high-tying 6.2 innings of work (also 5/17 vs. LAA)...Struck out the side in the first inning (Semien, Seager, Lowe), the second time he has struck out the side in an inning in his career; also did so in the third inning on September 22, 2022 vs. Houston...Is the first O's pitcher to strike out the first three batters of the game since Tommy Milone Toronto on August 19, 2020 vs. Toronto...Threw 85 pitches, 56 strikes.

**O's Félix Bautista** struck out the side in the ninth inning to record his 13<sup>th</sup> save of the season...Marked the 13<sup>th</sup> time in his career recording at least three strikeouts in an inning and the fifth time striking out the side in order (last: 10<sup>th</sup> inning, 5/20/23 at TOR)...His 13 saves rank second in the AL and tied for third in MLB.

**O's Austin Hays** went 3-for-4 with a triple and two RBI to collect his team-leading 17<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season...His six games with at least three hits are tied for second in the AL, trailing only Toronto's Bo Bichette (9 G)...Has recorded an extra-base hit in a season-high four straight games, one shy of his career high of five consecutive games from August 24-28, 2021...Has driven in eight runs in his last eight games and nine in his last 11.

**CLOSE ENCOUNTERS:** Of Baltimore's 53 games this season, 48 have been decided by four or fewer runs, the most in MLB...The O's have gone 31-17 in those games, the most wins in MLB and second-best winning percentage (.646), behind Tampa Bay (.649, 24-13)...The O's have gone 22-13 in games decided by three or fewer runs, tied for the most wins in MLB with Cleveland (22-19).

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is managing his 600<sup>th</sup> career game with the Orioles today...Will become the sixth skipper to manage 600 games for the Orioles, joining Earl Weaver (2,541), Buck Showalter (1,353), Paul Richards (1,063), Hank Bauer (726), and Mike Hargrove (649)...Managed his 600<sup>th</sup> overall game yesterday; served one game as Miami's interim manager on June 19, 2011 against Tampa Bay, following the resignation of manager Edwin Rodriguez...Hyde is currently in his fifth season as manager of the Orioles after being named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in club history on December 14, 2018...In 2022, he led the O's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the *Baseball America* MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers...He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The O's are in the middle of a six-game homestand, which began this weekend with three games against the Rangers (1-2)...The Orioles host the Guardians for three games beginning today...The Birds are 16-10 (.615) in Baltimore and own the third-best home winning percentage in the AL and fourth-best in MLB.

**AGAINST THE GUARDIANS:** The O's are facing the Guardians for the first of seven games this season...The Birds will travel to Cleveland for four games at Progressive Field from September 21-24...Baltimore went 3-3 against Cleveland in 2022, 1-2 at Oriole Park and 2-1 at Progressive Field...The O's have not won a season series against the Guardians since 2016 (5-1).

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The O's have won 25 of their last 37 games, 28 of 41, and 30 of 44...The 34-19 overall record ranks second in MLB to start the season (see box at right)...Entering today, the Rays (39-16), Rangers (33-19), Braves (32-21), Dodgers (32-22), Yankees (32-23), Astros (31-21), and Diamondbacks (30-23) are the only other teams with 30 wins this season, while the Rays and Rangers are the only other teams with fewer than 20 losses.

**MOUNT UP:** **Ryan Mountcastle** ranks fifth in MLB with 28 Barrels, per *Statcast*, trailing only Toronto's Matt Chapman (31), New York-AL's Aaron Judge (30), and New York-NL's Pete Alonso and Atlanta's Matt Olson (29)...He ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in MLB with 79 Hard-Hit Balls...His 38 RBI rank seventh in the AL and tied for 11<sup>th</sup> in MLB; they are tied for third among primary first basemen, trailing only New York-NL's Pete Alonso (46) and Atlanta's Matt Olson (41).

**SOLID CONTACT:** The Orioles rank tied with the Rangers for fourth in MLB with an 89.9 mph average exit velocity, per *Statcast*, trailing the Braves (91.2 mph), Rays (90.3 mph), and Angels (90.0 mph)...Baltimore's 15.1 degree average launch angle on batted balls is the second-highest in the majors, trailing only the Dodgers (15.5)...Baltimore's 570 Hard-Hit Balls rank sixth in the AL and 10<sup>th</sup> in MLB.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** The Baltimore bullpen owns a 3.07 ERA (68 ER/199.2 IP), the second-best in MLB behind the Yankees (2.99)...O's relievers have 16 wins this season, tied with the Yankees for the most in the majors...The O's are second in MLB with 233 strikeouts from the 'pen, trailing Kansas City (244).

**ON THIS DATE IN 1996:** One day after tying the record, **Cal Ripken, Jr.** hits his 334<sup>th</sup> career home run to pass **Eddie Murray** on the Orioles all-time list...Ripken finished his career with 431 home runs, the most in Orioles history.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his 11<sup>th</sup> appearance (10<sup>th</sup> start) of the season, sixth start at home, and fourth career appearance (second start) against the Guardians today...Went 7-7 with a 4.25 ERA (49 ER/103.2 IP) in 23 starts for the O's in 2022...Made his first career start on April 10, 2022 at Tampa Bay; dealt the loss after allowing four runs on three hits (1 HR) with two walks and two strikeouts in 1.2 innings...Did not walk a batter in five consecutive starts from April 21 to May 15, 2022, becoming the only Oriole starting pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to not walk a batter in five consecutive games...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 17 straight starts from April 16 to July 15, 2022...Ended the 2022 season on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder inflammation...Also spent time on the Injured List with lower left side discomfort in 2022...Originally selected by Minnesota in the 15<sup>th</sup> round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Cal State, San Bernardino before being taken by the Orioles in the Rule 5 Draft on December 10, 2020.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision after allowing a season-high five runs on five hits (3 HR)with two walks and career-high-tying eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings on May 24 at New York-AL...The three home runs tied a career-high (2x, last: 5/2 at KC)...Has thrown at least 5.0 innings in all 10 appearances (nine starts) to begin the season; had 12 career games of 5.0+ innings (all in 2022) entering 2023...Threw 95 pitches, 60 strikes.

**WATCH ME WHIP:** Wells enters play today leading MLB with a 0.84 WHIP...Also ranks among qualified pitchers in opponent on-base percentage (1<sup>st</sup>, .225), batting average (2<sup>nd</sup>, .176), and H/9 (2<sup>nd</sup>, 5.68)...He posted a 0.72 WHIP in April, tied for the seventh-lowest mark by an O's pitcher in a calendar month in club history (since 1954) and lowest since Scott McGregor recorded a franchise-record 0.61 WHIP in May 1978...Wells issued just three walks and allowed 18 hits in 29.0 innings through his first five appearances (four starts) in April.

**CAREER AGAINST THE GUARDIANS:** Making his fourth career appearance (second start) against the Guardians today...Owns an 0-0 record with a 2.70 ERA (2 ER/6.2 IP) through his first three appearances against Cleveland...Did not factor in the decision last time out, after allowing two runs on two hits (2 HR) with two walks and one strikeout in 4.0 innings on June 4, 2022 at Oriole Park...Threw 62 pitches, 42 strikes.

**CAREER AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** Making his 20<sup>th</sup> appearance (11<sup>th</sup> start) against the AL Central tonight...Owns a 5-3 record with a 3.68 ERA (26 ER/63.2 IP) and one save through his first 19 career outings against the division...Opposing batters have slashed .212/.265/.359 (49-for-231) in those games...Last time out, earned the win on May 2 at Kansas City after allowing four runs on three hits (3 HR) with three walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Threw 92 pitches, 60 strikes.

**LOVING LEFTIES:** Opposing left-handed batters are slashing .185/.225/.327 (62-for-336) against Wells through his first 77 career games (32 starts)...He has recorded more career strikeouts against lefties (93) than hits allowed (62)...Owns the third-lowest on-base percentage and seventh-lowest batting average to lefties in MLB since he debuted in 2021(min. 300 BFP).

**2022 HIGHLIGHTS:** Made his third straight Opening Day roster...Notched career highs in wins (7), starts (23), innings (103.2), and strikeouts (76)...Won five consecutive starts from June 11 to July 3, becoming the first Oriole to win five straight starts since Chris Tillman, who also won five straight from April 27 to May 18, 2016...Wells owned a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP) in those games, holding opposing batters to a .168 (17-for-101) batting average with 21 punchouts and eight walks...Finished the season with just 28 walks in 103.2 innings...Spent two different stints on the Injured List...Placed on the 15-day Injured List (lower left side discomfort) on July 28 and again on September 23, retroactive to September 30(right shoulder inflammation)...Recorded at least one strikeout in each of his 23 starts.

Slated to make his 11<sup>th</sup> start of the season, fifth at home, and 22<sup>nd</sup> career appearance (21<sup>st</sup> start) against the Guardians...Last time out on May 25 at Yankee Stadium, earned his sixth win of the season, allowing two hits, and four walks, with three strikeouts...Marked his first scoreless start this season...Threw 96 pitches, 56 strikes...Owns a 3-10 record against the Guardians with a 5.59 ERA (64 ER/103.0 IP) in his career...Last time out against Cleveland, was charged with a blown save on September 15, 2019, after allowing two runs (1 ER) on two hits (1 HR), and one walk in 1.0 inning with Minnesota.


