TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Phillies continue a four-game set tonight with the 14th of 19 meetings between the clubs this season...The teams will conclude the season series with three games in Atlanta next week, September 17-19.

- After getting swept in a season-opening, threegame series here in Philadelphia, the Braves have won seven of the last 10 games with the Phillies, outscoring their division rival 85-45 over the
- The Braves won the series in their last trip here, July 26-28, scoring a total of 28 runs and hitting seven home runs.
- LHP Max Fried is set to face the Phillies for the ninth time in his career, for the third time as a starter, and for the fifth time this season...The lefty is 1-1 with a 4.58 ERA (10 ER/19.2 IP) in his eight appearances against Philadelphia, earning his only win in his last start, July 27 here at Citizens Bank Park.
- LHP Jason Vargas is 2-2 with a 5.40 ERA (15 ER/25.0 IP) in seven career games, six starts, against Atlanta...Tonight marks his first appearance against the Braves since joining Philadelphia...In his last start against Atlanta, the lefty got one out and allowed four runs, earned, and three walks to take a no-decision in a 11-7 loss.

90 WINS: The Braves improved to 90-55 last night, beating Philadelphia, 7-2, to reach the 90-win mark for the second consecutive season...Atlanta went 90-72 in 2018 to capture the National League East title.

- The Braves have won 90 games in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2012 (94) and 2013
- This season marks the franchise's 19th 90-win season since Major League Baseball went to a 162game schedule for both leagues in 1962.
- The 19 total 90-win seasons since 1962 are the second most in the National League...The Dodgers lead with 25 such seasons, including one this year...St. Louis has 18 such seasons, and needs to go at least 9-10 over their last 19 games to win 90 games again.
- The Yankees have the most 90-win seasons in all of baseball since 1962 with 29.
- The Braves are on pace for 101 victories this season...They need go 10-7 or better in their last 17 games to reach the ninth triple-digit win season in franchise history...The 1998 team had the most regular season wins in team history, going 106-56 (.654) on their way to a loss in the National League Championship Series to San Diego.
- The 1897 Boston Beaneaters had the best regular season mark, going 93-39 (.705), to become one of 31 teams in baseball history to have .700 win percentage or better.

HOME RUNS: 3B Josh Donaldson hit a three-run homer in the seventh inning last night, giving the third baseman 37 home runs this season, one behind OF Ronald Acuña Jr. and 1B Freddie Freeman for the team

- According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Donaldson's 37 home runs are the fifth most homers hit by a player in his first season for the Braves in franchise history...The four higher: Andres Galarraga (44 in 1998), Davey Johnson (43 in 1973), Jeff Burroughs (41 in 1977) and Wally Berger (38 in 1930).
- The 2019 Braves are one six teams in major league history to have three players all reach 37 home runs in a single season and the first since the 2016 Baltimore Orioles (Chris Davis, Manny Machado, Mark Trumbo).
- The 1973 Braves was the first team to accomplish the feat, and is one of three teams to have three 40-home run players in a single season...2B Davey Johnson (43), Darrell Evans (41) and Hank Aaron (40) all reached the mark that year.
- The Braves now have 229 home runs this season, the fifth most in baseball and second most in the National League...The Braves are now six home runs away from tying the single-season mark, set by the 2003 team.

VS. THE NL EAST: The Braves are in the middle of 14 consecutive games against the NL East, specifically Washington (seven games) and Philadelphia (seven games)...The Braves are 42-22 (.656) against the division this season, the third-best mark by an Atlanta team since divisional play began in 1969.

- The Braves went 35-16 (.686) against the East in 1999, the club's best ever intradivision record... They won a franchise-record 51 games in 2004 (51-25, .671) against their division.
- Atlanta went 49-27 (.645) against the East last season...No other NL team has been better against their own division the last two seasons than Atlanta (91-49, .650)...The Astros have the best intradivision record in the majors for the last two seasons at 93-45

PRODUCTION FOR THE TOP: OF Ronald Acuña Jr., 2B Ozzie Albies, and 1B Freddie Freeman, the top three hitters in the Braves lineup, went a combined 6-for-13 (.462) with five runs scored, three RBI and two walks last night.

- The top three spots in the Braves lineup have combined to hit 104 home runs, score 343 runs and collect 289 RBI this season, all tops in the National League.
- Since July 24, when manager Brian Snitker moved Ozzie Albies to the second spot in the lineup full time, those three spots have a .920 OPS and 36 home runs in 46 games.

Tonight's Game

- - Is 7-0 with a 3.02 ERA (17 ER/50.2 IP) during the run, with wins over Milwaukee, Philadelphia, Cincinnati, Minnesota, the Mets, the White Sox and Washington...The stretch spans nine total starts.
 - At It is the third run of at least eight wins by Atlanta in a pitcher's starts this season, after winning eight straight games started by Mike Soroka from June 1 to July 14, and each of Mike Foltynewicz's last 10 games dating to June 11.
 - Atlanta is the only team in the majors to win eight straight starts by a single pitcher on three occasions this season, and one of just two teams with at least two such streaks...The Yankees won eight straight starts by both Chad Green (9 straight) and Domingo German (8 games).
- His 16 wins are most in the National League by a left-hander, and second most in the majors among lefties...BOS's Eduardo Rodríguez has won 17 games.
 - Fried's 16 wins are most by an Atlanta left-hander since 2002, when Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine won 18 games.
 - Atlanta is 21-6 in his starts as a team, including 14-2 in his last 16 turns.
- Makes his ninth career appearance against the Phillies, but just his third start... Is 1-1 with a 4.58 ERA (10 ER/19.2 IP) in his first eight games, including four this season.
 - In four games, two starts, against Philadelphia this season, is 1-0 with a 6.94 ERA (9 ER/11.2 IP)...Has allowed exactly seven hits and five runs in each of his two starts.
 - M In 12 intradivision games this season, including 10 starts, is just 4-2 with a 5.02 ERA (32 ER/57.1 IP)...It is easily his highest ERA against any one division... Has a 2.18 mark against the Central (6 games), a 4.14 ERA against the West (8 games) and a 2.55 mark versus the American League (3 games).
- Fanned nine batters over 7.0 scoreless innings in his last start, September 5 vs. Washington, and has struck out 20 batters in his last 13.0 innings.
 - In has last six turns dating to August 7, Fried has 47 strikeouts in 34.1 innings... His 12.32 strikeouts per 9.0 innings in that span are most in the National League and fourth most in the majors, trailing just Gerrit Cole (17.38), Lucas Giolito (13.05) and Justin Verlander (12.32).

2019 Recap

- Struck out a career high-tying 11 batters, 8/30 vs. CWS, to earn his 15th win of the season...Allowed four hits and four runs in 6.0 innings.
 - Also won both of his starts against the Cubs this season, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to beat both the Cubs and White Sox in a single season...Tim Hudson earned victories over both Chicago clubs in 2013...Dallas Keuchel also did so this season, beating the White Sox the day after Fried.
- Started against the Dodgers, 8/18 at SunTrust Park, and allowed eight hits and three runs in 5.0 innings...Did not factor in the decision.
 - Surrendered all three runs in the first inning and allowed the first two hitters to reach in the second, before retiring 11 of the next 13 hitters, including the final eight he faced.
 - Picked A.J. Pollock off first base in the opening inning, his fifth pickoff of the season...His five pickoffs are tied for second most in the majors.
- ★ Won five consecutive starts from July 15-August 13, becoming the first Atlanta
 pitcher to win five consecutive starts since Mike Minor won five in a row between
 the 2012 and 2013 seasons.
- - Was his second career stint on the Braves' injured list due to a blister...Missed from July 6 to July 29 of last season with a blister on his left third finger.
- Appeared in 20 games before the All-Star break, and set full-season career highs in wins (9), games (20), starts (18), innings (98.2) and strikeouts (97).
 - Went 9-4 with a 4.29 ERA (47 ER/98.2 IP) before the break...His nine wins were the most by a Braves lefty before the All-Star break since 2013, when both Paul Maholm and Mike Minor had nine...No Braves left-hander has won more since Tom Glavine had 11 wins at the break in 2002.
 - Æ His nine wins were second most by a left-hander in the National League...

 Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu won more (10 wins).
- A Allowed seven hits and two runs over 6.0 innings, 4/16 vs. ARI...Walked one and struck out three.
 - ✓ Opened the season with 16.2 innings without allowing an earned run, before
 Arizona scored twice in the fourth...It was the longest streak without an earned
 run to open the season by a Braves pitcher since 2013 (Paul Maholm, 25.1 IP).

- Is 1-0 with 3.90 ERA (12 ER/27.2 IP) in 37 games with Atlanta...Thirty of his 37 appearances have been scoreless, including 17 of his last 21.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 2.10 ERA (6 ER/25.2 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty of his 37 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .160 (8-for-50) average with 17 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-53 (.245).

- Is 0-1 with a 4.42 ERA (9 ER/18.1 IP) in 20 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.24 ERA (14 ER/56.1 IP) in 58 games on the season...He has converted 23 of 28 save opportunities.
- Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless appearances on 9/7 vs. Washington...Held opponents to just four hits
 while striking out 14 through 13.0 innings during the streak...Logged his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 vs. WSH.
- · Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...At the time ranked
 fourth in the AL with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball among qualifying relievers.

- Is 8-2 with a 3.97 ERA (29 ER/65.2 IP) in 63 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since OscarVillarreal also had eight in 2006.
- Per Statcast, has an expected batting average of just .209 and an average exit velocity of 87.9 mph...Opponents are
 officially batting .270 (70-for-259).
- Left-handers have just 16 hits in 97 at-bats (.165) against him...Righties are hitting .333 (54-for-162).
- Has fanned 90 batters in 65.1 innings for a career-best 12.40 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miami...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Recorded his second consecutive two-inning save, 5/15 vs. STL, to become the first Braves closer with back-to-back two-inning saves since Hall of Famer John Smoltz in 2002
