**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Chris Tunno's Cardinals** and the first game of a 6-game road trip that includes an upcoming 3-game set at **Petco Park in San Diego** (Mon-Wed).

- Following Wed's game at **SD** and Thu's off day, the Reds will return home for a 6-game homestand vs **AZ** (6/12-6/14) and **NYM** (6/15-6/17).
- The Reds are coming off a 2-4 homestand vs **Atl** (1-2) and **KC** (1-2).

**BLEDAY NAMED PLAYER OF THE MONTH: OF JJ Bleday** on Tue was named **National League Player of the Month for May**, his first career monthly award.

- Bleday** batted .301 (31-for-103) for the month with 8 HR, 25 RBI, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 15 walks, 17 runs scored, a stolen base, a .631 slugging pct., and a .387 on-base pct.
- He ranked second in the majors in slugging (.631), extra-base hits (17) and total bases (65)...he led the National League in slugging, TB, OPS (1.018) and T1st in RBI (25).
- Bleday** is the first Red to win a player of the month award since **Joey Votto** in July 2021...became the first Red with at least 30 hits and 25 RBI in a single month since **Votto** did it in July 2021.
- Bleday** became the first Red with 17 extra-base hits in a single month since **Aristides Aquino** in August 2019 (18).

**CATTLE DRIVE: OF/INF Spencer Steer** has reached base safely in a career-high 22 games, dating back to 5/9 vs **Hou**...it's the longest active streak in the majors.

- Steer** on Tue vs **KC** produced his fourth career multi-HR game with a pair of solo homers.
- He's hit safely in 30 of his last 33 games (.322/.397/.504), since 4/28.
- Has at least 1 hit in 44 games this season, which ranks among Major League leaders.
- Hit safely in 24 games during the month of May, most in the majors.
- Since 4/18, Steer is slashing .315/.401/.500 in 41 games (46-for-146, 6hr, 18rbi, 15xbh, 67 times on base).
- Overall this year, **Steer** has appeared in 27g in LF, 24g at 1B, 16g in RF, 7g at 2B, and 2g at 3B.
- Has 295 career starts in the infield and 174 career starts in the outfield...only **Pete Rose** and **Frank Robinson** have made 200 or more starts for the Reds in both the infield and outfield.

**NEVER GIVE UP:** The Reds won Tue's game vs **KC** despite a sterling effort from **Royals'** starter **Noah Cameron**, who allowed just 1 hit over 7.0 innings (**Spencer Steer** HR in the 5th inning)...it marked just the second time this season that a Major League team won a game when the opposing starting pitcher produces at least 7.0 innings and gives up fewer than 2 hits (4/20: **Bal** over **KC**, 7-5; **KC's Seth Lugo** 7.0 shutout innings, 1 hit).

- It marked the first such win for the Reds since 7/23/22 when they beat **Atl's Charlie Morton** after he pitched 7.0 shutout innings (1h)...that game, like Tue's, resulted in a 4-3 walkoff victory.
- Will Benson's** game-tying, pinch-hit homer in Tue's 9th inning was the first such HR by a Red in the 9th inning (or later) since **Devin Mesoraco** did it on 5/7/13 off **Atl's Craig Kimbrel** (the next batter, **Shin-Soo Choo** homered off **Kimbrel** to win the game, 5-4).

**MCCAMBLEY DEBUTS:** In Wed's 5-2 loss vs **KC**, RHP **Zach McCambley** made his Major League debut after being selected from AAA-Louisville on Tue...he relieved RHP **Tony Santillan** in the 9th inning (0.2ip, 1h, 1bb, 2k, 15TP).

- McCambley** became the third Red to make his Major League debut this season, along with RHP **Jose Franco** (3/30 vs **Pit**) and INF **Edwin Arroyo** (Mon vs **KC**).
- He also became the 27th different pitcher to appear in a game for the Reds in 2026, tied for most in the majors (also: **Hou**, **Bal**, **Tor**).

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds and Cardinals are meeting for the second time this season...were rained out at **Great American Ball Park** on 5/22, split a doubleheader the next day (5/23) and were rained out again on 5/24... will play a 5-game series at **GABP** from 8/17-8/20, including a day/night doubleheader on 8/17 to account for the 5/24 postponement.

- The Reds are 1,128 -1,239 vs the **Cardinals** since 1892, including 1-1 in 2026 and 6-7 in 2025 (1-2 at **StL** 6/20-6/22; 2-2 at **Cin** 4/28-5/1; 1-2 at **Cin** 8/29-8/31; 2-1 at **StL** 9/15-9/17).
- StL** has won or split 5 of the last 6 series and 9 of the last 11 dating back to September 2023...the Reds have dropped 10 of the last 12 season series entering 2026 (86-15, .428).

**POWER SURGE:** The Reds have homered 55 times over their last 38 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), fifth-most in the majors during that time, behind the **WSox** (60), **Mariners** (59), **Braves** (58), and **Yankees** (57).

- Are on pace to hit 204 homers this season, which would be the 10th time in franchise history they'd reach the 200-HR mark.
- Have hit 2 or more HRs in a game 21 times this season.
- Have hit 48 homers at **Great American Ball Park** in 2026, second-most by any Major League team at its home venue (**Sea**, 50hr).
- Entered the 4/21 game at **TB** ranked T17th in the majors with 22 HR... enter today's game ranked eighth in the majors with 77 HR.
- 120 of their 264 runs scored this year have come via HR (45.5%, 4th).

**BURNING BRIGHT:** In yesterday's 5-2 loss vs **KC**, RHP **Chase Burns** allowed 2 runs on 4 hits over 6.0 innings (1bb, 9k, 98TP).

- It marked his eighth quality start of the season, 2 off the pace of Major League-leader **Cristopher Sánchez**.
- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in a career-high 9 straight starts, which ties him for the third-longest single-season streak by a Reds pitcher since 1900, behind **Edinson Volquez** (12g, 2008) and **Andy Coakley** (10g, 1908)...overall has 11 starts of 2 runs allowed or fewer (T1st in majors).
- His 2.05 ERA ranks fourth in the majors.
- Overall this year, the Reds are 8-4 when **Burns** pitches.

**ALL-STAR BALLOTS:** Major League Baseball opened fan voting for the 2026 All-Star Game, using a 2-phase system to select all starters.

- Fans can cast their ballots online and via mobile devices on all MLB platforms, including the MLB App, the MLB Ballpark App, and at MLB.com/Vote.
- Phase 1 runs 6/3-6/25 with up to 5 votes per day; top finalists advance.
- League leaders in Phase 1 automatically earn starting spots.
- Phase 2 runs 6/29-7/2 with reset totals to choose the rest of the starters.
- Full All-Star rosters will be announced on 7/4.
- The 2026 Midsummer Classic will be held on 7/14 in **Philadelphia**.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the 5-2 loss vs Atl on Sat, 5/30 (5.0ip, 4h, 3r/3er, 4bb, 2k, 2hr, 94TP).

- Walked 4 batters for the second time this season (also: 4/19 at Min).
- Has given up multiple home runs in each of his last 3 games and in 5 of his last 6...it marks the first time in his career that he's allowed multiple HR in 3 straight appearances.
- Threw 34 of his 94 pitches in the 5th inning, his final inning of work.

**RAINED OUT:** Was originally scheduled to start the Sun, 5/24 game vs StL but was rained out...didn't pitch again until 5/30.

**MAY 17 at CLE:** Suffered the 10-3 loss at Cle on Sun, 5/17 (4.0ip, 7h, 5r/5er, 1bb, 6k, 3hr, 86TP).

- For the second consecutive start, allowed 3 home runs... it marked the first time in his career that he gave up 3 or homers in back-to-back starts.
- Threw 22 pitches in the 1st, 11 in the 2nd, 33 in the 3rd, and 20 in the 4th.

**MAY 12 vs WSH:** Suffered the 10-4 loss vs Wsh on Tue, 5/12 (3.2ip, 6h, 3r/3er, 1bb, 2k, 3hr, 75TP).

- For the third time this season was struck by a comebacker to the mound (right side of right foot; Daylen Lile, 2nd inning).
- Remained in the game until turning it over to Sam Moll with 2 outs in the 4th inning.
- Allowed a season-high 3 home runs...his most since 9/21/24 for KC vs SF (4hr).
- 7 of his 18 batters reached.

**MAY 6 at CHC:** Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 7-6 loss at Chc on Wed, 5/6 (6.0ip, 6h, 4r/4er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 96TP).

- 3 of his 4 runs allowed came with 2 outs.
- Produced a season high 14 swings-and-misses.
- 8 of his 25 batters reached.
- Allowed a 1st-inning, 2-out, 2-run HR to Ian Happ...were his 13th and 14th runs allowed this season with 2 outs.
- Pitched a scoreless 6th before turning it over to Sam Moll.

**MAY 1 at PIT:** Suffered the 9-1 loss on Fri, 5/1 at Pit (3.1ip, 7h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 1k, 2hr, 56TP).

- 3 of his 4 runs allowed came with 2 outs.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 11 of his 19 batters.
- Both homers he allowed came when he was ahead in the count (0-2 to Bryan Reynolds in the 1st inning; 0-1 to Henry Davis in the 4th inning).
