AROUND THE HORN

VOTE D-BACKS: In the second update announced on Monday by MLB for NL All-Star Balloting Phase 1 voting, Nolan Arenado is fourth (3B), Ketel Marte is sixth (2B), Gabriel Moreno is eighth (C), Ildemaro Vargas is ninth (1B) and Corbin Carroll is 10th (OF)...2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot voting continues thru Thursday @ 9:00 a.m. AZ at dbacks.com/vote, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 3 of their last 5 road games, in which 4 of those were decided by 2 or fewer runs...have allowed 3 or fewer runs in all 5.

- **Nolan Arenado**, in his first series @ Cardinals since being acquired by the D-backs in January, has recorded a hit and RBI in each of his first 2 games.
- **Mitch Bratt** was recalled from Triple-A Reno today and will make his Major League debut...is the first Canadian pitcher to make his MLB debut as a D-back and is the Majors' sixth Canadian starter to debut since 2016.
- D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 3 starts, have held opponents to 3 runs over 17.2 innings (1.53 ERA)...includes 2 scoreless starts.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in a franchise-record-tying 20 straight starts vs. Cardinals, hitting .306 (26-for-85)/.913 OPS with 7 doubles, 3 triples, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 5 walks...the 20 straight starts ties Jake Lamb (Aug. 24, 2015-Sept. 23, 2019).
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in a career-high 16 straight games, hitting .310 (18-for-58)/.963 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 6 RBI and 10 walks...his active streak is tied for the longest among catchers this season (also: Adley Rutschman/BAL, behind Shea Langeliers/ATH (20)).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 14 of his last 16 games, carrying an .855 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 6 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 4-3 vs. Cardinals last night.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** tossed 6.2 scoreless innings (ND, 3 H, 3 BB, 5 K) and recorded his team-leading ninth quality start.
- **Nolan Arenado** hit a go-ahead RBI double in the ninth inning.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** (2-for-4, 2B, 2 RBI) added a 2-run single to give the D-backs a 3-0 lead.
- **Jorge Barrosa** scored on a passed ball to push the lead to 4-0.
- **Gabriel Moreno** extended his career-high on-base streak to 16 straight games with a single in the ninth.
- **Kevin Ginkel** recorded his 300th career regular season appearance and third win of the season (0 ER in 1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 BB, K).
- **Brandyn Garcia** recorded his first career save (0 ER in 0.1 IP, 0 H, 0 BB, K).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled LHP **Mitch Bratt** (No. 60), optioned LHP **Kohl Drake** to Reno following last night's game and reinstated **Carlos Santana** from the 60-day injured list (strained right adductor) and designated him for assignment.

MILESTONE SNAKEBITES: **Kevin Ginkel** became just the third D-backs pitcher ever to record 300+ career regular season games (also: Andrew Chafin/380 G and Brad Ziegler/377 G).

- **Ginkel** became the first D-back and 15th pitcher since 2011 to record his 300th career regular season game and secure a win (last: Alex Vesia/LAD on Sept. 27, 2025 @ Mariners).

SCORELESS RUN: **Ryan Thompson's** current 17 straight scoreless road games are tied for the season's longest scoreless streak (also active: Robert Suarez/ATL and Luke Weaver/NYM)...since 2025, is tied for the third longest active streak (also: Caleb Thielbar/CHC), behind Weaver (20) and Suarez (18).

BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT: **Brandyn Garcia** is the seventh D-back ever to record his first career save on 4 or fewer pitches (last: Yoan Lopez 4 P July 24, 2019 vs. Orioles).

- **Kevin Ginkel** is scoreless in 11 of his last 12 road games, going 3-0 with a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), opponent .231 AVG (9-for-39)/.627 OPS with 2 walks and 13 strikeouts.
- **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in 15 of his last 16 road games, going 1-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP), opponent .170 AVG (9-for-53)/.476 OPS with 5 walks and 7 strikeouts.
- **Ketel Marte** owns a 12-game on-base streak, 1 game shy of his season-best 13 (April 10-26), hitting .340 (16-for-47)/.926 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 5 walks.
- Has reached base 2+ times in 5 of his last 6 games.

STAY CALIENTE: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 30 games, hitting .321 (35-for-109)/.928 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 homers, 16 RBI and 16 walks, including 2+ times in 17 of them.

ALL-STAR CALIBER: **Ketel Marte** ranks among NL second basemen in homers (T-2nd, 12), total bases (2nd, 136), extra-base hits (2nd, 31), RBI (3rd, 46) and SLG (3rd, .452)...defensively, is the only qualified second baseman without an error (0 E in 536.1 inn.).

- **Corbin Carroll** ranks among NL outfielders in extra-base hits (T-1st, 39), triples (1st, 9), SLG (2nd, .543), OPS (3rd, .910) and total bases (4th, 153).
- **Gabriel Moreno**, since May 13 [min. 100 PA] leads NL catchers in AVG (.321), OPS (.928), OBP (.414), SLG (.524), times on base (53) and ranks in homers (2nd, 5) and hits (2nd, 35)...defensively [min. 45 G], is tied for the second fewest errors (1) with Tyler Stephenson/CIN, behind William Contreras/MIL (0).
- **Nolan Arenado** ranks among NL third basemen in doubles (T-2nd, 13), SLG (3rd, .386), homers (T-5th, 8) and extra-base hits (T-4th, 21)...defensively, has the second fewest errors (3), behind Manny Machado/SD (2).

BATSTRAVEL: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 14 of his last 15 road games, hitting .382 (21-for-55)/1.088 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 9 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached safely in 13 of his last 15 road games, hitting .323 (21-for-65)/.845 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 homer, 10 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached in 15 of his last 18 road games with an .829 OPS (4 2B, 4 HR, 7 RBI, 10 BB).

VS. CARDINALS: The D-backs split each of their last 3 season series (3-3 in 2023, '24 and '25).

- **Corbin Carroll** has 2+ hits in 3 of his last 4 games vs. Cardinals and is batting .412 (7-for-17)/1.294 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 triples, and 1 RBI.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has reached base safely in 8 of his last 9 games vs. Cardinals, is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with 2 doubles and 4 RBI.
