**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-3 through five games on their current seven-game roadtrip, splitting 2-2 in Detroit, following by a loss to the Orioles in Baltimore last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three at Camden Yards...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then begin a seven-game homestand on Friday with three against the Tigers over the weekend, then four against the White Sox from Monday-next Thursday.

TWINS DROP OPENER IN BALTIMORE: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night at Camden Yards by a score of 7-4...Louie Varland (0-3) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on a career-high 11 hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Matt Bowman made his Twins debut in relief, allowing one run on one hit in 3.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 11 hits, tying their season high...Ryan Jeffers and Jose Miranda each had three hits and both drove in two runs apiece...Miranda hit his first home run of the season and had six total bases and had six total bases.

I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS: The Twins have recalled outfielder Trevor Larnach from Triple-A St. Paul...Larnach has played in three games on rehab assignment with Low-A Fort Myers, going 2-for-11 with one double, two walks, three RBI and two runs scored for the Mighty Mussels...Larnach began the season on St. Paul's 7-day Injured List with turf toe (right great toe)...to make room for Larnach on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Matt Wallner to the Saints...Wallner went 2-for-25 (.080) with one double, one home run, four RBI, four hit-by-pitches, three walks and 17 strikeouts in 13 games for the Twins this season.

**CHARM CITY:** The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the second of six games in 2024...Minnesota will host the O's for three games to complete the regular season from September 27-29.

September 27-29.

Minnesota has lost five straight vs. the Orioles, their longest losing streak to Baltimore since April 4-May 11, 2016 (also 5)...the last time they lost six straight to the O's was when they lost seven straight, from August 22, 2011-April 8, 2012.

The Twins are 38-22 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 16-10 against Baltimore for a .615 winning percentage, his highest of any opponent.

Since 2018, the Twins have hit 57 home runs in 33 games against the Orioles, their most vs. any opponent outside of the AL Central.

Christian Vazquez has 39 career hits at Camden Yards, his most of any opposing ballpark.

Trevor Larnach and Adley Rutschman were teammates at Oregon State, the club that won the 2018 College World Series.

BUCK AND THE BIRDS: Byron Buxton has hit safely in 11-straight games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, hitting .333 (15-for-45) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and a .997 OPS in that span...it marks the longest active streak in Baltimore for any major league player...it also is tied with Torii Hunter for the longest for a Twin in club history...below are the top four hitting streaks for a Twin at this ballpark:
