The Brewers took on **Tarik Skubal** in Detroit yesterday and are set to face **Paul Skenes** tonight, marking only the second time in MLB history that a team faced reigning Cy Young Award winners in consecutive starts....the Red Sox faced Skubal and the Braves' **Chris Sale** in back-to-back starts on May 14 and May 16 last season.

The Brewers have won each of their last 8 games against the Pirates.

Through 24 games, the Brewers have used 24 different starting lineups.

Bummer

A double for **William Contreras** on 4/18 at Miami has been changed by MLB reviewers to an error by second baseman **Xavier Edwards** thus ending a 16-start hitting streak....his 13-game hitting streak (4/1-4/18) was reduced to 12 games (4/1-4/17).

Start Me Up

Brewers starters have a 2.24 ERA in the last 10 games (52.1ip, 13er) with 4 quality starts while holding opponents to a .185 AVG (34-for-184, 16bb, 45k).

Homewood Bound

Brandon Woodruff is 15-1 (.938) with a 2.18 ERA over his last 26 starts at American Family Field....the team has gone 22-4 (.846) in those outings (153ip, 102h, 38r, 37er, 29bb, 201k).

The March to a Thousand

Brandon Woodruff currently ranks sixth on the all-time franchise list with 891 strikeouts....Woodruff needs 109 strikeouts for 1,000 in his career.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: **OF Akil Baddoo** (left quad), **OF Jackson Chourio** (left hand), **LHP Jared Koenig** (left elbow), **RHP Quinn Priester** (right thoracic outlet), **1B Andrew Vaughn** (left hand), **OF Christian Yelich** (left groin) and **LHP Rob Zastryzny** (left shoulder) are currently on the injured list....Baddoo and Zastryzny are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** (348g, 203-145, .583) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (29 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 16, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 5, **FOURTH:** 4, **FIFTH:** 3....the Brewers are currently in fifth place, trailing the first-place Reds and Cubs by 2.5 games, third-place Cardinals by 1.0 game and fourth-place Pirates by half a game.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 7-5 at home, going 3-1-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 6-6 on the road, going 2-2-0 in series play.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 10 replay challenges this season, going 8-2....their last challenge (won) came on 4/21 at Detroit as an out call at first base involving Garrett Mitchell was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 776 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (870), Astros (816) and Yankees (804).

WOODRUFF AT A GLANCE: Brandon Woodruff, 33, will be making his fifth start of the 2026 season....Woodruff last started last Saturday at Miami and picked up a 5-2 victory (7ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 4k, 92 pitches)....the team is 3-1 in his starts....he has 2 quality starts....opponents are batting .207 (18-for-87, 3hr)....Woodruff was selected by Milwaukee in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University....he is signed through the 2026 season after accepting a qualifying offer on November 18 (declined his mutual option on November 3).

LAST SEASON: Woodruff went 7-2 with a 3.20 ERA in 12 starts with Milwaukee as he returned from October 2023 right shoulder surgery in July....the team went 10-2 in his starts....he had 6 quality starts....opponents batted .188 (45-for-239, 9hr)....he recorded 83 strikeouts in 64.2 innings....Woodruff was placed on the 15-day injured list on September 21 with a right lat strain, ending his season.

CAREER: Woodruff is 55-28 with a 3.11 ERA in 146 games/131 starts (768.2ip, 266er)....is in his 10th Major League season, all with the Brewers (2017-26)....was a 2019 and 2021 All-Star....he underwent surgery on 10/13/23 to repair the anterior capsule in his right shoulder, performed by Dr. Keith Meister, and missed the entire 2024 season.

SIMPLY THE BEST: Woodruff is the all-time franchise leader with a 3.11 ERA (min. 500ip)....his 891 strikeouts rank sixth in franchise history....**Jim Slaton** ranks fifth (929).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 30-9 with a 2.84 ERA in 73 games/66 starts (392.1ip, 124er)....is 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 2 starts this season (11ip, 3er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 25-19 with a 3.40 ERA in 73 games/65 starts (376.1ip, 142er)....is 1-0 with a 4.26 ERA in 2 starts this season (12.2ip, 6er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Is 8-3 with a 3.05 ERA in 19 games/17 starts against Pittsburgh (97.1ip, 76h, 34r, 33er, 23bb, 115k, 9hr), including 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 2 starts last season (10ip, 6h, 0r, 2bb, 12k).
