THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2 (2-1 vs. Boston and 3-1 vs. Seattle), the Twins began their three-game roadtrip with a win over the Blue Jays in Toronto last night...they will play the second of three in Canada today, then wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel home for an off-day on Monday then a three-game homestand/series against New York-AL.
 ☑ Twins have won 16 of their last 18 games...since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (16-2), ahead of the Dodgers (13-3) and Phillies (13-4).

TWINS WIN NORTHERN LIGHT FIGHT: The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Rogers Centre by a score of 3-2, making them 6-3 in one-run games...Joe Ryan (2-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on six hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...Ryan's 7.0 innings marked the fourth time a Twins starter reached that mark this season...the offense recorded seven hits and struck out just five times (tied third-fewest in 2024)...Carlos Correa went 2-for-4 with a double and two runs scored...Carlos Santana hit his fifth home run of the season, all five of his home runs now coming in his last 15 games (4 on the road).

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: Twins are looking to extend their road winning streak to eight games...their last road loss was on April 17, a 4-2 walk-off defeat in Baltimore...one more win ties the club record...below are the Twins all-time road winning streaks (since 1961):

START THE FIRE: In their last eight games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 5-1, 1.70 ERA (47.2 IP, 9 ER), with six walks, 61 strikeouts (11.5 K/9.0 IP), an opponent batting average of .190, an opponent OPS of .518 and six quality starts.

TWINS AND THE SIX: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing the second of six meetings in 2024... Minnesota will host Toronto for three games from July 30-August 1.

☑ Twins have gone 9-4 in their last 13 games at Rogers Centre.
 ☑ In 27 regular season games vs. Toronto, Carlos Correa is hitting .318 (35-for-110) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI and a .968 OPS in 28 games...he has reached base safely against the Jays in the regular season in 13 consecutive games.
 ☑ Quebec City native Edouard Julien is 6-for-17 (.353) with four doubles, one home run, five walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.265 OPS in six career regular season games against Toronto...he grew up a Blue Jays fan.
 ☑ Jose Miranda is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.158 OPS in eight career games vs. Toronto.

WOODS' STOCK: Simeon Woods Richardson pitched in the Toronto organization from 2019-21, pitching at High-A Dunedin and Double-A New Hampshire...he was acquired by the Blue Jays at the deadline in 2019 as part of the Marcus Stroman trade, then acquired by the Twins (along with Austin Martin) from Toronto as part of the José Berrios deadline deal in 2021...below are where the 23-year-old ranks among AL rookie pitchers in a few categories (min. 20.0 IP):

KEP ON KEPPING ON: Max Kepler enters today with a career-high 12-game hitting streak (previous best was 10 G)...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .426 (23-for-54) with seven doubles, three home runs, seven walks, 15 RBI, a .484 on-base percentage and a 1.206 OPS (MLB-best in that span) in 17 games.
 ☑ Kepler's streak is the longest by a Twin this season and longest by a Twin since Ryan Jeffers hit in 14 straight from July 15-August 9, 2023.
 ☑ Kepler's 12-game hitting streak is the longest active hitting streak in baseball.
 ☑ Since June 30, 2023, Kepler is hitting .306 (104-for-340) with a .913 OPS in 97 games...fifth-best OPS in the AL since that date (minimum of 350 plate appearances).

TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .345 (20-for-58) with eight doubles, five home runs, 17 RBI, five walks, a .420 on-base percentage, a .741 slugging percentage and a 1.162 OPS in his last 17 games, since April 22.

☑ Jeffers has driven in 17 runs in his last 14 games overall.
 ☑ Among all MLB qualifiers on the season, Jeffers ranks fifth in OPS (.986), trailing Shohei Ohtani (1.106), Marcell Ozuna (1.025), Mookie Betts (1.003) and Juan Soto (.991).

STRIKING SUCCESS: From the beginning of the season to April 24 (23 games), the Twins posted a strikeout rate of 26.8%, which was the third-highest in baseball...since April 25 (15 games), they have posted a strikeout rate of 18.6%, the fifth-lowest in baseball since that date.

MAJORITY RULES: The Twins are looking for their seventh series win this season (6-4-2)...2024 series results to the right...Minnesota's last series win in the regular season over Toronto came June 9-11, 2023 at Rogers Centre, taking two of three.

☑ Twins are looking for six consecutive series wins for the first time since August 27-September 16, 2010, when they won series' at Seattle, vs. Detroit, vs. Texas, vs. Kansas City, at Cleveland and at Chicago-AL.

- ☞ Making fifth MLB start of 2024 and sixth of career (seventh appearance)...last pitched May 6 vs. Seattle, throwing 6.0 scoreless, one-hit innings with one walk and a career-high eight strikeouts... didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-1 win.
- ☞ Has never faced Toronto – the organization that traded him to Minnesota on July 30, 2021 – or any active Blue Jays hitters.
- ☞ Has yet to allow a home run in 34.0 total innings (MLB and Triple-A) this season.

SILENCING SEATTLE: Last pitched May 6 vs. Seattle, opposite Luis Castillo, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-1 victory...allowed one hit in 6.0 scoreless innings with one walk and an MLB career-high eight strikeouts...struck out the first three batters and five of the first six...only baserunners were Mitch Garver (third-inning leadoff single) and Cal Raleigh (fifth-inning leadoff walk).

- ☞ Generated 10 whiffs on 37 swings (27.0%)...his 18.6 percent whiff rate ranks in MLB's 11th percentile.
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph) – two lineouts and four flyouts...ranks in MLB's 16th percentile with a 45.6 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ Threw his two hardest pitches in the sixth inning – 94.6 and 94.7 mph 4-seamers to Julio Rodriguez.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched April 30 at Chicago-AL, opposite Michael Soroka, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 victory...allowed two runs (1 ER) on seven hits in 3.2 innings, with two walks and two strikeouts...allowed three hits in the third, including an RBI single by Eloy Jiménez that scored Tommy Pham; escaped the inning with the bases loaded...was pulled with bases loaded in the fourth after a double and back-to-back walks; Kody Funderburk entered and allowed an unearned run on a Carlos Santana error.

- ☞ Generated three whiffs on 35 swings (8.6%).
- ☞ Eight of 15 balls in play (53.3%) were hard-hit...the White Sox went 6-for-8 with two doubles on those swings.

TRADED FROM TORONTO: Has never faced Toronto or any of its current hitters (at the MLB level)...pitched in 17 games with Blue Jays organization from 2019-21 – six with High-A Dunedin, 11 with Double-A New Hampshire...was acquired by Minnesota along with Austin Martin in July 30, 2021 trade that sent José Berrios to Toronto.

RATED ROOKIE: Among AL rookies with a minimum of 20.0 innings pitched, he ranks first in fielding independent pitching (1.74) and ERA (1.74), second in strikeouts-per-walk (4.20), third in WHIP (1.06), and fourth in batting average against (.224) and strikeouts-per-9.0 IP (9.15).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making third road start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA (9.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks and seven strikeouts on the road, compared to 0-0 with a 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 14 strikeouts in two home starts...has allowed a .250 batting average (9-for-36) and .606 OPS on the road, compared to .200 (8-for-40) and .458 at home.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: On May 6, Seattle's left-handed hitters went 0-for-8 with a walk and four strikeouts, while his righties went 1-for-11 with four strikeouts...through four MLB games vs. Woods Richardson this season, left-handed hitters have hit .226 (7-for-31) with a .520 OPS and 23.5 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .222 (10-for-45) with a .534 OPS and 26.5 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Facing right-handed pitching this season, Toronto has hit .221 (209-for-944) with a .650 OPS and 20.9 percent strikeout rate.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix in his first four MLB starts this season...here is his 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ May 6 vs. Seattle, threw a season-high 27 changeups...Mariners went 0-for-4 against the pitch, with three whiffs on 13 swings.
- ☞ Slider has allowed a .207 slugging percentage – 16th lowest of 100 pitchers (min. 25 PA).

KEEPING IT IN THE BALLPARK: Has gone 10-straight starts – a 50.2-inning span – without allowing a home run, dating back to September 7, 2023 at Louisville...is one of three MLB starting pitchers yet to allow a home run through four-or-more starts this season (Reese Olson and Trevor Williams, both with seven starts)...has allowed two total home runs and 0.59 home-runs-per-9.0-innings in his MLB career...has allowed multiple home runs in a game just twice in his professional career: May 11, 2023 vs. Indianapolis and August 8, 2023 vs. Louisville.

GETTING AHEAD: Ranks eighth in baseball this season (min. 75 batters faced) with a 72.3 first-pitch strike percentage...teammate Bailey Ober ranks ninth with 71.5 percent first-pitch strikes...when Woods Richardson gets ahead 0-1 in the count, opponents have hit .255 (13-for-51) with a .559 OPS and 26.4 percent strikeout rate...when the count begins 1-0, opponents have hit .056 (1-for-18) with seven strikeouts.

- ☞ Pitched in Twins spring training for first time in career and was optioned to Triple-A on March 11.
- ☞ Made two starts for St. Paul from April 9-15...was recalled by Minnesota on April 21 and made a relief appearance for Twins on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- ☞ Optioned back to St. Paul on April 23.
- ☞ Pitched a professional career-high 7.0 innings April 28 at Rochester, allowing two runs on three hits.
- ☞ Earned first win of the season on July 2 vs. Gwinnett, his first of four-straight winning decisions.
- ☞ Struck out a season-high seven batters July 8 at Iowa (5.0 IP).
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on September 10 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- ☞ Went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- ☞ Made 22 starts and three relief appearances for St. Paul...went 5-6 with a 5.21 ERA (103.2 IP, 60 ER) as a starter, and 2-0 with a 4.30 ERA (14.2 IP, 7 ER) as a reliever.
- ☞ Ranked second on Saints staff in innings pitched (113.2) and starts (22), and third in strikeouts (96).
- ☞ Entering 2024, ranked as 24th-best prospect in Twins organization by MLB.com and 29th-best prospect in Twins organization by *Baseball America*.

CAREER NOTES

- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- In 2023 with Triple-A Saint Paul, went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in his final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Posted a 2.72 ERA with 38 walks, 118 strikeouts and a .199 opponents batting average across three levels in 2022.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berrios...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
- Made Team USA's roster for the 2021 Tokyo Olympics but didn't appear in a game for the silver medal-winning Americans.
- In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
