AROUND THE HORN

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: On March 9, the D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated earning a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations, in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs' .857 win. pct (6-1 record) vs. left-handed starting pitchers is tied for the best in MLB (also: Rays and Reds).

- The D-backs' .299 AVG vs. lefty starters leads MLB...also rank in OPS (2nd, .814), SLG (3rd, .472) and OBP (5th, .342).
- **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 27-game hitting streak since Sept. 26, 2025 and MLB's longest active streak came to an end yesterday.
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base 19 times in his last 10 games, hitting .438 (14-for-32)/1.170 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 5 walks (6 K).
- Since April 21, ranks among top third basemen [min. 30 PA] in MLB in OPS (1st, 1.170), OBP (1st, .514), AVG (2nd, .438), hits (3rd, 14), SLG (3rd, .656), runs (T-3rd, 8) and total bases (6th, 21).
- In his last 17 games, is hitting .363 (21-for-57)/1.062 OPS with 1 double, 5 homers, 15 RBI and 5 walks (10 K).
- **Jose Fernandez** has a 13-game on-base streak as a starter, hitting .333 (16-for-48)/.822 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 4 walks.
- His .315 AVG (28-for-89) leads all qualified rookies...ranks among NL rookie leaders in singles (1st, 22), SLG (3rd, .449), runs (3rd, 19), OPS (4th, .794), OBP (4th, .344) and hits (4th, 28) [min. 80].
- In his last 19 starts, is hitting .333 (24-for-72)/.785 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 4 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 2-0 @ Cubs yesterday...marked just the second time being shut out.

- **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 27 game hit streak ended after going 0-4.
- **Ryne Nelson** took the loss after allowing 1 run over 5.2 innings with 4 hits, 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.
- **Kevin Ginkel** (0.1 IP), **Taylor Clarke** (0.2 IP), **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP) and **Jonathan Loaisiga** (0.1 IP) combined to allow 1 run in 2.1 frames with 1 hit, 2 walks and 3 strikeouts.

VARGY'S MEMORABLE RUN ENDS: Ildemaro Vargas' 24-game hit streak to start a season is MLB's second-longest streak since 1940:

30 Ron LeFlore/DET April 17-May 27, 1976

24 Ildemaro Vargas/AZ March 30-May 1, 2026

- In the span, hit .404 (38-for-94)/1.131 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 6 homers (team high), 21 RBI (team high) and 4 walks.

- **Vargas'** 24-game hitting streak to start the season set a franchise record.

- His single-season 24-game hitting streak is tied for the second-longest in club history:

24 Ildemaro Vargas 2026

- Including streaks spanning multiple seasons, his 27-game hit streak is the second-longest:

- **Vargas'** 20-game road hitting streak since Sept. 8, 2025 was MLB's longest active road streak and set a franchise record.

VARGAS MEETS THE BABE: Ildemaro Vargas is the fourth MLB player in the last 40 years to record 35+ hits, 6+ homers, 6+ doubles, 2+ triples and 20+ RBI within their first 25 games of a season (prev. 3: Jimmy Paredes/BAL in 2015, Carlos Beltrán/NYM in 2007 and Hubie Brooks/WSH in 1986)...since 1901, the feat has been met by 21 players, including Babe Ruth/NYY (1921), Lou Gehrig/NYY (1927), Stan Musial/STL (1948), Ted Williams/BOS (1955) and Willie Mays/SF (1958).

PRODUCING AT THE BOTTOM: Since April 13, the D-backs' 7-9 hitters in the lineup rank among MLB leaders in combined RBI (1st, 34), extra-base hits (1st, 21), homers (T-2nd, 9), SLG (2nd, .488) and OPS (3rd, .794).

ROAD SNAKES: Geraldo Perdomo has reached base in 15 of his last 16 road games (13 H, 12 BB)/.368 OBP with 1 double, 2 homers and 6 RBI.

- **Adrian Del Castillo** has reached base in 9 of his last 10 road games (10 H, 2 BB)/.747 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers and 9 RBI.
- **Jose Fernandez** has reached base in 11 of his last 12 road starts (13 H, 2 BB) with 2 doubles and 4 RBI.

VS. LEFTIES: Corbin Carroll is hitting .452 (19-for-42)/1.251 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 3 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** is hitting .306 (11-for-36)/.342 OBP with 2 doubles, 4 RBI and 2 walks.
- **Jose Fernandez** is hitting .333 (8-for-24)/.760 OPS with 1 double, 3 RBI and 2 walks.

DAY SNAKES: Ildemaro Vargas has hit safely in 12 of his 13 day games at a .396 clip (21-for-53)/1.003 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 2 walks.

- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base in 12 of his 15 day games, hitting .315 (17-for-54)/.959 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base 16 times in his last 15 day games (12 H, 4 BB) with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI.
- **Nolan Arenado** in his last 9 day games, is hitting .323 (10-for-31)/.333 OBP with 2 RBI and 1 walk.
