THE TWINS: Completed their season-long 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with a record of 5-5, going 1-2 at Tampa Bay, 1-2 at Seattle and 3-1 against the A's in Sacramento...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game homestand with the first of three against the Blue Jays and play Toronto at Target Field through the weekend...after the Jays series, Minnesota will enjoy an off-day on Monday then welcome the Rangers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday. **Twins** are 27-13 in their last 40 games since April 22, tied with Detroit (27-14) for the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15. **On** the season, the Twins' 34 wins rank tied for third in the AL with Houston, and trailing Detroit's 41 and New York's 38.

A's REALLY, REALLY MAKE SURE TWINS CAN'T SWEEP: The Twins lost to the Athletics yesterday afternoon in Sacramento by a score of 14-3, missing the four-game sweep...it marked their biggest margin of defeat since a 15-0 loss on August 31, 2024 vs. Toronto...David Festa (0-1) made his return to the Twins and was the starter, allowing eight runs on six hits (3 home runs) in 3.2 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...Jonah Bride made his first career pitching appearance and threw 2.0 innings, striking out Lawrence Butler...the offense recorded just seven hits as Matt Wallner reached twice with a homer (3) and a walk.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams from Triple-A St. Paul...Adams, 25, has appeared in 13 games (2 starts) for the Saints this season, going 3-1, 3.43 ERA (42.0 IP, 16 ER), three saves, 10 walks, 37 strikeouts and a 1.14 WHIP...the 6-foot-1, 213-pound right-hander has spent parts of five seasons in the Twins minor league system, going 18-29, 4.42 ERA (380.2 IP, 187 ER) with 116 walks and 363 strikeouts in 88 games (72 starts)...the Palm Springs, California native was selected by the Twins in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of California State University, Sacramento. **To** make room on the 26-man roster the Twins have optioned Kody Funderburk to St. Paul...Funderburk, who was in his second stint with Minnesota this season, recently appeared in seven games, allowing eight runs on 15 hits, with four walks and four strikeouts.

TWINS AND JAYS: The Twins went 4-2 against the Blue Jays last season, going 3-1 at Rogers Centre, from May 10-12 and 2-1 at Target Field, from August 30-September 1...despite the record, the Twins were outscored 22-31, mostly in part to a 15-0 defeat on August 31 at Target Field...2024 marked their first season series victory against Toronto since 2022 (4-3). **In**cluding the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 8-3 in their last 11 games against the Blue Jays, dating back to June of 2023. **In**cluding the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 4-1 against Toronto in Minnesota over their last five games here.

BIRD WATCHERS: Notable individual numbers against the Blue Jays: **Byron Buxton** has posted a .912 OPS with nine doubles, eight home runs, 19 RBI and a .573 slugging percentage in 29 career regular season games against the Blue Jays. **In** 32 career regular and Postseason games against the Blue Jays, Carlos Correa is hitting .323 (40-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 25 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .556 slugging percentage and a .961 OPS...he has reached safely in 17-straight. **In** six career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner is hitting .368 (7-for-19) with one home run, three RBI and a .955 OPS...his first (of 2) career four-hit game came against Toronto on May 27, 2023 at Target Field. **In** seven career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .480 (12-for-25) with one double, three home runs, eight RBI, a .536 on-base percentage, a .880 slugging percentage and a 1.416 OPS...he has reached safely in all seven.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS: Twins are 18-8 through 26 home games this season, winning 12 of their last 14 and 16 of their last 19 at Target Field. **At** home, the pitching staff has posted a 2.75 ERA (236.0 IP, 72 ER) with a .232 opponent batting average and a 10.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio...starters have posted a 2.61 ERA (134.1 IP, 39 ER). **Notable** Individuals at Target Field this season: Kody Clemens is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with three doubles, one triple, one home run and a 1.429 OPS...Matt Wallner is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles, two triples and a .939 OPS...Harrison Bader is hitting .306 (19-for-62) with two doubles, two home runs and an .848 OPS. **Byron Buxton** has a .910 OPS in 20 home games this season...he is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with three home runs and 11 RBI in his last eight games at Target Field.

WE COME FROM FRANCE: Ty France has reached base safely in 17-straight games, tying his career-high, done twice previously (2021 and '23 with Seattle)...it also marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Carlos Correa's 19-game steak from June 26-September 22, 2024...during the streak, France is hitting .323 (21-for-65) with two doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, six HBP and a .380 on-base percentage.

GOOD WILLI: In his last 17 games, Willi Castro is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with three doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, nine walks, 13 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .424 on-base percentage, a .643 slugging percentage and a 1.067 OPS. **Since** the start of the Seattle series, May 30, he has gone 10-for-26 (.385) with one double, four home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored and a 1.385 OPS in seven games.

C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE: Over his last 28 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .301 (31-for-103) with five doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .466 slugging percentage and an .802 OPS — Twins 19-9 in those games...in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .167 (14-for-84) with six doubles, one home run, five RBI, a .274 slugging percentage and a .496 OPS — Twins went 8-16 in those games. **In** 11 games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL, Correa has posted an .890 OPS, while slugging .564.

FOREST RAKE: Matt Wallner enters tonight with a season-long seven-game hitting streak (dating back to April 13 - IL stint in between), one short of his career-high of eight, from August 4-13, 2024...in his last 14 games, dating back to April 6, Wallner is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, five RBI, three HBP, six walks, a .436 on-base percentage, a .609 slugging percentage and a 1.045 OPS.

DON'T WALK: Over the four-game series with the Athletics, Twins pitchers walked 20 batters, their most in a four-game series since issuing 21 walks to the Yankees from September 5-8, 2022...despite that, Twins pitchers still lead baseball in fewest walks on the season at 158.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2019, Max Kepler became the second player in club history to record multiple three-homer games (also 2016), joining Eddie Rosario (2017 and 2018), as Kepler hit all three homers off Trevor Bauer at Progressive Field...it also marked the second time Kepler homered three times in Cleveland.
