A's REALLY, REALLY MAKE SURE TWINS CAN'T SWEEP: The Twins lost to the Athletics yesterday afternoon in Sacramento by a score of 14-3, missing the four-game sweepit marked their biggest margin of defeat since a 15-0 loss on August 31, 2024 vs. TorontoDavid Fests (0-1) made his return to the Twins and was the starter, allowing eight runs on six hits (3 home runs) in 3.2 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeoutsJonah Bride made his first career pitching appearance and threw 2.0 innings, striking out Lawrence Butlerthe offense recorded just seven hits as Matt Wallner reached twice with a homer (3) and a walk	r 3

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams from Triple-A St. Paul...Adams, 25, has appeared in 13 games (2 starts) for the Saints this season, going 3-1, 3.43 ERA (42.0 IP, 16 ER), three saves, 10 walks, 37 strikeouts and a 1.14 WHIP..the 6-foot-1, 213-pound right-hander has spent parts of five seasons in the Twins minor league system, going 18-29, 4.42 ERA (380.2 IP, 187 ER) with 116 walks and 363 strikeouts in 88 games (72 starts)...the Palm Springs, California native was selected by the Twins in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of California State University, Sacramento.

◆ To make room on the 26-man roster the Twins have optioned Kody Funderburk to St. Paul... Funderburk, who was in his second stint with Minnesota this season, recently appeared in seven games, allowing eight runs on 15 hits, with four walks and four strikeouts.

TWINS AND JAYS: The Twins went 4-2 against the Blue Jays last season, going 3-1 at Rogers Centre, from May 10-12 and 2-1 at Target Field, from August 30-September 1...despite the record, the Twins were outscored 22-31, mostly in part to a 15-0 defeat on August 31 at Target Field...2024 marked their first season series victory against Toronto since 2022 (4-3). 
♣ Including the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 8-3 in their last 11 games against the Blue Jays, dating back to June of 2023. 
♣ Including the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 4-1 against Toronto in Minnesota over their last five games here.

BIRD WATCHERS: Notable individual numbers against the Blue Jays:

◆ Byron Buxton has posted a .912 OPS with nine doubles, eight home runs, 19 RBI and a .573 slugging percentage in 29 career regular season games against the Blue Jays.

♦ In 32 career regular and Postseason games against the Blue Jays, Carlos Correa is hitting .323 (40-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 25 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .556 slugging percentage and a .961 OPS...he has reached safely in 17-straight.

♦ In six career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner is hitting .368 (7-for-19) with one home run, three RBI and a .955 OPS...his first (of 2) career four-hit game came against Toronto on May 27, 2023 at Target Field.

♦ In seven career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .480 (12-for-25) with one double, three home runs, eight RBI, a .536 on-base percentage, a .880 slugging percentage and a 1.416 OPS...he has reached safely in all seven.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS: Twins are 18-8 through 26 home games this season, winning 12 of their last 14 and 16 of their last 19 at Target Field.

♣ At home, the pitching staff has posted a 2.75 ERA (236.0 IP, 72 ER) with a .232 opponent batting average and a 10.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio...starters have posted a 2.61 ERA (134.1 IP, 39 ER).

♣ Notable Individuals at Target Field this season: Kody Clemens is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with three doubles, one triple, one home run and a 1.429 OPS...Matt Wallner is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles, two triples and a .939 OPS...Harrison Bader is hitting .306 (19-for-62) with two doubles, two home runs and an .848 OPS.

♣ Byron Buxton has a .910 OPS in 20 home games this season...he is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with three home runs and 11 RBI in his last eight games at Target Field.

WE COME FROM FRANCE: Ty France has reached base safely in 17-straight games, tying his career-high, done twice previously (2021 and '23 with Seattle)...it also marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Carlos Correa's 19-game steak from June 26-September 22, 2024...during the streak, France is hitting .323 (21-for-65) with two doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, six HBP and a .380 on-base percentage.

GOOD WILLI: In his last 17 games, Willi Castro is hitting .321 (18-for-56) with three doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, nine walks, 13 runs scored, two stolen bases, a .424 on-base percentage, a .643 slugging percentage and a 1.067 OPS.

◆ Since the start of the Seattle series, May 30, he has gone 10-for-26 (.385) with one double, four home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored and a 1.385 OPS in seven games.

**C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE:** Over his last 28 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .301 (31-for-103) with five doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .466 slugging percentage and an .802 OPS — Twins 19-9 in those games...in his 24 games prior to April 25, he hit .167 (14-for-84) with six doubles, one home run, five RBI, a .274 slugging percentage and a .496 OPS — Twins went 8-16 in those games. 
■ In 11 games since returning from the 7-day concussion IL, Correa has posted an .890 OPS, while slugging .564.

**FOREST RAKE:** Matt Wallner enters tonight with a season-long seven-game hitting streak (dating back to April 13 - IL stint in between), one short of his career-high of eight, from August 4-13, 2024...in his last 14 games, dating back to April 6, Wallner is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, five RBI, three HBP, six walks, a .436 on-base percentage, a .609 slugging percentage and a 1.045 OPS.

**DON'T WALK:** Over the four-game series with the Athletics, Twins pitchers walked 20 batters, their most in a four-game series since issuing 21 walks to the Yankees from September 5-8, 2022...despite that, Twins pitchers still lead baseball in fewest walks on the season at 158.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2019, Max Kepler became the second player in club history to record multiple three-homer games (also 2016), joining Eddie Rosario (2017 and 2018), as Kepler hit all three homers off Trevor Bauer at Progressive Field...it also marked the second time Kepler homered three times in Cleveland.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on May 25 against the Royals, opposite Kris Bubic and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 1-2 defeat...allowed one run on seven hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 6.2 quality innings...his one run allowed came off an RBI double in the seventh inning from Freddy Fermin, scoring Drew Waters...recorded his second career balk with two outs and a runner on first in the first inning.

VS. THE JAYS: Ober is 2-2 in five career starts against Toronto, posting a 2.70 ERA (26.2 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and 34 strikeouts...faced the Blue Jays twice in 2024, posting a 0.73 ERA (12.1 IP, 1 ER) with three walks, 18 strikeouts and a .050 (10-for-53) opponent batting average, his lowest BAA among all opponents faced last season.

4 His career .160 opponent batting average is his lowest among teams he has faced at least three times, and fourth lowest all time, behind the Rockies (.091), Angels (.143) and Rats (1.58).

In his last start against the Blue Jays on September 1, 2024 at Target Field, Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-3 victory...allowed one run on one hit, a homer from Ernie Clement with three walks and eight strikeouts.

**THE BEARDED NIGHTMARE:** So far this season, Bailey is 3-0 in four night game starts, with a 2.35 ERA (23.0 IP, 6 ER), a .267 (24-for-90) opponent batting average, a .389 slugging percentage and a .280 opponent OBP; compared to 1-1 in eight daytime starts, with a 4.15 ERA (39.0 IP, 18 ER), a .286 (46-for-161) opponent batting average, a .466 slugging percentage and a .341 OBP.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.75 ERA (263.2 IP, 110 ER), 9.22 W/9, 2.15 BB/9 and 1.54 HR/9 in 51 games (50 starts) at home compared to 13-14 with a 3.84 ERA (274.0 IP, 117 ER), 8.80 W/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.28 HR/9 in 51 road starts.

© Ober is 2-0 in six starts at home so far this season, posting a 2.32 ERA (31.0 IP, 8 ER) with five walks, three home runs, 28 strikeouts and a .279 (34-for-122) opponent batting average.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through 12 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .279/.311/.403 in 129 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .279/.328/.475 in 122 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.3 mph and a whiff rate of 21.5 compared to righties' 92.4 mph and 28.8 percent.

This hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at his lowest since 2022, 27.1 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 52.1 percent.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 37.9% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

**EXTENSION # 6-9:** Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is tied with Aaron Slegers (2017-18) and Alex Meyer (2015-16) as the second-tallest players to pitch for the Twins in franchise history (since 1901), trailing only Jon Rauch (6-11, 2009-10)...on average this season, Ober has released his pitches 7.4 feet off the mound, the sixth-longest extension in baseball, which puts him in the 99th percentile according to Baseball Savant...teammate Pablo López also has one of the longest extensions in baseball (7.1 feet), ranking in the 93rd percentile.

**THRILL OF THE CHASE:** Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 34.9 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 94th percentile; ranks second on the Twins pitching staff, behind Griffin Jax (40.8) who ranks first in all of baseball.

**UNDER PRESSURE:** This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .220 (11-for-50) with three home runs, three walks and 16 strikeouts; with runners in scoring position *and* two outs, opponents are hitting .120 (3-for-25) with one home run, two walks and eight strikeouts.

FIXING THE FASTBALL: Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through 10 starts this season, Ober has lowered hard hit percentage, slugging percentage and opponent batting average...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:
