ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 49-25 on the road, going 18-4-1 in series play.....had a season-high 8-game road winning streak from 7/7-7/30.....had a season-high 5-game road losing streak from 5/3-5/7.....their 49 road wins break the franchise record set by the 1982 team (47-33).

ALL-STARS: The Brewers were represented at the All-Star Game by Corbin Burnes, Josh Hader, Freddy Peralta, Brandon Woodruff and Omar Narváez.....the five players selected tied a franchise record, all consecutively (also 2018 and 2019).....it marked the first time in franchise history that the team had three or more pitchers selected.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his seventh season as manager (523-468) and sixth full season.....he is second in franchise history in wins, trailing Phil Garner (563-617)... under Counsell, the Brewers made the postseason in three consecutive years for the first time in franchise history (2018-20).....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through 2023.

COACHES: Assistant hitting coach Jacob Cruz (2nd season), hitting coach Andy Haines (3rd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (3rd season), bullpen coach Steve Karsay (3rd season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (6th season, 1st as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach **Walker McKinven** (2nd season) and bench coach Pat Murphy (6th season) all returned from the 2020 coaching staff.....new to the staff

## TODAY'S STARTER: #53 - RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF (27gs, 9-8, 2.48)

WOODRUFF AT A GLANCE: Two-time All-Star Brandon Woodruff, 28, will make his 28th start of the season and first against the Tigers.....Woodruff last started on 9/6 vs. Philadelphia and took a 12-0 loss (6ip, 9h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 6k, 3hr, 101 pitches).....he was scratched from his next scheduled start (Sunday at Cleveland) due to intestinal discomfort.....the team is 16-11 in his starts.....he has 18 quality starts.....opponents are batting .197 (117-for-593, 17hr).....he has 191 strikeouts compared to 41 walks in 163.1 innings.....he was NL Player of the Week for 5/24-5/30.....Woodruff was selected in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.

ENCORE!: Woodruff was the first Brewers pitcher to start on Opening Day in consecutive seasons since Yovani Gallardo started a franchise-record five in a row from 2010-14.

CAREER: Is 28-19 with a 3.22 ERA in 89 games / 74 starts [444ip, 159er].....is in his fifth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2017-21).....was a 2019 and 2021 All-Star.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 15-7 with a 3.32 ERA in 46 games / 39 starts (233.1ip, 86er).....is 4-2 with a 2.37 ERA in 13 starts this season (79.2ip, 21er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 13-12 with a 3.12 ERA in 43 games / 35 starts (210.2ip, 73er)....is 5-6 with a 2.58 ERA in 14 starts this season (83.2ip, 24er).

CAREER vs. TIGERS: His only career outing against Detroit came in relief on 9/28/18 at American Family Field.....he threw 2.0 perfect innings (3k).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .180 (20-for-111) hitter with 1 HR and 7 RBI.....has 6 walks and 51 strikeouts.....homered on 7/13/18 at Pittsburgh (solo off Nick Kingham).....has 8 sacrifice bunts.....2021 AT THE PLATE: Is batting .083 (4-for-48) with 2 RBI.....has 3 walks and 28 strikeouts.....has 3 sacrifice bunts.
