COME AS YOU ARE: The St. Louis Cardinals visit the Emerald City to begin a three-game series tonight with the Seattle Mariners at T-Mobile Park ... After Thursday's off day, the Redbirds will continue their six-game "Seattle Pilots" road trip with a three-game weekend series with the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers at American Family Field ... St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the NL Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 4.5 games behind New York for the final Wild Card position.

SOMETHING IN THE WAY: The Cardinals play the toughest remaining strength of schedule, with combined .556 winning pct. against the Mariners (3g), Brewers (6g), Reds (3g), Giants (3g), and Cubs (3g). - *Elias*

EVEN FLOW: Yesterday's win returned the Cardinals back to .500 for the first time since August 14 and 10th time overall this season ... St. Louis needs a 10-8 run over its final 18 games to finish with a winning mark, above .500 ... The Cardinals have had winning marks in 25 of their past 31 seasons since joining the N.L. Central Division in 1994 and in 23 of their 25 seasons played since 2000.

CARDINALS vs. MARINERS

SUCH GREAT HEIGHTS: St. Louis has won three consecutive series for the first time since taking five straight from May 2-18 (NYM, PIT, at WSH, at PHI, at KC) as part of a season-high nine-game win streak ... The Cardinals have won seven of their last 10 games and share the Major League lead in victories since August 28.

ABOUT A BURL: Prior to tonight's game St. Louis activated 1B/OF **Alec Burleson** from the 10-Day Injured List and designated INF/OF **Garrett Hampson** for assignment ... Burleson, who missed nine games with right wrist inflammation (Aug. 29-Sept. 7), made his MLB debut on this date three years ago (Sept. 8, 2022), starting in right field at Busch Stadium against the Nationals ... Other notable Cards MLB Debuts on this date include OF **J.D. Drew** (Sept. 8, 2001) & LHP **Chris Narveson** (Sept. 8, 2006).

HELLO, I'VE WAITED HERE FOR YOU... EVERLONG: St. Louis selected the contract of LHP **Nick Raquet** (pronounced rah-KAY) today and optioned RHP **Andre Granillo** to Memphis following yesterday's game ... The 29-year-old Raquet has gone a combined 10-4 with a 1.68 ERA (48.1 IP) and 57 strikeouts in 36 games with Springfield (AA) and Memphis (AAA) this season.

LEARN TO FLY: With his first appearance, **Nick Raquet** becomes the 6th Cardinal to make MLB debut this season (RHP **Andre Granillo**, RHP **Matt Svanson**, OF **Nathan Church**, INF **César Prieto**, C **Jimmy Crooks**) and join OF **So Taguchi** (June 10, 2002) as the only other Cardinal to make his Major League debut in Seattle.

I STAY AWAY: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the only venues that have been full-time homes to Major League teams for at least one season in which the Cardinals have never played are The Kingdome (1977-99), Puerto Rico's Hiram Bithorn Stadium (2003-04), and Sacramento's Sutter Health Park (2025-present), where the Cardinals are scheduled to visit in May 2026 ... Cardinals to appear in the 1979 MLB All-Star Game at The Kingdome included OF Lou Brock, 1B Keith Hernandez, C Ted Simmons, and coach Dave Ricketts: SS Garry Templeton was selected as a reserve, but would not depart because he did not start.

GLORIFIED D: Shortstop **Masyn Winn** leads all of Major League Baseball in Outs Above Average (22) and MLB shortstops in fielding percentage (.994), which is currently is the best by a Cardinals shortstop over a full season all-time, surpassing .989 marks by **David Eckstein** (2006) and **Paul DeJong** (2019).

• Since 1974, only two Major League shortstops have played 125+ games and committed 3 or fewer errors with 500+ total chances: Baltimore's **Cal Ripken Jr.** (3 errors in 680 total chances in1990) and Cleveland's **Omar Vizquel** (3 errors in 648 total chances in 2000) ... Winn has made three errors over 498 total chances this season.

DO THE EVOLUTION: The Cardinals series in Seattle marks their final Interleague games in 2025 ... St. Louis is 22-23 in Interleague play this season (12-9 on the road), and 288-282 all-time vs. the AL, with a .505 win pct. that ranks 13th-best MLB.

DRAIN YOU: St. Louis is 153-155 all-time in night games played in the Pacific Time Zone since divisional play began in 1994 (0-1 at Arizona, 1-1 at San Diego, 1-1 at Los Angeles Dodgers this season).

THE DAY I TRIED TO LIVE: Happy 28th birthday to outfielder Lars Nootbaar ... Other notables born in this date include pitchers Gerrit Cole (age 35) and Ken Forsch (79), Hall of Famer Buck Leonard (1907-97), actors Martin Freeman (54), Jonathan Taylor Thomas (44), and Peter Sellers (1925-80), rapper Wiz Khalifa (38), singer Pink (46), and actress Brooke Burke (54).

SEATTLE CONNECTIONS

Brant Brown coached parts of six seasons over two stints in the Mariners organization (2013-17, 24), previously serving as the Mariners Bench Coach/Offensive Coordinator (2024), Offensive Coordinator (2017), and Minor League Outfield Coordinator (2013-16).

Randy Arozarena played in 19 games for St. Louis in 2019 and parts of three minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2017-19)...originally signed with the Cardinals as an international free agent (Aug. 1, 2016)...traded to Tampa Bay with José Martínez, and Cardinals Compensation draft pick A (INF Alika Williams) in exchange for Matthew Liberatore, Edgardo Rodriguez and Rays Compensation draft pick B (RHP Tink Hence) on Jan. 9, 2020.

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray** worked for the Seattle Mariners for three seasons (1993-95).

John King made his MLB debut at T-Mobile Park with Texas (Sept. 4, 2020)...fanned Kyle Lewis (swinging) that night for his first MLB strikeout.

Riley O'Brien was born in Seattle and resides in Shoreline, WA... graduated from Shorewood (WA) High School...pitched two seasons at Everett (WA) Community College (2014-15)...traded by Cincinati to the Mariners for Luis Chevalier (April 17, 2022) and pitched in one game for Seattle (May 7, 2022 vs. TB)...2023 PCL Post-Season All-Star for AAA-Tacoma...acquired by the Cardinals from the Mariners for cash considerations (Nov. 5, 2023).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in Seattle in 1995, including all 11 postseason games.

Cardinals Director of Pitching **Matt Pierpont** worked four seasons in Seattle's organization (2021-24), most recently as their minor league pitching coordinator.

Mariners Pitching Strategy Coach **Trent Black** was born in St. Louis...graduated from nearby Columbia (III.) High School.

Mariners broadcaster **Aaron Goldsmith** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Principia College in Elsah, Ill...began broadcast career in 2007 with the nearby Gateway Grizzlies in the independent Frontier League.

Mariners broadcaster **Rick Rizzs** is a 1975 graduate of Southern Illinois Univ. in Carbondale...previously served as a broadcaster for the Memphis Chicks (AA-Expos) from 1978-80.

MILES MIKOLAS'S HIGHS

NL Rankings: HR Allowed (24, T-3rd), BB/9 (2.18, 7th), BB % (5.6, 5th), % First Pitch Strikes (69.8, 1st). Non-Qualified

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Makes his 28th start of the season and 210th career; It's his 200th career start with the Cardinals (2018-present) in addition to the 10 the made with the Rangers in 2014.
- Has held his opposition to four hits or fewer in 13 starts this season, most of any Cardinals starter and T-7th most in the National League (Peralta, MIL. 19).
- Become the 12th Cardinal with 200 career starts, joining most recent Redbirds to accomplish the feat **Adam Wainwright** and **Matt Morris**.
- At age 37 is the oldest player on the team's active roster.
- Has not received more than three runs of support in any of his last 14 starts. His 23 runs total runs of support since June 15 rank tied for fewest in MLB with Houston's **Hunter Brown**.
- Receiving an average of 3.23 run support per game; lowest in the National League and 2nd-lowest behind former Cardinal Michael Wacha (KC, 3.17).
- Has not earned a road win since May 17 at Kansas City (1-0), going 0-5 with a 10.31 ERA in 7 starts since then, allowing 16 HR in 29.1 IP; Is 3-3 with 3.25 ERA in 10 Home starts since then allowing 6 HR in 55.1 IP.
- Has made 25+ starts in six seasons over his career each of those while with the Cardinals.
- Has surrendered 7 HR in 76.2 innings at home, but 17 homers in 59.2 innings on the road.
- Has hurled 6.0+ innings in 9 of his 27 starts (8 quality starts).
- Mikolas is one of just 3 MLB pitchers to have made as many as 199 starts <u>exclusively with one team</u> since he joined the Cardinals in 2018; also Philadelphia's **Aaron Nola** (221) & Colorado's **Kyle Freeland** (199)
- Opened the season with 29.0 homerless IP (March 31-April 30), but averaging MLB-leading 2.01 HR/9 IP since May 1.
- Is closing out his 8th season (was injured for all of 2020) with the Cardinals in 2025; Leads active Cardinals pitchers in wins (67), innings pitched (1.138.1), strikeouts (818) and games started (199).
- The Cardinals are 108-91 in his 199 career starts with St. Louis and Miles holds a 67-68 mark as a Cardinal.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas leads MLB in first strike percentage (68.2) and lowest walk percentage (4.4%).

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, Sept. 2 vs. Athletics): Recorded his 1st win since July 25 with a 2-1 victory over the Athletics; Allowed just one run on 5 hits in 6.0 IP, using just 67 pitches; he had no strikeouts and his lone walk was an intentional pass; **Ivan Herrera's** 2-out, 2-run HR in the 6th was the decisive blow of the game.

2025 NOTES:

- St. Louis is 13-14 in his starts this season. The Cardinals lost each of his first 5 starts to begin the season, then won 7-straight from April 30-June 5.
- Pitched 3 scoreless starts this season (22nd career since joining STL in 2018). Posted two scoreless starts in July (7/10 vs. WSH & 7/25 vs. SD).
- Surrendered a franchise record six home runs vs. CHI (7/4) at Wrigley Field en route to a franchise record eight total home runs (King 2) allowed by the Cardinals. Five of the six home runs allowed were solo. Of pitchers who have allowed six home runs in MLB history, pitched the longest outing (6.0) since Tommy Thomas of the St. Louis Browns (6/27/1936) vs. NYY.
- Blanked the Reds over 5.1 IP (77 pitches) on April 30 in Game 1 of double header at Great American Ball Park. Was credited with his 1st win of
 the season as he and three relievers combined on the 6-0 shutout win. The Cardinals got back/back/back HR's from Scott II, Nootbaar and Winn
 to break the game open in the 9th inning.
- Fanned a season-high 7 batters in his 6/15 start at MIL over 6.0 IP.
- Threw a 3-pitch inning in 4th inning on 9/2 vs. ATH, just the 4th by a Cardinals pitcher since pitch tracking became official.

MIKOLAS vs. SEATTLE:

- Has made three career starts against the Mariners, two while pitching for the Cardinals and one while pitching for Texas in 2014.
- Owns a career mark of 1-1 with 5.28 ERA in his three starts, blanking the M's over 8.0 IP on 8/25/14 at Seattle in a 2-0 win.
- Has a 1-0 mark with a 2.03 ERA in his two starts in Seattle, the last taking place on 4/22/23 when he took a no-decision in 5-4 Cardinals loss.
- He's 11-10 in 39 career games (37 starts) in Interleague play, including a 2-3 mark in his 10 Interleague starts this season.
