RAY REPORT—The Rays open their final homestand of the season against the Red Sox (3 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...have not won or lost more than three consecutive games since being swept by Baltimore from June 7-10, going 42-42 since that series...are 19-25 since the July 30 trade deadline and 25-29 since the All-Star break...including off days, this marks their 90th consecutive day occupying fourth place in the AL East...are 6.0 games behind the Twins for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500...are on the final of eight consecutive series vs. clubs that hold a .500 or better record (Aug. 23–Sept. 19), going 9-14 so far.

Tampa Bay suffered its eighth shutout loss on Sunday at Cleveland...the Rays collected only four hits in the contest, marking their 21st game of the season with four or fewer hits...the 21 such games are tied for second most in a season in club history (also 2022, 2017, 2001), trailing only the 2002 Devil Rays (25).

The Rays have been held to two runs or fewer 61 times, second most in the majors behind the White Sox and tied for second most in club history (also 2014) behind the 1998 Devil Rays (71).

The Rays 3.29 ERA since the All-Star break ranks third in MLB behind the Tigers (3.12) and Astros (3.15), but the offense is averaging 3.59 runs per game in that span, second fewest in the majors behind the White Sox (2.96).

Tonight, Tampa Bay looks to avoid a fourth straight home loss to Boston for the first time since a five-game skid from April 19-July 23, 2019...a loss would also send them a season-high-tying five games below .500 for the first time since entering play on June 19 at 34-39.

WIZARD OF BAZ—Shane Baz has completed 5.0+ innings while vielding three hits or

WIZARD OF BAZ—Shane Baz has completed 5.0+ innings while yielding three hits or fewer in four consecutive starts, tied with Shane McClanahan (July 2 [G1]-26, 2022) and Blake Snell (Sept. 12-29, 2018) for the longest streak in franchise history...only three pitchers in the majors this season have accomplished the feat in five straight starts: TOR Bowden Francis, CIN Hunter Greene and CWS Drew Thorpe.

KELL-YEAH—**Kevin Kelly's** 19.1 scoreless inning streak is tied with PIT **Dennis Santana** the longest active run in the majors...he has not allowed an earned run in 21 straight outings (23.2IP) since July 23, limiting opponents to a .150/200/.188 (12-for-80) line with a 0.68 WHIP during that time...the 21-appearance streak is the longest by a Ray since his own career-best 21-appearance (20.1IP) run from May 14–July 15 (G2), 2023 and is the longest active streak in the majors, ahead of AZ **A.J. Puk** (20)...the last longer streak by a Rays reliever was **Pete Fairbanks'** club-record 30-appearance run (July 25, 2022–April 28, 2023).

EN FUEGO—Yandy Díaz has hit safely in seven straight games, going 11-for-25 (.440) with 1 2B, 1 HR and 3 RBL..in 24 games since Aug. 17, he is batting .356/.412/.552 (31-for-87) with 5 2B, 4 HR and 13 RBI, ranking among AL leaders during that stretch in AVG (1st), OBP (2nd), OPS (6th, .964), SLG (.552) and hits (T9th).

Jonathan Aranda has recorded a hit in a career-best seven straight starts, batting .308 (8-for-26) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 3 BB and 5 R...he has also reached base safely in a career-best 12 straight starts.

Manuel Rodríguez has a 1.31 ERA (20.2IP, 3ER) and 0.73 WHIP over his last 22 appearances...min. 30.0 IP, Edwin Uceta's 1.42 ERA ranks third in MLB behind CLE Emmanuel Clase (0.65) and TEX Kirby Yates (1.27).

BAG BANDITS—The Rays 77 SB since the All-Star break are second most in the majors behind the Nationals (84)...they are 21-for-24 (87.5%) in their last 20 games and 56-for-63 (88.9%) in their last 39 since Aug. 6, the most steals in the majors and best efficiency in the AL over that period...the Rays 47 multi-steal games pace the AL and are third most in club history behind 2009 (54) and 2010 (49).

Josh Lowe has been successful on 15 consecutive stolen base attempts, the second-longest streak of his career behind a 22-steal streak last year (July 23-Sept. 8, 2023).

On the season, the Rays 172 SB lead the AL, ahead of the Guardians (142), and rank fourth in MLB...they are looking to lead the AL in steals for the first time since 2011.

TROP TALK—At 37-38, Tampa Bay must go 4-2 over the next six games to secure an eighth straight winning season at home, with the last losing season coming in 2016 (36-45).

Nine of the Rays last 14 home games have been one-run games, including four of their last five...they are 14-9 (.609) in one-run home games this season, but have gone 3-5 in their last eight after opening the year 11-4 in such games.

Tampa Bay has gone 19 straight home games without a multi-homer effort, the longest single-season run since 2014 (19G)...the longest single-season streak in franchise history is held by the 2002 Devil Rays (23G).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays are 49-31 (.613) in games decided by two runs or fewer, tied with the Phillies (38-24/.613) for the best mark in the majors...their 80 such games lead the AL, trailing only the Brewers (81) in all of MLB...10 of their 15 games in September have had a margin of two runs or fewer...their 26-19 (.578) mark in one-run games ranks second in the AL behind the Guardians (24-16/.600), while the 26 victories are tied for third most in MLB behind the and Tigers (28) and Cardinals (27).

UN(RISP)ONSIVE—The Rays .212 batting average with RISP is the worst in the majors and would signal the worst full-season mark in club history, a record currently held by the 2011 team (.224)...the .212 average would be the fifth-lowest mark by any team since play-by-play data is available (1969), trailing the 1969 Padres (.200), 1981 Mets (.210), 1972 Padres (.213) and 1972 Mets (.213), per Baseball-Reference.

However, the Rays pitching staff has held opponents to a .188 (18-for-96) clip with RISP this month, fourth in the majors behind the Padres (.145), Blue Jays (.168) and Guardians (.179).

SHIPPING DOWN TO ST. PETE—Tampa Bay and Boston continue a 13-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field, with the Red Sox holding a 4-3 advantage...tonight's game marks the first of six in a span of 13 days from Sept. 17-29...in their first meeting of the season from May 13-16, Tampa Bay took three of four at Fenway Park before suffering a three-game sweep in St. Pete the following week...the two clubs close out the 2024 season with a three-game series in Boston from Sept. 27-29.

Tampa Bay is 56-31 (.644) against Boston since 2019, marking the highest winning pct. by any club against the Red Sox during that stretch (min. 10G), ahead of Houston (20-12/.625) and New York-AL (56-37/.602).

DOWN ON THE FARM—On Sunday, Class-A Bowling Green defeated Hudson Valley (NYY), 5-1, in Game 1 of the South Atlantic League Championship Series...the Hot Rods out-hit the Renegades, 16-1, with key performances coming from two players acquired at the trade deadline, 3B Mac Horvath (3-for-5, 2B, 3B, HR, 2RBI, 2R) and RHP Brody Hopkins (W, 5.0IP, 1H, 1ER, 2BB, 7SO)...RHP Chandler Murphy takes the ball tonight for Bowling Green in Game 2, looking to clinch the South Atlantic League title...Game 3 (if necessary) would take place tomorrow night.

Double-A Montgomery opens a best-of-three set tonight vs. Biloxi (MIL) in the Southern Division Series...RHP Sean Hunley will start for the Biscuits...following an off-day tomorrow, the series shifts to Riverwalk Stadium in Montgomery, where Game 2 and Game 3 (if necessary) will take place on Thursday and Friday.

TONIGHT'S START—The right-hander will take the ball for his 12th start of the campaign and fifth at Tropicana Field...has recorded a 1.88 ERA (24.0IP, 5ER) in his last four starts...min. 50.0 IP, his 2.88 ERA (50.0IP, 16ER) since the All-Star break ranks 11th in the AL...missed the 2023 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28, 2022...has a 3.58 ERA (100.2IP, 40ER) in 20 career MLB starts...is two strikeouts shy of 100 for his career.

LAST TIME OUT—Did not factor into the decision of the Rays 3-2 loss at Philadelphia on Sept. 11 (5.1IP, 3H, 2ER, BB, 4SO, HR)...surrendered both runs in the opening frame when a Trea Turner single preceded Nick Castellanos' replay-assisted two-run homer, which narrowly cleared the left-field wall...retired 12 consecutive Phillies before departing in the 6th frame...snapped a streak of five straight multi-walk outing, issuing one or zero for the first time since Aug. 2 at HOU (1)...has pitched to a 1.42 ERA (19.0IP, 3ER) across his last three road starts.

SHANE AND THE SOX—Baz will be making his first career regular-season start opposite the Red Sox...he started against them in Game 2 of the 2021 ALDS at Tropicana Field, taking a no-decision in a 14-6 defeat (2.1IP, 6H, 3ER, BB, 2SO, HR)...Baz is 2-1 with a 2.13 ERA (38.0IP, 9ER) in eight career starts vs. AL East opponents...this includes a 2.63 ERA (13.2IP, 4ER) across three starts this season

TROP TALK-Baz is 3-1 with a 2.91 ERA (43.1IP, 14ER), 0.97 WHIP and .185 (29-for-157) opp. average in eight career home starts, permitting three runs or fewer in each of them...excluding openers, it marks the fifth-lowest ERA through a pitcher's first eight career home starts in club history, trailing Drew Rasmussen (2.09, 2021-22), Jeremy Hellickson (2.63, 2010-11), Chris Archer (2.70, 2012-13) and David Price (2.82, 2009).

THE WIZARD OF BAZ—Baz has completed 5.0+ IP while yielding three hits or fewer in four consecutive starts, tied with Shane McClanahan (July 2 [G1]-26, 2022) and Blake Snell (Sept. 12-29, 2018) for the longest streak in franchise history...it ties the fourth-longest streak in the majors this season, trailing five-start runs by TOR Bowden Francis (Aug. 7-29), CIN Hunter Greene (July 6-Aug. 3) and CWS Drew Thorpe (June 22-July 21)...Baz has limited opponents to a .128/.225/.244 (10-for-78) clip since the streak began on Aug. 20 at OAK...opposing hitters are 3-for-34 (.088) against his four-seam fastball during the streak.

On the season, he has yielded three runs or fewer in 10 of his 11 starts, including seven with two runs or fewer.

NO RISP. NO REWARD—Opponents are just 1-for-7 (.143) against Baz with runners in scoring position over his last five starts, with the lone hit coming on Aug. 13 vs. HOU (Yainer Diaz RBI-single)...seven of the eight runs against him in that span have come on home runs by HOU Alex Bregman (solo), HOU Jeremy Peña (solo), SD Jake Cronenworth (2-run), BAL Gunnar Henderson (solo) and PH Nick Castellanos (2-run).

During the five-start run (since Aug. 13), opposing hitters are 4-for-37 (.108) with runners on base and 10-for-68 (.191) with the bases empty...they have hit .316 (6-for-19) vs. his slider compared to a combined 11-for-86 (.128) in at-bats ending with his four-seamer (7-for-47), curveball (4-for-29) and changeup (0-for-10).

LEFT BEHIND—In his last five starts, Baz has limited left-handed hitters to a 3-for-49 (.061) clip, but two of the hits were home runs...min. 40 AB, it marks the lowest opp. average vs. LHH in the majors over that span, ahead of OAK **Osvaldo Bido** (0.65)...he has an active 0-for-12 skid against left-handers dating to the 6th inning on Sept. 6 at BAL...southpaws are 1-for-23 (.043) against his fastball in that span and are hitless off his curveball (0-for-12) and change up (0-for-8). for-12) and changeup (0-for-8).

KEEPING COUNT—Baz is holding opponents to a .196 (13-for-83) clip when ahead in the count compared to .340 (19-for-55) when behind...opponents are 14-for-114 (.123) against him in two-strike counts, fifth lowest among AL starters (min. 10GS) behind TOR Bowden Francis (.081), TEX Cody Bradford (.111), DET Tarik Skubal (.116) and NYY Luis Gil (.116).

He has limited opponents to a combined .063 (3-for-48) average against his curveball (3-for-37) and changeup (0-for-11) in two-strike counts.

LIKE FINE WINE—He has posted a .236 (21-for-89) opp. average the first time through the lineup and .224 (19-for-85) the second time...however, the third time through and beyond, opponents are 8-for-47 (.170) against him...of the 23 runs against him, 16 (69.6%) have come in the first three innings...he has a 4.36 ERA (33.0IP, 16ER) in innings 1-3 compared to a 1.98 ERA (27.1IP, 6ER) from the 4th frame on.
