## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-17) vs. OAKLAND ATHLETICS (14-17) May 1, 2024 at Oakland Coliseum, Oakland, CA - 12:37 PDT - GAME #32/ROAD #20 RHP QUINN PRIESTER (0-1, 3.48 ERA) vs. RHP ROSS STRIPLING (0-5, 4.98 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...lost 5-2 in the middle game of their three-game series at Oakland last night...Are 1-4 heading into the finale of their six-game road trip to San Francisco and Oakland...Are wrapping up a stretch that has the team playing 13 straight days before tomorrow's scheduled off day...Have played the most road games (19) in all of MLB heading into today...Have lost three straight and six of their last seven games...Have been charged with one error in their last six games and three in their last nine contests...Have had six of their last nine games decided by one or two runs (are 5-3 in one-run games and 2-5 in two-run contests this season)...Have gone 4-0 in extra innings this season, which is tied for the most wins in extra frames in MLB...It is Pittsburgh's longest win streak in extra-innings games to begin a season since 2012 (also 4-0)...The last start to a season with a longer streak was 1960 (7-0).

**ON Q:** Quinn Priester will make his third start of the season today after being promoted from Triple-A Indianapolis on April 19...The 23-year-old Priester went 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (13.2ip/6er), 20 strikeouts and .226 batting average against in three starts this season with Indianapolis...He entered this season rated by Baseball America as Pittsburgh's No. 8 prospect...The Pirates drafted Priester out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School with the 18th overall selection in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft...He made his big league debut last year on July 17 against Cleveland and suffered the loss before winning each of his next two starts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Quinn Priester tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with a career-high tying 14 whiffs but had a no-decision in his last start Friday night at San Francisco...The Giants won the game in the 10th inning on a three-run walkoff home run by Patrick Bailey.

**BACK TO THE BURGH:** The Pirates will return to Pittsburgh following today's game to begin a 10-day, nine-game homestand on Friday...Colorado will visit PNC Park for a three-game series this weekend followed by a three-game series against the Angels that gets underway Monday...Following an off day on May 9, the homestand will wrap up with three games against the Cubs from May 10-12.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Paul Skenes struck out seven batters in 6.0 scoreless innings in his sixth start of the season last night with Triple-A Indianapolis...Skenes, who is rated as the No. 1 right-handed pitcher prospect by MLB Pipeline, enters today first in the International League in ERA (0.39) and strikeouts (41) and third in both batting average against (.171) and WHIP (0.87).

**CRUZZING ALONG:** Oneil Cruz has hit safely in each of his last seven starts after singling in his final at-bat in Monday's start...Cruz is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with a pair of doubles and two RBI in his last seven starts.

**GO JOE:** Connor Joe connected for his third home run of the season last night while finishing the game 2-for-4...Since April 15, Joe has recorded a .293 batting average and .853 OPS while reaching base safely in 12 of his 13 games.

**START ME UP:** Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 3.23 ERA (47.1ip/17er) in the team's last nine games...Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranks fifth in the National League in ERA (3.70) and batting average against (.239) and third in innings pitched (170.1).

**CALL TO THE PEN:** Pittsburgh's bullpen has recorded a 2.33 ERA (38.2ip/10er) and 44 strikeouts in the team's last 11 games...Since April 20 the bullpen's 2.33 ERA is the seventh-lowest in all of MLB and second-lowest among National League clubs...The only National League team to record a lower bullpen ERA in that time is Los Angeles (1.75).

**THE RENEGADE:** David Bednar has converted each of his last four save opportunities and comes into today with 66 as a member of the Pirates...Bednar's next save will tie him with Matt Capps for the eighth-most in team history.

**ON THE MEND:** Yasmani Grandal went 1-for-5 with a walkoff single in the 11th inning Tuesday night with Triple-A Indianapolis...He is now 6-for-26 (.231) with a double, home run and six RBI in seven games on rehab...Grandal has been on the 10-day injured list since March 28 with left foot plantar fasciitis.

**MARTÍN PÉREZ:** The 33-year-old lefthander will make his seventh start when the Pirates open a three-game series Friday night at PNC Park against the Rockies...Allowed one unearned run in 6.0 innings but had a no-decision in his last start against the Giants on Saturday at Oracle Park...Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in four of his first six starts...Has allowed one home run in 34.2 innings, which came in his outing on 4/4 at Washington...Signed a one-year contract with the Pirates on 1/5/24...Went 10-4 with a 4.45 ERA (141.2ip/70er) in 35 appearances (20 starts) last year with Texas.

**vs. COLORADO:** 2-2 with a 3.74 ERA (33.2ip/14er) in six career appearances (six starts)...Won a 7-2 decision (7.0ip/2r) in one start last year on 5/19 while pitching for the Rangers...Since allowing five runs in 5.0 innings in his first start on 5/5/14, he has gone 2-1 with a 2.83 ERA (28.2ip/9er) in his last five outings.
