## 2-1

Atlanta scored a pair of first-inning runs and
held on to beat Detroit, 2-1, last night The held on to beat Detroit, 2-1, last night. The Braves beat the Tigers by the exact same score on Monday.
Atlanta won just one game all of last season by a 2-1 score, beating Tampa Bay on July 7 . The Braves had not won consecutive games by a $2-1$ final score since 2015 , when they swept the Phillies in a three-game set, September $18-20$, by a $2-1$ margin in all three games.
That three-game series against the Phillies in 2015 was also the last time the Braves won back-to-back games while scoring no more than two runs, regardless of margin.
Atlanta is one of just five teams in baseball this season to win consecutive games while scoring two runs or fewer. No team has
won three straight such games.

## Braves Breakdown



TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Tigers today conclude a three-game series in what is the only scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...The two teams met last year in Detroit, and are playing in back-to-back seasons for the first time.

A The Braves have won each of the first two games of the series, 2-1, and will play for the sweep this afternoon.

A Atlanta has won the series, two-games-to-one, in each of the last three seasons these two clubs have met...The Braves won the series by that margin last year, in 2019 and in 2016, and have not lost a series to the Tigers since getting swept in 2013.

A The Braves and Tigers have met 29 times since the advent of interleague play in 1997, with Atlanta going just 14-15 (.483) against Detroit all-time... Despite the losing record, Atlanta has won five of the nine total series between the clubs, although Detroit has the only two sweeps between the teams.

A The Braves have hosted just one series all-time against the Tigers here at Truist Park, taking two-of-three in 2019...In 20 total games in the city of Atlanta, the Braves hold a slight edge, 11-9.
A LH Tarik Skubal is set to make his 15 th start of the season and the first of his career versus Atlanta... The 6-foot-3, 240-pound native of Hawyard, CA, is 8-2 with a 2.20 ERA (21 ER/86.0 IP) through his 14 turns this year, and ranks fourth in the American League in both ERA and wins (tied)... Each of his two losses have come in his seven starts on the road, and he is 3-2 with a 2.40 ERA (11 ER/41.1 ERA) away from Comerica Park.
WIN: RH Spencer Schwellenbach earned the first victory of his major league career last night, holding the Tigers to three hits and one run over 6.0 innings in Atlanta's win, 2-1.

A Atlanta will play for the sweep this afternoon...The Braves have not swept a three-game series since beating the Marlins, April 22-24.

A The win was Atlanta's 40th of the season, and the Braves became the ninth team across the majors to reach the 40 -win threshold...Atlanta is the fourth National League club to do so, following Philadelphia, Los Angeles and Milwaukee...Last year's club won its 40th game in game No. 64.

A The Braves improved to 19-10 (.655) against American League opponents this season...Los Angeles-NL (9-6, .600), Seattle (12-9, .571) and New York-AL (12-6, .667) are the only clubs with a higher winning percentage in interleague games...Each of the Braves' next four games are against the American League.
A Paired with Monday's 2-1 victory, Atlanta has won consecutive one-run games...Prior to this series, the club had endured seven consecutive one-run defeats...Overall, the Braves are 8-10 (.444) in one-run games this season.

REYNALDO LOPEZ: Atlanta's right-hander has faced Detroit more than any other opponent in his major league career, making 29 total appearances and 13 starts against the Tigers...The 5-foot-11, 200-pound native of the Dominican Republic is $6-7$ with a 3.35 ERA (35 ER/94.0 IP) all-time against Detroit.
A In his 13 starts versus the Tigers, he is an even 4-4 with a 3.42 ERA ( 30 ER/79.0 IP)...He last started against them in 2020 while with the White Sox, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings to earn the win.

A López has posted a 1.69 ERA (13 ER/69.1 IP), lowest in the major leagues (min. 60 IP) and best by a Brave through 12 starts since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine pitched to a 1.59 ERA and an 8-2 record in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.34) are only other starters in the Atlanta era (since 1966) with lower ERAs through 12 starts.

A He pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in his last turn, June 13 at Baltimore, and has allowed more than two earned runs in just one of his 12 starts on the year...He yielded three earned over 5.0 innings on April 30 at Seattle.
A Opponents are batting just . 082 against him with runners in scoring position, the lowest mark in baseball among pitchers to face at least 50 such batters...Hitters are just 4 -for- 49 with a double, seven RBI and 16 strikeouts against him with runners in scoring position.

MARCELL OZUNA: Plated Atlanta's second run of the game last night with a run-scoring single in the first inning...His 63 RBI on the season are most in the National League and trail just Aaron Judge (64) in the majors.

A Since the franchise moved to Atlanta in 1966, just two players have driven in more runs through 71 team games than Ozuna's 63 this year...Andrés Galarraga had 67 RBI through 71 games in 1998, and Hall-of-Famer Hank Aaron had 64 in 1970.

A He is on pace for 46 home runs and 144 RBI, both of which would easily establish new career highs.
A His RBI in the first inning last night was his 17th in the opening frame this season, behind only Judge and Philadelphia's Alec Bohm, who have each driven in 18.
KELENIC AT LEADOFF: Jarred Kelenic singled to lead off the first for Atlanta last night and came around to score on Ozzie Albies' triple one batter later... In four games since moving to the top spot in the batting order, he is hitting .333 (6-for-18), with two home runs, three RBI and three runs.

## A Atlanta is 3-1 in these games.

A He replaced Ronald Acuña Jr in the leadoff spot on May 26 and collected three hits off the bench, and is batting .409/.409/.727 in five total games from the top spot in the order.

A Scheduled to make his 13th start of the season and 14th of his career against Detroit.
A Owns a 3.35 ERA in 13 starts and 16 relief appearances against the Tigers.
A Held Baltimore to two hits while fanning eight hitters, tied for a season high, over 6.0 scoreless frames in his last start.

A Recoreded three consecutive quality start dating to May 31 against Oakland.
A López has posted a 1.69 ERA (13 ER/69.1 IP), lowest in the major leagues and best by a Brave through 12 starts since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine pitched to a 1.59 ERA and an $8-2$ record in 2002. Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.34) are only other starters in the Atlanta era (since 1966) with lower ERAs through 12 starts.
A In his last turn he made his seventh start with at least six days rest between outings... No other pitcher has made more starts with at least six days rest between games.
López has garnered the fourth-highest slider Whiff Rate (46.8\%) in the majors (min. 200 sliders thrown) ...Teammate Dylan Lee leads the league (50.4\%)
A His 1.73 ERA through his first 10 games with the Braves is the second lowest in Atlanta franchise history among starters' first 10 outings that have joined from another club.
A Shelby Miller owns the lowest ERA, sporting a 1.48 ERA in his fist 10 starts with the team in 2015.
A Allowed six earned runs through his first seven starts of the season.
A Joined Hall-of-Famers Tom Glavine ('02) and Greg Maddux ('94) along with Michael Soroka ('19) and Max Fried ('20) in Atlanta franchise history to hold opponents to six earned runs or less in the first seven starts of the season.
A Enters play with a 1.69 ERA; the lowest in the majors among pitchers with at least as many starts as López.

A Has held opponents to one earned run or less in eight of his 12 starts this season.
A Pitching to a . 082 opp. BA (4-for-49) with RISP this year; the lowest rate in the majors among starters with at least 10 outings.
A Owns a $25.0 \%$ LOB rate with RISP; the highest in MLB (min. 10 starts).
A Stranded $85.8 \%$ of all baserunnes this season; the highest rate in the NL.
A Throwing his fastball for an average of 95.2 MPH
A Has thrown three pitches over 98 MPH this season.
A Throwing his four-seam fastball on $56.4 \%$ of pitches; seventh higest rate in the majors (min. eight starts).

A Struck out a season most eight hitters on May 31 against Oakland.
A Opened the season with four consecutive quality starts.
A Became the first Braves pitcher to pitch at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts since LHP Sean Newcomb, spanning May 2-19, 2018

A Is the second hurler in franchise history to match the criteria in their first four starts with the club, joining RHP Aaron Harang, who did so in five straight starts to begin his Braves tenure in April 2014
A Joined Ben Sheets (2012) as the only pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to only allow one earned run over 18.0 innings pitched in their first three starts after joining the club.
A Since 2000, there have been seven pitchers, league-wide, to log at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts to begin their tenure with a club: Cliff Lee (Philadelphia, July-August, 2009), Harang (Atlanta, April 2015), Cody Anderson (Cleveland, June-July 2015), Kenta Maeda (Los AngelesNL, April 2016), Mat Latos (Chicago-AL, April 2016), Justin Verlander (Houston, September 2017) and López (Atlanta, April 2024).
A Made his first start since June 10, 2022 against Texas on April 2 earlier this season.
A Appeared in 68 games last season out of the bullpen...Made one start in 2022 and 60 relief appearances...Was used as a reliever in 11 outings while making nine starts with the White Sox in 2021.
A The last season he was used exclusively as a starter was 2020; he made eight starts and pitching to a 6.49 ERA with a 1-3 record.
A Signed by the Atlanta Braves to a three-year contract with a club option for 2027 on November 20, 2023.

A Has played for four teams over an eight-year career...Started his career in the rotation, before transitioning to the bullpen in 2021.

A Made his major league debut on July 19, 2016 with Washington...Suffered a 8-4 loss to Los Angeles after starting the game and going 4.2 innings.

A Acquired by the White Sox on December 7, 2016 in a four-player trade that sent Adam Eaton to Washington...López, RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Lucas Giolito went to Chicago.

A This season marks the first time he will not be in the same organization as RHP
