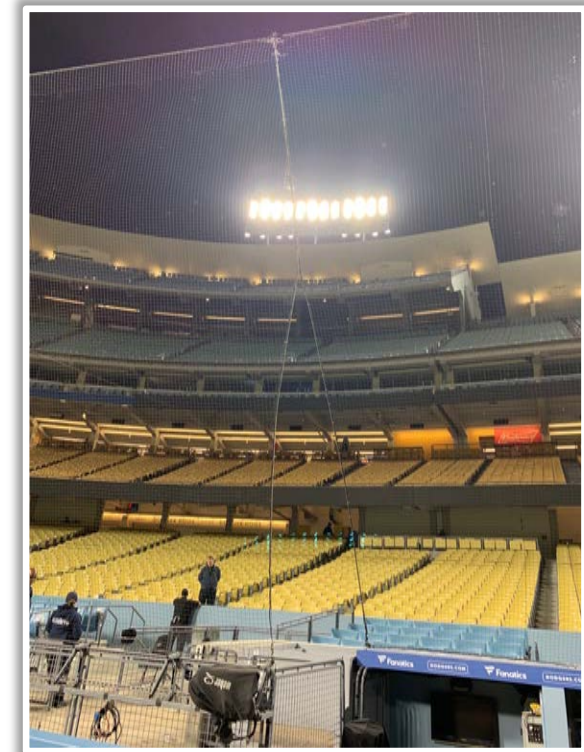
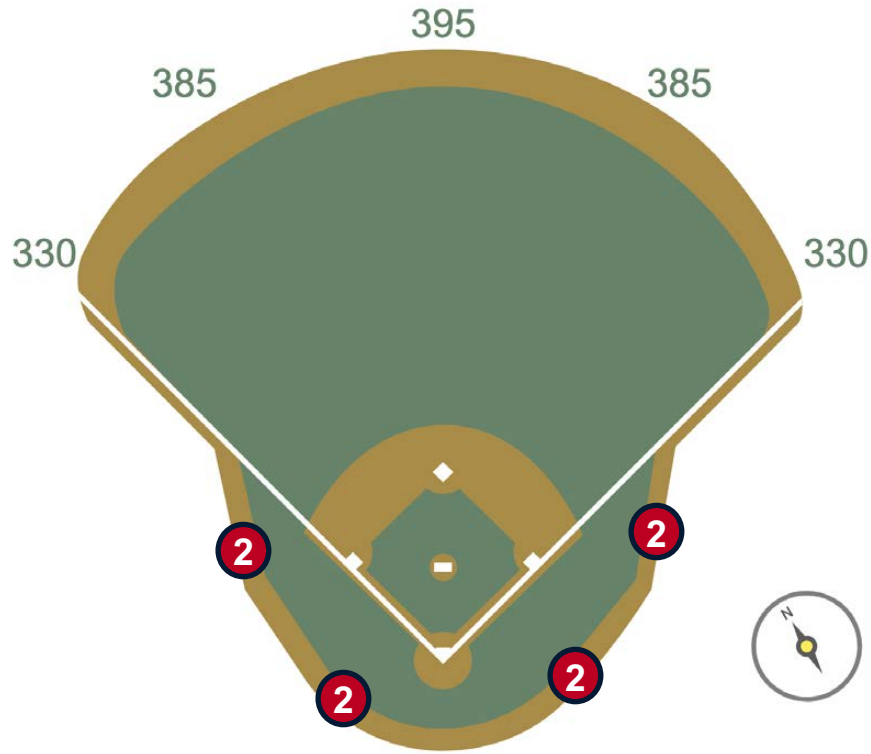
Dodger Stadium Ground Rules

RULE #1: Batted ball striking camera on top of backstop: **Dead Ball**



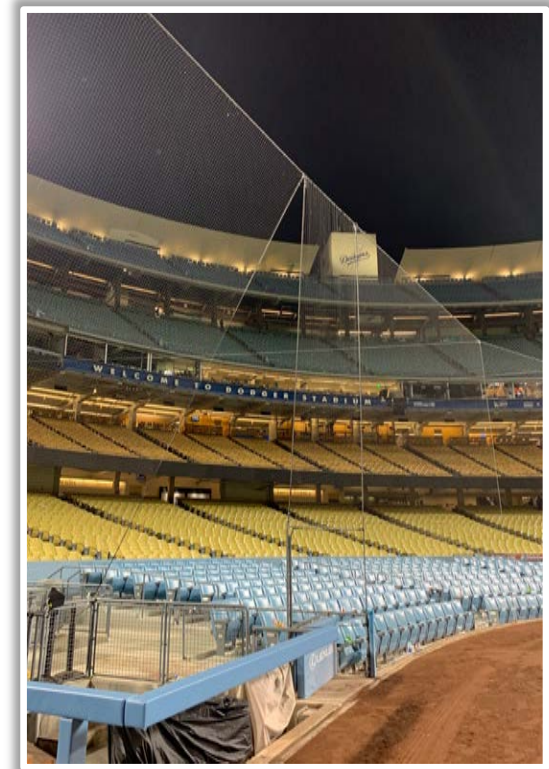
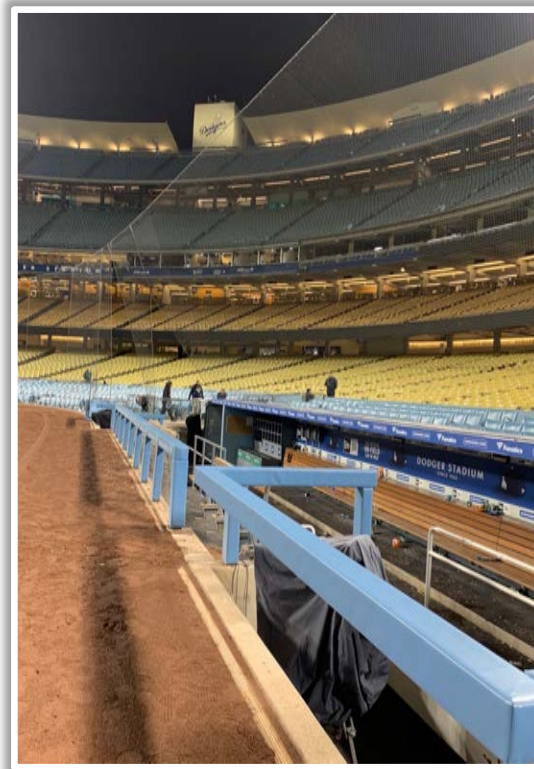
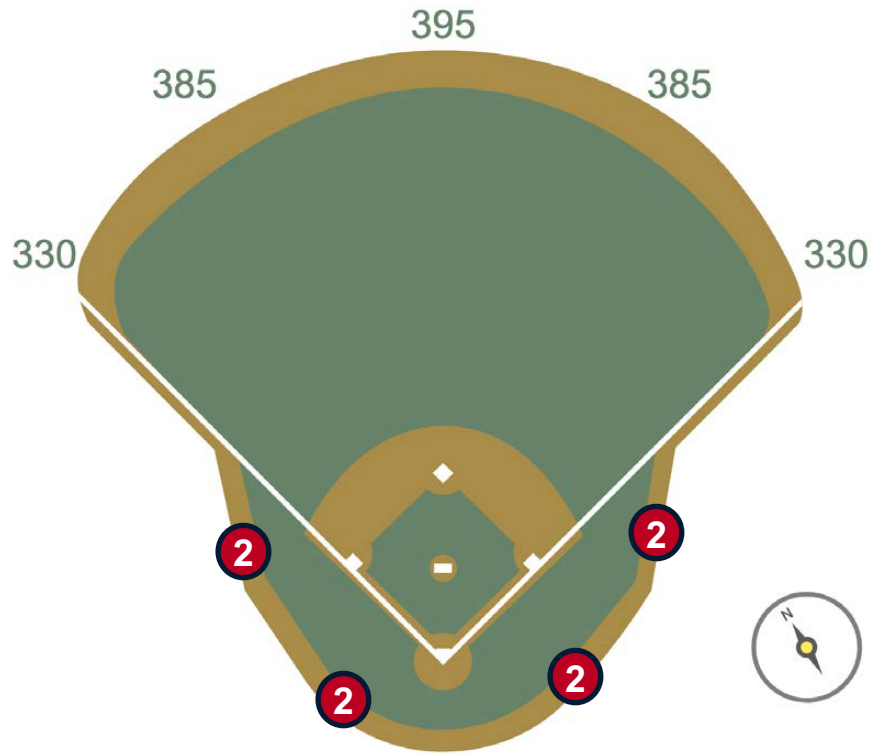
Dodger Stadium Ground Rules

RULE #2: A live ball (batted, thrown, or otherwise) striking any screen or protective netting set on a field facing wall or railing (e.g., a backstop or protective netting along the first or third base lines) and rebounding onto the playing field is **Live and In Play**.



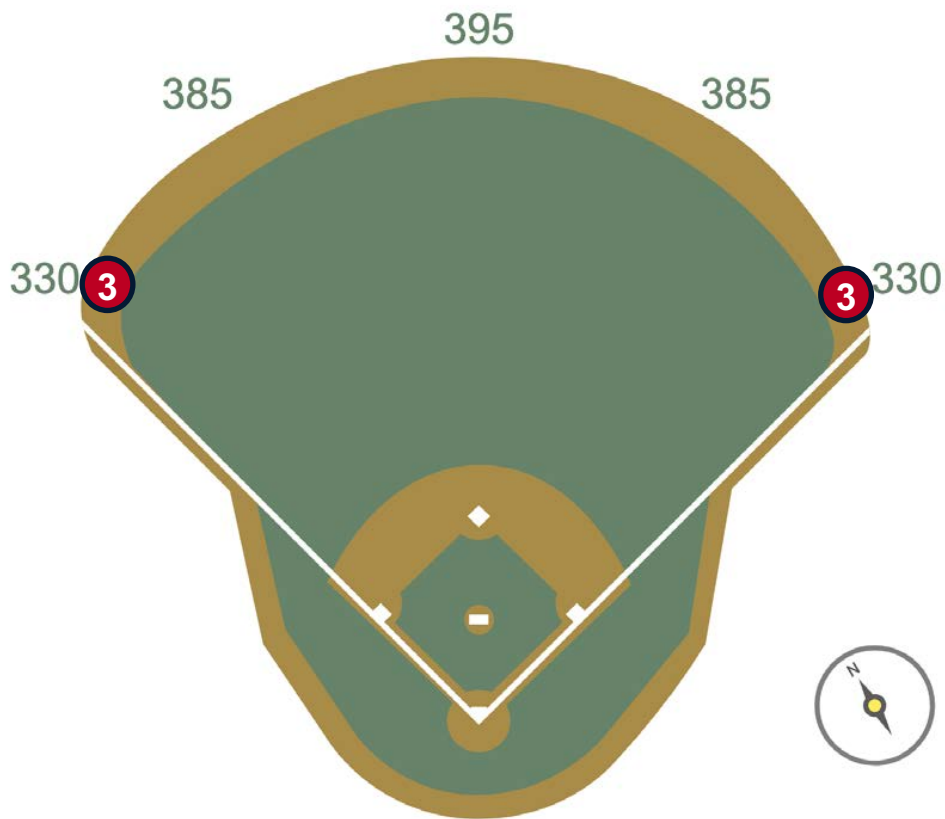
Dodger Stadium Ground Rules

RULE #2 (cont.): Any additional screening set behind an out of play area (e.g., dugout, photo or camera well, etc.) shall be considered **Out of Play**. Thus, any ball striking such screening is dead regardless of whether it ricochets back onto the field of play.



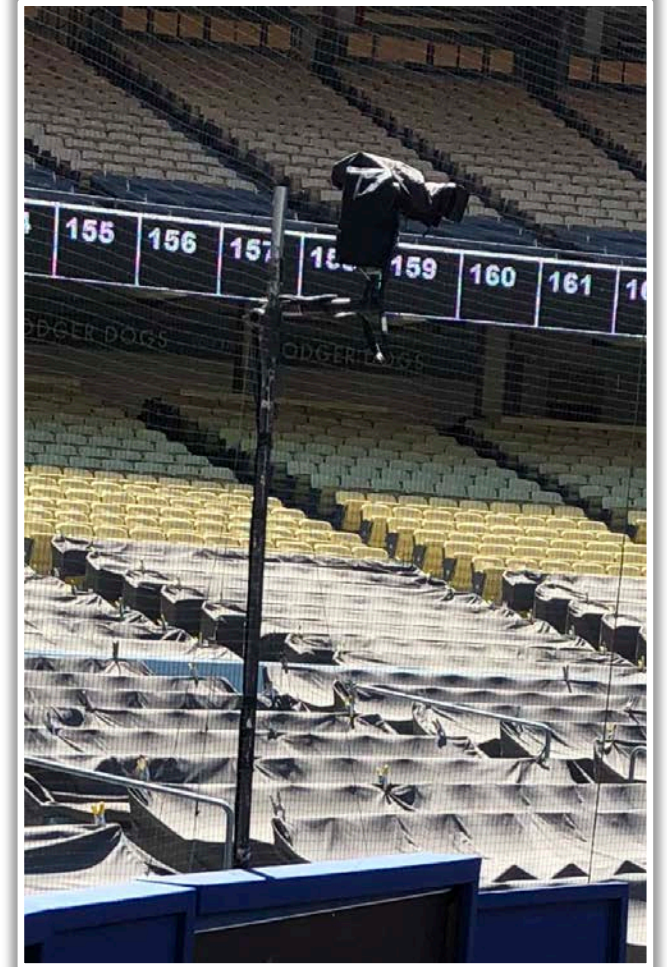
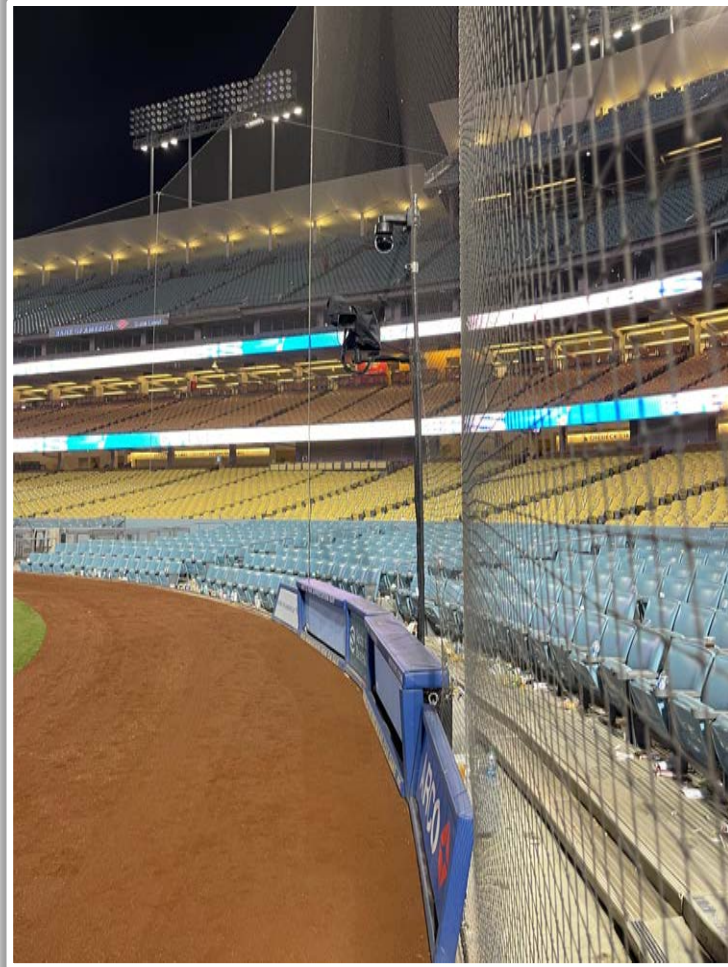
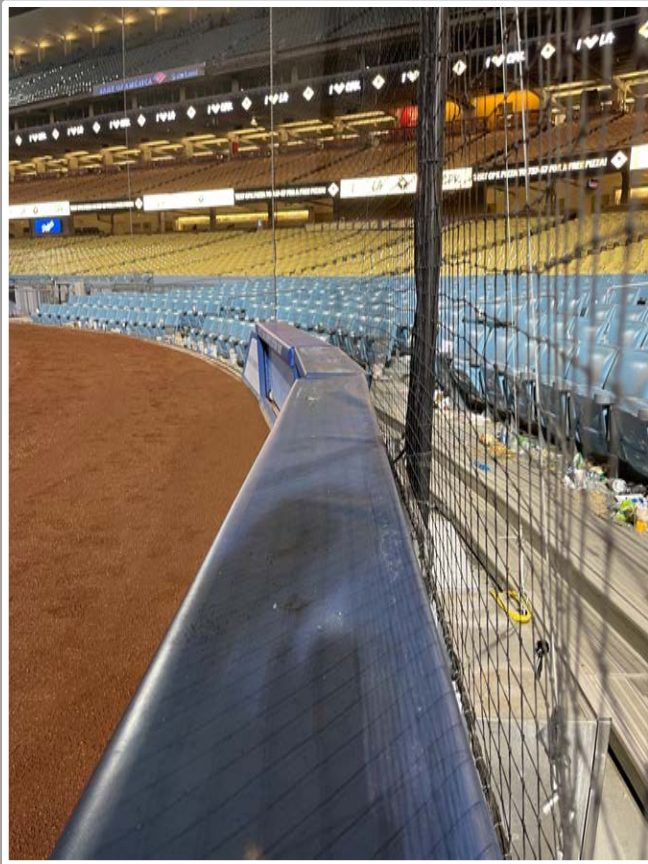
Dodger Stadium Ground Rules

RULE #3: Batted ball hitting bullpen gate in either left or right field at a point above the lower wall and continuing over the lower wall in fair territory: **Home Run**



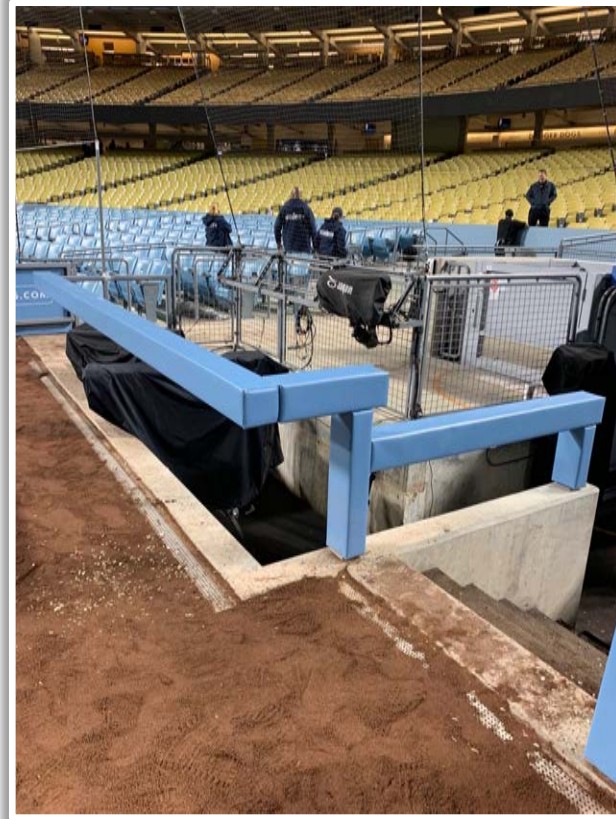
