


**2023 Ground Rules** 

**Date: March 30, 2023** 

RULE #1: Batted ball striking camera on top of backstop: Dead Ball












**RULE #2:** A live ball (batted, thrown, or otherwise) striking any screen or protective netting set on a field facing wall or railing (e.g., a backstop or protective netting along the first or third base lines) and rebounding onto the playing field is **Live and In Play**.












RULE #2 (cont.): Any additional screening set behind an out of play area (e.g., dugout, photo or camera well, etc.) shall be considered Out of Play. Thus, any ball striking such screening is dead regardless of whether it ricochets back onto the field of play.










RULE #3: Batted ball hitting bullpen gate in either left or right field at a point above the lower wall and continuing over the lower wall in fair territory: Home Run








