Olson vs. New York

Matt Olson went 2-for-4 with a homer and an RBI last night, and is 3-for-8 (.375) with a pair of RBI over the first two games of this series.

Since joining Atlanta in 2022, Olson has batted .270/.353/.562 with 15 homers and 37 RBI in 47 total games versus New York. No other player in baseball even has double-digit homers against the Mets in that span, and his 37 RBI are eight more than anyone else.

Olson's .915 OPS versus New York since 2022 is also best in baseball among the 35 players to tally at least 100 plate appearances against the club in that span.

Atlanta's first baseman has hit in a season high-tying nine straight games dating to June 8, and is batting .353/.425/.618 in that span.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets tonight conclude a three-game mid-week series with what is the third of 13 scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...The two are set to meet seven times over a 10-day span, with a four-game set scheduled for Monday-Thursday of next week at Citi Field.

 The Braves blanked the Mets, 5-0, last night and have won each of the first two games of this series...Atlanta will play for the sweep tonight.

 Atlanta won four of the final five games between the clubs last season and went 7-6 in 13 total games versus New York for the year...The Braves beat the Mets, 3-0, in the second game of a doubleheader on the final day of the season to clinch a spot in the postseason.

 The Braves have won 25 of the last 35 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 210-135 (+75) over the stretch.

 The Braves have taken the season series from their NL East rivals for seven consecutive seasons dating to 2018, and are 70-44 (.614) against the club overall in that stretch...New York has lost 15 more games to Atlanta than any other team in baseball in that span.

 Atlanta went an even 3-3 against New York here at Truist Park last season, but won two-of-three in the final series of the season...Since Truist Park opened in 2017, the Braves are 40-26 (.606) against the Mets here in their home park.

 RH Clay Holmes is set to make the first start and 11th appearance of his career against Atlanta, and owns a 1-0 record with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) all-time against the Braves, including 8.0 consecutive scoreless innings...The 6-foot-5, 245-pound Alabama native is in his first full season pitching from the rotation after making 307 appearances out of the bullpen from 2018-2024...The right-hander has allowed more than three runs in a start just twice this season, and owns a 2-0 record with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) through three starts this month.

WIN: Chris Sale fell one out shy of a shutout last night, tossing 8.2 scoreless innings as Atlanta blanked New York, 5-0...It was the longest start for the left-hander since June of 2019, and his 116 pitches were his most since July of that same season.

 Atlanta has won each of the first two games of this series, clinching its third consecutive series win...The Braves had not won three straight series since a four-set run over the Twins, Cardinals, D-backs and Rockies in late April.

 The Braves will try to clinch just their second series sweep of the season tonight, joining three straight wins over the Twins, April 18-20.

 Ronald Acuña Jr. and Matt Olson each hit solo homers for Atlanta last night, and the Braves are now 15-7 (.681) when hitting multiple home runs in a game.

SPENCER STRIDER: Is set tonight to make the seventh start and ninth total appearance of his career against New York, and is 4-1 despite a 5.58 ERA (19 ER/30.2 IP) over his first eight appearances...The Braves are 5-1 versus the Mets in his six career starts against them.

 Strider earned his first win of the season in his last start, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings and fanning 13 Rockies in the Braves' win, 4-1, last Saturday...The right-hander allowed just three hits and one walk in the victory.

 He induced 24 swings-and-misses in that start versus Colorado, after collecting just 57 whiffs over his first five starts of the season...From 2022-23, his last two full seasons in the majors, Strider's 1,032 swings-and-misses were 65 more than any other pitcher in baseball.

 Strider's fastball averaged 96.2 mph last Saturday and topped out at 98.1...The pitch averaged just 95.1 mph over his first five starts, and maxed out at 97.9 mph.

RONALD ACUÑA JR: Drove the very first pitch of last night's first inning out to dead center for his eighth home run of the season...The drive was the 36th leadoff homer of his career, extending his own franchise record.

 Of his 36 career leadoff homers, last night's shot was the 15th to come on the first pitch...That total trails just Hall-of-Famer Craig Biggio (19) for the most in baseball history.

 Since making his season debut on May 23, Acuña Jr. leads the National League in batting average (.390), on-base percentage (.495), slugging percentage (.720), OPS (1.215) and homers (tied, 8), and ranks second in hits (tied, 32), runs (tied, 21) and total bases (59)...His 1.9 fWAR since his debut is most in the majors.

 Extrapolated over a full, 162-game season, Acuña Jr.'s numbers over his first 23 games this season would equate to 225 hits, 147 runs, 56 homers, 98 RBI and 13.4 fWAR.

RUNNER ON THIRD PRODUCTION: Marcell Ozuna lifted a sacrifice fly into center field in last night's first inning, plating Austin Riley and extending Atlanta's lead to 3-0...Over the first five games of this homestand, during which the Braves are 4-1 and have averaged 5.4 runs per game, the club has a major league-most five sac flies.

 Atlanta had 12 total sac flies over its first 67 games.

 The Braves have tallied 16 total plate appearances with a runner on third and less than two outs this homestand, and have hit .300 (3-for-10) with a walk, five sacrifices and 11 runs scored in such situations.

 From the start of the season through June 12, a day before this homestand started, Atlanta's .267 average with a runner on third and less than two outs, and its 12 sac flies, were both lowest in the majors.

Made his season debut agaist Toronto on April 16, allowing two runs and five hits over 5.0 innings pitched.

It was his first start since undergoing season-ending surgery on his right elbow last year.

Prior to his season debut, Strider made his last start on April 5, 2024 against Arizona, allowing seven hits, five runs, three walks and a home run with four strikeouts.

He was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 7, 2024 with a right elbow sprain.

Dr. Keith Meister performed the surgery on April 12.
- 🔪

Strider went 376 days between starts.
- 🔪

Struck out Addison Barger to reach 500 k's on his career.
- 🔪

Became just the ninth pitcher in the modern era to reach 500 strikeouts in 68 appearances or less; and first to do so since Shane Bieber in 2021.
- 🔪

The other pitchers were José Fernández, Yu Darvish, Mark Prior, Kerry Wood, Hideo Nomo, Dwight Gooden, and Herb Score.
- 🔪

Of those pitchers, Strider is the only one to have more than three relief appearances in that span of games with 13.
- 🔪

Was placed on the 15-day IL on April 21 (backdated to April 18) with a strained right hamstring...Activated on May 19.

NL Ranks: Wins (1st, 20), Strikeouts (1st, 281), SO/9.0 IP (1st, 13.55), FIP (1st, 2.71), WHIP (4th, 1.09).

Pitched his second full major league season and went 20-5 with a 3.86 ERA (80 ER/186.2 IP)...Led the majors in wins and strikeouts.

Set a new Atlanta franchise record for most strikeouts in a single season with 281.

The previous mark of 276, was set by Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz, during his Cy Young Award-winning season in 1996... Smoltz ('96) is the only other Atlanta-era (since 1966) to lead the majors in strikeouts.

His 186.2 innings pitched were the fewest by any pitcher to lead the majors in strikeouts, over a full season, in MLB history...Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson paced the majors with 204 punch-outs in 172.0 innings in the strike-shortened season in 1994, while Cleveland's Shane Bieber did the same, fanning 122 over 77.1 frames in the truncated 2020 campaign (COVID-19).

Strider had 11 double-digit strikeout efforts this season; only Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz (12) has more in a single season in franchise history.
- 🔪

Finished the season averaging 13.55 strikeouts per nine innings pitched; the highest rate in the major among qualified starters.
- 🔪

At 24 years old, Strider became the youngest pitcher to record a K/9 rate higher than 13.00 in a single season.
- 🔪

It was the second highest K/9 rate in a single season in major league history among qualifiers with at least 100 innings pitched in a season, trailing only Gerrit Cole in 2019 (13.81).
- 🔪

Strider's 433 strikeouts as a starter are the most in baseball history through a player's first 50 starts...Dwight Gooden ranks second with 418.
- 🔪

His 17 games with at least 10 strikeouts are the second most in MLB history (1901) through a player's first 50 starts; trails only Dwight Gooden (20).

Strider truck out Shohei Ohtani (LAA) for his 200th strikeout of the season.

🔪

Broke his own record – becoming the fastest pitcher, by innings pitched (123.1), to reach the 200-strikeout plateau within a single season since the mound moved to its current distance in 1893.

Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 31 yrs • #49

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 22/11
- Has pitched to a 1.59 ERA (3 ER/17.0 IP) in his last 15 appearances, dating to May 3...It's his best 15-game stretch since joining the Braves organization.
 - In his June 1 outing versus Boston, set a new career high with five strikeouts.
 - Per Baseball Savant, his xERA is 2.41, which is the 10th-best in the National League (94th percentile)...Also ranks highly in barrel percentage (99th percentile, 1.3%).
 - His home ERA is 0.57 (1 ER/15.2 IP) but his road ERA is 6.00 (8 ER/12.0 IP)...Among pitchers with at least 15.2 innings pitched in their home venue, his ERA is sixth-best in MLB.
 - Among pitchers that have faced at least 300 batters since the start of 2024, Bummer's three barrels allowed are the fewest in Major League Baseball...Every other qualifying pitcher has allowed at least six in that span.
 - Has induced a ground ball rate of 58.7%, which ranks in the 95th percentile league-wide...The league-average ground ball rate is 43%...That ground ball rate ranks fifth in the National League (min. 25 IP).

Enyel De Los Santos • RHP • 6-3 • 235 • 29 yrs • #61

- Saves/Opp:** 0/1 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 29/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 17/5
- Has thrown his slider 200 times, and has surrendered just eight hits on it...Among pitchers that have thrown at least that many, those eight hits are tied for the sixth fewest in Major League Baseball.
 - In at-bats that end with a changeup, opposing hitters are batting .063 (1-for-16).
 - In at-bats that last three pitches-or-fewer, opponents are batting .239...Fourth pitch-and-on, they're batting .177.
 - On April 8, struck out the side (9th inning) for the 13th time in his MLB career and for the first time this season...He last did it as a member of the San Diego Padres on July 28, 2024, at Baltimore.
 - Last year, allowed 26% of his earned runs (10) in just five games with the Yankees.
 - Tossed an "immaculate inning" on September 27, 2022 vs. the Rays in the seventh inning...Signified the 110th immaculate inning in MLB history, and the fourth in Cleveland's franchise history.

Dylan Dodd • LHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #46

- Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 4/3 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2
- In 23 appearances since his first outing of the season (AAA/MLB), Dodd has pitched to a 2.53 ERA (6 ER/21.1 IP) with 28 strikeouts and two walks...Owns a 0.94 WHIP in that time...In his last 12 games with Gwinnett, owns a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP).
 - Allowed five earned runs in his first appearance of 2025...Has also allowed just six in 23 appearances since.
 - Has transitioned to the bullpen for the first time in his professional career...Across 19 appearances with Triple-A Gwinnett, the southpaw has gone 2-1 with a 5.40 ERA (11 ER/18.1 IP).
 - At the Triple-A level, has struck out 25 batters and walked just three...Owns a K/9 of 12.27.

Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 35 yrs • #26

- Saves/Opp:** 8/12 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 29/20 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 5/4
- Has allowed 11 barrels this season, tied for fourth most in MLB among relievers...He allowed seven throughout all of 2024.
 - Has surrendered seven home runs this season, already surpassing his total from all of 2024 (4)...Pitched just 20.1 innings to allow those seven, contrasting the 69.1 innings he covered last season.
 - Has 232 career saves, fifth most among active pitchers.
 - Among pitchers with as many appearances since his Braves debut on August 5, 2022 (181 apps.), Iglesias' 2.57 ERA (51 ER/178.2 IP) is the sixth best in Major League Baseball.
 - Last season, was named August's Reliever of the Month for the third time in his career...Within the month, went 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/13.1 IP) and six saves in 11 total appearances...Allowed just two hits without issuing a walk.

Pierce Johnson • RHP • 6-2 • 202 • 34 yrs • #38

- Saves/Opp:** 1/3 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 28/23 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/6
- From April 19 until May 10, retired 26 consecutive batters over nine appearances – the longest such streak of his eight-year MLB career...Since 2000, his 26-batter streak was tied for the second-longest streak by a Brave of not allowing a batter to reach via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch, trailing Raisel Iglesias (38, July 27-August 23, 2024) and tied with Chris Sale (26, April 26-May 1, 2024).
 - From April 19-May 15, posted 11 consecutive scoreless outings...Across 11.0 innings in that time, he struck out 10 and walked one.
 - Has thrown his curveball 69.2% of the time...Among pitchers with at least five appearances so far, he easily leads the field...The second-place pitcher is Toronto's Brendon Little, who has thrown his curve 46.3% of the time.

Dylan Lee • LHP • 6-3 • 214 • 30 yrs • #52

- Saves/Opp:** 1/4 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 33/28 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 14/2
- Has thrown his slider 274 times, and has surrendered just five hits on it...**Among pitchers that have thrown as many, those five hits are the fewest in Major League Baseball...**Every other pitcher with at least 274 sliders has allowed at least eight hits on the offering.
 - Per Baseball Savant, throws the fourth-most-valuable slider in the game (tied), with a Run Value of eight.
 - Has pitched to a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP) at home and a 1.23 ERA (2 ER/14.2 IP) on the road.

Rafael Montero • RHP • 6-0 • 193 • 34 yrs • #48
