A Call to Arms

Aaron Civale, who was acquired via trade from Tampa Bay on Wednesday, will be the 16th different pitcher to start a game for the Brewers this season, the most in the Major Leagues and one shy of the franchise record of 17 set in 1969 as the Seattle Pilots.

Did You Hiura 'Bout This?

Jackson Chourio enters the day on a 10-game hitting streak during which he is batting .424 (14-for-33) with 2 HR and 9 RBI while posting a .472 OBP/.697 SLG/1.169 OPS....his streak marks the longest by a Brewers rookie since **Keston Hiura** (15g in 2019).

Star Power

William Contreras [catcher] and **Christian Yelich** [outfield] will be in the National League starting lineup at the 2024 All-Star Game....this is the eighth time in franchise history and first time since 2014 that the team has had multiple All-Star starters....**Carlos Gómez** (LF), **Jonathan Lucroy** (C) and **Aramis Ramirez** (3B) started in the 2014 Midsummer Classic.

Star Catcher

William Contreras will become just the third catcher in franchise history to start an All-Star Game....Contreras will join **Ted Simmons** (1984) and **Jonathan Lucroy** (2014).

Born Again Christian

Christian Yelich has made his third career All-Star Game (also 2018-19) and will be starting for the second time....Yelich is the last Brewer to start an All-Star Game (2019).

THIS EVENING'S GAME: Is the fifth game (2-2) of a 7-game road trip to Colorado (2-2) and Los Angeles-NL (3g)....following this trip and an off day on Monday, the team returns to American Family Field for a 6-game homestand against Pittsburgh (3g) and Washington (3g) leading into the All-Star break.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 27-13 at home, going 10-2-1 in series play....the team has gone 22-6 in its last 28 home games after a 5-7 start....the Brewers had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 5/29-6/10....the team has won its last nine home series....their last home series loss came from 4/26-4/28 against the Yankees (1-2).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 25-23 on the road, going 7-6-2 in series play....the team has gone 12-19 in its last 31 road games after a 13-4 start....the team had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from 4/9-4/13.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....**Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 21 replay challenges this season, going 13-8....their last challenge (won) came on 7/3 at Colorado as a safe call at first base involving Michael Toggia was overturned (pickoff).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #32 - RHP AARON CIVALE (17gs, 2-6, 5.07)

CIVALE AT A GLANCE: Aaron Civalde, 29, will make his Brewers debut and 18th start of the season....Civale was acquired by Milwaukee from Tampa Bay on Wednesday in exchange for INF Gregory Barrios....he went 2-6 with a 5.07 ERA in 17 starts with the Rays (87ip, 93h, 51r, 49er, 27bb, 84k)....he had 3 quality starts....the team went 5-12 in his starts....opponents are batting .270 (93-for-345, 16hr)....he last started last Saturday vs. Washington in an 8-1 loss (5.2ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 4bb, 2k, 1hr, 1wp, 102 pitches).... name is pronounced "sih-VAH-lee."

LAST SEASON: Civale went 7-5 with a 3.46 ERA in 23 starts between Cleveland and Tampa Bay....he made 7 quality starts....his teams went 13-10 in his starts....opponents batted .235 (109-for-463, 12hr)....he began the season with the Guardians, going 5-2 with a 2.34 ERA in 13 starts....he was traded to the Rays on July 31 in exchange for first baseman Kyle Manzardo and went 2-3 with a 5.36 ERA in 10 starts.

CAREER: Has gone 33-32 with a 4.10 ERA in 103 starts (562.1ip, 256er)....is in his sixth Major League season pitching for Cleveland (2019-23), Tampa Bay (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2024)....Civale was selected by Cleveland in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Northeastern University.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Civale has never pitched at our beautiful venue.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 16-15 with a 3.92 ERA in 54 starts (291.2ip, 127er)....is 1-2 with a 6.10 ERA in 8 starts this season (38.1ip, 26er).

CAREER vs. DODGERS: Civale has never faced Los Angeles, one of six teams he has not pitched against (also Atlanta, Arizona, Houston, Philadelphia and Tampa Bay).

RHP **Freddy Peralta** will make his 18th start of the season.....Peralta last started last Sunday vs. Chicago-NL in a 7-1 win (7ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 8k, 1hr, 103 pitches).....the team is 12-5 in his starts.....he has 7 quality starts.....opponents are batting .212 (73-for-344, 12hr).....he is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in his last 3 starts (18ip, 9h, 3r, 3er, 6bb, 22k, 1hr).....Peralta is 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA in 4 career starts against the Dodgers (20ip, 9h, 4r, 4er, 11bb, 21k, 2hr).....his only start at Dodger Stadium came on 7/30/18 as he received no decision in a Brewers' 5-2 win (4ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 4bb, 6k, 1hbp).....he earned a 9-3 win in his only start vs. Los Angeles last season on 5/8 at American Family Field (6ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 5k).
