PITTSBURGH PIRATES (12-16) vs. SAN DIEGO PADRES (17-13+)

May 4, 2021 at Petco Park, San Diego, CA -- GAME #29/ROAD #17

RHP MITCH KELLER (1-3, 8.20 ERA) vs. TBA (No Record)

THE PIRATES... have lost five straight games after winning a season-high three in a row and four-of-five...Have gone 11-10 in their last 21 games after losing a season-high six in a row from 4/3-8...Were 9-19 after 28 games in 2020 (9-20 after 29).

THE PRIDE OF POWAY: Bucco shortstop **Kevin Newman** is from nearby Poway, CA...He is a 2013 graduate of Poway High School, where was named the team MVP during his senior season...Entering today's action, Newman was one of just three MLB shortstops (min: 20 games) without an error this season (also San Francisco's Brandon Crawford and Miami's Miguel Rojas)...Newman has reached base safely in seven straight games.

FROM THE PADRES TO THE PIRATES: **David Bednar** was selected by San Diego in the 35th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft and made his Major League debut with the Padres in 2019...He was acquired by Pittsburgh, along with three other players, in exchange for Joe Musgrove on 1/19...The Pittsburgh native has made nine straight scoreless appearances (7.2ip) and has been scored upon once in his first 12 outings with the Pirates.

CURRENT BUCS: The Pirates began this six-game, seven-day road trip with a 2-0 loss Monday night...After this series, the Bucs will spend a day off in Chicago Thursday before starting a three-game series at Wrigley Field Friday afternoon...The Pirates have gone 7-9 on the road this season, winning six of their last 10 after going 1-5 in their first six.

ON THE ROAD: The Pirates have gone 6-4 in their last 10 games played on the road while posting a 3.04 ERA (83.0ip/28er)...The starting pitchers have produced a 4.08 ERA (53.0ip/24er) while the bullpen has turned in a 1.20 ERA (30.0ip/4er).

BUCS/FRIARS: The Pirates and Padres split their four-game series in Pittsburgh April 12-15 and will wrap up their season series on Wednesday...Dating back to the 2015 season, the Bucs have gone 22-16 against the Friars...The Bucs have won three of their last four games played in San Diego and six of their last nine.

BULLISH PEN: Dating back to April 8, Pittsburgh's bullpen has posted the lowest ERA among National League teams (2.55) and the third-lowest in the Majors behind Seattle (1.89) and Oakland (2.44).

ON A SERIES NOTE: The Pirates have won each of their last three series played on the road, marking the first time since 2018 (3-0 in Cincinnati, 2-1 in Cleveland and 2-1 in Colorado) in which the Bucs have won three straight road series...Overall, the Pirates have gone 4-1-2 in their last seven series after dropping their first two.

CAPTAIN REDBEARD: **Colin Moran** leads the team in RBI (19) and shares the team lead in home runs (4)...His 18 RBI from the fourth spot of the lineup rank second behind Arizona's David Peralta (19) for the most among all MLB players and his 18 RBI as a first baseman are tied for second among N.L. players at that position...In addition, Moran is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with runners in scoring position and .429 (6-for-14) with RISP and two outs.

HISTORY MAKER: **Richard Rodríguez** has made seven straight hitless outings (8.0ip) and has surrendered just one hit overall in his first 11 appearances (11.1ip)...Rodríguez is the first pitcher in Pirates history to allow no more than one hit over his first 11 appearances of a season.

HOT ROD: Dating back to June 1, 2019, **Richard Rodríguez** has produced a 2.09 ERA (77.2ip/18er) in his 81 games - that is the lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances...Rodríguez has allowed just two baserunners (one hit and one walk) in his first nine outings this season (35 at bats) and has made 22 consecutive scoreless appearances (22.0ip) dating back to August 30 of last season.

PEN PALS: **Kyle Crick** has made seven straight hitless outings (6.2ip) and has allowed one hit in his first 10 games (28 at bats) overall...**Sam Howard** has stranded all eight of his inherited runners this season...Howard is one of five pitchers in the Majors who has stranded all eight or more inherited runners...**Clay Holmes** has stranded all five of his inherited runners and has been charged with one earned run in his last eight appearances (10.2ip).

SHELTY'S CREW: Manager **Derek Shelton** and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021...**Christian Marrero** has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include **Tarrik Brock** (First Base), **Joey Cora** (Third Base), **Rick Eckstein** (Hitting), **Don Kelly** (Bench), **Oscar Marin** (Pitching), **Justin Meccage** (Bullpen), **Mike Rabelo** (Field Coordinator) and **Glenn Sherlock**...Catching coaches **Herbie Andrade** and **Jordan Comadena** have returned.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 4, 1992: The Bucs trailed Cincinnati, 5-1, after 5 ½ innings before scoring 11 runs in the sixth inning in a 12-5 win. It was only the second time the Pirates scored 11 runs in an inning in the century (the other time came in 1942). Andy Van Slyke went 4-for-5 and Jeff King went 3-for-5 to lead the offensive attack. The 11-run outburst remains a club record for most runs in an inning.
