AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their six-game road trip today with the second game a three-game series at Toronto (0-1 thus far)...are 3-1 on the road trip after sweeping a three-game series at Cleveland and dropping their series opener at Toronto on Friday...following this homestand, will return home for a six-game homestand, featuring three-game sets against Chicago-AL (Tues.-Thurs.) and Cincinnati (6/19-21).

- Their 41-27 (.603) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- Had their four-game winning streak snapped on Friday...are 5-2 in their last seven games (since 6/4), 11-5 in their last 16 games (since 5/24) and 13-8 in their last 21 games (since 5/18)...are 33-20 in their last 53 games (since 4/13).
- Are 14G over .500, 1G shy of their season high (15G at 41-26 on 6/10).
- The Yankees' +100 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors...have outscored their opponents, 95-60, over their last 16 games (since 5/24).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees had their four-game winning streak snapped after falling to the Blue Jays, 8-5, on Friday at Rogers Centre...**LHP Ryan Weathers** (4.1IP, 5H, 6R/ER, 1BB, 2K, 2HR, 1HP, 1WP) suffered his fifth loss of the season after allowing a season-high 6R/ER...**1B Paul Goldschmidt** (1-for-4, 1RBI, 1SF) drove in the Yankees' first run with a sac fly in the fifth inning...**LF Cody Bellinger** (1-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his 10th home run of the year with a two-run shot in the fifth inning...**CF Trent Grisham** (1-for-4, 2RBI) hit a two-run single in the sixth inning and exited the game with right hamstring tightness...**SS José Caballero** (2-for-3, 1R, 1 double, 1BB) reached base three times...**DH Ben Rice** (0-for-3, 1R, 2BB), **2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (1-for-4, 1BB, 1SB) and **RF/CF Spencer Jones** (0-for-2, 1R, 2BB) each reached base twice...**Yankees relievers** allowed 2R/ER in 3.2IP.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games (since 5/25), batting .333/.368/.524 (21-for-63) with 8R, 3 doubles, 3HR, 15RBI, 4BB, 1SF and 1SB over that span.

- Has recorded 6RBI in his last five games (since 6/7) and 15RBI in his last 13 games (since 5/27).
- Has recorded multiple hits in two of his last three games and three of his last five games (since 6/7).
- Is batting .317/.380/.553 (39-for-123) with 18R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 7HR, 26RBI, 11BB, 2HP, 1SF and 1SB over his last 34 games (since 4/26).
- **Has hit .400/.525/.667 (12-for-30) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 21RBI, 7BB, 1SF and 2HP with RISP this season...** as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .331/.422/.453 (46-for-139) with 8 doubles, 3HR, 55RBI, 21BB/5IBB, 3HP and 3SF with RISP.

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. is batting .287/.364/.552 (25-for-87) with 17R, 4 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 15RBI, 11BB, 1SF and 7SB over his last 23 games (since 5/13).

- Has recorded 7RBI over his last five games (since 6/7) and 9RBI over his last eight games (since 6/3).

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice reached base twice on Friday at Toronto...has hit .291/.389/.609 (67-for-230) with 50R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR, 45RBI, 36BB/3IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 63 games this season...has reached base safely in 48-of-59 starts...35 of his 67H this year have been XBH (15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners have recorded 17SB over their last 10 games (since 5/31)...their 68SB this season are the most in the AL and the fourth-most in the Majors.

- **Their 68SB this season are their most through their first 68 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 79SB in 2001...** marks only the third time in the last 37 years (since 1990) the Yankees recorded as many stolen bases through their first 68 games of a season (79SB in 2001 and 86SB in 1998).
- **INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (18SB) ranks fourth in the AL and sixth in the Majors in stolen bases...his 18SB are the most by a Yankee through the team's first 68 games of a season since Jacoby Ellsbury recorded 18SB in 2014.
- **INF/OF José Caballero** (15SB) ranks fifth in the AL and is tied for ninth in the Majors in stolen bases.

SCHLITZ'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schlichter will make his 15th start of the season today vs. Toronto...**has gone 7-3 with a 1.87 ERA (82.0IP, 17ER) and 89K in 14 starts, holding opponents to a .191/.229/.285 (57-for-298) slash line.**

- **His 1.87 ERA is the second-lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher through his first 14 starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985) and the seventh-lowest in the last 82 years (since 1945),** trailing only Ron Guidry (1.45 ERA in 1978), Allie Reynolds (1.52 ERA in 1952), Whitey Ford (2x: 1.55 ERA in 1958 and 1964), Phil Niekro (1.77 ERA in 1984) and Max Fried (1.84 ERA in 2025).
- **Joins Ron Guidry (1.45 ERA and 104K in first 14GS in 1978) as the only two pitchers in franchise history to post as low of an ERA and record at least 85K through their first 14 starts of a season.**
- **Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 13 of his 14 starts this season, including 1R-or-fewer in nine starts (including four scoreless starts)...** his 13 starts of 3R-or-fewer are the most in the AL and the second-most in the Majors.
- **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in 10 of his starts this season,** the most in the AL and tied for the most in the Majors.
- **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in eight of his last 10 starts (since 4/17), going 5-2 with a 1.64 ERA (60.1IP, 11ER) and 59K in that span.**
- The Yankees are 10-4 in his starts...his 10 team wins are tied for the third-most in the Majors this season (tied for third in AL).
- Has tossed at least 6.0IP in eight of his last 13 starts (since 4/1), including seven of his last 10 starts (since 4/17).
- According to *Elias*, **his 2.38 ERA is the fourth-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 28 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances and excluding openers), trailing only Stan Bahnsen (2.16 ERA from 1966-68), Bill Stafford (2.30 ERA from 1960-61) and Mel Stottlemyre Sr. (2.35 ERA from 1964-65)...**also marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 28 career appearances were all starts and the third-lowest by any Major League pitcher since 1913 (when ER became an official stat),** trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.14 ERA) and Miami's José Fernández (2.19 ERA).

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger hit his 10th home run of the year with a two-run shot in the fifth inning on Friday at Toronto...is hitting .292/.382/.542 (42-for-144) with 22R, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 7HR, 31RBI, 23BB, 5SB and 3SF over his last 39 games (since 4/28).

- Has recorded 13RBI in his last 15 games (since 5/25).
- Is batting .305/.370/.441 (18-for-59) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 28RBI, 9BB and 5SF with RISP this season.
- According to FanGraphs, his 15 DRS are tied for the most in the Majors (most in AL)...is tied for first in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (13, tied for first in AL) and tied for sixth in game-winning RBI (seven, tied for third in AL).

WALK IT OUT: Yankees batters walked seven times on Friday at Toronto...lead the AL and rank second in the Majors with 294BB, trailing only Chicago-NL (299BB in 70G)...marks their most walks through their first 68 games of a season in the last 22 years (since 2005) and their most since recording 310BB in 2004.

GOT YOUR NUMBER: INF/OF José Caballero has hit .500/.500/.700 (5-for-10) with 2 doubles in his career against Toronto's RHP Kevin Gausman...**INF Paul Goldschmidt** has batted .455/.556/.636 (10-for-22) with 1 double, 1HR and 5BB in his career against Gausman...**INF Ryan McMahon** owns a career .313/.389/.688 (5-for-16) slash line with 3 doubles, 1HR and 2BB vs. Gausman.

HIP HIP JOSÉ: INF/OF José Caballero reached base three times and recorded his second straight multi-hit game on Friday at Toronto...has reached base safely in 34 of his last 42 games with a PA (since 4/13), batting .299/.358/.467 (41-for-137) with 22R, 8 doubles, 5HR, 14RBI, 10BB, 3HP, 1SF and 10SB over that span.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP CAM SCHLITTLER (7-3, 1.87 ERA)

RHP Cam Schlittler will make his 15th start of the season today at Toronto...the 25-year-old will pitch on extended five days' rest due to Thursday's team off day...made his 14th start of the season on Sunday vs. Boston and did not record a decision despite allowing 1R/ER over 5.2IP (4H, 1BB, 5K, 0HR)...has gone 7-3 with a 1.87 ERA (82.0IP, 57H, 20R/17ER, 14BB, 89K, 4HR) in 14 starts this season...has also allowed 1ER-or-fewer in 10 of his starts, including eight of his last 10 starts (since 4/17)...made his first career Opening Day roster...**over his last 22 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 10-4 with a 2.01 ERA (125.1IP, 84H, 31R/28ER, 31BB, 143K, 6HR)**...saw his first Major League action in 2025 with the Yankees, going 4-3 with a 2.96 ERA (73.0IP, 58H, 24R/ER, 31BB, 84K, 8HR) in 14 starts...in 28 career Major League starts, has gone 11-6 with a 2.38 ERA (155.0IP, 115H, 44R/41ER, 45BB, 173K, 12HR)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 25-of-28 career starts, 2R-or-fewer in 21 starts and 1R-or-fewer in 16 starts...according to *Elias*, **his 2.38 ERA is the fourth-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 28 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances and excluding openers), trailing only Stan Bahnsen (2.16 ERA from 1966-68), Bill Stafford (2.30 ERA from 1960-61) and Mel Stottlemyre Sr. (2.35 ERA from 1964-65)...**also marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 28 career appearances were all starts and the third-lowest by any Major League pitcher since 1913 (when ER became an official stat)**, trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.14 ERA) and Miami's José Fernández (2.19 ERA)...**his 173K through his first 28 career games are tied with Al Downing for the third-most in franchise history**, trailing only Masahiro Tanaka (192K) and Luis Gil (175K)...**his 44R allowed are the fewest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 28 career starts...has posted a .204 opponents' BA over his first 28 career starts...according to *Elias*, marks the seventh-lowest opponents' BA by a Yankees pitcher through their first 28 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances), trailing only Tommy Byrne (.180), Luis Gil (.182), Al Downing (.186), Russ Ford (.190), Spec Shea (.195) and Dave Righetti (.202)...the Weymouth, Mass., native was selected by the Yankees in the seventh round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Northeastern University (Mass.).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 14th start of the season on Sunday vs. Boston and did not record a decision despite allowing 1R/ER over 5.2IP (4H, 1BB, 5K, 0HR).

2026: In 14 starts this season, has gone 7-3 with a 1.87 ERA (82.0IP, 57H, 20R/17ER, 14BB, 89K, 4HR)...has held opponents to a .191/.229/.285 (57-for-298) slash line...**see Major League rankings at right.**

- ✦ **His 1.87 ERA is the second-lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher through his first 14 starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985) and the seventh-lowest in the last 82 years (since 1945)**, trailing only Ron Guidry (1.45 ERA in 1978), Allie Reynolds (1.52 ERA in 1952), Whitey Ford (2x: 1.55 ERA in 1958 and 1964), Phil Niekro (1.77 ERA in 1984) and Max Fried (1.84 ERA in 2025).
- ✦ **Joins Ron Guidry (1.45 ERA and 104K in first 14GS in 1978) as the only two pitchers in franchise history to post as low of an ERA and record at least 85K through their first 14 starts of a season.**
- ✦ **Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 13 of his 14 starts this season, including 1R-or-fewer in nine starts (including four scoreless starts)**...his 13 starts of 3R-or-fewer are the most in the AL and the second-most in the Majors...**had allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of his first 12 starts of the season from 3/27-5/26, tied for the fourth-longest streak in franchise history**, trailing only Clarke Schmidt's 15-start streak to begin the 2024 season, Ron Guidry's 15-start streak to begin the 1978 season and Jordan Montgomery's 13-start streak to begin the 2022 season (Jim Bouton also had a 12-start streak to begin the 1966 season).
- ✦ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in 10 of his starts this season, including eight of his last 10 starts (since 4/17)**...his 10 starts of 1ER-or-fewer are the most in the AL and tied for the most in the Majors...allowed 1ER-or-fewer in six straight starts from 4/17-5/15...was one of just three Yankees starters (not including openers) in the last 29 seasons (since 1998) to allow 1ER-or-fewer in at least six straight starts in a single season, joining Luis Gil (7GS from 5/1-6/4/24) and Michael King (7GS from 8/24-9/26/23)...**his six-start streak of 1ER-or-fewer matched the sixth-longest by a Yankees starter in franchise history** (not including openers), trailing only Whitey Ford (9GS from 8/24-9/28/63), Spud Chandler (8GS from 9/29/45-5/19/46-G1), Gil, King and Steve Kline (7GS from 7/18-8/14/72).
- ✦ **Has allowed only 4HR to 317BF this season**...his 0.44 HR/9.0IP ratio is the fourth-best mark in the Majors (second in AL)...is the only Yankees starting pitcher (not including openers) in the last 13 seasons (since 2014) to allow four-or-fewer home runs over his first 14 starts of a season (first since Iván Nova - 4HR in first 14GS in 2013).
- ✦ Has recorded at least 7K in seven of his starts, including 8K in four starts.
- ✦ Has allowed 4H-or-fewer in nine of his starts, the most in the AL and tied for the second-most in the Majors.
- ✦ The Yankees are 10-4 in his starts...his 10 team wins are tied for the third-most in the Majors this season (tied for third in AL).
- ✦ Has tossed at least 6.0IP in eight of his last 13 starts (since 4/1), including seven of his last 10 starts (since 4/17).

ON A ROLL: Since making his Major League debut on 7/9/25, ranks third among Major League pitchers (min. 100.0IP) in ERA (2.38, first in AL), sixth in opponents' SLG (.310, second in AL), eighth in opponents' OPS (.578, third in AL) and tied for eighth in strikeouts (173, tied for third in AL)...also ranks second in the AL in HR/9.0IP (0.70), fifth in opponents' BA (.204), sixth in WHIP (1.03) and opponents' OBP (.268), seventh in strikeout rate (27.9%), tied for eighth in innings pitched (155.0) and 10th in K/9.0IP (10.05) over that stretch.

- ✦ Has recorded at least 6K in 20 starts since making his Major League debut, the most in the AL and tied for the fourth-most in the Majors over that stretch.
- ✦ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in eight of his last 10 starts (since 4/17), going 5-2 with a 1.64 ERA (60.1IP, 11ER) and 59K in that span.**
- ✦ **Over his last 22 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 10-4 with a 2.01 ERA (125.1IP, 84H, 31R/28ER, 31BB, 143K, 6HR)**...the Yankees are 17-5 in those starts...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 13 of those starts.

ROAD TRIP: Has gone 6-1 with a 1.09 ERA (49.1IP, 25H, 7R/6ER, 6BB, 57K, 3HR) in eight road starts this season...has allowed one-or-zero ER in seven starts (including four scoreless starts).

- ✦ **His 1.09 ERA is the lowest by a Yankees pitcher over their first eight road starts in a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat).
- ✦ **Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of his first eight road starts to begin the season...matches the fifth-longest streak to begin a season in franchise history**, trailing only Whitey Ford (first 14 road starts in 1958), Bill Hogg (first 13 road starts in 1906), Bob Shawkey (first 10 road starts in 1920) and Ray Caldwell (first nine road starts in 1914).
- ✦ Did not allow a run through his first 13.2 innings to begin the season on the road (3/27-4/1).

VS. TORONTO: Has made three career regular season starts vs. Toronto, going 0-2 with a 5.68 ERA (12.2IP, 20H, 8R/ER, 7BB, 12K, 0HR)...made one start vs. the Blue Jays earlier this season on 5/20 at Yankee Stadium (L, 6.0IP, 8H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 7K, 0HR).

- ✦ Also started against the Blue Jays in 2025 ALDS Game 4 at Yankee Stadium (L, 6.1IP, 8H, 4R/2ER, 0BB, 2K, 0HR).
