- AT A GLANCE: The Yankees will continue their seven-game road trip today with the final game of a three-game set at Milwaukee (1-1 thus far)...will also play a four-game series at Baltimore from Mon.-Thurs... went 4-3 on their recent homestand after winning two-of-three games vs. Tampa Bay and splitting a four-game set vs. Oakland.

  In Their 18-10 record (.643) is tied with Philadelphia for the fifth-best record in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta (18-7, .720), Cleveland (19-8, .704), Baltimore (17-9, .654) and Milwaukee (17-9, .654)... their 18 wins are tied for the second-most in the Majors, trailing only Cleveland (19).

  Marks the fifth time in the last 21 years (since 2004) the Yankees have gone 18-10 or better to start a season (also went 20-8 in 2010 and '22, 19-9 in 2017 and 18-10 in 2018)...with a win today, would also mark the fifth time in the last 21 years (since 2004) the Yankees went 19-10 or better to start a season (went 21-8 in 2010 and '22, 20-9 in 2017 and 19-10 in 2018).

  The Yankees are in the midst of a 17-day stretch without an off day (4/19-5/5)...marks their longest stretch of the season
- off day (4/19-5/5)...marks their longest stretch of the season without an off-day...are 5-4 so far.
- **Are 3-0 in rubber games this year**. Have won or split seven of their eight completed series (6-1-1) this season.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Brewers, 15-3, on Saturday at American Family Field...LHP Carlos Rodón (6.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 8K, 1HR) started and earned his second win of the season...LF Alex Verdugo (3-for-5, 2R, 1HR, 4RBI, 1SF) recorded a season-high-tying 3H and recorded a career-high-tying 4RBI, hitting a three-run HR in the first inning and a sac fly in the ninth inning...2B Gleyber Torres (3-for-6, 1 double, 3RBI) recorded a season-high 3H and hit a bases-clearing double in the third inning...3B/1B Oswaldo Cabrera (1-for-5, 1RBI) hit an RBI single in the fifth inning...CF Aaron Judge (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 1HR, 2RBI, 1BB) reached base three times and hit a two-run HR in the sixth inning...1B Anthony Rizzo (3-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI) recorded a season-high 3H and hit a two-run HR in the sixth inning...DH Giancarlo Stanton (2-for-5, 2R, 1HR, 3RBI, 1BB) reached base three times and hit a three-run HR in the ninth inning...RF Juan Soto (1-for-3, 2R, 2BB) and C Austin Wells (2-for-5, 1 double, 1BB) each reached base three times...RHP Luke Weaver (2.0IP, 1H, 1BB, 2K) tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...Jose Trevino (1.0IP, 2H, 2R/ER, 1BB) made his first career pitching appearance.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.19 ERA (152.1IP, 54ER) in 28 starts this year, the fourth-lowest ERA in the Majors, trailing only Boston (2.11), Philadelphia (2.13) and Kansas City (2.86)... have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 24 of their 28 starts, 2ER-or-fewer in 17 starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 12 starts.

- PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers have posted a 3.01 ERA (254.0IP, 85ER) this year, the second-lowest ERA in the Majors, trailing only Boston (2.63).

  In Have held opponents to 3R-or-fewer in 18 of 28 games this year (are 13-5 in those games)...are 16-5 this season when holding their opponent to 4R-or-fewer.

  Rank fifth in the Majors in opponents' BA (.217) and opponents' SLG (.349) and sixth in opponents' OPS (.647).

**VERDAWGO: OF Alex Verdugo** recorded a season-high-tying 3H and a career-high-tying 4RBI on Saturday at Milwaukee... homered in his second straight game, hitting a three-run HR in the first inning...has homered in consecutive games for the eighth time in his career and first since his only three-game HR streak from 8/24-26/23 with Boston.

  Has hit .350/.446/.600 (21-for-60) with 13R, 6 doubles, 3HR, 10RBI, 11BB, 1HP, 15B and 2SF in his last 18 games (since 4/8)...has reached base multiple times in six of his last seven games (since 4/21) and 11 of his last 18 games.
  His 12.67 plate appearance per strikeout ratio (114PA/9K) is the best in the Majors this season...has struck out just once in his last 38PA (since ninth inning on 4/17).

**GLEYBER DAY: INF Gleyber Torres** recorded a season-high 3H and hit a bases-clearing double in the third inning on Saturday at Milwaukee...is 6-for-19 (.316) with 1 double and 3RBI over his last four games (since 4/24).

STANTON ISLAND: DH/OF Giancarlo Stanton reached base three times and hit a three-run HR in the ninth inning on Saturday at Milwaukee...is hitting .286/.348/.587 (18-for-63) with 12R, 4 doubles, 5HR, 15RBI and 6BB over his last 18 games (since 4/6). BRONX BOMBERS: Yankees batters set season highs on Saturday in runs (15), hits (19) and home runs (4)...their 15R were their most in a game since their 16R on 7/6/22 at Pittsburgh...their 19H and 26TOB were their most since 8/25/22 at Oakland (20H and 26TOB).

  Have hit 12HR over their last five games (since 4/23) after hitting 3HR in their previous seven games (4/15-22). STRO SHOW: RHP Marcus Stroman will make his sixth start of the year today at Milwaukee... is 2-1 with a 2.93 ERA (27.2IP, 9ER) and 28K in five starts this season...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in four of his five starts and 2ER-or-fewer in three of those starts.

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge reached base three times and hit his fifth HR of the year with a two-run HR in the sixth inning on Saturday at Milwaukee...over his last five games (since 4/23), has reached base in 10-0f-24 PA (.417 OBP)...has hit 2HR in his last four games (since 4/24).

NEW YORK GIANTS: OF Aaron Judge and DH/OF Giancarlo Stanton both homered on Saturday at Milwaukee...marked the 33rd time the pair has both homered in the same game with the Yankees during the regular season (since 2018), tied for the sixth-most such games the regular season (since 2018), tied for the sixth-most such games by a pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history, trailing only Lou Gehrig and Babe Ruth (73), Yogi Berra and Mickey Mantle (55), Bob Meusel and Babe Ruth (47), Mickey Mantle and Roger Maris (42), and Jorge Posada and Alex Rodriguez (37)...Derek Jeter and Jorge Posada (33), and Bill Dickey and Lou Gehrig (33) also homered in the same game 33 times – credit *Elias*...the Yankees are 29-4 in those games (the duo has also homered in four Yankees postseason games, with the team winning each of those games).

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP MARCUS STROMAN (2-1, 2.93 ERA)

RHP Marcus Stroman will make his sixth start of the season in today's series finale at Milwaukee...the 32-year-old will pitch on regular four days' rest...last pitched on Tuesday vs. Oakland and earned his second win of the year in the Yankees' 4-3 victory (5.1IP, 7H, 3ER, 1BB, 9K, 2HR, 1WP)...was 10-9 with a 3.95 ERA (136.2IP, 120H, 68R/60ER, 52BB, 119K, 9HR) in 27 games (25 starts/1SHO) with the Cubs in 2023...among Major League pitchers with at least 100.0 innings pitched in 2023, ranked second in groundball percentage (58.4) and home runs allowed per 9.0 innings (0.59), eighth in opponents' slugging percentage (.335) and 12th in opponents' OPS (.640)...is a two-time All-Star (2019 with Toronto and 2023 with Chicago-NL) and a Gold Glove Award winner (2017 with Toronto)...over parts of 10 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays (2014-19), New York Mets (2019, '21), Chicago Cubs (2022-23) and Yankees (2024), has gone 79-77 with four complete games (two shutouts) and a 3.64 ERA (1,331.1IP, 1,281H, 603R/538ER, 386BB, 1,119K, 124HR) in 236 career games (228 starts)...since making his Major League debut in 2014, ranks second in the Majors in groundball percentage (57.5) and fourth in home runs allowed per 9.0 innings (0.84)...was selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Duke University...was signed by the Yankees to a two-year Major League contract extending through the 2025 season with a conditional player option for the 2026 season on 1/17/24. player option for the 2026 season on 1/17/24.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his second win of the season in the Yankees' 4-3 victory vs. Oakland at Yankee Stadium on Tuesday (5.1IP, 7H, 3ER, 1BB, 9K, 2HR, 1WP)...recorded a season-high 9K...marked just the eighth time in his career he has recorded at least 9K in a game and his first since 8/17/21 at San Francisco with New York-NL (also 9K)... allowed an RBI double to Seth Brown in the first inning and solo home runs to Shea Langeliers in the second inning and Lawrence Butler in the fourth inning...his 2HR were his most in a game since 4/23/23 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3HR).

- 2024: Is 2-1 with a 2.93 ERA (27.2IP, 9ER) and 28K in five starts this season... has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in four of his five starts and 2ER-or-fewer in three of those starts.
  + Has received one-or-zero runs of support in three of his five starts this year.
  + His 57.3 groundball percentage is the highest in the AL and the eighth-highest in the Majors (min. 20.0IP).
  + Was just the third Yankee in the last 57 years (since 1968) to toss at least 6.0IP and not allow an earned run in each of his first two starts of a season, joining Freddy García (first 2GS in 2011) and Ramiro Mendoza (first 2GS in 1999).
  + Made his Yankees debut on 3/30 at Houston and earned the win in the Yankees' 5-3 victory (6.0IP, 4H, 3R/0ER, 2BB, 4K, 0HR, 1HP).
  + Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and did not record a decision in his first start in the Bronx as a Yankee on 4/5 vs. Toronto (6.0IP, 3H, 0R, 1BB, 6K)...according to Elias, was the seventh New York-born pitcher in franchise history to start the Yankees' home opener, joining Dave LaPoint (1990), John Candelaria (1989), Whitey Ford (1955-58, '60-64, '66-67), Ed Lopat (1949), Waite Hoyt (1927) and George Mogridge (1919)...started his club's home opener for the fourth time in his career.
  + Took his first loss of the year in the Yankees' 5-2 loss on 4/10 vs. Miami (5.0IP, 4H, 4R/ER, 4BB, 7K, 1HR)...allowed 4ER after not surrendering an earned run over his first two starts...allowed an RBI single to Luis Arraez and a three-run HR to Jake Burger in the third inning.
  + Did not record a decision in the Yankees' 6-4 win on 4/17 at Toronto (5.1IP, 6H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 2K, 1HR).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Will make his third road start of the season today...is 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA (11.1IP, 2ER) on the road this year.

+ Went 4-3 with a 3.98 ERA (63.1IP, 65H, 35R/28ER, 27BB, 54K, 4HR) in 14 road games (12 starts) in 2023...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in nine of his 12 road starts in 2023.

VS. MILWAUKEE: Has made seven career starts vs. Milwaukee, going 3-1 with a 2.58 ERA (45.1IP, 13ER)... has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five of his seven career starts against the Brewers.

- Made two starts against Milwaukee in 2023, going 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0IP, 4ER) and 14K...earned the win in his Opening Day start on 3/30 at Wrigley Field (6.0IP, 3H, 0R, 3BB, 8K)...also faced the Brewers on 7/6 at American Family Field and did not record a decision (5.0IP, 4H, 4R/ER, 4BB, 6K, 1HR). Has made three career starts at American Family Field, going 2-0 with a 4.08 ERA (17.2IP, 8ER). Has held the Brewers to 3H-or-fewer in four of his seven starts, posting a .159/.257/.291 (24-for-151) opponents' BA.

**HOMETOWN HERO:** Is just the sixth New York-born pitcher to start a game for the Yankees in the last 34 seasons (since 1991), joining Michael King (19GS from 2020-21, '23), Brian Gordon (2GS in 2011), Dellin Betances (1GS in 2011), Tim Redding (1GS in 2005) and Mike Jerzembeck (2GS in 1998).

2023: Went 10-9 with a 3.95 ERA (136.2IP, 120H, 68R/60ER, 52BB, 119K, 9HR) in 27 games (25 starts/1SHO) with the Cubs in 2023...was an All-Star for the second time in his career...opponents batted .231/.304/.335 (120-for-519, 9HR); LH .194/.293/.282 (53-for-273, 4HR); RH .272/.318/.394 (67-for-246, 5HR).

+ Among Major League pitchers with at least 100.0 innings pitched, ranked second in groundball percentage (58.4) and home runs allowed per 9.0 innings (0.59),

eighth in opponents' slugging percentage (.335) and 12th in opponents' OPS (.640).

STRO SHOW: Over parts of 10 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays (2014-19), New York Mets (2019, '21), Chicago Cubs (2022-23) and Yankees (2024), has gone 79-77 with four complete games (two shutouts) and a 3.64 ERA (1,331.1IP, 1,281H, 603R/538ER, 386BB, 1,119K, 124HR) in 236 career games (228 starts)...is a two-time All-Star (2019 with Toronto and 2023 with Chicago-NL) and a Gold Glove Award winner (2017 with Toronto).

Since making his Major League debut in 2014, ranks second in the Majors in groundball percentage (57.6) and fourth in home runs allowed per 9.0 innings (0.84).

- Was one of only 11 pitchers to make 25-or-more starts in at least six of the seven non-shortened seasons from
- His 1,173.2 innings since the start of 2016 are the 12th-most among Major League pitchers.
- Has made at least 30 starts in four seasons since 2016, tied for the eighth-most in the Majors over that span (32GS in 2016, 33GS in 2017, 32GS in 2019 and 33GS in 2021)...his four such seasons from 2016-21 matched the
- most by a Major League pitcher over that span. Has reached double-digit wins five times (2014, '17, '19, '21 and '23).

BIGGER THAN BASEBALL: Once a homestand this season, Stroman will host a meet-and-greet with a different community group at Yankee Stadium...prior to the Yankees' game on 4/24 vs. Oakland, the Long Island native hosted youth from the NYPD Blue Chips Program...Blue Chips is a youth mentoring program that uses sports and education to create safe and cohesive avenues for young individuals to interact with each other and create stronger bonds with members of the NYPD...prior to the Yankees' 4/8 game vs. Miami, Stroman spent some time with players and staff from The Eagle Academy for Young Men (Bronx) baseball team in the Yankee Stadium Press Conference Room.

In March, the Marcus Stroman Height Doesn't Measure Heart Foundation, in collaboration with the educational platform Bold.org, announced the launch of the Marcus Stroman Scholarship...the initiative aims to empower high school seniors, offering them a chance to pursue higher education without the burden of financial constraints...the scholarship has committed \$250,000 over the next five years...this year, two deserving students attending high schools in the Bronx will each receive a \$25,000 scholarship to cover their freshman year college expenses for the academic year 2024-2025.
