RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a six-game, seven-day homestand against the Mariners (2-0, 1 to play) and Nationals (3 to play) today at Tropicana Field...the Rays have won seven of their last nine games and 10 of their last 14...are 15-12 in their last 27 contests on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak from May 19-25...prior to that stretch, Tampa Bay posted an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 contests from May 3-18...the Rays are 9-9 so far during a stretch of 19 games in 20 days that began on June 7 and concludes today.

In last night's 11-3 win, Tampa Bay's scored its most runs at Tropicana Field since Aug. 22, 2023 vs. COL (12R)...the eight-run margin of victory was also its largest at home since Aug. 22, 2023 vs. COL (12-4). Tampa Bay has out-hit its opponent in five of its last six games (64-32, +32)...prior to that stretch, the Rays were out-hit in 10 of their previous 11 games (109-73, -36). The Rays have not committed an error in a season-high seven consecutive games, their longest streak since Aug. 22-Sept. 2, 2023 (10G). Tampa Bay pitching has allowed four runs or fewer in a season-high-tying five consecutive games (also May 6-11)...the Rays last allowed four runs or fewer in six straight games from Sept. 10-15, 2023 (also 6G).

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would: Earn their third series sweep of the season (May 3-5 vs. NYM & June 4-5 at MIA). Collect their first sweep of the Mariners since Aug. 9-11, 2019 and their first at Tropicana Field since a four-game sweep from April 30-May 3, 2012. Win their sixth straight game against the Mariners, their longest winning streak against Seattle since a franchise-best nine-game run from July 31, 2011-July 20, 2012. Move above the .500 mark for the first time since entering play on May 17 (23-22). Win four consecutive games for the first time since May 15-18 (also 4G).

THE CHAMP IS HERE—Yandy Díaz has hit safely in a career-high 18 straight games, batting .358/.373/.506 (29-for-81) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 10 RBI during the streak...it marks the second-longest active streak in MLB behind PIT Bryan Reynolds (22G)...the 18-game run is tied with Wilson Ramos (April 14-May 12-G2, 2018) and Quinton McCracken (18G: Aug. 18-Sept. 9, 1998) for the second-longest streak in club history behind Jason Bartlett (19G: May 15-June 25, 2009)...the Rays are the only franchise in the majors that has not seen player record a hitting streak of 20+ games.

Díaz also owns a career-high 27-game on-base streak, the second-longest active streak in MLB behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (32G)...he is the first Ray to reach base safely in 26 straight games since Wander Franco (43G: July 25-Sept. 29, 2021). He has recorded an RBI in a career-high seven straight games...the seven-game run is tied with STL Brendan Donovan for the second-longest active streak in MLB behind LAD Shohei Ohtani (9G)...the last Ray with an RBI in seven straight games was Austin Meadows (7G: Aug. 28-Sept. 6, 2021)...with an RBI today, Díaz can tie the franchise record of eight straight games, a mark shared by Rocco Baldelli (2004), Carlos Peña (2008), Evan Longoria (2009) and Ben Zobrist (2009).

RED-HOT RORTVEDT—Ben Rortvedt is batting .359/.405/.692 (14-for-39) with 4 2B, 3 HR and 14 RBI over his last 12 games...his 14 RBI since June 13 are tied with TEX Wyatt Langford for second most in the AL behind BAL Anthony Santander (16RBI)...he has hit safely in a career-high-tying five straight games (also April 3-10, 2024)...his 4 RBI last night matched a career high (also June 16 at ATL).

He is one of four MLB catchers with multiple 4+ RBI games this season, joining OAK Shea Langeliers (3G), SEA Cal Raleigh (2G) and BAL Adley Rutschman (2G). Rortvedt has recorded 1+ RBI in a career-high four straight games, the longest streak by a Tampa Bay catcher since Mike Zunino (5G, Aug. 11-17, 2021).

PALACIOS' PLATE DISCIPLINE—Richie Palacios has gone 25 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout, the longest active streak in MLB, ahead of LAD Miguel Vargas (24PA)...following an 0-for-13 skid from June 15-21, Palacios is hitting .500 (7-for-14) with 1 2B, 2 RBI, 2 BB, 5 R and 2 SB...he scored a career-high three runs last night.

SIRI-OUSLY SPEAKING—Jose Siri reached base safely a career-high-tying four times (2x, last: June 21, 2024 at PIT) in last night's victory...he went 1-for-1 with an RBI and two runs while drawing a career-high-tying three walks (also April 5, 2024 at COL)...he has four multi-walk games this season, having entered the 2024 campaign with one such career performance (2BB, April 10 at LAA) in 226 games.

Over his last 13 games since June 12, Siri is batting .326/.404/.609 (15-for-46) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI, 6 BB and 13 R...the 13 runs are second most in the AL during that stretch behind BAL Gunnar Henderson (14R).

AROZARENA ANSWERS—Randy Arozarena is batting .292 (19-for-65) with 5 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 11 BB, 16 SO, 3 SB and 6 HBP over 21 games in June...his .434 on-base pct. this month is fifth in the AL behind NYY Juan Soto/NYY Aaron Judge (both .500), CLE Steven Kwan (.488) and BAL Gunnar Henderson (.436).

He has reached base safely in a season-high 10 straight games, his longest run since Sept. 6-16, 2023 (10G)...his last on-base streak of 11 straight games came during a career-best 20-game run from April 17-May 9, 2023.

He has been hit by four pitches during the on-base streak...his 56 HBP with the Rays are two shy of Brandon Guyer (58HBP) for the franchise record.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays 16-7 (.696) record in one-run games leads MLB, ahead of the Red Sox (10-5/.667)...their 28-12 (.700) mark in games decided by two runs or fewer also paces the majors, ahead of Philadelphia (20-11/.645)...since April 29, they are 19-6 in games decided by two runs or fewer and 8-18 in all other contests...Tampa Bay is 12-5 in its last 17 one-run games.

The Rays 22 comeback wins are tied for the MLB lead with the Nationals.

GOING, GOING, GONE!—Tampa Bay pitching has allowed an MLB-high 112 HR, with the next closest team being the Blue Jays (108HR)...the Rays have allowed 1+ HR in a season-high 11 straight games, the longest active streak in MLB...it marks Tampa Bay's most consecutive games allowing 1+ HR since Sept. 11-22, 2023 (11G)...the Rays last allowed 1+ in 12 straight games from July 27-Aug. 10, 2019 (12G).

STUCK IN NEUTRAL—In 34 games since May 18, only two wins have been credited to a Rays starter: Ryan Pepiot (June 4 at MIA) and Taj Bradley (June 13 vs. CHC).

Tampa Bay starters have a combined 14 wins on the season, third fewest in the majors, ahead of only Colorado and Miami (both 13)...in comparison, Rays relievers have 26 victories, second most in MLB behind Milwaukee (29).

MARINERS ON THE BAY—Tampa Bay and Seattle conclude its three-game set this afternoon at Tropicana Field...the Rays took four of seven games from the Mariners last season, including three straight from Sept. 8-10 at Tropicana Field...since a six-game losing skid to Seattle from June 17-Aug. 3, 2021, the Rays are 12-5 against the Mariners, including a 8-2 mark at home.

CONNECTIONS

- Seattle RHP George Kirby made his MLB debut on May 8, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay (ND, 6.0IP, 4H, OR, 0BB, 7SO).
- Rays Manager Kevin Cash and Mariners Manager Scott Servais are two of the three longest-tenured skipper in MLB...Cash is in his 10th full season, while Servais and LAD Dave Roberts are each in their ninth full seasons at the helm.
- Mariners SS J.P. Crawford is the cousin of Rays Hall of Famer Carl Crawford.
- Seattle C Cal Raleigh and Tampa Bay INF Taylor Walls were teammates at Florida State University (2016-17)...both were selected in the third round of MLB's First-Year Player Draft (Walls-2017, Raleigh-2018).
- David Lowe, the father of Rays OF Josh Lowe, was drafted by the Mariners in the fifth round in 1986 out of Satellite Beach (Fla.) High School, but instead accepted an appointment to the U.S. Naval Academy.
- Seattle Assistant General Manager, Baseball Operations Andy McKay spent one season as a Player/Coach at the University of Tampa and won the 1993 Division II National Championship.
- Tampa Bay RHP Shawn Armstrong spent parts of two seasons (2018-19) with Seattle, going 0-2 with a 3.93 ERA (18.1IP, 8ER) and one save in 18 relief appearances.
- Lou Piniella, who managed the Mariners (1993-2002) and Devil Rays (2003-05), was born in Tampa...was inducted into the Mariners Hall of Fame in 2014.
- Mariners Pitching Coach Pete Woodworth was born in St. Pete and attended Saint Petersburg Catholic High School...was signed by the Rays as a non-drafted free agent in 2010 following his collegiate career at Florida Gulf Coast University.
- Rays RHP Zack Littell was selected by Seattle in the 11th round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft...pitched four seasons (2013-16) in the Mariners minor league system before being dealt to the Yankees on Nov. 18, 2016 for LHP James Pazos.
- Jacob Maton, the younger brother of Rays RHP Phil Maton, was originally selected by the Mariners in the 39th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.

TODAY'S START—Pepiot will take the mound for his 14th start of the season, including his ninth at home...has a 7.07 ERA (14.0IP, 11ER) over his last three starts...is seeking his first home win since April 18 vs. LAA... has recorded a 6.25 ERA (31.2IP, 22ER) since the beginning of May (7GS) compared to a 3.12 ERA (34.2IP, 12ER) in April (5GS)...was on the 15-day IL from May 6-22 (lower left leg contusion) after being struck by a 107.5 mph comebacker on May 5 vs. NYM.

LAST TIME OUT—Pepiot breezed through three frames, allowing only three baserunners (H, BB, HBP), but was unable to escape the 4th inning in his shortest start as a Ray on June 21 at Pittsburgh (ND, 3.1IP, 3H, 2ER, 4BB, 3SO)...allowed five of six batters in the inning to reach base (2H, 3BB)...was lifted after walking **Yasmani Grandal** to load the bases...**Colin Poche** needed only one pitch to produce an inning-ending double play and escape the jam.

NEW FACES—He will be making his first career start against the Mariners... he is 1-1 with a 4.67 ERA (17.1IP, 9ER) across three career starts against AL West opponents, all coming this season at Tropicana Field (April 1 vs. TEX; April 18 vs. LAA; May 29 vs. OAK).

TRAFFIC JAM—He has recorded a 1.55 WHIP over four June starts, allowing opponents to slash .293/.356/.561 (24-for-82) with 6 HR...entering June, those figures stood at a 0.95 WHIP, .175/.256/.319 (28-for-160) opponent slash line and 5 HR through his first nine starts... min. 20.0 IP, his .917 opp. OPS this month is sixth highest in the AL...from Opening Day through the end of May, the .175 opp. average ranked third in the AL while the 0.95 WHIP was fifth (min. 40.0IP).

THIS ISN'T RIGHT—Right-handed hitters have given Pepiot trouble over his four June starts, hitting .310/.356/.524 (13-for-42) with 3 HR...entering June, he had held righties to a .160/.213/.272 (13-for-81) clip with 2 HR over his first nine starts, ranking among AL leaders vs. RHH in that span (min. 75AB) in opp. average (2nd), opp. on-base pct. (2nd) and opp. slugging pct. (4th).

BARREL BARRAGE—Pepiot has allowed a 16.7 pct. barrel rate and 50.0 pct. hard-hit rate over his last three starts (since June 10) compared to a 7.9 pct. barrel rate and 38.6 pct. hard-hit rate in his first 10 outings...a "barrel" is defined as a batted ball with an ideal combination of exit velocity and launch angle.

THINK FAST—Pepiot has held opponents to a 15-for-117 (.128) clip on his four-seam fastball, recording 45 of his 75 strikeouts (60.0%) on the pitch... the .128 average is the lowest mark on any individual pitch in the majors (min. 85AB ending with pitch), outpacing STL **Sonny Gray's** sweeper (.129) and CLE **Tanner Bibee's** slider (.135)...opponents are 9-for-44 (.205) against the four-seamer across Pepiot's last four starts compared to .082 (6-for-73) in his first nine.

✦ He has produced a 33.3 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the highest mark on any MLB starter's fastball (min. 100 swings, starts only), ahead of WSH **DJ Herz's** four-seamer (32.7%).

✦ He has yielded 5 HR on the four-seamer, his most on any pitch...four of the last seven hits he has allowed against it have been HR.

✦ While opponent are hitting .128 against his four-seamer, they are a combined 36-for-118 (.305) against his other two primary pitches, his slider and changeup.

WHIFF YOU PLEASE—Pepiot's 30.3 pct. whiff rate ranks fifth in the AL behind DET **Jack Flaherty** (34.2%), CWS **Garrett Crochet** (32.6%), KC **Cole Ragans** (32.4%) and DET **Tarik Skubal** (31.7%) and 10th in the majors...he had a 32.7 pct. whiff rate prior to his IL stint (7GS) compared to 27.4 pct. since his return (5GS).

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.73 ERA (36.1IP, 7ER) and 0.83 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to an 8.10 ERA (29.0IP, 27ER) and 1.50 WHIP in all other frames...Pepiot has not allowed a run in the 2nd inning, limiting opponents to 3-for-40 (.075) with 15 SO.

THIRD TIME'S (NOT) THE CHARM—Pepiot is holding opponents to a .195 average (40-for-205) the first two times through the order, including .173 (17-for-98) the second time through...when navigating a lineup for the third time, opponents are 24-for-82 (.324) with 6 HR against him.
