YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles were shut out for the second time in four games and third in their last eight, 10-0, by the Giants...Keegan Akin threw 2.2 scoreless innings while Burch Smith tossed 2.0 perfect frames...O's batters struck out 15 times, second most this season (16, 5/26 at CWS).

WHAT'S TRENDING: Baltimore holds the top AL Wild Card spot ahead of the Royals (+2.5 games) and Twins (+4.0 games)...The Orioles have the tiebreaker with Kansas City (4-2) and need to win one of the final three matchups with Minnesota (3-0) to end the season from September 27-29 to clinch the tiebreaker between the teams...The O's have lost four of their last five games and seven of nine and fallen 4.0 games behind the Yankees in the AL East...The Birds are 31-36 (.463) since July 1, 26-29 (.473) since the All-Star break, and 19-23 (.452) since August 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 185-128 (.591), the best record in the AL and tied for the second-best winning percentage in MLB with the Braves, trailing the Dodgers (.604, 189-124), during that time.

**OPENING STATEMENTS:** The Baltimore rotation has a 2.89 ERA (26 ER/81.0 IP) in 14 September starts...0's starters have posted a 2.31 ERA (9 ER/35.0 IP) in six games since September 10...Last night was only the second time in the last 10 games since September 6 that a starter surrendered more than three runs in a game...For the season, the rotation for the Birds has a 3.82 ERA (350 ER/824.2 IP), sixth best in MLB behind the Mariners (3.43), Royals (3.54), Braves (3.67), Phillies (3.68), and Tigers (3.70).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 218 home runs behind the Yankees (222)...The Dodgers (211) rank third...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 79 home runs since, tied for 14th in MLB...The 0's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and this year are the most by the club since 2017 (232).

② Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: Anthony Santander (41), Gunnar Henderson (37), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman (19), Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullins (15), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (13), and Ramón Urias (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

③ Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (53) and Juan Soto (40); the 0's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trunbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

③ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (14); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind Brady Anderson, who hit all 12 for the club in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the 0's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shorstop (11th occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x. 1988-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x. 1957-60)...He passed Cal Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004), who held the O's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season...With three more long balls and one more stolen base, he would be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with Brady Anderson (50 HR, 21 SB) in 1996.

(b) He was named the AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; Henderson slashed. 4177. 4647.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.

(c) Henderson's 113 runs scored are tied for third in the AL and fourth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since 1996, when Roberto Alomar set the club record with 132; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

(c) He's on pace to score 121 times; Alomar, Frank Robinson (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

(d) He ranks tied for third in the AL and MLB with 7.7 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr., set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have ended a season with at least 7.0 fWAR in a season and four 0's (six occurrences) have ended a season with at least 7.0 fWAR in a season and four 0's (six occurrences) have finished with an 8.0 fWAR in one year.

(d) Henderson has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind Brady Anderson (35) in 1996.

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander is the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since Mark Trumbo in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

(b) He's five RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since Jonathan Schoop (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is Bobby Bonilla (116) in 1996.

(c) Santander has hit 32 home runs since the start of June, two behind Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and one behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge and for the most in MLB during that time; his 41 home runs rank third in MLB behind Judge (53) and Ohtani (48).

(d) His 102 home runs since the start of 2022 are tied for sixth in MLB during that time and for second in the AL with Houston's Yordan Alvarez, behind only Judge (152).

(d) He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Eddie Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Boog Powell (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Jim Gentile (2, 1961-62).

HOLY COWSER: Colton Cowser leads AL rookies and is tied for third among MLB rookies with 20 home runs with Chicago-NL's Michael Busch, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (24) and Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio (21)...He's the 10<sup>th</sup> rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since Gunnar Henderson (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in 0's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023... Among rookies, Cowser is second in the AL and fifth in MLB with 3.6 fWAR, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (4.7), Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (3.9), Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio (3.7), and New York-AL's Austin Wells (3.7)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1<sup>st</sup>, 70), extra-base hits (2<sup>nd</sup>, 46), walks (2<sup>nd</sup>, 49), total bases (2<sup>nd</sup>, 201), RBI (3<sup>rd</sup>, 62), doubles (3<sup>rd</sup>, 23), OPS (3<sup>rd</sup>, 761), and slugging percentage (4<sup>th</sup>, 437).

(b) His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other 0's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

**THE FINAL HOMESTAND:** Baltimore began its final homestand of the regular season last night with the first of three games with the Giants through Thursday...The homestand finishes with three games against the Tigers beginning Friday...The Birds are 42-34 (.553) at Camden Yards this season, but 13-17 (.433) at Oriole Park since the beginning of July...The Orioles are 91-66 (.580) at home since 2023.

**AGAINST THE GIANTS:** The Orioles and Giants meet for their only series of the season this week... Baltimore won two of three at Oracle Park last season from June 2-4...Entering this series, the 21 games against San Francisco were tied for the fewest against one opponent along with Cincinnati, Los Angeles-NL, and St. Louis...Only seven of those games have come at Camden Yards, fewest by any

opponent.  $\theta_{\rm A}$  The Birds are 19-25 (.432) against the NL this season.

**GETTING VIRTUAL:** Major League Baseball's virtual ballpark will host interactive watch parties for select regular season matchups every Wednesday in September, including the Giants vs. Orioles tonight... Fans from around the world can access the virtual ballpark for free on any internet-connected device at <a href="mailto:mlb.com/virtual-ballpark">mlb.com/virtual-ballpark</a>, simply by logging in with their MLB account.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...He is one win away from 400 for his career, all with Baltimore...Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), **Paul Richards** (517), and **Hank Bauer** (407).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Orioles recalled right-handed pitcher Bryan Baker from Triple-A Norfolk and designated righty Craig Kimbrel for assignment...The O's 40-man roster currently has 37 players.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision on September 11 at Boston after allowing two runs (1 ER) on five hits and two walks with seven strikeouts in a season-high-tying 7.0 innings...Tossed his ninth quality start of the season; has thrown back-to-back quality outings...Retired each of the final 10 batters faced...Threw 103 pitches and a season-high-tying 70 strikes.

**AGAINST THE GIANTS:** Slated to make his second career start against San Francisco...Earned the win in his sole appearance against the Giants on June 2, 2023 at Oracle Park; allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR) and two walks with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

**AGAINST THE NL WEST:** Has gone 1-3 with a 5.12 ERA (18 ER/31.2 IP) in six starts against the NL West in his career...ls 0-2 with a 4.80 ERA (8 ER/15.0 IP) against the division this year; NL West foes are slashing .274/.329/.403 (17-for-62) off Kremer this season.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Is 3-4 with a 4.28 ERA (26 ER/54.2 IP) in 10 starts at Oriole Park compared to 4-5 with a 3.94 ERA (28 ER/64.0 IP) in 12 road starts this season...Has pitched to a 2-0 record with a 2.00 ERA (4 ER/18.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts to 7 walks in his last three home starts since July 27.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Earned the win on September 28 vs. Boston, clinching the AL East...Collected his 300<sup>th</sup> career strikeout on September 17 vs. Tampa Bay, matching Chuck Estrada and Daniel Cabrera as the fifth-fastest Orioles by appearances (69) to reach the mark...Kremer pitched to a 5-1 record with a 3.09 ERA (28 ER/81.2 IP) and seven quality starts in his final 15 outings last season...Logged four straight quality starts from August 10-29, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic; made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaragua in Pool Play on March 12, 2023 at loanDepot park in Miami (4.0 IP, 3 H, BB, K).
