Scoring

The Braves have scored one run-or-fewer in back-to-back games for the third time this season, and for the first time since May 23-24 versus Washington.

Prior to this downturn, Atlanta had scored 46 runs in its previous six games.

The Braves' 63 runs scored in July still rank as the second most in baseball behind Colorado (68). The team's 18 home runs this month rank fourth in MLB behind Washington, New York-AL and Miami.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and St. Louis Cardinals conclude their pre-All-Star break slate today, also finishing the season series against one another...The Cardinals took two-of-three games at Truist Park from June 30-July 1 and have taken the first two games of this series, securing the season set.

 The Braves out-hit St. Louis last night, 6-5, but still fell to the Cardinals, 4-1...RHP Owen Murphy covered 3.0 scoreless innings in relief.

 Atlanta has lost the season set to St. Louis for just the second time since 2018...They went 2-4 against the club in 2024...Since 2018, the Braves have played to a 29-20 (.592) record against the Cardinals – the second-best record of any National League club behind Philadelphia (27-18, .600).

 The Braves are 15-8 (.652) at Busch Stadium since 2018, the best record of any NL club in that span.

 RH Dustin May has faced the Braves four times in his career, including July 2 at Truist Park when he surrendered five earned runs in 0.2 of an inning...He was removed with a right ankle contusion...All-time, the 6-foot-6, 180-pound right-hander from Justin, TX, is 0-2 against Atlanta with a 8.78 ERA (13 ER/13.1 IP).

JR RITCHIE: Atlanta's preseason No. 2 prospect (*MLB.com*) is set to follow Danny Young and make his 12th appearance of the season with a 1-2 record and a 4.60 ERA (23 ER/45.0 IP)...The right-hander has never faced the Cardinals.

 The 23-year-old hasn't allowed a home run in his last 12.1 innings pitched, dating to the third inning versus San Francisco on June 17.

 Ritchie, a native of Seattle, WA, has pitched to a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/9.1 IP) as a reliever and a 5.55 ERA (22 ER/35.2 IP) as a starter...He has posted a 3.21 ERA his first time through the order, but a 5.23 mark afterward.

RILEY IN ST. LOUIS: Austin Riley went 1-for-4 last night...His batting average at Busch Stadium (.338) is his best of any venue (min. 5 games)...Across 18 career contests in these confines, he's slashing .338/.400/.559 (23-for-68) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and a .959 OPS.

 Riley has hit in 16 of the 18 games he's played in Busch Stadium, including in each of the last 11...He has collected at least four hits in four of the six previous series he's played here.

 Riley's 11-game hitting streak at Busch Stadium is the second-longest active in the majors...Juan Soto is riding a 12-game hitting streak in St. Louis.

 On April 3, 2023, Riley belted the longest home run of his career here (473 feet)...Since that date, the homer is tied for the second longest by a Brave behind Travis d'Arnaud (474 ft)..Drake Baldwin matched Riley's distance this season on June 16.

THE SERIES: Atlanta today will attempt to stave off its second series sweep of the season...To this point, just one MLB club has been swept fewer times: Los Angeles-NL (0)...The Braves, Guardians and Brewers have each been swept once.

 The Braves were previously swept in three games at San Diego from June 22-24...Last season, Atlanta had been swept six times heading into the All-Star break.

MAURICIO DUBÓN: Plated the only run for Atlanta last night with his seventh-inning, solo home run...The longball marked Dubón's 10th of the season, already matching his career high...He went deep 10 times for Houston in 2023 to establish the mark.

 The San Pedro Sula, Honduras, native has already surpassed his previous career highs in bWAR (2.8), RBI (51) and walks (25).

 Additionally, Dubón is pacing to set career highs in hits (164), doubles (34), triples (4), OPS (.749) and total bases (259).

 According to Statcast, Dubón's fielding run value of seven is tied for the 10th best in the National League...The utility player has appeared in left field (50 games), shortstop (37 games), center field (14 games), third base (4 games) and designated hitter (1 game).

MLB DRAFT: The 2026 MLB Draft began yesterday, with the Braves holding a pair of first-round selections...The club took five total players in the first five rounds: OF AJ Gracia, OF Carter Beck, RHP Kaiden McCarthy, RHP Jensen Hirschhorn and RHP Cole Dennis...The draft will continue today with rounds 5-20.

 Gracia attended the University of Virginia and finished his collegiate career with more walks (152) than strikeouts (129) and posted a 1.000 OPS-or-higher in each of his three seasons.

 Beck attended Indiana State University and reached base in 39 straight games from March 13-May 16...He recorded 28 multi-hit games...The outfielder also attended the MLB Draft Combine last month, where he held two of the top eight hit distances among all prospects (438 ft., 466 ft.).

 McCarthy, a 17-year-old from Vermont Academy (VT), throws a fastball that has been clocked as high as 99 mph...He was named the Gatorade Vermont POY after posting a 0.72 ERA as a senior.

 Hirschhorn, a 6-foot-7 right-hander from Kingsburg High School (HS) posted a 1.07 ERA across four seasons at the varsity level...His scouting report mentions a fastball that sits 96 mph, an above-average slider and a changeup.

 Dennis, 17, attended Bishop Snyder High School (FL) and attended the MLB Draft Combine in June...At the showcase, he demonstrated a 96-mph fastball with an 85-mph slider, as well as a changeup.

Makes the fourth outing out of the bullpen of his career and 11th appearance in the finale of a three-game series at St. Louis, Atlanta's final game before the All-Star break.
- 🔥

Is set to face the Cardinals for the first time in his career...The 6-foot-2, 185-pound Bainbridge Island, Washington native has previously appeared against Washington, Detroit, Seattle, Chicago (NL), Miami, New York (NL), San Francisco, San Diego and Pittsburgh.
- 🔥

Has gone 1-2 with a 4.60 ERA (23 ER/45.0 IP) and 42 strikeouts over 10 major league appearances (seven starts) this season.
- 🔥

Has not made a start since June 23 at San Diego...Has worked twice out of the Atlanta bullpen in the interim, allowing one run over 4.1 innings (2.08 ERA) with five strikeouts...Also made one start for Triple-A Gwinnett on June 27.
- 🔥

Recorded the first save of his career July 4 against New York (NL), tossing 3.0 scoreless innings on three hits with four strikeouts in a 14-3 win.
- 🔥

Matched his career high with seven strikeouts in his most recent start June 23 at San Diego...Also fanned seven in his April 23 debut against Washington.
- 🔥

Has held right-handed hitters to a .190 average (12-for-63) with one home run this season...Left-handers are batting .250 (26-for-104) with six homers.
- 🔥

Became the seventh starter in Atlanta-franchise history (since 1966) to allow five hits or fewer in each of his first four career outings (minimum 20.0 innings), and the first since Hurston Waldrep across 2024-25.
- 🔥

Became the first pitcher in Atlanta history (since 1901) to complete at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than two runs and striking out at least seven in his Major League debut.
- 🔥

Was the first Atlanta pitcher to start his career with at least 12.0 innings pitched over his first two outings since Darius Vines (12.0 IP, 2023).

- 🔥

Became the 12th Washington-state native to appear for the franchise, and the first since Dana Eveland on April 7, 2015.
- 🔥

Opponents are batting .152 (5-for-33) with no home runs against his sinker this season...The pitch has produced a ground ball in 19 of the 33 at-bats it has ended, and those grounders have yielded two hits (.105).
- 🔥

Worked with a six-pitch mix this season with Triple-A Gwinnett, leading with a four-seam fastball (27 percent usage, 93.7 mph average) and complementing it with a changeup (21), curveball (18), sinker (14), sweeper (12) and cutter (8).

Worked 1.1 innings of relief July 9 at Pittsburgh, allowing one run on two hits with two walks and one strikeout in Atlanta's 10-5 win at PNC Park.
- 🔥

Earned the first save of his career July 4 against New York (NL), tossing 3.0 scoreless innings on three hits with one walk and four strikeouts in a 14-3 victory at Truist Park.
- 🔥

Received a no-decision June 23 at San Diego, charged with five runs (four earned) on five hits over 5.0 innings with four walks and seven strikeouts on 98 pitches in Atlanta's 7-6, 10-inning loss at Petco Park...The seven strikeouts matched his career high...All five runs scored in a five-run second inning.

Took the loss June 17 against San Francisco in the nightcap of a doubleheader, charged with five earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings with three walks and four strikeouts on 90 pitches in Atlanta's 7-5 defeat at Truist Park...A leadoff solo home run by Adames, a two-run drive by Arraez and a solo shot by Eldridge all came in a four-run second inning...The three long balls set a career high, surpassing his previous mark of two...Held San Francisco hitless from the third inning on after the Giants went 5-for-10 over the first two frames.
- 🔥

Worked 5.0 scoreless innings in his first Major League relief appearance June 12 at New York (NL), allowing two hits with two walks and five strikeouts on 73 pitches in Atlanta's 7-5 loss at Citi Field.
- 🔥

Became the only pitcher in the Atlanta era (since 1966) to throw at least 5.0 scoreless innings while allowing two hits or fewer in his first career relief appearance within his first six career games.
- 🔥

Took the loss in his fifth career start May 18 at Miami, charged with six runs (five earned) over 4.0 innings on five hits and one walk with four strikeouts on 83 pitches in Atlanta's 12-0 defeat at loanDepot park.
- 🔥

Earned the victory in his Major League debut April 23 against Washington, working 7.0 innings of two-run ball with two walks and seven strikeouts on 89 pitches in the 7-2 win at Truist Park...The two runs came on solo home runs by James Wood leading off the first and CJ Abrams with one out in the fourth.
