BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a six-game road trip tonight at Tropicana Field, having dropped three of their last four...Baltimore and Tampa Bay will meet five times in the next nine days, with the Rays coming to Camden Yards from May 25-27.

☞ Last night's 16-6 defeat marked Baltimore's fourth double-digit loss of the season, including its second in three games (5/16 at WSH; L, 13-3)...It was the O's largest margin of defeat at Tropicana Field since a 10-0 loss on August 17, 2021.

☞ The O's 18 hits allowed were their most in a game since August 29, 2025 at San Francisco (also 18).

☞ **Weston Wilson** became the first Oriole to homer in the same game that he pitched since **Zack Britton** on July 3, 2011 at Atlanta.

☞ The O's 12 hits last night were their most on the road this season...They have 10+ hits in three straight road games for the first time since a three-game run from June 19-21, 2024...They have not done so in four straight since September 2-9, 2023 (7 G).

☞ The Birds have hit multiple home runs in three straight road games for the first time since a three-game run from June 5-7, 2025...They look to do so in a fourth consecutive contest in a single season for the first time since July 6-20, 2024 (also 4 G).

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the Orioles selected the contract of **RHP Albert Suárez** from Triple-A Norfolk, optioned **RHP Cameron Foster** to Triple-A Norfolk, and designated **C Maverick Handley** for assignment.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .389/.421/.639 (14-for-36) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, eight runs, and seven RBI during his career-best 10-game hitting streak...The 10-game stretch is the longest by an Oriole this season and is the longest active streak in the majors.

☞ He has scored a run in a career-best five straight games, tied with three others for the second-longest active run in MLB behind CLE's Angel Martínez (6 G).

☞ In 21 games since April 20, Basallo is 28-for-73 (.384) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 runs, and 13 RBI.

LOUD CONTACT: In four games since May 15, the O's have recorded an MLB-best 42 batted balls hit at 100.0+ mph, ahead of the Nationals (36) and Diamondbacks (34).

☞ **Jeremiah Jackson's** nine such batted balls during that period lead MLB ahead of ATL's **Drake Baldwin** (8), while **Gunnar Henderson** has seven and **Pete Alonso** has six.

TROUBLESOME TWO'S: Oriole pitching has allowed opponents to slash .258/.352/.418 (140-for-543) and a .770 OPS with two outs...The .770 OPS is the fourth-highest mark in the majors ahead of the Astros (.790), White Sox (.785), and Reds (.775)

☞ In last night's loss, the Rays went 7-for-14 (.500) with one double, one triple, eight RBI, four walks, and one strikeout with two outs.

☞ Baltimore hurlers own a .560 opponent OPS with two strikes, the fourth-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.591), Houston (.587), and Washington (.581).

SECOND-INNING STRUGGLES: Baltimore has been outscored 42-14 in the second frame this season...The 42 runs allowed are the most by any club in the majors with the next closest being San Diego (34), while the 14 runs scored are tied for seventh fewest.

☞ Overall, the Birds have been outscored 93-50 (-43) from innings 1-3...From innings 4-6, the O's are deadlocked with their opponents, 87-87...From the seventh frame on, they have been outscored, 85-74 (-11).

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: Oriole pitching has allowed opposing right-handed hitters to bat .288, the highest clip in MLB, with the next closest club being the Rockies (.269)...Opposing righties have also posted an .817 OPS, the highest mark in the majors with the next closest being the Astros (.786).

☞ Left-handers have hit .245 against the Birds, the 13th-highest mark in MLB, while their .752 OPS is seventh highest.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (1st, 45), doubles (T-1st, 15), times on base (T-2nd, 90), and on-base percentage (4th, .419).

☞ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

☞ His 90 times on base are the third most in a players' first 47 games to begin his time with the Orioles, trailing **Roberto Alomar** (102 in 1996) and **Frank Robinson** (95 in 1966).

☞ Ward has seen 971 total pitches this season, most in the majors ahead of WSH's **James Wood** (953) and ATH's **Nick Kurtz** (929)...An MLB-best 364 of those pitches have come in a 3-2 count.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20.0 IP) with two hits, seven walks, and 24 strikeouts across 21 appearances to begin the season.

☞ Garcia has faced 32 right-handed hitters, holding them hitless (0-for-29) with three walks...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the 32 right-handed batters faced without a hit allowed is the longest season-opening streak in franchise history (since 1954), surpassing **Eddie Watt** (29 BF) in 1967.

☞ Overall, his .033 (2-for-61) opponent average and 0.45 WHIP are the best among MLB relievers.

☞ Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 21 outings of a season was eight, shared by **Andrew Miller** (2014), **Brian Matusz** (2013), **Armando Benítez** (1998), and **Jesse Orosco** (1997)...**Yennier Cano**, however, has surpassed each of them, having allowed only seven hits across his 21 outings in 2026.

☞ Garcia's 40.6 percent whiff rate is third highest in the majors (min. 20.0 IP) behind SD's **Mason Miller** (56.1%) and NYY's **Fernando Cruz** (43.0%).

'PEN PALS: Baltimore has an 18.6 percent inherited runners scored rate (11 IRS/59 IR), second best in the majors behind Seattle (14.0%; 7 IRS/50 IR)...The Orioles posted a 27.6 percent rate last season, ranking eighth in MLB.

☞ **Rico Garcia** has stranded all 12 of his runners, the best mark in MLB ahead of LAA's **Sam Bachman** and TOR's **Louis Varland** (both 7.1%, 1-for-14).

☞ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 10th start of the season and 77th of his career tonight at Tampa Bay...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradish earned his second victory of the season on May 13 vs. New York-AL after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings on one hit, three walks, and one wild pitch with seven strikeouts...Struck out at least seven batters for the fourth time this season and for the first time in consecutive starts since September 15-28, 2025, when he did so in three straight...Threw 100 pitches, 60 strikes.

- ⌚ Marked his third career start working 6.0+ innings and allowing one or zero hits, joining June 8, 2024 at Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K) and May 26, 2024 at Chicago-AL (7.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 11 K).
- ⌚ Completed at least 6.0 innings against the Yankees for the third time in nine career starts (last: 9/21/25, also 6.0 IP).

TAMPA ON MY MIND: Bradish is set to make his eighth career start against the Rays, having gone 2-3 with a 5.94 ERA (24 ER/36.1 IP)...In his three starts at Tropicana Field, he is 2-1 with a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts against three walks...Last pitched at Tropicana Field on June 8, 2024, when he earned the win with 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with zero walks and nine strikeouts.

- ⌚ Is 6-14 with a 5.28 ERA (97 ER/165.1 IP) over 34 career starts vs. the AL East... Snapped a three-decision losing streak against the division in his last start on May 13 vs. New York-AL.
- ⌚ His 2.12 ERA at Tropicana Field is his lowest mark at any opposing ballpark in the AL East, ahead of Yankee Stadium (4.13), Rogers Centre (6.10), and Fenway Park (13.50).

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 53.9 percent first-pitch strike rate, the fourth-lowest mark in the majors (min. 45.0 IP), ahead of SF's Tyler Mahle (52.4%), NYY's Max Fried (52.9%), and LAA's Jack Kochanowicz (53.7%)...However, he's recorded a 61.2% (30/49) first-pitch strike rate over his last two starts since May 8.

⌚ In his six starts last season, Bradish posted a 63.5 percent first-pitch strike rate.

WALK DON'T RUN: Bradish's 12.1 percent walk rate this season is the highest of his career (9.2%; 2024) and is the fourth-highest mark in the majors (min. 45.0 IP) ahead of ATH's Luis Severino (12.9%), KC's Kris Bubic (12.6%), and MIA's Eury Pérez (12.2%)... His 25 walks in nine starts this season are his most over any nine-game span in his career with the next closest being 23 walks, which has been done twice (last: 9/21/25-5/2/26).

BREAKDOWN: Bradish's 45.6 percent whiff rate on his curveball is the third-best mark in the majors (min. 35 AB) behind HOU's Spencer Arrighetti (50.0%) and ATH's Scott Barlow (47.6%)...Last season, he recorded a 46.9 whiff rate on his curve.

⌚ On his slider, his .480 slugging percentage is the fourth-highest mark in the majors (min. 50 AB ending in the pitch) ahead of SEA's Logan Gilbert (.604), STL's Matthew Liberatore (.529), and MIA's Janson Junk (.490)...Opponents slashed .063/.063/.156 (2-for-32) off his slider with one home run in 2025.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his third consecutive loss on May 15 at Washington after tossing 7.0 innings of three-run ball on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with four strikeouts...Marked his first quality start since September 1, 2025 vs. Seattle (6.0 IP, 0 R)...Has allowed a home run in four straight games, tied for the second-longest streak of his career behind a seven-gamer from May 1-June 4, 2025.

vs. TAMPA BAY: Baz is set to make his first career start opposite Tampa Bay, where he spent the first four seasons of his major league career from 2021-25...Holds a 7-4 record and 3.31 ERA (39 ER/106.0 IP) over 21 career starts vs. the AL East...Suffered the loss in his only outing against the division this season on May 4 at New York-AL (5.2 IP, 6 R, 5 ER).
