**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their two-city, six-game road trip to Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (2-0) with the final game of a three-game series against the Athletics in what could be their final visit to the Oakland Coliseum. St. Louis won 3-2 last night and has won two in a row, matching their season-high win streak. Following today's game, the Cardinals will fly to St. Louis for an Open Date tomorrow before opening a six-game homestand against their National League Central Division rivals, the Milwaukee Brewers (April 19-21) and defending National League Champion Arizona Diamondbacks (April 22-24). St. Louis will play 19 of their first 28 games against teams who made the 2023 Postseason.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals open today's schedule in 5th place in the National League Central, 2.0 games out of first place behind Milwaukee (10-6) and Pittsburgh (11-7). St. Louis has been at .500 six times this season and a season-best one game over .500 (5-4) on April 6.

**SWEEP-STAKES:** With a win today, the Cardinals could earn their first sweep of the season and since July 17-19, 2023 vs. Miami at Busch Stadium. Their last road sweep was May 12-14, 2023, at Fenway Park against the Boston Red Sox. The Cardinals last swept the Athletics in 2004 in a three-game series at Busch Stadium II. A win would give them a winning record at the Oakland Coliseum.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Cardinals won their third series of the season taking the first two games of this series. They took the first two games at the San Diego Padres (April 1-3) and the following series vs. the Miami Marlins (April 4-7) in St. Louis. The Cardinals didn't win their 3rd series of the 2023 season until May 8-10 against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field.

**THE LAST ACT:** So far this season, the Cardinals are 0-5 in the series finale. This is the 7th instance the club as lost the final game of a series (more than one game) for at least their first five series of the season in club history. The last time this occurred was 1997 with the longest streak in 1898 dropping the final game of the series in their first eight. -Elias Sports Bureau

**PERFECT SAVE:** With a 1-2-3 inning last night for his Major League-leading 7th save of the season, **Ryan Helsley** recorded his 5th one innings perfect save. Last season, Helsley had five perfect saves of his 14 total on the season and has matched last season's total by April 16 (18th game of the season).

**HOLD'EM UP HIGH:** **JoJo Romero** and **Andrew Kittredge** each have seven Holds this season, leading all Major League Baseball relievers. Prior to this season, Romero's single season high was four in 2020 with the Phillies, while Kittredge matched his single-season high with the Rays from his All-Star season in 2021, also with seven.

**CALIFORNIA DREAMIN':** This year, the St. Louis Cardinals will play road series at all five California-based organizations. The 'Birds opened the season with the Los Angeles Dodgers (March 28-31), then drove down the Golden State Freeway to play the San Diego Padres (April 1-3). Today starts a series with the Oakland Athletics. May 13-15, the Cardinals will travel to Orange County with a series with the Los Angeles Angels. Finally, the Cardinals conclude the 2024 regular season across the Bay at the San Francisco Giants (Sept. 27-29).

**DAY TRIPPER:** The Cardinals are playing their ninth day game of the season, making up 47% of their contests. This season, St. Louis is 2-6 in the daytime, while the Athletics are 5-4. Last season, the Cardinals were 29-25 in day tilts while the Athletics were 14-52. Oakland plays 37 day games at home this season to the Cardinals scheduled 34 road games.

**A CASE OF THE WILLIES:** With a 7th inning single last night, Cardinals catcher **Willson Contreras** extended his career-high for on-base streak with 22. Dating back to September 6, 2023, Contreras' mark ranks T-2nd in MLB with the suspended **Noelvi Marte** (CIN, 22) and trailing only **Christian Yelich** (MIL, 23). Yelich has sat out the last three games. Contreras has also matched his career-high with a 10-game hit streak.

**MAKING A SACRIFICE:** Through 18 games this season, the Cardinals have dropped six sacrifice bunts, with **Michael Siani** leading Major League Baseball with three. Last season, the Cardinals dropped 13 all of the 2023 season and only five in 2022. The Cardinals ranked T-3rd in MLB with 40 sacrifice bunts in 2021. The Cardinals are also tied for the MLB lead with 10 sacrifice flies joining the Los Angeles Dodgers and Cleveland Guardians.

**Sonny Gray** was selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#18) of the 2011 MLB Draft...pitched parts of his first five seasons with the Athletics (2013-17) before traded to the Yankees with international bonus slot money for **Dustin Fowler**, **James Kaprielian**, and **Jorge Mateo** (July 31, 2017).

**Andrew Kittredge** made his MLB Debut vs. the Athletics (July 18, 2017 at Oakland)...fanned **Jacob Brugman** (swinging) for his first batter faced.

**Brandon Crawford** was born in Mountain View, Calif., moved to Pleasanton in his youth and was a 2005 graduate of from Foothill High School.

**Tommy Edman** played college baseball at Stanford University (2014-16).

**Daniel Descalso** was born in Redwood City, Calif...graduated from Saint Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at University of California, Davis (2005-07)...resides in Danville, Calif.

**Willie McGee** played 29 games for the Athletics in 1990 and a member of their AL Championship squad...traded by St. Louis to Oakland for **Daryl Green**, **Felix Jose**, and **Stan Royer**...was born in San Francisco, Calif...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo...resides in Hercules.

**Dean Kiekhefer** pitched in four games for Oakland during the 2018 season.

**T.J. McFarland** pitched in 66 games over two seasons for the Cardinals (2021-22).

Former 1999 Athletics 2nd round draft pick **Ryan Ludwick** and **Jason Isringhausen**, who pitched for the Athletics (1999-2001), are both Cardinals Player Development Special Advisors.

Athletics First Base coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2008-11) and bench coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 National League pennant winner...his son, **Michael Aldrete**, was selected by St. Louis in the 39th round of the 2012 Draft.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

**Brandon Allen** played in 44 games for the Athletics from 2011-12 & was the A's Opening Day 1st baseman in 2012.

Athletics Assistant Athletic Trainer **Brad LaRosa** spent three years in the same role with the Cardinals Springfield (AA) affiliate.

Hall of Famer **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Cardinals Manager of Player Development & Performance **Emily Wiebe** grew up in nearby San Francisco, Calif...attended University High School.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series in both.

...His 70 postseason victories (50 with St. Louis, 19 with Oakland, & 1 with Chicago) rank 2nd to Joe Torre (84)...La Russa piloted the A's to four division titles, three AL pennants, and the 1989 World Championship...is A's franchise wins leader (798)...also played parts of four seasons in Oakland (1968-71).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** played parts of 12 seasons in Oakland (1986-97)...1987 AL Rookie of the Year...1989 World Series Champion & member of three AL pennant winners (1988-90)...eight-time AL All-Star (1987-92, '95-97)...won two Silver Sluggers (1992 & '96) and one Gold Glove (1990)...selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#10) in the 1984 MLB Draft...traded to St. Louis for **Eric Ludwick**, **T.J. Mathews** and **Blake Stein**.

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray**'s son, **Chris Caray**, is an Athletics broadcaster.

Athletic writer **Katie Woo** is a native of Vacaville, Calif...previously covered the Giants, 49ers, & Warriors for NBC Sports Bay Area & California.

Bally Sports Midwest analyst **Al Hrabosky** was born in Oakland, Calif.

Athletics Head Athletic Trainer **Jeff Collins** is a SIU-Edwardsville graduate.

**TODAY'S GAME**

- Making his fourth start of the 2024 season today, his third road start of the year.
- Carries a 5-game win streak from last season into today's game. It's the 2nd longest active MLB win streak over the past two seasons among starters (Max Fried, ATL - 7)
- Has not allowed a HR in his first three starts (15.0 IP) for 1st time career. His longest career homerless stint was over four consecutive starts, four times (most recently 7/20-8/5/23, 23.0 IP).
- The Cardinals are 3-0 as a team in his 1st three games started this season.
- Made his first start of the season against the Dodgers on Sunday Night Baseball in Los Angeles on 3/31 and received a no decision after departing with a 4-2 lead in the 6th.
- Has held left-handed batters to 3-for-15 mark (.200 BA) with the only XBH being a ground-rule double by Shohei Ohtani.
- Opposing batters are 5-for-29 (.172) on two strike counts in his 1st three starts.
- Was 1-1 with a 8.16 ERA in five Spring Training appearances, four starts.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Failed to qualify for win, as he exited after 4.2 IP in start last Fri. (4/12) at Arizona, as D-Backs used a 6-run 5th inning to tie the game at 6-6. The Cardinals won the game, 9-6, and remain a perfect 3-0 in games that Matz has started.

**2023 SEASON**

- Made 25 appearances (17 starts) between the starting rotation and bullpen in 2023
- Limited left-handed batters to a .215/.295/.304 slashline (17-79) with three extra-base hits (two home runs and double).
- Recorded a season-high 17.0 scoreless innings streak from July 20-August 5), longest by a Cardinal pitcher in 2023.
- Opened season making 10 starts in the rotation, starting 0-6 with a 5.72 ERA (50.1 IP) and 45 strikeouts. Received 16 runs of support while St. Louis was 2-8 in those games.
- Moved to the bullpen in late May, and made eight relief appearances, logging a 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts and .224 average against.
- Allowed runs in only three of eight relief appearances, while working 2.0+ IP in four outings.
- As a starter, went 4-6 with a 4.04 ERA (89.0 IP) in 17 starts.
- Pitched 5.0 innings or more in 13-of-17 starts (four quality).
- Hurled career-high 3.1 scoreless innings in relief (3.1) twice, garnering 10 scoreless outs, in London vs. Cubs (6/24) and vs. Astros (6/29).
- Returned to the starting rotation on July 9, finishing his season 4-0 with a 1.86 ERA (8 ER/38.2 IP) and 38 strikeouts in his final seven starts. Held his opposition to two runs or fewer in six of starts, including one run or fewer in five.
- Over that seven-start span from July 9-Aug. 12, ranked among MLB leaders in wins (T-2nd), innings (T-4th), ERA (3rd), average against (.190, T-7th), opponent OPS (.537), WHIP (0.88, 5th), BR/9 (7.91, 3rd), and FIP (2.85, 4th).
- Missed the final 44 games of season due to a left lat strain.

- St. Louis Cardinals 2023 Darryl Kile Award winner.
- Graduated from Ward Melville (NY) High School in 2009. As a senior, threw 44.0 innings, allowing 11 hits with 81 strikeouts.
- Spent a week during the 2015-2016 offseason in Honduras, working with the non-profit group "Hearts 2 Honduras". Helped build a three-room learning center and also played baseball with the youngsters.
- Received the Joan Payson-Shannon Forde Award for Community Service at the 2020 BBWAA Dinner.
- His wife, Taylor Cain, is a Christian Rock music singer with the band Cain.

- Is facing the Athletics for just the 3rd time in his career, and for the first time since the 2021 season (May 3 at the Coliseum) while pitching for Toronto.
- Aside from Toronto, who he has never faced, his two career starts vs. Oakland match his fewest among teams faced (also White Sox, Astros, Padres, Rays & Rangers).
- Is 5-5, 4.36 ERA in 14 career games (12 starts) against AL West clubs, including a 3-3, 4.13 ERA mark in seven road games (6 starts).
- Today mark his 12th career game (10th start) in Interleague play, going 2-4 with a 4.15 ERA in those games with a 1.08 WHIP and .232 Opp. BA.

**CAREER**

- Joined the Cardinals on a four-year contract (2022-25) after previously pitching for the New York Mets (2015-20) and Toronto Blue Jays (2021) organizations.
- Missed 102 games on the Injured List in 2022 with a left shoulder impingement (5/23-7/16) and strained left knee (7/24-9/16). Was activated from his second stint in mid-September and was added to the bullpen where he made five appearances.
- Prior to the 7/23/22 start at Cincinnati, Matz had missed approx. two months with a left shoulder impingement.
