**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants are coming off a 4-2 homestand where they went 2-1 against the Athletics and 2-1 against the Braves.

- ▶ The Giants are 7-5 over their past 12 games having won two straight series, and three of their last four series.
- ▶ SF begins a six-game road trip to Arizona (today-Wednesday) and Colorado (Friday-Sunday)...they are 8-14 against divisional opponents this season, which is the fourth worst intra-division record in the Majors.
- ▶ Giants pitching over their last 12 games has a 2.66 ERA (31er, 105.0ip), the best in the Majors since June 14.

**BEAT THE HEAT:** The Giants have dropped each of their first six games against the Diamondbacks and are 0-6 to start the season for the first time in franchise history...this marks the first time they have dropped the first six games in a single season vs. one opponent since the Giants lost their first seven games vs. the Padres in 2010.

- ▶ SF has been outscored by the Diamondbacks 39-17 (-22) and been out-hit 60-44 (-16) through the first six games of this season series vs. Arizona.

**MALLY TIME:** RHP Tyler Mahle will start the first game of this three game series against the Diamondbacks.

- ▶ He had one of his best starts of the year in his last outing against the Athletics on June 24th at Oracle Park...he came off the Injured List and tossed 5.2-scoreless innings, allowing just two hits in the Giants 2-1 victory over the A's.
- ▶ He faces the Diamondbacks for the eighth time in his career and the second time this season...he's 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA (9er, 10.0ip) and 1.40 WHIP over his two starts against Arizona this year.
- ▶ Mahle has a 3.32 ERA (14er, 38.0ip) in seven games at Oracle Park this season, however he's struggled to a 8.88 ERA (24er, 24.1ip) in five road starts.

**THE STARTING LINE:** Giants starters have been a bright spot for San Francisco as of late...after a rocky start, SF's rotation has a 3.24 ERA in June that is second-best in the Majors behind only the Marlins (3.02).

- ▶ SF starters have posted a 1.13 ERA (5er, 40.0ip) over their last six games and a 2.03 ERA since June 14 (12 games).

**DYNAMIC DUO:** IF Luis Arraez (.324) and OF Jung Hoo Lee (.322) are each hitting at least .320 for the Giants through the team's first 83 games in 2026...they are the first teammate duo to each have a .320+ average through their team's first 83 games in a season (min. 300 PA) since Colorado's Charlie Blackmon and Nolan Arenado in 2019 (STATS, LLC).

**A LIGHTER STRETCH:** The Giants next 22 games are against teams currently under .500...they'll face Arizona (three games), Colorado (seven games), Toronto (three games), Seattle (three games), Kansas City (three games) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).

**PITCHER OF THE MONTH INCOMING?:** RHP Logan Webb fired 7.0 scoreless innings in Saturday's win to lower his June ERA to 0.71 (3er, 38.0ip)...in his five starts this month, he's limited opposing hitters to a .148 clip with a 0.61 WHIP and an opponent's OPS of .370.

- ▶ Webb's 0.71 ERA is the lowest in a calendar month (min. five games started and 35.0 innings pitched) by a Giants starter since Noah Lowry logged a 0.69 ERA in August of 2005...overall Webb's 0.71 ERA this month is sixth-lowest by a Giants starter since 1913...chart courtesy of Elias via Sarah Langs.
- ▶ His 0.71 ERA is the lowest figure in the Majors this month, while his .148 opponents average ranks as the fifth-lowest in MLB.

- ▶ Webb became the first Giants pitcher to have a stretch of five games in which he pitched 38.0 innings and allowed three or fewer earned runs since Matt Cain in 2010...the only other Giants in the last 50 years to do so are Vida Blue and Noah Lowry.

# TYLER MAHLE RHP #54

**2026 RECORD: 1-7, 5.49 ERA**

**FIRST YEAR GIANT:** Is in his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5 and is making his 13th start of the season tonight.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Got a no-decision against the Athletics, which was his first start since May 26 after a stay on the 15-day IL with a left hamstring strain...pitched 5.2 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out four...leads the Giants with four starts of 5.0-or-more shutout innings this season.

**AGAINST ARIZONA:** Is making his eighth career appearance (all starts) against Arizona, and third this season alone... has lost both of his starts against them this year, over which he carries an 8.10 ERA (9er, 10.0ip)...overall, he's 0-3 with career ERA of 3.38 (15er, 40.0ip) against the Diamondbacks.

**HOMEBOY:** Has been pitching much better at home this season... in seven starts at Oracle Park, the righty has a 3.32 ERA (14er, 38.0ip), a .213 BAA and a .662 opponents' OPS...in five starts away from home, he is 0-4 with a 8.88 ERA (24er, 24.1ip), a .356 opposing average and a 1.001 OPS...Mahle's -5.56 difference between his road and home ERA represents the largest ERA differential in the Majors this season (min. 60.0ip)...last season, Mahle had a 0.84 ERA in 10 starts at home and 4.36 ERA in six road starts.

**FAST AND FURIOUS:** Over his last seven starts, opponents are 12-for-66 (.182) with 21 strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seamer...Mahle is throwing his four-seam fastball 48.5% of the time this year, averaging 92.3 mph with batters hitting .250 off the pitch... it leads all of his pitches with a +2 run value.

**PUT IT IN REVERSE:** Has been putting up reverse splits this season, with right handers slashing .333/.419/.523 (.941 OPS) off him while lefties are .222/.270/.413 (.683 OPS)...among right-handed pitchers, his .333 BAA and .941 OPS versus right-handed hitters are both highest in the Majors.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** Is throwing the first pitch of an at-bat for a strike just 55.8% of the time, the lowest of his career and 9% lower than his 64.8% mark last season...his 55.8% first pitch strike rate this season ranks as the 10th-lowest in MLB and third-lowest in the National League.

**ANTI-AGGRESSION:** Despite his low first-strike rate, opponents are still 21-for-23 (.478) with a double, triple and two home runs against Mahle on the first pitch of an at-bat, which is his worst BAA in any count this season besides 2-0 (.571).

**SPLIT ON THE UP?:** Opponents were 0-10 in Mahle's last start off of his main secondary pitch, his split finger...prior to that start, batters were hitting .284 (19x67) with four doubles and three homers off his split, which Mahle has thrown 24.8% of the time...last year, Mahle's splitter was his most valuable pitch, accumulating a +5 run value... he used the pitch 27.7% of the time last year, with opponents hitting just .196 off his split-finger with 25 strikeouts (24.0% whiff rate).

- ▶ Received a no decision in his last start despite a solid outing vs. the A's on June 25...allowed two runs on six hits and a walk while striking out six over 6.0 innings.
- ▶ Will be making his third start vs. the Diamondbacks this season...is 0-1 with a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip) with 10 strikeouts and a 1.36 WHIP in those outings.
- ▶ Has not earned a win since April 26...is 0-6 with a 5.12 ERA (29er, 51.0ip), 58 strikeouts and a 1.55 WHIP over his last 10 starts...the Giants are winless in those 10 starts.
