THE TWINS: Began their six-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games with the Rangers, winning on Tuesday night followed by a loss last night...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale at Globe Life Field...after today's game, the Twins will fly to Philadelphia to play a three-game series against the Phillies at Citizens Bank Park over the weekend to finish the season.

RANGER DANGER: The Twins lost to the Rangers last night at Globe Life Field by a score of 4-2...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run (Josh Smith HR) on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and nine strikeouts...Travis Adams (1-4) was dealt the loss in relief, allowing three runs in the seventh inning...the offense recorded just five hits, two from Edouard Julien...Byron Buxton his his 32nd home run of the season with a leadoff homer, his ninth of the season.

KEASCHALL FOR KEIRSEY: The Twins have placed infielder Luke Keaschall on the 10-day Injured List with a left thumb sprain... Keaschall, who sustained the injury Tuesday night while sliding into second base, hit .302 (55-for-182) with 14 doubles, four home runs, 28 RBI, 19 walks, 14 stolen bases, 25 runs scored and an .827 OPS in 49 games for the Twins this season...to replace Keaschall on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder DaShawn Keirsey Jr...this is Keirsey Jr.'s fifth stint with the Twins this season, going 9-for-83 with two home runs, six RBI, two walks, nine stolen bases and 11 runs scored in 71 games.

COWBOY UP: Twins and Rangers are playing each other for the sixth and final time in 2025... Twins went 1-2 at Target Field vs. the Rangers from June 10-12 and are 1-1 this week... Twins and Rangers will first meet in 2026 for a four-day, three-game series at Globe Life Field from June 15-18, followed by the season series finale from September 25-27 at Target Field.

▼ The Twins are 10-5 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023, 3-1 in 2024 and 1-1 in 2025... since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 20-8 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 14-5 in their last 19.

▼ Byron Buxton is hitting .389 (7-tor-18) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, two walks, a stolen base and a 1.283 OPS in five games against Texas this season.

▼ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with one double, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .694 slugging percentage and a 1.095 OPS in 10 career games at Globe Life Field.

▼ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 14-5 all-time in Arlington, going 4-0 at Globe Life Park and 10-5 at Globe Life Field...his .737 win percentage in this city is his best; Washington, D.C. (2-1, .667) and Toronto (14-7, .667) are next.

ONE-NOTHING: Byron Buxton hit his 18th career leadoff home run last night off Jacob deGrom... he has nine leadoff home runs on the season, tied for third-most in baseball...below are Twins all-time leadoff homers (left) and 2025 MLB leadoff homers (right).

ADDITIONALLY: Last night marked Buck's ninth leadoff homer of the season, breaking a tie with Brian Dozier (8 in 2017) for the second-most single-season leadoff homers in Twins history (since 1961)... Jacque Jones' 11 in 2002 is the club record.

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): With a win today, the Twins will earn their 18th series victory of the season...Minnesota is 17-31-2 in series play, going 11-13-2 at home and 6-18-0 on the road.

♣ Twins last series win against the Rangers was August 15-18, 2024, taking three of four at Globe Life Field.

♣ Twins have won just one series (August 29-31 vs. SD) in their last 12 tries. >>> ♣ Minnesota's last road series win was August 4-6 at Detroit, taking two of three...they are 0-5-0 on the road since.

THE LIGHT WON'T GET ANY GREENER: The Twins have stolen 27 bases in their last 16 games.

♣ Prior to the July 31 trade deadline, Minnesota stole 55 bases, tied for 24th-most in baseball... since August 1, they rank second in baseball with 57 steals.

♣ Christian Vazquez swiped his first base of the season on Juesday night, making him the 17th different Twin to steal a base this season...that ties 2004 team for second-most in a season in Twins history (since 1961)...the team record is 18 separate players with at least one stolen base in 2001...active players on the 28-man roster that need a stolen base still are: Ryan Jeffers, Edouard Julien and Carson McCusker.

STARTER STUFF: Over their last three games, Twins starters have combined to go 1-0, 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER) with four walks, 18 strikeouts and a .138 opponent batting average...on the season, Twins starters have struck out 754 batters, eighth-most in club history...next is the 2018 team with 760.

ROCTEMBER: Twins manager Rocco Baldelli is celebrating his 44th birthday today...Twins are 2-3 on Rocco's birthday...he shares a birthday with actors Michael Douglas, Donald Glover, Bella Ramsey, Will Smith and Mark Hamill, rapper T.I., and former NBA stars Chauncey Billups and Scottie Pippen.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1965**, Jim "Mudcat" Grant threw a complete-game one-hitter, as the Twins defeated the Senators in the first game of a doubleheader...the win marked Grant's 20th of the season, becoming the first African-American pitcher in the American League to win 20 games in a season...in **1985**, Bert Blyleven led the Twins to a 5-1 win in Texas, the 2,000th win in Minnesota history...in **2019**, the Twins celebrated Rocco Baldelli's 38th birthday and first season as the club's manager with an American League Central title, winning 5-1 over the Tigers at Comerica Park (also a White Sox 8-3 win over Cleveland).

RE"GUARD"ING CLEVELAND: Last pitched on September 20 in Game 2 of the doubleheader vs. Cleveland, opposite Logan Allen... he was dealt his ninth loss of the season in Minnesota's 0-8, shutout defeat, tying his single-season career-high losses (9 in 2024)...allowed six runs on eight hits with two walks and a career-low-tying one strikeout in 5.0 innings...all six of his runs allowed came in the fifth inning; an RBI single to Steven Kwan, an RBI single to Kyle Manzardo, a two-run double to Gabriel Arias and an RBI single to C.J. Kayfus...was the second time this season he has allowed six runs in a single inning (also, June 23 vs. Seattle).

The Was his fifth career start in a doubleheader, and first in Game 2 of a doubleheader.

Did not allow a home run for just the third time in his last 15 starts.

Marked the fourth time this season he has given up six-or-more runs in a single game and the eighth time he has allowed eight-or-more hits.

SNAKE OIL: Pitched on September 14 vs. Arizona, opposite Nabil Crismatt, where he was dealt his eighth loss of the season in Minnesota's 4-6 defeat...allowed four runs on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and a season-high nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings...permitted an RBI single to James McCann in the second and a three-run homer to McCann in the fourth.

4 The home run allowed to McCann was Ober's 30th longball allowed this season...he leads the American League in homers and is third in the majors, behind Jake Irvin (35) and Zack Littell (34)...he is just the 26th pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to give up 30-or-more home runs in a single season, and the first since Joe Ryan in 2023 (32).

4 Marked his third 6.0-or-more innings pitched, non-quality start game this season, and sixth of his career (2 in 2024, 1 in 2022).

EVERYTHING'S BIGGER IN TEXAS: Bailey has gone 1-1 in four career starts against the Rangers...has posted a 7.32 ERA (19.2 IP, 16 ER), with seven home runs, 13 walks, 15 strikeouts and a .275 (22-for-80) opponent batting average...his 7.32 ERA is his second-lowest among teams he has faced at least twice, behind the St. Louis Cardinals (12.15)...his 16 total runs given up to Texas are his most among

opponents he has faced six-or-less times.

◆ Last faced Texas on June 12 where he was dealt the loss in Minnesota's 16-3 defeat...allowed seven runs on six hits (career-high 4 HR), with a career-high six walks and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Ober has gone 16-15 with a 4.25 ERA (315.1 IP, 149 ER), 8.90 K/9, 2.17 BB/9 and 1.68 HR/9 in 60 games (59 starts) at home compared to 14-16 with a 4.10 ERA (300.2 IP, 137 ER), 8.71 K/9, 1.71 BB/9 and 1.44 HR/9 in 56 road starts.

◆ Bailey is 3-3, 5.62 ERA (57.2 IP, 36 ER) with 13 home runs, 12 walks, 45 strikeouts and a .314 (76-for-242) opponent batting average in 11 road starts this season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 26 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .280/.317/.493 in 300 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .280/.320/.521 in 261 at-bats..leftise have posted an average exit velocity of 87.2 mph and a whiff rate of 20.1 compared to righties' 91.8 mph and 27.9 percent.

This hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 30.7 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 50.0 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 35.6% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown.
