**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 5-1 (2-1 vs. Chicago-AL and 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games in Cleveland...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the third of four at Progressive Field...they will complete the series tomorrow afternoon then travel to Boston for a three-game series at Fenway Park over the weekend.  
 ☞ Twins are 6-2 in their last eight games and 8-5 in their last 13.  
 ☞ Over the last eight games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +27 (43-16)... they now sit at +7 overall on the season (118-111).

**MANZARD-NOOO!!!!:** The Twins were walked off by the Guardians last night at Progressive Field, losing by a score of 2-1, their first walk-off defeat of 2025...Chris Paddock was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits (1 HR - Naylor) in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...Louis Varland (1-2) was dealt the loss, allowing a walk-off homer to Kyle Manzardo to start the bottom of the ninth inning...the offense recorded seven hits, three from Ty France, who singled twice and homered, his third of the season...the game experienced a three hour and 10 minute weather delay to start, but lasted just 2:17.  
 ☞ Last night's defeat marked the seventh walk-off victory for the Guards over the Twins since the start of 2022 (17 total games).

**DIVISION COLLISION:** The Twins are playing the Guardians today, for the third of 13 games in 2025...after this series, these two will meet again for a three-game series at Target Field from May 19-21...Twins will come back to Cleveland for three games, from August 1-3.  
 ☞ Two more wins in these next two days will give the Twins their first series win over the Guardians since taking two of three from September 4-6, 2023 at Progressive Field.  
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .311 (42-for-135) with seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .396 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and an .892 OPS in 36 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022 (since he joined the Twins).  
 ☞ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 72 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most of any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (91)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 55).

 ☞ Over the last five games, the Twins are hitting .389 (21-for-54) with runners in scoring position.

**EIFFEL POWER:** Ty France has eight hits in 16 at-bats over his last four games, with an extra-base hit in all four...he drove in another run last night, giving him a team-leading 18 on the season...of those 18 RBI, 16 have come in his last 19 games, since April 9...since that date, the 16 RBI rank second in the AL, trailing Spencer Torkelson (17).  
 ☞ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 25 RISP at-bats, his .419 RISP average ranks fifth, trailing Paul Goldschmidt (.444), William Contreras (.429), Teoscar Hernández (.424) and Gavin Lux (.423).  
 ☞ France has posted a 13.3 barrel percentage this season, up 6% from 2024 (7.3%), the 11th best year-to-year increase among AL players.  
 ☞ His MLB percentile rankings in a few categories: 89th in K% (13.4%), 88th in xwOBA (.392), 86th in xBA (.292) and 85th in xSLG (.537).

**C4, IGNITING:** Carlos Correa enters tonight with a season-best five-game hitting streak...a hit tonight would match a season-long for a Twin, done previously by Luke Keaschall and Edouard Julien...during the streak, he is hitting .474 (9-for-19) with a 1.055 OPS...below are his first 18 games (March 27-April 16), compared to his last 11 games (since April 18):

**ROYCE ON REHAB:** Royce Lewis has gone 3-for-9 in three games on his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul...he plans to play nine innings at third base today as the Saints play in Columbus at 5:35 pm (CT)...Royce has missed all 30 games with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.

**BON ANNIVERSAIRE:** Edouard Julien is celebrating his 26th birthday today...he shares a birthday with former Twins reliever Ryan O'Rourke (36)...Eddy has appeared in one major league game on his birthday, coming last season at Chicago-AL, going 0-for-4 with a walk.

- ☞ Making fifth start of the season and 163rd career start...seventh career start against the Guardians.
- ☞ López is 2-2 with a 3.50 ERA (36.0 IP, 14 ER), 12 walks and 25 strikeouts in six career starts against Cleveland.
- ☞ Took the win in Minnesota's 11-4 victory, allowing two runs on five hits, with two walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings against the Angels during his first start since coming off the IL.

**LIFE OF PABLO:** Last pitched on April 25 vs. the Angels at Target Field, opposite Kyle Hendricks...was López's first outing in the majors after coming off the IL...allowed two runs on five hits, two walks and six strikeouts over 5.0 innings...earned his second win of the season - and second in a row - in Minnesota's 11-4 victory...it was the team's first time this season scoring 10-plus runs in a game...seven marked the largest margin of victory for the Twins this season.

- ☞ López's two runs came off an RBI single from Jo Adell, scoring Nolan Scahnnuel in the second and an RBI single from Mike Trout, scoring Jorge Soler.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched for the Twins on April 8 at Kansas City, opposite Cole Ragans, allowing one unearned run on three hits, one walk and six strikeouts over 4.2 innings...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-1 loss...exited the game with two on and two outs in the fifth inning due to a right hamstring strain; in relief, Cole Sands recorded the third out without allowing a run...López was placed on the 15-day Injured List on April 11.

**CLEAN BILL OF HEALTH:** Pitched on April 19 for the Triple-A St. Paul Saints on a rehab assignment against the Iowa Cubs at Principal Park...allowed one run off three hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...took the loss in St. Paul's 0-1 defeat.

- ☞ Until this season, López had not missed a major league game in three years, pitching 32 games in 2022, 2023 and 2024.
- ☞ His last appearance in the minors was in 2021 when he was on rehabilitation assignment with the Triple-A Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp.

**AGAINST THE GUARDS:** In six career starts against Cleveland, López is 2-2, posting a 3.50 ERA (36.0 IP, 14 ER), with 12 walks and 25 strikeouts...allowing 17 runs off 40 hits (1 HR).

- ☞ Went 0-1 in two starts against the Guardians in 2024, posting a 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER), with three walks and six strikeouts...his last outing against the team was September 16, 2024 at Progressive Field where he allowed two runs off eight hits (0 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts.
- ☞ His last win against Cleveland was September 4, 2023 where he allowed one run on eight hits in 6.0 quality innings.
- ☞ Has allowed the highest opponent batting average (.276) to the Guardians among teams he has faced at least five times, second only to the Washington Nationals (.296) whom he has faced 14 times.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 14-8 with a 3.92 ERA (196.1 IP, 84 ER), 10.22 K/9, 1.97 BB/9 and 0.96 HR/9 in 33 starts at home, compared to 16-11 with a 3.52 ERA (217.1 IP, 85 ER), 9.90 K/9, 2.19 BB/9 and 1.28 HR/9 in 37 road starts.

- ☞ In his last five starts on the road, dating back to September 16, 2024, López has gone 1-2, posting a 4.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 12 ER), with five walks and 21 strikeouts; compared to 4-1, 1.11 ERA (32.1 IP, 4 ER), with seven walks and 36 strikeouts in his last five home starts.
- ☞ Pablo is 2-0 in three starts against the Guardians at Progressive Field, posting a 1.45 ERA (18.2 IP, 3 ER), with seven walks and 13 strikeouts...also has a .250 (18-for-72) opponent batting average.
- ☞ 1.45 is his lowest ERA among ballparks where he has pitched at least 18.0 innings...has never allowed a home run or stolen base at Progressive Field...has only allowed three multi-base hits and four total runs.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through four starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .343/.378/.514 in 35 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .160/.192/.200 in 50 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 90.6 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 50.0 compared to righties' 87.3 mph and 25.7 percent.

- ☞ Has a whiff rate of 18.5 and put-away percentage of 16.7 vs. lefties; compared to 27.3 percent and 18.5 percent against righties.
- ☞ His 50.0% hard hit rate against lefties is significantly higher than in previous years, his average from 2018-2024 was 32.8%.
- ☞ His average exit velocity is higher than in recent years at 88.8 mph, compared to 86.8 in the previous seven years.

**COOL UNDER PRESSURE:** With runners in scoring position, López allows a .245 (177-for-722) opponent batting average...with a runner on third, he puts up a .214 (19-for-89) BAA and with runners on second and third, he allows just a .185 (10-for-54) BAA.

**THE ARSENAL:** López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 40% of the time...primarily uses his sweeper, sinker and curveball against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ Ranks in the 91st percentile for extension, 88th for chase % and 87th for BB %.
- ☞ Ranks in the bottom two percent of MLB in Max EV at 116.5 mph.

**PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT:** Pablo historically pitches better the higher his pitch count is...when on pitch 101+, he allows just a .194 (7-for-36) opponent batting average, with five walks, 13 strikeouts and no home runs...on pitch 76-100, he allows a .229 (148-for-702) BAA, with 47 walks, 180 strikeouts and 16 home runs...compared to pitch 1-25 where he allows a .263 (236-for-899) BAA, 54 walks, 230 strikeouts and 40 home runs.

**APRIL FLOWERS:** López has a 3.26 ERA in 32 career games in March/April (the most of any month), with 42 walks, 193 strikeouts and 16 home runs, second only to August where he posts a 3.01 ERA, 39 walks, 140 strikeouts and 18 home runs in 29 games...comparatively, in September/October, he has a 4.68 ERA, 41 walks, 153 strikeouts and 18 home runs in 27 games.

**Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE:** This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund.

**CAREER NOTES**

- In 2025, made his third career Opening Day start, became the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79).
- In 2024, recorded his 800th career strikeout on June 6 at New York-AL, fanning Gleyber Torres in the second inning.
- Tied career high and set 2024 season high with 14 strikeouts on June 23 at Oakland (6.0 IP)...also pitched 8.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and one walk during the start, earning the win in a 3-0 Twins victory.
- Earned 50th career win in 150th career start on August 12, 2024 vs. Kansas City, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts.
- 2023 recipient of Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" Award and Carl R. Pohlad Outstanding Community Service Award.
- Won both 2023 Postseason starts, allowing one run in 12.2 total innings and helping Twins snap 18-game Postseason losing streak with a G1 win in the ALWCS vs. Toronto.
- In 2023, earned first All-Star selection and finished seventh in AL Cy Young Award voting after posting career highs in innings (194.0) and strikeouts (234).
- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as No. 2 starter for Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
