TODAY'S GAME: The Giants look to avoid the sweep at the hands of the Padres as well as clinch a winning homestand by trying to salvage this afternoon's finale.

- ▶ The last time the Giants were swept in a three-game series here at home by the Padres was last year from August 11-13...in fact, the Giants have suffered at least one home sweep at the hands of San Diego in each of the last two seasons and in three of the last four seasons (2023 was the exception).
- ▶ SF needs to win just one of its final 14 games to avoid the second 100-loss season in team history (the club went 62-100 in 1985).

CAKE AND CANDLES: IF Osleivis Basabe turns 26 today.

ROSTER MOVES: OF **Scott Bandura** (#91) was selected from Triple-A Sacramento...he is seeking his Major League debut.

- ▶ In a corresponding move, **IF Rafael Devers** was placed on the 60-day Injured List with a core muscle injury.

ON THE HILL: RHP **Logan Webb** toes the slab for a 27th time this afternoon looking to guide SF back to the win column...today marks the 16th time Webb has taken the hill this year following a Giants' loss the game before...in those 15 starts Webb is 6-3 with a 2.25 ERA (24er, 96.0ip) and a 0.95 WHIP...the Giants as a team in those games are 8-7.

STANDING 0: With **IF Rafael Devers** undergoing season-ending surgery, he wraps up a superb first full season in the city by the bay.

- ▶ Devers' 37 homers fall one shy of his career high (38 in 2021 with Boston) and are the most by a Giant since **Barry Bonds** hit 45 in 2004...his 98 RBI are the fifth-most for him in a single season and most by a Giant since **Hunter Pence** had 99 in 2013.
- ▶ Entering play today, Devers ranks among the NL leaders in doubles (36, T-1st), SLG (.525, 2nd), extra-base hits (74, 2nd), total bases (293, 2nd), RBI (T-4th), homers (5th) and OPS (.865, 8th) and wRC+ (135, 8th).
- ▶ The 29-year-old became the fifth Giants since 1958 (sixth overall) to record a season with at least 36 doubles, 37 homers, 98 RBI, 74 XBH and a .525 SLG...see the chart to the right for others.

GREAT SCOTT!: OF **Scott Bandura** is the latest Giant to get the call and seek out a Major League debut...when he does so, he'll be the 16th Giant to do so this year to tie a franchise record from 2008.

- ▶ The 25-year-old has steadily ascended the Giants organizational ladder to get to this point...in 131 games this year between Double-A Richmond (37 games) and Triple-A Sacramento (94 games), Bandura has slashed .320/.407/.488 (.895 OPS) with 37 doubles, five triples, 13 homers, 94 RBI, 73 walks and 34 stolen bases (caught only four times).
- ▶ Bandura ranked among the organizational leaders in hits (163, 1st), RBI (T-1st), runs scored (104, 2nd), extra-base hits (55, 3rd), doubles (T-3rd), steals (T-3rd) and OPS (4th)...he was drafted by SF in the seventh round in 2023 out of Princeton.

THE MORE YOU KNOW...: With **C Drew Cavanaugh** connecting on his first career homer yesterday, the Giants now have had six different players homer as a catcher this year.. according to *Sarah Langs*, that ties the 2022 Reds and 2019 A's for the most different players to homer as a catcher for a team in a season in MLB history.

FOR ALL THE MARBLES: Single-A San Jose begins its bid for a second straight California League title with the beginning of the Cal League Championship Series today in Lake Elsinore...it will be a best-of-three series with San Jose hosting games two and three.

- ▶ Double-A Richmond wraps its regular season today and begins its Eastern League Divisional best-of-three series on Tuesday at Erie...**RHP Jackson Flora**, the fourth-overall pick in this year's draft, was added to Richmond's roster today.

WEBBMASTER: Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

LAST TIME OUT: Had one of his strongest outings of the season on Monday vs. St. Louis...matched a season-high eight strikeouts over 8.0 innings of work and held Cardinals batters to a run on three hits with two walks...hitters were 1-for-7 with a pair of strikeouts vs. his sinker and were hitless in five at-bats ending with his changeup.

VS. SAN DIEGO: Will face the Padres for the 20th time in his career and third time this season...in two starts vs. San Diego so far this season, Webb is 1-1 with a 8.10 ERA (9er, 10.0ip), four walks, nine strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP...overall, the righty is 5-6 with a 3.60 ERA (44er, 110.0ip) and 90 strikeouts in 19 games (18 starts) vs. San Diego...here at Oracle Park, Webb has a 3.05 ERA (22er, 65.0ip) in 11 games (10 starts) vs. the Padres but SF is 4-6 in the 10 starts.

HOME, SWEET HOME: Webb is 2-0 with a 1.97 ERA (7er, 32.0ip), 27 strikeouts, a .184 BAA and 0.81 WHIP in his last five starts at Oracle Park dating to July 29 vs. Milwaukee...overall, he is 4-4 with a 3.26 ERA (33er, 91.0ip), a 0.99 WHIP and .576 opponents OPS in 14 starts at home this season, compared to a 5.29 ERA (38er, 64.2ip) and .730 OPS in 12 starts on the road...Webb is 43-29 with a 2.90 ERA in 104 career games (101 starts) at Oracle Park compared to a 4.10 ERA in 102 starts on the road...since 2021, Webb's 2.75 ERA at home is fifth-best in the Majors (min. 60 GS).

PICK SIX: Webb's most recent start vs. the Cardinals on Monday marked his 20th start this season of 6.0+ innings, tied for sixth-most in the Majors this season...overall, Webb leads all Major League pitchers with 131 such starts since the start of 2021.

STAY GROUNDED: Has a 51.8% ground ball rate this season, fourth-best in the Majors behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (58.7%), DET's Framer Valdez (55.8%) and TOR's José Soriano (53.7%).

LATE BLOOMER: Has a 5.42 ERA (60er, 99.2ip) with a 1.37 WHIP, .736 OPS and 10 home runs from innings 1-4...after the 4th inning, the righty's ERA lowers to 1.77 ERA (11er, 56.0ip), with opponents slashing .174/.221/.231 (.452 OPS) with two homers and a 0.75 WHIP.

WORKHORSE: Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 975.2 innings...the next closest pitcher is Framer Valdez, who has logged 931.1 innings...Webb's 102 quality starts and 158 total games started since 2022 are most in MLB over that span.

FRENEMIES: Webb is 2-3 with a 6.23 ERA (21er, 30.1ip) and .789 opposing OPS in six starts vs. NL West opponents this year...it's his second-highest mark vs. any division this year (8.71 ERA vs. AL East in four starts).

DAMAGE CONTROL: Opponents are slashing .311/.333/.500 with three triples, a pair of homers and an .833 OPS on the first pitch of an at-bat...after falling behind 0-1, however, they are slashing just .188/.222/.289 (.510 OPS)

TOUGH LUCK: SF is 10-16 in Webb's 26 starts this year after going 18-16 in his 34 starts a season ago...since 2022, SF as a team is 77-81 in Webb's 158 starts, yet his 3.36 ERA in that time is fifth-best in MLB among starters (min. 120 GS).
