THE TWWWWWWWWWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 6-0 (3-0 at Los Angeles-AL and 3-0 at Chicago-AL), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a victory over Boston last night...today, the Twins will continue the series against the Red Sox with the second of three...after this series, the Twins will welcome the Mariners for four from Monday-Thursday.

Over the last 11 games, the Twins have a run differential of +43 (81-38)...prior to the current winning streak their run differential was at -25 (67-92).

Minnesota's last loss came 13 days ago, on April 21, a 6-1 loss to Detroit at Target Field.

THE SHERIFF LEADS 'EM TO 11: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 5-2, earning their 11th consecutive victory...Chris Paddock (3-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts...Griffin Jax earned his fifth hold with 1.0 scoreless inning, striking out all three batters faced on 11 pitches...the offense scored four of their five runs in the seventh inning, highlighted by an Edouard Julien pitch clock violation walk and a Ryan Jeffers two-run double.

TWINS STILL ALIVE AT 11: With a win today, the Twins' winning streak will hit 12...it's MLB's longest winning streak in 2024...below are all the club's streaks of 11-plus consecutive victories:

NOTE: Three teams in 2023 had winning streaks of 11-plus games: Tampa Bay - 13 (March 30-April 13), Cincinnati - 12 (June 10-23) and Los Angeles-NL - 11 (August 6-17).

SOX APPEAL: The Twins and Red Sox are playing for the second of six games in 2024 - they will play three games at Fenway from September 20-22...the Twins went 3-4 against Boston last season, going 1-2 at Fenway Park from April 18-20 and 2-2 at Target Field from June 19-22...the Twins have won six of their last nine against the Sox in Minnesota.

Since 2022, the Twins have scored 5.20 runs-per-game against Boston (15 games), their third-most against any AL opponent in that span (LAA - 5.53 and OAK - 5.33).

TWIN CITIES LUMBER COMPANY: Over the current 11-game winning streak, the Twins have hit .313 (122-for-390) with 34 doubles, two triples, 15 home runs, a .385 on-base percentage, a .526 slugging percentage and a .910 OPS...they have scored a total of 81 runs (7.4 runs-per-game) during the stretch...below are the Twins numbers through April 21 (first 20 games), compared to numbers since April 22 (11 games) and MLB ranks in parenthesis:

FASHIONABLY LATE: The Twins have scored 70 of their 148 runs from the seventh inning-or-later, accounting for 47% of their runs scored...the 70 runs scored lead all of baseball...Minnesota has scored 27 runs in the seventh inning, 11 runs in the eighth inning, 24 runs in the ninth inning and eight in extra innings.

During the 11-game winning streak, five wins have been in come-from-behind fashion.

WILL-MATIC: Willi Castro has hit safely in nine a career-high straight games, it's also the longest on the club this season...the last Twin with a hit in nine straight was Kyle Farmer, who hit in 10 straight from September 18-29, 2023.

The streak is tied with Rafael Devers for the longest active streak in the AL.

Additionally, Castro has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games, hitting .414 (24-for-58) with eight doubles, two triples, one home run, 10 RBI, a .672 slugging percentage and a 1.117 OPS in his last 15 games.

THE JEFFOLUTION: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .378 (14-for-37) with five doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, four walks, a .467 on-base percentage, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.142 OPS in his last 11 games, since April 22.

Jeffers' strikeout percentage is 18.0% this season...his previous seasons were: 27.8 in 2023, 26.3 in 2022, 36.9 in 2021 and 30.7 in 2020.

His 21 RBI are tied for eighth in the AL...his .941 OPS ranks fourth...his 172.2 OPS+ is fifth.

Since June 20, 2023, Ryan Jeffers has hit .302 (84-for-278) with a .932 OPS in 82 games...since that date, he ranks 11th in baseball in slugging percentage (minimum of 300 plate appearances) and 12th in OPS.

TWINS TRY MEATLOAF THE SOX: The Twins are looking for their fifth series win this season...their four series wins came March 28-31 at Kansas City, April 22-25 vs. Chicago-AL, April 26-28 at Los Angeles-AL and April 29-May 1 at Chicago-AL (full list to the right).

Last series win over the Red Sox was August 29-31, 2022, taking two of three in Minneapolis.

Twins are looking for four consecutive series wins for the first time since they finished the 2023 season with five straight series victories (at Chicago-AL, at Cincinnati, vs. Los Angeles-AL, vs. Oakland and at Colorado).

PABLO DAYS: The Twins, in partnership with Pablo and Kaylee López, announced last month a special "Pablo Day" ticket package for each of Pablo's home starts at Target Field from May to September that includes a commemorative jersey and philanthropic contributions to three local nonprofits designated by the López family...the "Pablo Day" package includes a ticket to the Twins home game that López starts, plus a unique, Pablo-themed jersey whose design pays homage to the All-Star's Venezuelan roots...a portion of the proceeds from each package sold will benefit a trio of local nonprofits specially selected by Pablo and Kaylee López: Children's Minnesota, Project Success and Ruff Start Rescue...this limited-quantity ticket package will be available for purchase at twins.com/PabloDay beginning approximately 48 hours before Pablo's next scheduled home start...fans will be able to sign up via the link to receive email notifications regarding the Pablo Day ticket package; updates will be emailed once starting pitcher probables for each upcoming López home start are announced.

THE MOR YOU NEAU: Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau played in 57 career games against the Red Sox, hitting .338 (74-for-219) with 16 doubles, six home runs, 45 RBI and an .883 OPS...the batting average was his highest against any opponent (minimum 200 plate appearances)...one of his two five-hit games came against the Red Sox at Fenway Park on September 19, 2006 (3 singles, 2 doubles).

ALMOST FLAWLESS IN ANAHEIM: Last pitched April 28 at Los Angeles-AL, opposite Reid Detmers, earning his second win of the season in Minnesota's 11-5 victory...allowed four runs on four hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and a season-high eight strikeouts...retired 14-straight hitters to begin the game, including six strikeouts in innings 1-3...with two outs in the fifth, allowed five-straight baserunners: Logan O'Hoppe double, Jo Adell double, Luis Rengifo home run, Nolan Schanuel home run and Mike Trout walk; induced a Zach Neto popout to end the fifth and didn't return.

- ⚔ Generated 13 whiffs on 42 swings (31.0%)...now has a 29.1 percent whiff rate this season, ranking in MLB's 71st percentile.
- ⚔ Angels had five hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...went 2-for-5 on those balls, including the Rengifo (95.7 mph) and Schanuel (99.8 mph) home runs.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started April 23 vs. Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0-inning no-decision...walked two and struck out six...all three runs came on a fourth-inning home run by Eloy Jiménez...struck out three-straight batters to end a 38-pitch fourth and didn't return for the fifth...Minnesota scored five runs in innings 7-9 and won 6-5 on Alex Kirilloff's walk-off single in the ninth.

- ⚔ Threw 76 pitches, his fewest in a start since September 4, 2022 at Atlanta...59.2 percent strike rate was his lowest in a start since August 18, 2023 vs. Pittsburgh (58.6%).
- ⚔ Generated five whiffs on 30 swings (16.7%).
- ⚔ Seven of nine balls in play were hard-hit (95.0+ mph).

PABLO VS. BOSTON: Only career start vs. Boston came June 19, 2023 at Target Field...allowed five runs (4 ER) on six hits in 5.2 innings, with three walks and nine strikeouts, and took the loss in Minnesota's 9-3 defeat...exited with runners on second and third in the sixth; Jovani Morán entered and allowed both to score...López threw 104 pitches, his third-highest count of the season (106, 2x).

RETURNING HOME: Making third home start of 2024...last home start came April 23 vs. Chicago-AL...has gone 0-1 at home with a 5.59 ERA (9.2 IP, 6 ER), 1.34 WHIP, three walks and eight strikeouts, compared to 2-1 in four road starts with a 4.50 ERA (22.0 IP, 11 ER), 0.91 WHIP, four walks and 29 strikeouts...has allowed a .270 batting average (10-for-37), .722 OPS and 2.4 percent home run rate at home, compared to .198 (16-for-81), .680 and 5.9 percent on the road...this afternoon marks the first of several Pablo Days at Target Field.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: On April 28 at Los Angeles-AL, left-handed hitters went 2-for-6 with two home runs and three strikeouts vs. López, while righties went 2-for-13 with two doubles, a walk and five strikeouts...through six games vs. López this season, left-handed hitters have hit .231 (15-for-65) with a .681 OPS, 27.9 percent strikeout rate and 4.4 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .208 (11-for-53) with a .710 OPS, 31.0 percent strikeout rate and 5.2 percent home run rate.

- ⚔ Lefties have a 38.3 percent hard-hit rate vs. López, righties a 60.0 percent rate.
- ⚔ Through May 3, facing right-handed pitching, Boston has hit .250 (212-for-847) with a .732 OPS and 24.6 percent strikeout rate.

- ⚔ Sweeper has resulted in a .213 *expected* batting average, compared to actual figure of .304...the pitch has a .522 slugging percentage and .295 *expected* slugging percentage.
