## Detroit Tigers (18-11) at Houston Astros (15-13)

Tuesday, April 29, 2025 • Daikin Park, Houston, TX • 7:10 p.m. CT

**I FEEL TUESDAY:** The Detroit Tigers and Houston Astros tonight play the middle game of their three-game set at Daikin Park after the Tigers endured an 8-5 loss in the series opener last night, also the start of Detroit's 11-day, 10-game, three-city trip through Houston (three games), the Angels (four games starting Thursday) and Colorado (three games starting next Tuesday) ... last night marked just the second series-opening setback for Detroit and its first since Opening Day at Dodger Stadium more than a month ago, snapping a streak of eight-straight series opening victories.

- Despite last night's loss, the Tigers still have the best record in the American League this season at 18-11, 1.0 game ahead of the Yankees ... the Tigers have started a season 18-11 through 29 games for the first time in 10 years (also 18-11 in 2015).
- The Tigers have gone 18-8, a .692 winning percentage, in their last 26 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... that 18-8 record starting March 31 is one game behind the Mets for best in baseball during this span.
- This week marks Detroit's first visit to Houston since sweeping the American League Wild Card Series here in two games last October, Detroit's first playoff appearance in 10 years.
- The Tigers tonight continue their stretch of 23 games in 24 days through this Sunday, May 4.

**YESTERDAY ONCE MORE:** Kerry Carpenter yesterday slugged his sixth homer of the season that was also his 50th career home run ... he is the 77th player in franchise history to reach that mark and just the third Tiger to reach 50 home runs through his first 263 games, joining Rudy York (71) and Tony Clark (59) ... Riley Greene yesterday recorded his fourth-career two homer game to match Carpenter with six homers this year ... Greene now has 46 career home runs.

**HE'S (YET AGAIN) GOING STREAKING:** Zach McKinstry enters today riding an active eight-game hitting streak, tied for the fourth-longest active hitting streak in the American League and already McKinstry's second eight-game hitting streak on the young season ... he's the only player in all of baseball with multiple hitting streaks of at least eight games thus far this year ... McKinstry is tied for the A.L. lead with three triples and ranks fifth with a .321 batting average.

- According to Fangraphs, McKinstry this season has posted a team-leading 1.3 WAR, tied for seventh-best in the American League.

**POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ:** The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.58 ERA (28 ER/97.2 IP) this season, the lowest mark in the American League and third-lowest mark in all of baseball behind only San Diego (1.63) and San Francisco (2.11) ... Tigers relievers have also combined to limit opponents to a .585 OPS, the lowest mark in the A.L. and third-lowest in the majors ... Detroit's 97.2 relief innings pitched are the fifth fewest in the A.L.

**WE WERE ON A BREAK:** While the Tigers lead the American League with an 18-11 record this season, they've also got the best record in the A.L. dating back to last year's All-Star Break ... the Tigers are 57-37 since the start of the "second half" last year, good for a .606 winning percentage and 3.5 games ahead of the next-closest A.L. clubs, the Astros and Yankees, and their 53-40 marks (.570) ... overall, the Tigers have the fourth-best record in all of baseball since last year's Break.

**THIS IS SOME HIGH END TORK:** Spencer Torkelson enters the day with 16 extra-base hits, tied with Boston's Alex Bregman, New York's Aaron Judge and Seattle's Cal Raleigh for most in the American League ... Torkelson and teammate Andy Ibáñez are tied for third in the A.L. with four game-winning RBI this season ... overall, Torkelson's 24 RBI are tied for second in the A.L., behind only New York's Aaron Judge with 28, and are tied for sixth in the majors.

**A REESE PIECE:** Tigers starter Reese Olson takes the ball for the sixth time this season today after tossing 7.1 scoreless innings last Wednesday vs. San Diego to collect his third win this year and lower his ERA by more than a point to 3.29 ... Olson is already several steps ahead of last year, as the righthander went 0-4 despite a strong, similar-to-2025 3.18 ERA in five starts in April of 2024 ... the 25-year-old Olson entered this season in the starting rotation for the second year in a row after going 4-8 despite a solid 3.53 ERA in 22 starts last year ... his second half of the 2024 season was marred by a right shoulder strain but he returned late in the year to pitch in a pair of playoff games, including one start.

**THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE:** The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the American League on the strength of a +39 run differential this year, the second-best mark in the A.L. behind the Yankees (+41) ... the Tigers are one of seven A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, but they and the Yankees are well ahead of the third-best Seattle Mariners (+15) ... overall, the Tigers are tied for fourth in the majors with their +39 run differential.

**AND FINALLY:** Casey Mize already has four wins in April while Reese Olson and Tarik Skubal have three wins this month ... the Tigers have never had two pitchers win four games each within the month of (the same) April ... Mize is the first Tigers pitcher win four games in April since Jordan Zimmermann won five games in April of 2016.

- Threw a season-high 7.1 shutout innings on April 23 against San Diego...allowed just two hits and one walk while striking out seven to move to 3-1 and lower his ERA on the year to 3.29.
- Made 22 starts for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 4-8 record with a 3.53 ERA (44ER/112.1IP) and 101 strikeouts...set a career high in games (22) and innings pitched (112.1)
- Allowed a home run to Michael Massey on May 20 at Kansas City, snapping his streak of innings without allowing a homer to start the season at 48.1...in the Wild Card Era (since 1955), that was the third-longest streak by a Tigers starting pitcher to begin the season and sixth longest by any Tiger.
- Allowed one earned run-or-fewer in six consecutive starts from April 26-May 25...became the second Tiger in franchise history to post a sub-2.00 ERA (0.77) while allowing 40-or-fewer hits through his first 10 starts of a season, joining Tom Timmermann in 1972.
- Made his postseason debut on Oct. 6, pitching in relief and giving up a run on three hits with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...became the first pitcher to throw 5.0-or-more innings of relief in his first career Postseason game since Ed Willett on Oct. 11, 1909, vs. Pittsburgh.

- Made his first career Opening Day roster this year.

- In 50 relief appearances with the New York Yankees last season, he went 0-2 with one save and a 2.11 ERA (10ER/42.2IP)...his 2.11 ERA ranked 10th among AL relievers (min. 40.0 IP).
- Did not allow an earned run in 44 of his 50 appearances, including 39 of his final 43 games from 6/12-9/27, posting a 1.47 ERA (6ER/36.2IP) and 40 strikeouts over that 43-game stretch.
- He held opponents to a .190 BA (8-for-42) with RISP on the season, and allowed 1H-or-fewer in 46 of his 50 appearances.

- Allowed seven earned runs on nine hits and five walks over his first five games (6.0 innings) with the Tigers...he has finished three games for Detroit, as all five of his appearances have been in relief.
- Completed his first season in Detroit last year, appearing in 29 games (17 starts) and posting a 3-7 record with a 6.09 ERA (76ER/112.1IP) and 96 strikeouts...over 12 relief appearances last season, he had a 3.86 ERA (18ER/42.0IP) with 41 strikeouts.

- Led the team in appearances through their first 25 games with 11, going 1-0 with a 0.84 ERA over that stretch...in those 10.2 innings, he struck out 12 compared to just three walks.
- Inherited 49 runners during the 2024 season, which was tied for the third most in the Majors...were the most for a Tigers reliever since Phil Coke inherited 52 in 2014
- Pitched in six postseason games, compiling a 1-0 record with one save, a 1.50 ERA (1ER/6.0IP) and nine strikeouts.
