AT HOME: The Brewers are 12-9 at home, going 4-2-1 in series play.....the team has gone 7-2 in their last 9 home games after a 5-7 start.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 15-10 on the road, going 4-3-1 in series play.....the team has lost its last three road series (1-2 at CHC/1-2 at KC/1-2 at HOU) after going 4-0-1 in its first five.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23. replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame [1988-94] and Arizona State University [1995-2009].

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 10 replay challenges this season, going 6-4.....their last challenge came on 5/19 at Houston as an out call at first base involving Sal Frelick was overturned.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JOE ROSS (8gs, 2-4, 4.61)

ROSS AT A GLANCE: Joe Ross, 30, will be making his ninth start.....Ross last started last Tuesday vs. Pittsburgh in a 4-3 win (5ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 91 pitches).....the team is 3-5 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .253 (41-for-162, 4hr).....Ross signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on Dec. 12.....he is signed through the 2024 season.

WE MEET AGAIN: Joe Ross played under current Brewers manager Pat Murphy as a 19-year-old pitcher in the Padres organization at Class-A Eugene in 2012.....Ross made 8 starts under Murphy that season, posting a 2.03 ERA.

LAST SEASON: Ross returned to action in August of last season and appeared in 8 games/7 starts in the San Francisco Giants farm system.....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery in June 2022, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache, the second such surgery of his career (also 2017).

CAREER: Is 28-32 with a 4.29 ERA in 106 games/84 starts (484.1ip, 231er).....is in his seventh Major League season with Washington (2015-19, 2021) and Milwaukee (2024)..... selected by San Diego in the first round (25th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Bishop O'Dowd High School in Oakland, CA, Ross was traded to Washington as part of a three-team (also Tampa Bay), 11-player deal on Dec. 18, 2014.....he was a member of the 2019 World Series-champion Nationals.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-2 with a 5.27 ERA in 6 games/5 starts [27.1ip, 16er].....is 1-2 with a 6.87 ERA in 4 starts this season [18.1ip, 14er].

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-16 with a 3.86 ERA in 52 games/41 starts [228.2ip, 98er].....is 1-2 with a 2.78 ERA in 4 starts this season [22.2ip, 7er].

CAREER vs. MARLINS: Is 2-2 with a 2.53 ERA in 9 games/5 starts (32ip, 30h, 12r, 9er, 10bb, 26k, 2hr), including 1-1 with a 1.04 ERA in 5 games/3 starts at loanDepot park (17.1ip, 16h, 3r, 2er, 5bb, 17k, 1hr).....has gone 2-2 with a 1.98 ERA as a starter against the Marlins (27.1ip, 25h, 9r, 6er, 9bb, 23k, 2hr).

LHP Robert Gasser will be making his third start of the season.....Gasser last started last Wednesday vs. Pittsburgh and picked up a 10-2 victory (5ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 2k, 82 pitches).....he made his Major League debut on 5/10 vs. St. Louis and earned an 11-2 win (6ip, 2h, 0r, 0bb, 4k, 1hbp, 79 pitches).....he became the first pitcher in franchise history to throw at least 6.0 innings with no runs and no walks in a Major League debut.....he is the first pitcher in franchise history to win each of his first 2 appearances in the Major Leagues.....Gasser entered the 2024 season as the sixth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.
