LAUNCHING PAD: Fresh off an 8-2 win on Opening Day, the Detroit Tigers tonight get back after it with the middle game of their three-game series in San Diego ... Tarik Skubal yesterday pitched six innings of zero-earned-run ball to earn his second-career Opening Day win while Dillon Dingler hit a two-run homer and Kevin McGonigle had a notable major league debut ... more on that below ... tonight the club witnesses another debut of sorts as Framer Valdez makes his first Tigers start.

- The Tigers yesterday improved to 62-63-1 in their 126 Opening Day affairs with wins in 12 of their last 15 season openers ... Tigers manager A.J. Hinch is now 11-2 in his 13-career Opening Day contests as a skipper.
- The Tigers will spend their first week of the season on the west coast, as the club plays a three-game series here through tomorrow evening ... after an off day on Sunday, the Tigers play a three-game set at the Arizona Diamondbacks from March 30-April 1.

THERE'S A LOT LEFT: While the Tigers have the longest streak in the majors with seven-straight southpaws to start on Opening Day, Tarik Skubal and Framer Valdez mark the first time Detroit will start a season with back-to-back left-handed starters in 61 years when Mickey Lolich and Hank Aguirre kicked things off in 1965 ... one must go back 100 years to find the only two other such instances in franchise history when this has happened in 1925 (Dutch Leonard and Earl Whitehill) and 1926 (Earl Whitehill and Augie Johns) ... thanks to Elias.

IN THE BIG INNING: The Tigers yesterday jumped out to a 4-0 lead after the top of the first inning, their largest frame to kickoff a campaign in 43 years when the club scored six runs in the top of the first inning in an 11-3 win at Minnesota.

- The six-run win represented Detroit's largest margin-of-victory on Opening Day in 21 years when the Tigers picked up an 11-2 win vs. Kansas City on April 4, 2005 ... it was Detroit's largest Opening Day win on the road since a year prior, a 7-0 victory on April 5, 2004 at Toronto.

KEVIN!!!: Kevin McGonigle yesterday ripped the first pitch he ever saw in the big leagues into right field for a two-run double, instantly becoming only the sixth Tiger since the RBI became a stat in 1920 to record two RBI in his major league debut, the first since Isaac Paredes on August 17, 2020.

- McGonigle is the second of the six to accomplish this feat on Opening Day ... he joins Paredes, JaCoby Jones (August 30, 2016), Rob Richie (August 19, 1989), Jake Wood (Opening Day April 11, 1961), Hank Riebe (August 26, 1942) and Sammy Hale (April 20, 1920) in turning this trick.
- McGonigle is the first Tiger ever with two doubles in his major league debut on Opening Day and the second in the history of the franchise with two doubles in his major league debut on any day, joining Hank Riebe on August 26, 1942.
- McGonigle is the second player in franchise history to collect four hits in his major league debut, joining Billy Bean (April 25, 1987).

IT'S ONLY A NUMBER: At 21 years, 220 days old, Kevin McGonigle yesterday became the second-youngest player in the history of the Tigers franchise to make his major league debut in the starting lineup on Opening Day and the youngest in 112 years since starting first baseman George Burns made his major league debut on Opening Day April 14, 1914 ... thanks to Elias.

- Overall, McGonigle is the fourth-youngest Tiger in the history of the franchise to make his major league debut on Opening Day, joining Burns at 21 years, 73 days; pinch-hitter Frank Fuller at 21-103 on April 14, 1915; and relief pitcher Joel Zumaya at 21-145 on April 3, 2006.
- McGonigle became the youngest Tigers player to earn an Opening Day roster spot since Omar Infante in 2003, though Infante made his big league debut the year prior.
- McGonigle is only the second player aged 21-years-old or younger in the last 65 years of the expansion era (since 1961) to record four hits in his major league debut, joining Montreal's Delino DeShields who did so on April 9, 1990 ... thanks to Elias.
- McGonigle became the youngest player in franchise history with multiple extra-base hits and multiple-RBI on Opening Day.

THERE'S A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING: Framer Valdez tonight makes his Tigers debut after signing a three-year contract with the club back in February ... Valdez joins Detroit after spending all or part of the last eight seasons with Houston (2018-25), where he earned a pair of A.L. All-Star nods (2022-23) and was a 2022 World Champion.

- In the past four seasons from 2022-25, Valdez leads all left-handed pitchers with 767.2 innings (105.0 more than his next closest foe), 83 quality starts (19 more than his next closest foe), 750 strikeouts (51 more), 57 wins (five more) and a 61.0 ground ball percentage. season mark in franchise history.
- Only five left-handers have totaled 350.0 innings with a sub-3.50 ERA in the past two seasons: Tarik Skubal, Christopher Sanchez, Garrett Crochet, Max Fried and Valdez.

SAVE ME!!!

The Tigers are the first team in major league history to have three players on their opening day roster with 20 or more saves from the year prior: Kyle Finnegan (24 saves), Kenley Jansen (29 saves) and Will Vest (23 saves) ... Elias.

Kenley Jansen has 476 career saves, fourth-most in major league history and only two saves shy of tying Lee Smith (478 saves) for third-most.

- Signed with the Detroit Tigers as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026...went 2-0 with a 0.98 ERA in four Spring Training starts for the Tigers.
- In 2025, led the Astros in wins (13) and innings (192)...marked the 3rd-highest win total of his career behind his 17 wins in 2022 and 15 wins in 2024...also led the team in starts alongside RHP Hunter Brown (31).
- Was one-of-five pitchers in the AL to record a winning decision in 6 consecutive outings with NYY LHP Max Fried, BOS LHP Garrett Crochet and TEX RHP Nathan Eovaldi, all posting the longest such streaks last season with a winning decision...was joined by RHP Hunter Brown as the only Astros pitchers to record a win in 5 consecutive appearances this season.
- Among AL pitchers on the 2025 season, finished 2nd in GB% (59.2), 2nd in opponent GIDP (22), 2nd in GIDP/9 (1.03), 5th in Pitching WAR (4.3), T-5th in quality starts (20), 6th in innings pitched (192.0), T-6th in wins, and 10th in opponent OPS (.667).
- Won a career-long 10 consecutive decisions, a streak that started on May 7 and spanned 14 starts, his final win of the streak coming on July 22...in that span, Valdez went 10-0 with a 1.86 ERA (18ER/87IP), 92 strikeouts, a .206 opponent average, a 1.06 WHIP and 11 quality starts...this marked the longest winning streak by an Astro since RHP Gerrit Cole set the club record with a 16-game winning streak from May 27-Sept. 29, 2019.
- Surpassed 1,000 career strikeouts in his start on July 18 vs. WSH, finishing the season with 1,053...surpassed 1,000 career innings during his start on July 5 at LAD.
- Capped off the regular season by hurling 7.0 quality innings, allowing 1 run on 7 hits and 2 walks, striking out 10...marked his fifth 10+ strikeout game of the season, finishing 4th in the AL and 7th in the Majors with 10+ strikeout games...also recorded his 12th game of the season pitching 7.0+ innings, ranking 5th in the Majors.
- On May 30 vs. TB, after surrendering a leadoff homer, turned in his most dominant start of the season by throwing his 9th career complete game in 83 pitches, giving up just 3 hits and 1 walk while striking out 9 batters...his 83-pitch gem is tied for the fewest pitches by an Astro in a 9+ inning CG since RHP Darryl Kile did so on Sept. 8, 1993.
- On April 26 at KC, spun 8.0 innings for his 8th career complete game...surrendered a 1st inning run on a sac fly and a solo home run in the 5th...allowed just 3 hits and walked 2 batters while striking out 5.

- Signed with Detroit on a one-year major league contract with a club option for the 2027 season on Dec. 16, 2025.
- Spent each of the previous two seasons with the SSG Langers of the KBO League...went 12-7 with a 2.25 ERA (43 ER/171.2 IP) in 30 starts for SSG last season, recording 245 strikeouts in his 171.2 innings pitched, an average of 12.8 strikeouts per nine innings.
- In his two seasons with SSG, went 23-10 with a 2.91 ERA (93 ER/287.1 IP) in 54 appearances (53 starts)...released by Detroit after nine appearances with Triple-A Toledo in 2024 prior to signing with the Langers.
- Has spent parts of five seasons with the Philadelphia Phillies (2017-19), Chicago White Sox (2020) and Texas Rangers (2021) prior to joining the Tigers this year...also pitched with Hiroshima in the NPB for the 2022-23 campaigns.

- Re-signed with Detroit on a two-year deal as a free agent on Dec. 20, 2025...appeared in 16 games with the Tigers last season, posting a 3-0 record with a 1.50 ERA (3ER/18IP) with 23 strikeouts.
- Made his first post-season appearance with the Tigers in 2025, playing six games and striking out three in 7.1 innings of work.
