RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals, who were off yesterday (their 3rd scheduled Friday off day this season), concluded their six-game homestand on Thu. night with a one-hit, 8-0 shutout win over the Chicago Cubs that moved them back into sole possession of 1st place in the N.L. Central...entering play today, St. Louis sits in 1st place in the NL Central, 1/2-game ahead of Chicago and 2-1/2 in front of 2nd place Milwaukee...The Cardinals went 16-9 in July, and own the majors best winning pct. (.700; 14-6) since the All-Star break, matching San Francisco, Cleveland and Houston for the most wins (14) in all of Major League Baseball.

REDBIRD ROAD SHOW: The Cardinals have won five-straight road games and seven of their last eight, and are 27-27 away from home.

GOLDY'S ROAD TO RECORD: Paul Goldschmidt, who has hit safely in 10-straight games, and earlier today was named the Natonal League Player of the Month for July (he was also selected in June of 2018), has homered in four-straight road games, one shy of matching **Rip Collins** (1935) and **Jim Bottomley** (1929) for the club record of homering in five-straight road games.

THE "BIG BEAR" IS BACK/O'NEILL TO I.L.: Outfielder Marcell Ozuna was activated from the 10-day Injured List earlier today and outfielder Tyler O'Neill

(left wrist strain) has been placed on the 10-day Injured List, retroactive to August 1...Ozuna, who has been sidelined since suffering finger fractures to his right hand on June 28, has missed 28 games while on the Injured List. Ozuna was producing at an All-Star level at the time of his injury, batting .259 with a then team-high 20 HR and 62 RBI in 78 games. His RBI total still leads the team...in three injury rehab games with Memphis (AAA) earlier this week, Ozuna was 4-for-9 (.444) with 6 RBI. He homered, doubled and had five RBI in a three-hit game vs. Albuquerque on Thursday (August 1)...O'Neill is batting .279 with 5 HR and 16 RBI in 46 games this season, including a .301 mark with 4

HR and 12 RBI in 23 July games. He was also on the Injured List April 16-25 with a right elbow injury.

"VICTORY" BLUES: The Cardinals this year introduced "victory" blue uniforms, patterned off their threads from the 1980s, that they wear for Saturday road games...they are however just 1-7 when wearing the color rush threads, winning at Texas on May 18...overall, the Cardinals are 1-8 in Saturday road games, also losing to Cincinnati in Monterrey, Mexico on April 13 during the Mexico Series while wearing their gray road uniforms.

PUTTING THE BARK IN DOG DAYS: Since 2000, the Cardinals have sported a winning August record in 16 of 19 seasons (excluding 2006, '08, & '10), with a combined .590 win pct. (316-220) that is highest in Major League Baseball over that time span. Last season, St. Louis (.786, 22-6) led MLB in August victories and winning percentage, marking the team's first 22-win August since 1946 (22-9; .710).

MANAGER MILESTONE: Skipper **Mike Shildt** piloted the Cardinals to his 99th career win on Thursday and he's 99-78 (.559) overall since taking the helm of the Redbirds last July...he's 23-6 in August games.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!: Since July 5, Kolten Wong has reached base safely in a career-best 20 straight games (.409/.481/.515), 2nd-longest active on-base streak in MLB (Yasmani Grandal, MIL, 21g) and 2nd-longest by a Cardinal this season (Yadier Molina, 22g, April 9-May 6).

Cardinals Hall of Famer and current coach Willie McGee played 29 games for the Athletics in 1990 and a member of their AL Championship squad... traded by St. Louis to Oakland in exchance for pitcher Daryl Green, outfielder Félix José, and infielder Stan Royer...was born in San Francisco, Calif...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond, Calif...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, Calif...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, Calif...resides in Hercules, Calif.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

Former Athletics 2nd round draft pick in 1999 Ryan Ludwick and Jason Isringhausen who pitched for the Athletics (1999-2001) are members of the Cardinals Core, a program that teaches character building and leadership skills to players throughout the Cardinals minor league system.

Cardinals 1B/OF **Rangel Ravelo** was a member of the Athletics organization from 2015-16 before joining the Cardinals in 2017.

Stephen Piscotty was selected by the Cardinals in the first round (36th overall) of the 2012 MLB Draft out of Stanford University...played parts of three seasons for St. Louis (2015-17) before traded to Oakland in exchange for minor league infielders Yairo Muñoz and Max Schrock (Dec. 14, 2017)...named the 2015 Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year.

Athletics assistant hitting coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2008-11) and bench coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 National League pennant winner.

Athletics Assistant GM **Dan Kantrovitz** was the Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...was also a Cardinals 25th round draft pick out of Brown University in 2001...took his first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coordinator (2004).

Athletics Minor League Roving Infielder and Baserunning Instructor **Steve Scarsone** played five games for the Cardinals (1997).

Athletics Triple-A (Las Vegas) Athletic Trainer **Brad LaRosa** spent three years in the same role with the Cardinals Springfield (AA) affiliate. He holds two degrees from SIU-Edwardsville and resides in Illinois in the off-season.

Athletics Roving Infielder and Baserunning Instructor **Steve Scarsone** played five games for the St. Louis Cardinals in 1997.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is the only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series title in both... His 70 postseason victories (50 with St. Louis, 19 with Oakland and 1 with Chicago) rank second to Joe Torre (84)...In Oakland, La Russa piloted the A's to four division titles, three American League pennants and the...1989 World Championship...is the A's franchise wins leader (798)...also played parts of four seasons with Oakland (1968-71).

Hall of Famer **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Mark McGwire played parts of 12 seasons with Oakland (1986-97)... Named AL Rookie of the Year (1987)...member of the 1989 World Series Champions and three AL pennant-winning teams (1988-90)...selected to eight AL All-Star teams (1987-92, '95-97)...won two Silver Sluggers (1992 & '96) and one Gold Glove award (1990)...selected by Oakland in the 1st round (10th overall) in the 1984 MLB Draft...traded to the Cardinals by Oakland in exchange for pitchers Eric Ludwick, T.J. Mathews and Blake Stein.

Cardinals Baseball Development Analyst **Emily Wiebe** grew up in nearby San Francisco, Calif... attended University High School.

- Has allowed a home run in his last seven starts, tied with Jack Flaherty for the longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher this season and longest since Matt Morris was hit for a longball in 10 straight in 2004. The club record is held by Andy Benes (11) in 2001.
- Has a team leading 10 wins. The last rookie to lead the Cardinals in wins was Matt Morris (12, 1997). His 10 wins co-lead MLB rookies with Mike Soroka of ATL.
- Lowered his season ERA from 6.08 on April 15 to 3.36 on June 22. His 3.88 ERA currently ranks 21st among National League qualifiers and 2nd among NL rookies.
