RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Minnesota Twins play the second game of a three-game series tonight from Busch Stadium as the Cardinals continue their nine-game, 10-day homestand (three games vs. Atlanta and three games vs. Kansas City) ... St. Louis has now won or split six of their last nine series since June 28 (15-10 record) ... St. Louis begins the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 9.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee.

CARDINALS HONOR SIMBA: The Cardinals paid tribute to National Baseball Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** with the unveiling and dedication of a bronze Ted Simmons statue outside of Busch Stadium this afternoon ... The statue joined the existing 11 outside at the intersection of 8th and Clark and is the first addition since Hall of Fame shortstop **Ozzie Smith** in August 2002 ... A pregame retirement of "Simba's" uniform number 23 will take place as Simba becomes the 15th individual associated with the organization to have his number retired and first since Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa's** number 10 in May 2012 ... Simmons will be officially inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on Sept. 8 with fellow Class of 2020 inductees **Derek Jeter**, **Larry Walker** and **Marvin Miller**.

23: According to *Baseball Reference*, 35 players have worn No. 23 with the Cardinals, most notably by **Marcell Ozuna** (2018-19); **David Freese** (2009-13); **Anthony Reyes** (2006-08); **Cal Eldred** (2003-05); **Jamey Wright** (2002); **Fernando Tatis** (1998-2000); **Mark Sweeney** (1996-97); **Bernard Gilkey** (1990-95); **Tom Brunansky** (1988-90); **Ted Simmons** (1968-80); **Tito Francona** (1965-66); **Sam Jones** (1957-58); **Max Lanier** (1940-51); and **Syl Johnson** (1926-33).

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: The Cardinals are 4-6 in Interleague play this season against the AL Central (1-2 at White Sox; 2-2 vs. Indians; 0-2 at Tigers, 1-0 vs. Twins) ... St. Louis is 202-201 all-time in Interleague play, with a .501 win pct that ranks 4th-best among NL teams ... St. Louis is 103-96 at home in Interleague play, but just 60-74 at Busch III since 2006.

GO WITH THE FLO: Since returning from the Injured List (rib fracture) on July 1, **Harrison Bader** is batting .363/.409/.638 (29-80) with a 1.047 OPS, ranking 4th in the NL in July batting average ... The last time any Cardinal hit .360 or better in July was 2012, highlighted by a trio of Redbirds: **David Freese** (.458, 33-72); **Skip Schumaker** (.385, 20-52); **Matt Holliday** (.363, 33-91).

BETTER AT BUSCH: Since June 9, the Cardinals are 14-5 (.737) in their last 19 home games (+18 run differential), representing the MLB's best home win pct. (.737) over that span. ... St. Louis is 29-20 (.592) overall at home this season.

SOUTHPAW STARTERS: The last Cardinals rotation to primarily feature four left-handers was 1995: **Danny Jackson** (19 GS), **Allen Watson** (19), **Donovan Osborne** (19) and **Tom Urbani** (13) ... The last time the Cardinals had four or more lefties start a game in a season was 2015: **Garcia** (20), **Tyler Lyons** (8), **Tim Cooney** (6), and **Marco Gonzales** (1) ... The last time St. Louis had four or more lefties start multiple games in a season was 1999: **Rick Ankiel** (5), **Kent Mercker** (18), **Darren Oliver** (30), **Donovan Osborne** (6), and **Lance Painter** (4) ... This season, **Kwang Hyun Kim** and **Wade LeBlanc** have combined for 24 starts, most by a St. Louis team since **Jaime Garcia** made 30 in 2016.

MORE LEFTIES!: With the first appearances by **Jon Lester** and **J.A. Happ**, the Cardinals will have 10 different left-handers pitch this season, tying the 1993 Cardinals (**Rod Brewer**, **Rheal Cormier**, **Steve Dixon**, **Lee Guetterman**, **Paul Kilgus**, **Joe Magrane**, **Rob Murphy**, **Donovan Osborne**, **Tom Urbani**, **Allen Watson**) for most in single-season franchise history.

DEADLINE STARTING PITCHERS: Prior to yesterday, Cardinals starting pitchers acquired by mid-season trades since 1960 include **John Lackey** (2014), **Justin Masterson** (2014), **Edwin Jackson** (2011) **Jake Westbrook** (2010), **Joel Píñeiro** (2007), **Mike Maroth** (2007), **Jeff Weaver** (2006), **Sterling Hitchcock** (2003), **Jamey Wright** (2002), **Chuck Finley** (2002), **Woody Williams** (2001), **Darren Oliver** (1998), **Joaquín Andújar** (1981), **Tom Underwood** (1977), and **Ron Reed** (1975) - *Orf*

AGE IS JUST A NUMBER: The additions of Lester and Happ gives St. Louis five pitchers at age 36 or older (**Wade LeBlanc**, **Andrew Miller**, **Adam Wainwright**), most in Major League Baseball since the 2013 Pirates (**A.J. Burnett**, **José Contreras**, **Kyle Farnsworth**, **Jason Grilli**, **John McDonald**), and one fewer than the franchise record of six from 2011 (**Miguel Batista**, **Chris Carpenter**, **Octavio Dotel**, **Ryan Franklin**, **Trevor Miller**, **Arthur Rhodes**).

Adam Wainwright was selected as the starting pitcher in the 2014 All-Star Game at Target Field, while **Yadier Molina** and **Matt Carpenter** were selected as reserves.

Tommy Edman's brother, **John Edman**, works for the Twins as Data Quality Engineer, Baseball R&D

Cardinals Assistant GM/Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in 11 games for the Twins in 2010.

Twin Pitching Coach **Wes Johnson** previously served as the 2016 Mississippi State University Asst./Pitching Coach in 2016, where he coached **Dakota Hudson** as a junior.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tommy Herr** was traded by St. Louis to the Twins for **Tom Brunansky** (April 22, 1988)...played in 86 games for the Twins.

Twins Hall of Famer **Paul Molitor** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 28th round of the 1974 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Danny Coulombe was born in St. Louis.

Joe Mauer and current Twins Special Assistant **Justin Morneau** represented Minnesota in the 2009 All-Star Game at Busch Stadium.

Bally Sports Director of Cardinals telecasts for over 30 years, **Tom Mee's** father, **Tom**, was the first employee hired by the Twins in the fall of 1960...later served as the Twins director of media relations until 1991, then he became the team's official scorer.

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** was the voice of the Twins in 1987...has been the play-by-play voice for three World Series championship teams: 1987 Twins, 2005 White Sox and 2006 Cardinals.

Twins Communications Coordinator and Translator **Elvis Martinez** spent 2017 in the Cardinals organization as a Baseball Operations Fellowship and GCL Cardinals Coordinator in Jupiter, Fla.

Twins VP Player Personnel **Mike Radcliff** is a 1979 graduate of the University of Missouri.

The Cardinals and Twins played a two-game Exhibition series (April 2-3) at Target Field prior to the 2010 season.

The Twins defeated the Cardinals, 4-3, in the 1987 World Series...marked the first World Series in history in which the home team won every game... notable Cardinals to appear included coaches **Wilie McGee** and **José Oquendo**, Cardinals Hall of Famers **Ozzie Smith** and **Vince Coleman**, & **Tom Herr**, and broadcaster **Ricky Horton**.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Was recalled on July 19 after being optioned to Memphis (AAA) on June 28 to ramp up to be as a starting pitcher. Has started two games since with a 1-1 record and 3.38 ERA over 10.2 innings.
- Making his third start of the season and fourth career Major League start. Has appeared in 31 games over his MLB career with 28 coming in relief.
- Is making his second career appearance vs. the Twins and first career start. Marks his second career Interleague start and 10th appearance.
- In his 19 appearances this season, the Cardinals are 2-17, with Woodford earning the winning decision in both of the games he's pitched that St. Louis has won (5/28 at ARI & 7/19 vs. CHI).
- Is 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA in three career starts and 2-1 with a 5.19 ERA in 28 career relief appearances.
- Has posted a solid reverse split this season hoding left-handed batters to a .194 BA (7-36, HR) on the year.
- His longest relief outing in the majors in 2021 came at Arizona (5/28) striking out a career-high six in 2.2 scoreless innings en route to an 8-6 victory.
- Has made seven relief appearances of 2.0 innings or more.
- Was optioned to Memphis (AAA) on June 28 to ramp up as a starting pitcher. His two most recent minor league starts were each 5.0 innings, at Louisville (7/7) and vs. Norfolk (7/13). Tossed a season-high 83 pitches vs. Norfolk.

LAST TIME OUT

- Suffered his first loss as a Major League starting pitcher exiting after 5.0 innings with a 3-1 deficit. Allowed a home run to Joey Votto which ignited a 6-game HR streak for the Reds' veteran.
- Matched or established 2021 season-highs in runs (3), earned runs (3), hits (7), walks (2) and pitches thrown (88).

- Started for the first time in 2021 and since his Major League debut (8/15/20 - Game 2 of DH at CWS), vs. CHI (7/19) and earned the win by holding the Cubs to one run over a career-high 5.2 innings matching his season-high with six strikeouts.
- Struck out a season-high six batters in relief at ARI (5/28) over 2.2 scoreless innings earning the win.
- Did not allow a home run in his first eight appearances of the season (4/3-5/30), covering 13.0 innings and 59 total batters faced.
- Made seven relief appearances of 2.0 innings or more, three of them scoreless.
- Allowed a career-high two home runs vs. PIT (6/27) in a 7-2 loss.
- Was credited with four games finished, most recently at CHI (6/11).

- Originally signed his college letter of intent to play at the University of Florida, but was selected 39th overall (supplemental first round) in the 2015 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Collected his first Major League strikeout fanning Jose Abreu in the 2nd inning of his MLB debut (8/15/2020) in the second game of the doubleheader.
