THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 11
2016 - 2B Jose Altuve goes 3x4 with a walk, an RBI and three runs scored in an Astros 8-2 win over the Royals in Houston...this game is the first of a seven-game stretch for Altuve in which he hit .407 (11x27) with eight runs scored, three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, and a 1.336 OPS en route to being named the AL's Co-Player of the Week...he shares the honors with the Orioles **RF Mark Trumbo**.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros look to stop a five-game losing skid as they continue their 10-game road trip with the second game of a four-game series against the Seattle Mariners at T-Mobile Park in Seattle, WA...**RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** will be on the mound for the Astros opposite **RHP Luis Castillo** and the Mariners.

ABOUT MCCULLERS: **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** is set to make his third start of the season...in his last start on April 5 at ATH, he allowed three runs on five hits and three walks with four strikeouts in four innings...also tossed seven innings of one-run ball in his season debut on March 30 vs. BOS...was his longest outing since Sept. 21, 2022 at TB, where he also went 7.0 innings...was his first quality start and win since July 4, 2025 at LAD...he made his return to the mound in 2025 after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...he worked around four IL stints in 2025 to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP in 16 games (13 starts).

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,046).

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market.

AT THE HELM: Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

ROAD TRIP: Tonight is the eighth game of a 10-game road trip for the Astros...the Astros are 1-6 so far on this road trip...Houston went 41-40 on the road last season...following this four-game series in Seattle, the Astros will face the Colorado Rockies for a three-game series at Daikin Park from April 14-16.

AGAINST THE MARINERS: The Astros and Mariners face each other tonight for the second of 13 scheduled matchups in 2026...the Astros went 5-8 against the Mariners in 2025, including 2-4 record at T-Mobile Park...Houston owns a 132-98 all-time regular season record against Seattle...the Mariners will travel to Daikin Park for the first of two road trips to Houston from May 11-14 for a four-game series.

ON THE MEND: **LHP Bennett Sousa** will begin a rehab assignment with Triple A Sugar Land tonight...he began the season on the Injured List due to a left oblique strain.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have optioned **RHP J.P. France** to Triple A Sugar Land...to take his place on the active roster, the Astros recalled **RHP Jayden Murray**.

IMAI UPDATE: **RHP Tatsuya Imai** flew back to Houston today for further evaluation due to right arm fatigue.

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: The Houston Astros were defeated by the Seattle Mariners, 6-9 last night at T-Mobile Park...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (0.1IP, 1H, 3ER, 4BB) made the start for the Astros but wasn't able to get out of the first inning...**LF Yordan Alvarez** (2x3, HR, 3RBI) and **C Christian Vázquez** (2x3, 2B, 3RBI) led the way offensively for the Astros.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the American League in runs (85), doubles (35), total bases (216), hits (130), walks (71), SLG (.449), OBP (.372) and OPS (.821)...individually, **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads the AL in walks (14), OPS (1.266) and OBP (.516)...**2B Jose Altuve** ranks tied for first in the AL in runs (12) and **1B Christian Walker** ranks second in the AL in doubles (6) and tied for second in RBI (13).

TUVE VS. THE MARINERS: **2B Jose Altuve** has hit .311 (242x779) with 48 doubles, 21 homers, 96 RBI and an .828 OPS in 191 career games against the Mariners...he already ranks third all-time in hits vs. SEA, trailing only **Cal Ripken Jr.** (261) and **Michael Young** (259), and ranks eighth all-time in games played vs. the Mariners.

NO. 1000: **C Christian Vázquez** and **1B Christian Walker** each appeared in their 1,000th career game last night vs. SEA...Vázquez ranks third among active catchers in games, behind **KC Salvador Perez** (1,721g) and **PHI J.T. Realmuto** (1,383g)...Walker has played in games with Arizona (819g) Houston (168g) and Baltimore (13g).

MOVIN' ON UP: **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 175th career home run last night at SEA...the home run moved into sole possession of seventh place on the Astros all-time home run list, passing franchise icon **OF George Springer**...next up on the Astros all-time list is **3B Alex Bregman** (191 HR).

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: On Monday, **LF Yordan Alvarez** was named the American League Player of the Week for the week of March 30-April 5...Alvarez batted .471 (8x17) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, seven walks and a 1.733 OPS for the week...marked the fourth time that Alvarez has been named the AL Player of the Week.

YORDAN'S CYCLE: On July 21, 2024 at Seattle, **DH Yordan Alvarez** recorded his first career cycle and the 10th cycle in Astros franchise history...it was the second cycle in T-Mobile Park history (also, **Miguel Tejada** on Sept. 29, 2001)...it was also the first cycle by an Astros left-handed hitter since **Luke Scott** hit for the cycle on July 28, 2006 vs. ARI...he also became the only DH to hit for the cycle in Astros history and ninth in MLB history (last, **Jake Bauers** on June 14, 2019).

LAST START, 4/5 at ATH: took the mound on April 5 at ATH and spun 4.0 scoreless innings before allowing 2 men to get on base via a single and a walk to start the bottom of the 5th inning...a subsequent RBI double provided the 1st run allowed off McCullers Jr. for the afternoon, ending his day with 2 runners on...both runs would later score on a triple...finished the day after 4.0+ innings with 3 runs allowed on 5 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts (79 pitches-45 strikes)...did not receive a decision as the Astros dropped the game 12-10 in extras.

SEASON DEBUT: had a spectacular debut to his 2026 season, striking out 9 over 7.0 innings while allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk (96 pitches-63 strikes) on March 30 vs. LAA...was his longest start since also tossing 7.0 innings on Sept. 21, 2022 at TB...was his longest start while allowing 1-or-fewer runs since allowing 1 run through 7.0 innings on July 16, 2021 at CWS...was his longest start in a season debut in his 9-year MLB career and were his most strikeouts in a season debut since striking out 10 batters on March 31, 2018 at TEX...is also the longest start by an Astro and tied for the 2nd-longest start by an AL pitcher this season.

VS. SEA: including the postseason, has gone 10-3 with a 2.95 ERA (38ER/116IP), 136 strikeouts (10.55 SO/9IP) and a .206 opponent batting average through 21 career starts vs. the Mariners...his 21 starts vs. the Mariners (including the postseason) are the 3rd-most among active players, behind former teammate **RHP Justin Verlander** (41) and **LHP Martín Pérez** (26)...his 2.95 career ERA against the Mariners ranks 3rd among active pitchers (min. 55.0 innings)...in 2 starts against the Mariners last season, he held a 7.71 ERA (6ER/7.0IP) with 6 walks and 9 total strikeouts.

2025 RECAP: made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark...ended the season with 51 wins, directly trailing **RHP Mark Portugal** for No. 22 on the franchise's all-time list.

GROUNDING: is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.4% ground-ball rate ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP Framber Valdez** (62.3%) and **RHP Logan Webb** (57.9%).

ABOUT MCCULLERS JR.: the 2017 All-Star has made 148 apps. (142 starts) in 9 MLB seasons with Houston (2015-18, 2020-22, 2025-26), posting a 52-37 record with a 3.69 ERA (322ER/785IP) and 874 strikeouts (9.98 SO/9IP)...missed the 2019 and 2023-24 seasons due to injury.

ROAD WARRIOR: on the road in 2025, he recorded a 2.59 ERA (9ER/31.1IP) with 26 strikeouts, two quality starts and a .230 opponent batting average.

MILESTONE ACHIEVED: with his 1.0 inning pitched Wednesday at COL, he has surpassed **RHP Ryan Pressly** for the 11th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...is now 3.2 innings from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** for 10th-most.

VS. SEA: has struck out 50 batters through 35.0 innings in 32 career appearances vs. the Mariners, holding an impressive 12.86 SO/9IP with a 3.34 ERA (13ER/35.0IP)...has the most strikeouts among active relievers against Seattle with 50.

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last 8 seasons (2019-26)...owns 17 saves, a 2.84 ERA (105ER/333.1IP) and 456 strikeouts in 333.1 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks 4th in strikeouts (456) and 7th in appearances (322).
